# 2022 Mountain West Championship - Semifinal Round

(5) San Diego State (7-5-7, 5-3-3 MW) vs. (1) Wyoming (7-6-5, 6-3-2 MW)

#### **Pressure Moments**

- San Diego State enters the Mountain West tournament semifinal after a marathon penalty shootout in the quarterfinal
  round against Utah State. The No. 5 seeded Aztecs earned a thrilling 19-18 penalty shootout win over the Aggies to
  advance to the semifinals and will play top seeded Wyoming on Wednesday at 4 p.m. MT.
- In what is believed to be an NCAA record, the Aztecs prevailed over Utah State after 22 rounds of penalties on Sunday. In total 44 penalty kicks were taken during the shootout, and 37 of those kicks were scored as the Aztecs emerged victorious after a marathon of spot kicks.
- SDSU heads into the semifinal round of the tournament having only given up three goals in their last nine matches
  of the 2022 season. The Aztec backline lead by keeper Alexa Madueno has also posted six shutouts over those nine
  matches
- As for Wyoming, SDSU earned a 2-1 win over the Cowgirls during regular season play. Goals from first-team all-conference member Emma Gaines-Ramos, and second-team selection Kiera Utush sealed the win for the Aztecs on the SportsDeck. All-time the Aztecs are 18-6-2 against Wyoming, and are 13-4-1 under Friesen.
- During conference play as a whole, San Diego State has reached eight of the last nine Mountain West Tournament
  Championship matches, and has advanced to the NCAA tournament in four of those seasons. 2021 was the only
  season that the Aztecs did not reach the MW tournament final in those nine seasons.

#### Aztec Accolades

- Four Aztecs earned spots on the Mountain West all-conference teams, which was announced on Sunday afternoon.
   Denise Castro, Gaines-Ramos, Grace Goins, and Utush garnered All-Mountain West honors. Castro and Gaines-Ramos earned first-team honors, while Utush earned a second-team selection, and Goins was named to the newcomers team.
- Castro, a sophomore midfielder/forward, earned first-team all-conference honors for the first time in her SDSU career.
   The MW offensive player of the week for the week of August 22nd, earned six points during conference play. She scored the game winning goal at Air Force to give the Aztecs a 2-1 win, and scored the Aztecs second goal in the 3-3 comeback draw with Colorado College. The San Ysidro, California native also tallied two assists during the MW campaign, appeared in all 11 contests for SDSU throughout the conference season, and started all 11 games and played 934 minutes in conference play.
- Gaines-Ramos broke out in a big way in 2022 en-route to her first career first-team all-conference selection. The
  junior from San Diego, lead the Aztecs and was in the top three in the conference in almost every offensive statistical
  category during conference play. Gaines-Ramos scored three goals in conference play and tallied five assists during
  the 2022 MW season. Her five total assists put her in a tie for first in the conference, and her 0.45 assists per match
  average was also tied for first in the conference.

- Utush, a senior defender from Rocklin, California earned second-team all-conference honors and played an integral part in the
  Aztecs defense all season. She started and completed all 90 minutes in all 11 conference matches, totaling 990 minutes of play
  during conference action. Utush also scored the game winning goal in the Aztecs 2-1 win over Wyoming and provided an assist
  on the third goal in the Aztecs 3-3 comeback draw with Colorado College. Defensively, Utush was part of a backline that gave up
  iust three goals during the final eight matches of conference play, and helped the Aztecs post five shutouts in conference action.
- Goins, a freshman defender from Folsom, California earned a spot on the newcomers team. As a true freshman Goins started and
  played in all 11 matches throughout the conference slate for the Aztecs, totaling 990 minutes of action during conference play. A
  force at centerback for SDSU, Goins helped the Aztecs give up just three goals in their final eight conference matches, and played
  an integral part in the Aztecs only giving up nine goals during conference play as a whole. Goins was the only defender named to
  the Mountain West all-Newcomers team.

