Snapdragon Stadium Spotlight

- San Diego State returns home to host San Jose State at 7 p.m. PT on Thursday at Snapdragon Stadium. The match
 will be the first women's collegiate soccer match ever held at the brand-new facility.
- All-time the Aztecs are 14-2-3 against the Spartans, and have been successful against them under Head Coach Mike Friesen, having posted a 12-1-3 record under him.
- After facing the Spartans at Snapdragon Stadium, the Aztecs will return to the SDSU Sportsdeck on Sunday for another
 conference matchup against Fresno State. All-time the Aztecs are 14-5-2 against the Bulldogs, and are extremely
 successful as well against them under Friesen, 8-3-2.
- During conference play as a whole, San Diego State has reached eight of the last nine Mountain West Tournament Championship matches, and has advanced to the NCAA tournament in four of those seasons. 2021 was the only season that the Aztecs did not reach the MW tournament final in those nine seasons.
- SDSU has been widely successful in the Mountain West Conference. Since the Aztecs joined the conference in 1999
 San Diego State boasts a .675 winning percentage, and an overall record of 116–50-23. Additionally, under Friesen
 the Aztecs have a .723 winning percentage and an overall record of 93-31-15.

The Season So Far

- The Aztecs were up at altitude to take on Colorado College and Air Force this past week and took home four points from the two matches. San Diego State tied with Colorado College 3-3, after being down 3-0 after the first 35 minutes, and then beat Air Force 2-1 to earn their second MW win of the campaign.
- Emma Gaines-Ramos earned MW Player of the Week for her four assist performance against Colorado College and Air Force. The junior from San Diego had two assists against each squad and is now up to six assists on the year heading into the San Jose State match. Denise Castro also scored twice over the weekend, bringing her tally to seven on the season, which is tops on the squad.
- Two weeks agp SDSU opened conference play against Colorado State and Wyoming. The Aztecs fell in the conference opener against Colorado State, 2-0. That was followed by a bounce-back game for SDSU, who ran out with a 2-1 win over Wyoming on Sunday. Emma Gaines-Ramos scored her fourth goal of the season to give the Aztecs a 1-0, before the Cowgirls equalized in the 59th minute. Kiera Utush then scored the game-winner in the 80th minute to give the Aztecs the win.
- In mid-September, the Aztecs traveled north to Los Angeles, where they took on the No. 1 ranked UCLA Bruins. San

Alexa Madueno made eight saves in the SDSU goal that night.

- San Diego State earned their third draw in a row last Friday when they played Saint Mary's to a 2-2 draw on the Sports Deck.
 In rainy conditions the Aztecs got goals from Deinse Castro and a penalty by Gaines-Ramos to earn a point. The match was the team's third consecutive draw, and is the first time in team history that SDSU has drawn three times in a row.
- The Aztecs earned two hard fought draws on Thursday and Sunday against cross-town foes University of San Diego and UC San Diego. On Thursday, the Aztecs and Toreros squared off, but neither team was able to find the back of the net and the teams finished level at 0-0. Claire Watkins hit the post twice in the draw, while Denise Castro was sent off late in the match and the Aztecs had to play with 10 for the final 20 minutes.
- Against UC San Diego, the Aztecs went down 1-0 at the halftime break. But goals from Logan Nidy and a penalty from Kiera
 Utush 44 seconds apart gave the Aztecs a 2-1 lead in the 58th minute. However, the Tritons would equalize in the 89th minute to earn the 2-2 draw.
- The Aztecs also drew at Long Beach State on Aug. 25, 2-2. With the Aztecs down 2-0 in the 82nd minute, Castro and Trinity
 Coker got San Diego State level in the final minutes as the Aztecs stole a draw on the road. Coker's game-tying goal was the
 first of her career. The Aztecs would then travel to No. 14 Pepperdine on Aug. 28 and fell 4-0 in Malibu, Calif.
- In the season opener the Aztecs traveled to Nebraska to take on the Cornhuskers. The Aztecs would come out of the match with a win in dramatic fashion, as Castro earned the Aztecs the win 2-1, in the 90th minute. Off a cross from Lauren Dicus, Castro headed the ball into the back of the net, earning her first game-winner of the season. She also scored the Aztecs first goal of the match in the 28th minute, and finished the night with a brace for the second time in her career.

