- The Aztecs (13-13, 7-8) finish the regular season with three road games, beginning this week with games at Colorado State (18-7, 9-6) Thursday and Wyoming (12-11, 8-6) Saturday. The Aztecs are seventh in the Mountain West standings, right behind Wyoming (6th) and Colorado State (T-5th).
- The Aztecs beat Fresno State 77-69 last Saturday, shooting a season-high 50.8 percent from the field. Mercedes Staples tied a season-high with 21 points on 8-for-10 shooting (5-6 from three).
- SDSU finished their home schedule 10-5, their most home wins and best home winning percentage since the 2012-13 season.
- The Aztecs have four players averaging double-digit points: Sophia Ramos (14.9), Asia Avinger (12.0), Mallory Adams (10.9) & Mercedes Staples (10.7). This is just the second time in the Mountain West era (1999-present) that the Aztecs have had four players averaging 10 or more points.
- The Aztecs are averaging 33.3 points in the paint over their last six games after averaging 23.3 in their first 20 games.
- SDSU is 13-13 on the year and their total score is 1,656-1,656.
- Ramos (San Antonio, Texas) is one of four active four-year players with career totals of at least 1,400 points, 500 rebounds, 350 assists and 150 steals (Northwestern's Veronica Burton, Ohio's Erica Johnson & Florida's Kiara Smith).
- Ramos is currently in the top 10 in program history in seven statistical categories, including assists (6th), made threes (6th), made free throws (7th) and points (7th) and three-point percentage (10th).
- Ramos is second in the conference in steals per game (2.1) and minutes per game (37.2) and third in made threes (52). She is in the top 100 nationally in five statistical categories.
- Adams has over 800 points & 500 rebounds in her career and has the second most career double-doubles in the MW (14).
- Asia Avinger (Cerritos, Calif.) is one of three freshmen in the nation to average at least 12.0 points, 4.5 rebounds and 4.0 assists per game. (Notre Dame's Olivia Miles & Pacific's Anaya James). Avinger leads all Mountain West freshmen in scoring and assists.
- SDSU has three active players in the top 10 all-time in career three-point percentage. Mercedes Staples (Centerville, Utah) is fourth at 36.2 percent (59-163), Isabela Hernandez is sixth (35.9%, 60-167) and Sophia Ramos is 10th (35.1%, 148-422).
- The Aztecs are 9-3 when they shoot at least 40 percent from the floor and 9-2 when they out-assist their opponent.
- With their next win, SDSU will match its highest single-season total since the 2012-13 season.

Sophia Ramos Enters Senior Year with Sights Set on SDSU Record Books

- Barring injury, senior guard Sophia Ramos (San Antonio, Texas) could finish her career in the top five all-time in points and assists and become the only Aztec ever with 1,500 points, 400 assists and 500 rebounds in a career. She is also one of the best free-throw and three-point shooters in program history.
- Sophia Ramos (San Antonio, Texas) is one of four active four-year players with career totals of at least 1,400 points, 500 rebounds, 350 assists and 150 steals (Northwestern's Veronica Burton, Ohio's Erica Johnson & Florida's Kiara Smith).
- Ramos is in the top 10 all-time in seven categories: 3-point field goal percentage, 3-point field goal attempts, 3-point field goals made, 3-point field goal attempts, assists, field goal attempts, made free throws and points.
- Career records aren't kept for free throw percentage, but she has two of the top ten single-season marks for free throw percentage. She was 85 percent from the line in 2019-20 and 83.1 percent last year.
- Ramos is the 13th Aztec to reach 1,000 points in three seasons or less and the 10th to do it in 70 or fewer games.

Asia Avinger Named Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year

- Redshirt freshman point guard Asia Avinger (Cerritos, Calif.) was named the Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year by select media and the league's coaches.
- Avinger won the award prior to last year as well but then suffered a season-ending injury.
- She is the first player to ever win the Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year twice.
- Avinger is the highest ranked recruit under head coach Stacie Terry-Hutson. She was one of the nation's best prep combo guards in 2020 earning a ranking of No. 56 in the nation according to espnW.
- Following her senior year, she was named the Orange County Register's Female Athlete of the Year and to the MaxPreps All-California First Team. She was also named the Trinity League MVP and the OC Player of the Year.
- As a senior she averaged 13.8 points, 6.3 rebounds and 4.0 assists and helped lead Rosary High School to the 2020 CIF Southern California DI Regional championship before the tournament was suspended due to COVID-19. Rosary HS won the 2019 State Championship and Avinger took home tournament MVP honors after scoring 24 points in the championship game.
- Avinger's twin brother Noah is on the Aztec football team and became the first freshman cornerback to start a game since 2009. Her older brother Lucky is also on the team.