# The Season So Far

- Despite losing or drawing in their final four matches SDSU enters the MW tournament with one of the best defensive records in the league. The Aztecs gave up less than a goal per game in league play, and posted a 0.82 goals given up per game average throughout conference play.
- SDSU struggled into the three most recent matches at Boise State, at Utah State and at New Mexico. The Aztecs failed to score a
  goal in any of those contests but still came away with the two points needed to secure a spot in the Mountain West tournament.
- Two weeks ago the Aztecs earned a win over Nevada, 3-0, on the SportsDeck on senior night. Carlin Blake and Emily Lowe scored their first career goals to give the Aztecs a 1-0 lead and a 3-0 lead respectfully. SDSU would then fall to UNLV on Sunday 1-0. In that match the Aztecs had 13 shots but could not find the back of the net.
- Earlier in October, San Diego State went a perfect 2-0 as the Aztecs took down both San Jose State at Snapdragon Stadium 2-0,

and beat Fresno State 1-0 to take all six possible points. In front of 2,546 on Thursday at Snapdragon Stadium the Aztecs got a late goal from Emma Gaines-Ramos to seal the 2-0 win. SDSU also beat Fresno State on Sunday courtesy of a perfect free kick from Trinity Coker to earn the hard fought 1-0 win.

- The Aztecs were up at altitude to take on Colorado College and Air Force at the end of September and took home four points
  from the two matches. San Diego State tied with Colorado College 3-3, after being down 3-0 after the first 35 minutes, and then
  beat Air Force 2-1 to earn their second MW win of the campaign.
- Emma Gaines-Ramos earned MW Player of the Week for her four assist performance against Colorado College and Air Force.
   The junior from San Diego had two assists against each squad and is now up to six assists on the year heading into the San Jose State match. Denise Castro also scored twice over the weekend, bringing her tally to seven on the season, which is tops on the squad.
- In late September SDSU opened conference play against Colorado State and Wyoming. The Aztecs fell in the conference opener
  against Colorado State, 2-0. That was followed by a bounce-back game for SDSU, who ran out with a 2-1 win over Wyoming on
  Sunday. Emma Gaines-Ramos scored her fourth goal of the season to give the Aztecs a 1-0, before the Cowgirls equalized in
  the 59th minute. Kiera Utush then scored the game-winner in the 80th minute to give the Aztecs the win.
- In mid-September, the Aztecs traveled north to Los Angeles, where they took on the No. 1 ranked UCLA Bruins. San Diego State
  fell 2-0 in the match, courtesy of a UCLA goal at the end of the first half and the beginning of the second half. Alexa Madueno
  made eight saves in the SDSU goal that night.
- San Diego State earned their third draw in a row when they played Saint Mary's to a 2-2 draw on the Sports Deck. In rainy
  conditions the Aztecs got goals from Deinse Castro and a penalty by Gaines-Ramos to earn a point. The match was the team's
  third consecutive draw, and is the first time in team history that SDSU has drawn three times in a row.
- The Aztecs earned two hard fought draws on Thursday and Sunday against cross-town foes University of San Diego and UC San
  Diego. On Thursday, the Aztecs and Toreros squared off, but neither team was able to find the back of the net and the teams
  finished level at 0-0. Claire Watkins hit the post twice in the draw, while Denise Castro was sent off late in the match and the
  Aztecs had to play with 10 for the final 20 minutes.
- Against UC San Diego, the Aztecs went down 1-0 at the halftime break. But goals from Logan Nidy and a penalty from Kiera
   Utush 44 seconds apart gave the Aztecs a 2-1 lead in the 58th minute. However, the Tritons would equalize in the 89th minute to earn the 2-2 draw.
- The Aztecs also drew at Long Beach State on Aug. 25, 2-2. With the Aztecs down 2-0 in the 82nd minute, Castro and Trinity
  Coker got San Diego State level in the final minutes as the Aztecs stole a draw on the road. Coker's game-tying goal was the
  first of her career. The Aztecs would then travel to No. 14 Pepperdine on Aug. 28 and fell 4-0 in Malibu, Calif.
- In the season opener the Aztecs traveled to Nebraska to take on the Cornhuskers. The Aztecs would come out of the match with
  a win in dramatic fashion, as Castro earned the Aztecs the win 2-1, in the 90th minute. Off a cross from Lauren Dicus, Castro
  headed the ball into the back of the net, earning her first game-winner of the season. She also scored the Aztecs first goal of the
  match in the 28th minute, and finished the night with a brace for the second time in her career.
- As for the match against Idaho, the Aztecs initially trailed 1-0, before marching to a 7-2 win on the Sports Deck. The Aztecs scored five goals in the span of 23 minutes during the first half. Gaines-Ramos scored two goals, including the first penalty of the season. Six Aztecs got on the score sheet, including freshman Logan Nidy and sophomore Olivia Sekimoto who scored their first career goals.