As for the match against Idaho, the Aztecs initially trailed 1-0, before marching to a 7-2 win on the Sports Deck. The Aztecs
scored five goals in the span of 23 minutes during the first half. Gaines-Ramos scored two goals, including the first penalty of
the season. Six Aztecs got on the score sheet, including freshman Logan Nidy and sophomore Olivia Sekimoto who scored their
first career goals.

Draws on the Deck

San Diego State have drawn four matches so far out of their 10 matches played this season. They also had a three-match draw
streak, having drawn at home against the University of San Diego 0-0, UC San Diego 2-2, and most recently Saint Mary's, 2-2. It
was the first time in program history that the Aztecs have earned three ties in a row.

At The Peak

Denise Castro (San Ysidro, Calif.) entered 2022 as the Aztecs top returning goal-scorer from the 2021 season when she bagged
eight goals. The sophomore sensation has started the 2022 campaign on a tear, scoring five goals and assisted twice in nine matches, including the game-winner over Nebraska to open the season. That goal came in the 90th minute with 28 seconds remaining in
the match, and gave the Aztecs a 2-1 win to start the season. She also scored the game-winner in the Aztecs 7-2 win over Idaho on
August 28. Castro has seven goals this season to lead the team, and is tied for 31st in the country in total goals.

Shot Stopper

Junior keeper Alexa Madueno has moved into the top-10 all-time in career saves this season. Madueno has played in 35 matches
and stopped 166 shots in her career, including 51 so far this season, putting her seventh all-time in career saves.

Sharing The Wealth

- San Diego State scored a total of nine goals in the first two weeks of the season, including putting seven past Idaho on August 28.
- Those seven goals scored against Idaho were the most the Aztecs had scored in a match since the 2008 season when the Aztecs beat the Air Force Academy 7-0.
- The Aztecs have a total of 12 assists through seven matches this season, and nine different players have assisted on those goals.
- Denise Castro, Emma Gaines-Ramos, and Rachelle Elve all have two assists, Trinity Coker, Lauren Dicus, Olivia Sekimoto, Grace Goins, Hope Paredes and Kiera Utush have one.

Team Notes

- Castro earned Mountain West Offensive Player of the Week for her performance in the Aztecs opening two matches. She totaled seven points over the two matches, scored three goals and dished out an assist. The award was the first Offensive Player of the Week award of Castro's career.
- Entering the second week of the season, the Aztecs are the only Mountain West team to win both of their matches, going 2-0. Utah
 State and Boise State also have not lost, but each have at least one tie on their record.
- Head Coach Mike Friesen enters his 16th campaign leading the Mountain West's most dominant women's soccer program. Friesen
 has guided his squad to ten Mountain West championships (five tournament and five regular season), and five NCAA Tournament
 appearances, both the most among any current league head coach. Now in his 16th season of conference play, Friesen has an
 93-31-15 record. His 93 league victories are the most by any head coach in Mountain West history (the inaugural season of the
 MW was in 1999).
- Friesen's 167 victories (167-107-39) since the start of the 2007 season, the year he took control of the program, are the most
 by any current coach in the Mountain West and rank second in league history (Jennifer Rockwood, BYU, 190 victories). Colorado
 College's Geoff Bennett's 150 victories in the last 15 seasons ranks second among current MW head coaches.
- San Diego State is picked to finish in second place in the MW coaches' preseason poll. This marks the 12th time in 13 seasons the
 Aztecs have been picked to finish in either first or second place. The only time SDSU was lower than second place in the preseason
 poll in the last 13 years was in 2019, a year in which the Aztecs were predicted to finish fourth. That team went 10-9-1, shared the
 Mountain West regular-season title at 8-2-0, and reached the championship game of the league tournament.
- Having won five of the last nine regular-season titles, not including the 2020 season in which the league was divided into two divisions and the Aztecs earned the West Division title, SDSU finds itself not the favorite in the eyes of the conference's head coaches for just the third time in the last nine years.
- The Aztecs have won nine of the last 19 MW trophies (regular season and tournament), all of which have come under the direction
 of head coach Mike Friesen. In total, the 16th-year head coach has guided San Diego State to 11 conference titles.
- San Diego State has earned 11 Mountain West titles since the conference's inception in 1999. SDSU was the regular season champions in 1999, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015 and 2019. The program was the tournament champion in 2009, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2017, and its five tournament titles are the most among any current member of the Mountain West and the second best in the league's history (BYU, 7).