Beginning this season, the team will wear the latest Jordan Brand footwear and all on-court apparel including uniforms, practice gear and travel attire will be Jumpman branded.

SDSU is the ninth women's basketball program in the Jordan lineup, joining Florida, Georgetown, Houston, Marquette, Michigan, North Carolina, Oklahoma and UCLA. The Aztecs are one of just two programs on the West Coast to be partnered with the brand.

The apparel will feature San Diego State's official color scheme of red and black elements and will sync with Jordan Brand's iconic colors.

The San Diego State men's team has been partnered with the Jordan Brand since the beginning of the 2018-19 season.

"We are excited to be a part of this special brand," Head coach Stacie Terry-Hutson said. "We recognize that we are in elite company being one of the few women's programs to don the Jumpman logo. Jordan is one of the most popular shoes in the basketball community and this will help us market the San Diego State program.

Aztecs Add Jason Glover and Kellie Lewis to Coaching Staff

Head coach Stacie Terry-Hutson added two new assistant coaches in the offseason in Jason Glover and Kellie Lewis.

Glover was most recently the Associate Head Coach at USC (2017-21) and brings over 30 years of coaching experience to SDSU including 15+ years at the DI level. Glover, who has spent time in the NBA, WNBA, NBA G-League and junior college, is known for being an X's and O's tactician and has an impressive track record in player development.

Glover, who attended SDSU for two years, has spent the past eight seasons as an associate head coach at the DI level. He was at USC for the last four years coaching under Mark Trakh, who he also coached with at New Mexico State for the 2016-17 season. That year the Aggies went 24-7 and 14-0 in the WAC and reached the NCAA Tournament.

Lewis was most recently at Colorado State (2018-21) and comes to SDSU with 17 years of DI experience, including five as the head coach at Florida Atlantic.

Lewis also spent a combined nine years at Nebraska (2007-12) and Washington (2003-17) as an assistant while also coordinating each program's recruiting efforts. In her career, Lewis has coached in the Big Ten, Big 12, Pac-12 (then Pac-10), Conference USA and Sun Belt.

During Lewis' last two years at Colorado St., the Rams were second in the nation for fewest turnovers per game. Last season, CSU went 15-6 overall and 11-5 in the Mountain West and ranked in top ten nationally in four categories (turnovers/game, assist-to-turnover ratio, three-point % and defensive rebounds/game).

Lewis coached a high-scoring offense throughout her tenure as head coach of Florida Atlantic, including the program's No. 2 all-time single-season scoring offense both by total points (2,331) and average (77.7) in 2013-14. Her teams made 195 three-pointers or more in four of her five seasons and broke the school record for threes in a season twice. The Owls sunk 264 triples in 2013-14, then 294 in 2015-16, a Conference USA record.

In addition to those single-season three-point field goal records, FAU also set the program record for highest team three-point field goal percentage (.350) in 2015-16.

Terry-Hutson also announced the hiring of Mel Boscarino as the Director of Player Development. She joins the women's basketball team after working for SDSU's event management department since 2019.

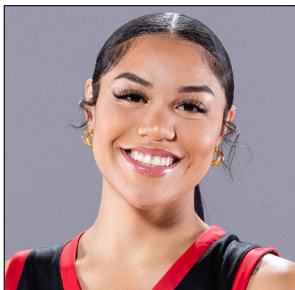

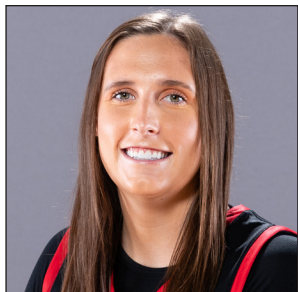