# At The Peak

- San Diego State has multiple players in the top-10 in terms of overall stats in the conference in a variety of categories. Denise Castro
  currently leads the conference in total game-winning goals with three, while she is also fourth in the conference in total points with
  18, tied for third in goals scored with 7, and is tied for fifth in the conference in shots on goal with 19.
- Emma Gaines-Ramos is also amongst the leaders in the MW Conference. She ranks first in assists with seven, third in points with 19, tied for fourth in shots on goal with 22, and is tied for fourth in goals with seven.

Shot Stopper

Junior keeper Alexa Madueno has moved into the top-10 all-time in career saves this season. Madueno has stopped 205 shots
in her career, including 90 so far this season, putting her fifth all-time in career saves at San Diego State. Her 90 saves during the
2022 campaign puts her in a tie for fifth all-time on the single season saves list.

**Sharing The Wealth** 

- San Diego State scored a total of nine goals in the first two weeks of the season, including putting seven past Idaho on August 28.
- Those seven goals scored against Idaho were the most the Aztecs had scored in a match since the 2008 season when the Aztecs beat the Air Force Academy 7-0.
- The Aztecs have a total of 24 assists through 19 matches this season, and 11 different players have assisted on those goals.

# The Chase For 100

Head Coach Mike Friesen finished the 2022 campaign with 98 career regular season MW wins at the helm of San Diego State
women's soccer. The 16-year MW veteran head coach, who is already the winningest coach all-time in conference history would
become the first MW head coach to reach the milestone in the league's history.

# Into the History Books

San Diego State women's soccer, like many programs around the country, saw an uptick in the amount of draws they earned during
the 2022 regular season due to the new rule change of no overtime in the regular season in NCAA soccer. The Aztecs posted a
program record seven draws in 2022, one more than the previous program record of six which was set in the 2004 campaign.

#### Team Notes

- Castro earned Mountain West Offensive Player of the Week for her performance in the Aztecs opening two matches. She totaled
  seven points over the two matches, scored three goals and dished out an assist. The award was the first Offensive Player of the
  Week award of Castro's career.
- Head Coach Mike Friesen enters his 16th campaign leading the Mountain West's most dominant women's soccer program. Friesen
  has guided his squad to ten Mountain West championships (five tournament and five regular season), and five NCAA Tournament
  appearances, both the most among any current league head coach. Now at the end of his 16th season of conference play, Friesen
  has an 98-34-18 record. His 98 league victories are the most by any head coach in Mountain West history (the inaugural season of
  the MW was in 1999).
- Friesen's 167 victories (172-110-42) since the start of the 2007 season, the year he took control of the program, are the most
  by any current coach in the Mountain West and rank second in league history (Jennifer Rockwood, BYU, 190 victories). Colorado
  College's Geoff Bennett's 150 victories in the last 15 seasons ranks second among current MW head coaches.
- San Diego State is picked to finish in second place in the MW coaches' preseason poll. This marks the 12th time in 13 seasons the
  Aztecs have been picked to finish in either first or second place. The only time SDSU was lower than second place in the preseason
  poll in the last 13 years was in 2019, a year in which the Aztecs were predicted to finish fourth. That team went 10-9-1, shared the
  Mountain West regular-season title at 8-2-0, and reached the championship game of the league tournament.
- The Aztecs have won nine of the last 19 MW trophies (regular season and tournament), all of which have come under the direction
  of head coach Mike Friesen. In total, the 16th-year head coach has guided San Diego State to 11 conference titles.
