- The Aztecs (9-9, 3-4) return to Viejas Arena for a pair of home games this week. On Thursday they host Air Force (10-9, 4-4) at 6 p.m. and then on Saturday, SDSU takes on the first place New Mexico Lobos (17-4, 8-0) at noon.
- Air Force is coming off a 40-39 loss to Nevada where they had just seven players available due to health and safety protocols.
- The Aztecs lost at New Mexico 75-72 Jan. 9, the closest margin of victory the Lobos have had this season. In that game, SDSU nearly had three players finish with double-doubles (Adams; 21 pts, 9 rebs, Avinger; 10 pts, 9 assists; Villalobos; 17 pts, 11 rebs).
- New Mexico plays at UNLV (15-4, 7-1) Thursday night in a battle between the top two teams in the conference.
- SDSU lost at Nevada 58-46 last Wednesday. They committed a season high 24 turnovers which led to 23 points for the Wolf Pack. It was the Aztecs first loss when holding a team under 60 points (4-1).
- SDSU has played their last two games with just eight scholarship players available.
- The Aztecs are second in the MW in opponent field goal percentage (.375) and third in opponent three-point percentage (.299).
- SDSU is second in the conference in defensive rebound percentage (.750) in Mountain West games.
- Sophia Ramos (San Antonio, Texas) is one of three active four-year players with career totals of at least 1,300 points, 500 rebounds, 350 assists and 100 steals (Ohio's Erica Johnson & Florida's Kiara Smith). She is currently in the top 10 in program history in seven statistical categories, including points, assists and made threes.
- Ramos is second in the conference in steals and is in the top 100 nationally in five statistical categories.
- Mallory Adams (Frisco, Texas) leads SDSU in scoring (15.6) and rebounding (7.7) in conference games. She is shooting 46.2 percent from deep in Mountain West play and has made the second most threes in Mountain West games.
- Ramos (.404) and Adams (.398) are second and third respectively in the conference in three-point percentage.
- Asia Avinger (Cerritos, Calif.) has won two of the last three MW Freshman of the Week awards and leads all MW freshmen in the in scoring and assists. On Jan. 15, she scored 30 points on 10-for-12 shooting against Boise St. to become the first Aztec freshman to score 30 or more points in the MW era. She is one of just six freshmen in the nation to score 30 or more points in a game.
- Kim Villalobos (Van Nuys, Calif.) is averaging 8.8 rebounds over her last five games.

Sophia Ramos Enters Senior Year with Sights Set on SDSU Record Books

- Barring injury, senior guard Sophia Ramos (San Antonio, Texas) could finish her career in the top five all-time in points and assists and become the only Aztec ever with 1,500 points, 400 assists and 500 rebounds in a career. She is also one of the best free-throw and three-point shooters in program history.
- Ramos is one of three active four-year players with career totals of at least 1,300 points, 500 rebounds, 350 assists and 100 steals (Florida's Kiara Smith & Ohio's Erica Johnson).
- Ramos is in the top 10 all-time in seven categories: 3-point field goal percentage, 3-point field goal attempts, 3-point field goals made, 3-point field goal attempts, assists, field goal attempts, made free throws and points.
- Career records aren't kept for free throw percentage, but she has two
 of the top ten single-season marks for free throw percentage. She was 85
 percent from the line in 2019-20 and 83.1 percent last year.
- Ramos is the 13th Aztec to reach 1,000 points in three seasons or less and the 10th to do it in 70 or fewer games.

Asia Avinger Named Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year

- Redshirt freshman point guard Asia Avinger (Cerritos, Calif.) was named the Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year by select media and the league's coaches.
- Avinger won the award prior to last year as well but then suffered a season-ending injury.
- She is the first player to ever win the Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year twice.
- Avinger is the highest ranked recruit under head coach Stacie Terry-Hutson. She was one of the nation's best prep combo guards in 2020 earning a ranking of No. 56 in the nation according to espnW.
- Following her senior year, she was named the Orange County Register's Female Athlete of the Year and to the MaxPreps All-California First Team.
 She was also named the Trinity League MVP and the Orange County Player of the Year.
- As a senior she averaged 13.8 points, 6.3 rebounds and 4.0 assists and helped lead Rosary High School to the 2020 CIF Southern California DI Regional championship before the tournament was suspended due to COVID-19. Rosary HS won the 2019 State Championship and Avinger took home tournament MVP honors after scoring 24 points in the championship game.
- Avinger's twin brother Noah is on the Aztec football team and became the first freshman cornerback to start a game since 2009. Her older brother Lucky is also on the team.

Opponent Notebook (Air Force)

- The Falcons are 10-9 overall and 4-4 in the Mountain West.
- They are 4-5 in road games.
- Thursday will be their fourth game in the last eight days. The first three were all at home.
- They are coming off a 40-39 loss to Nevada where they suited up just seven players.
- They lead the Mountain West in six defensive categories, including scoring defense (57.1) and turnovers forced per game (21.5).
- They are second to last in the conference in scoring, averaging 61.4 points per game.
- Riley Snyder leads the Falcons with 14.8 points per game. She makes a living at the line, where she is 72-for-80 on the year (.900).
- Haley Jones averages 8.6 rebounds per game, the second most in the conference.
- Cierra Winters averages 3.0 steals per game, tops in the MW and 10th in the nation.
- Head coach Chris Gobrecht (7th season) has over 40 years of collegiate head coaching experience and over 600 wins. She has been a head coach at Cal State Fullerton (1979-85), Washington (1985-96), Florida State (1996-97), USC (1997-04) and Yale (2005-2015) before coming to the Academy.

Series Notes

- The Aztecs lead the all-time series 37-13 but are just 4-6 in the last 10 meetings.
- SDSU is 18-6 all-time against the Falcons in San Diego.
- Air Force went 2-1 against SDSU last year and beat the Aztecs 56-48 in the first round of the Mountain West Tournament last year.
- Neither team has topped 60 points in their last four meetings.
- Their first meeting was Jan. 1, 1997, a 70-41 Aztec win. SDSU won 13 of the first 14 meetings.

Opponent Notebook (New Mexico)

- The Lobos are 17-4 overall and 8-0 in conference play.
- They are 5-2 on the road.
- Entering the week, they are one of 10 teams in the nation on a nine-game win streak or
- They lead the conference with 77.4 points per game.
- They are second in the nation with 206 made threes and in made threes per game (10.3).
- They shoot 38.1 percent from three, the ninth highest in the country and 45.8 percent from the field (21st).
- They made 21 three-pointers against Utah St. on Jan. 6, a new MW single-game record.
- They are the only team in the conference with five players averaging double-digits in scoring (McGruder, de la Cerda, LaTora Duff, Latascya Duff and Anderson).
- Shaiquel McGruder is ninth in the nation in field goal percentage (.604).
- Latascya Duff is sixth in the nation in made threes (52) and 3-point percentage (.470).
- Head coach Mike Bradbury (6th season) is 111-59 (.653) all-time at New Mexico and is closing in on 300 wins for his career.

Series Notes

- New Mexico leads the all-time series 37-32.
- The Aztecs have played the Lobos more times than any other program.
- SDSU is 15-14 all-time against the Lobos in San Diego.
- New Mexico beat SDSU 75-72 in Albuquerque on Jan. 9. The game featured 11 lead changes and eight ties. The Aztecs trailed by 14 points with 5:33 left and then scored 17 points in the final five minutes and nearly pulled off the incredible comeback.
- The Aztecs outrebounded the Lobos 53-35 including a remarkable 24-8 advantage on the offensive glass which led to a 16-1 edge in second chance points for SDSU.
- Their first meeting was Jan. 18, 1992, a 91-44 Aztec win.

Aztecs Partner with Jordan Brand

The San Diego State women's basketball program is the newest member of the Jordan Brand family.

Beginning this season, the team will wear the latest Jordan Brand footwear and all on-court apparel including uniforms, practice gear and travel attire will be Jumpman branded.

SDSU is the ninth women's basketball program in the Jordan lineup, joining Florida, Georgetown, Houston, Marquette, Michigan, North Carolina, Oklahoma and UCLA. The Aztecs are one of just two programs on the West Coast to be partnered with the brand.

The apparel will feature San Diego State's official color scheme of red and black elements and will sync with Jordan Brand's iconic colors.

The San Diego State men's team has been partnered with the Jordan Brand since the beginning of the 2018-19 season.

"We are excited to be a part of this special brand," Head coach Stacie Terry-Hutson said. "We recognize that we are in elite company being one of the few women's programs to don the Jumpman logo. Jordan is one of the most popular shoes in the basketball community and this will help us market the San Diego State program.

Aztecs Add Jason Glover and Kellie Lewis to Coaching Staff

Head coach Stacie Terry-Hutson added two new assistant coaches in the offseason in Jason Glover and Kellie Lewis.

Glover was most recently the Associate Head Coach at USC (2017-21) and brings over 30 years of coaching experience to SDSU including 15+ years at the DI level. Glover, who has spent time in the NBA, WNBA, NBA G-League and junior college, is known for being an X's and O's tactician and has an impressive track record in player development.

Glover, who attended SDSU for two years, has spent the past eight seasons as an associate head coach at the DI level. He was at USC for the last four years coaching under Mark Trakh, who he also coached with at New Mexico State for the 2016-17 season. That year the Aggies went 24-7 and 14-0 in the WAC and reached the NCAA Tournament.

Lewis was most recently at Colorado State (2018-21) and comes to SDSU with 17 years of DI experience, including five as the head coach at Florida Atlantic.

Lewis also spent a combined nine years at Nebraska (2007-12) and Washington (2003-17) as an assistant while also coordinating each program's recruiting efforts. In her career, Lewis has coached in the Big Ten, Big 12, Pac-12 (then Pac-10), Conference USA and Sun Belt.

During Lewis' last two years at Colorado St., the Rams were second in the nation for fewest turnovers per game. Last season, CSU went 15-6 overall and 11-5 in the Mountain West and ranked in top ten nationally in four categories (turnovers/game, assist-to-turnover ratio, three-point % and defensive rebounds/game).

Lewis coached a high-scoring offense throughout her tenure as head coach of Florida Atlantic, including the program's No. 2 all-time single-season scoring offense both by total points (2,331) and average (77.7) in 2013-14. Her teams made 195 three-pointers or more in four of her five seasons and broke the school record for threes in a season twice. The Owls sunk 264 triples in 2013-14, then 294 in 2015-16, a Conference USA record.

In addition to those single-season three-point field goal records, FAU also set the program record for highest team three-point field goal percentage (.350) in 2015-16.

Terry-Hutson also announced the hiring of Mel Boscarino as the Director of Player Development She joins the women's basketball team after working for SDSU's event management department since 2019.


