- The Aztecs (10-11, 4-6) play at Boise State (7-14, 3-7) Saturday at 11 a.m. PT (12 p.m. MT).
- SDSU beat the Broncos 80-63 in San Diego on Jan. 15.
- Asia Avinger had 30 points against the Broncos, shooting 10-for-12 from the floor and 9-for-10 from the line. This was the first time in the Mountain West era (1999-2022) SDSU had a freshman score 30 or more points.
- Mallory Adams had a career-high 25 points and made seven three-pointers, tied for the second most in a game in SDSU history.
- This was just the fourth time in the Mountain West era that SDSU had two players score 25 or more points in a game.
- The Aztecs won at Utah State 68-67 Wednesday behind a last second fast break lay-in from Mercedes Staples. The game featured six lead changes in the final minute of the game.
- Sophia Ramos (San Antonio, Texas) scored 27 points for the second straight game making her the first Aztec in the Mountain West era to score 25 points or more in back-to-back games.
- Ramos surpassed 1,400 points for her career on Wednesday, the eighth Aztec to reach that mark. She is one of four active four-year players with career totals of at least 1,400 points, 500 rebounds, 350 assists and 150 steals (Northwestern's Veronica Burton, Ohio's Erica Johnson & Florida's Kiara Smith). She is currently in the top 10 in program history in seven statistical categories, including assists (6th), three-point percentage (6th), made threes (6th), made free throws (7th) and points (8th).
- Ramos is second in the conference in steals per game (2.1) and made threes per game (2.14) and is in the top 100 nationally in seven statistical categories.
- Mallory Adams (Frisco, Texas) is averaging (13.7) and rebounding (8.1) in conference games. She is making 2.9 three-pointers per game in MW play, the most in the Mountain West.
- Adams reached the 800 point and 500 rebound plateau at Utah State on Wednesday.
- Asia Avinger (Cerritos, Calif.) leads all Mountain West freshmen in scoring and assists.
- Kim Villalobos (Van Nuys, Calif.) is averaging 7.2 rebounds in conference play and her 3.1 offensive rebounds per game is third in the conference.
- SDSU has three active players in the top 10 all-time in career three-point percentage. Mercedes Staples (Centerville, Utah) is fourth at 37.5 percent (54-144), Sophia Ramos is sixth (35.9%, 142-393) and Isabela Hernandez is ninth (35.4%, 56-158).
- The Aztecs are second in the MW in opponent field goal percentage (.380) and opponent three-point percentage (.301) and third in rebounds per game (39.1).

## Sophia Ramos Enters Senior Year with Sights Set on SDSU Record Books

- Barring injury, senior guard Sophia Ramos (San Antonio, Texas) could finish her career in the top five all-time in points and assists and become the only Aztec ever with 1,500 points, 400 assists and 500 rebounds in a career. She is also one of the best free-throw and three-point shooters in program history.
- Sophia Ramos (San Antonio, Texas) is one of four active four-year players with career totals of at least 1,400 points, 500 rebounds, 350 assists and 150 steals (Northwestern's Veronica Burton, Ohio's Erica Johnson & Florida's Kiara Smith)
- Ramos is in the top 10 all-time in seven categories: 3-point field goal percentage, 3-point field goal attempts, 3-point field goals made, 3-point field goal attempts, assists, field goal attempts, made free throws and points.
- Career records aren't kept for free throw percentage, but she has two of the top ten single-season marks for free throw percentage. She was 85 percent from the line in 2019-20 and 83.1 percent last year.
- Ramos is the 13th Aztec to reach 1,000 points in three seasons or less and the 10th to do it in 70 or fewer games.

### Asia Avinger Named Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year

- Redshirt freshman point guard Asia Avinger (Cerritos, Calif.) was named the Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year by select media and the league's coaches.
- Avinger won the award prior to last year as well but then suffered a season-ending injury.
- She is the first player to ever win the Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year twice.
- Avinger is the highest ranked recruit under head coach Stacie Terry-Hutson. She was one of the nation's best prep combo guards in 2020 earning a ranking of No. 56 in the nation according to espnW.
- Following her senior year, she was named the Orange County Register's Female Athlete of the Year and to the MaxPreps All-California First Team. She was also named the Trinity League MVP and the OC Player of the Year.
- As a senior she averaged 13.8 points, 6.3 rebounds and 4.0 assists and helped lead Rosary High School to the 2020 CIF Southern California DI Regional championship before the tournament was suspended due to COVID-19. Rosary HS won the 2019 State Championship and Avinger took home tournament MVP honors after scoring 24 points in the championship game.
- Avinger's twin brother Noah is on the Aztec football team and became the first freshman cornerback to start a game since 2009. Her older brother Lucky is also on the team.

## Opponent Notebook (Boise State)

- The Broncos are 7-14 and 3-7 in conference play.
- They are 6-4 at home and just 1-10 in road or neutral games.
- They have lost three in a row.
- They are second in the conference in rebound margin (+5.7), rebounds per game (40.4) and blocks per game (3.6).
- They are holding their opponents to 38.3 percent shooting from the field, the third best in the conference.
- They are last in the conference in made threes per game (4.4) and three-point percentage (27.6%).
- Dominique Leonidas leads the Broncos with 11.2 points per game.
- Abby Muse averages 10.0 points and 7.7 rebound and has eight double-doubles.
- Elodie Lalotte averages 9.2 points and 6.6 rebounds.
- Head coach Gordy Presnell (17th season) has over 300 wins at Boise State and over 700 in his career (35th season). He has led Boise State to eight postseason appearances and 10 total conference titles.

## Series Notes

- The Broncos lead the all-time series 11-10.
- SDSU is 3-7 in Boise.
- Boise State has won seven of the last nine meetings, but the Aztecs have won two of the last three.
- The Aztecs beat the Broncos 80-63 in San Diego on Jan. 15.
- Asia Avinger had 30 points, shooting 10-for-12 from the floor and 9-for-10 from the line. This was the first time in the Mountain West era (1999-2022) SDSU had a freshman score 30 or more points.
- Mallory Adams had 25 points and made seven three-pointers, tied for the second most in a game in program history.
- Their first meeting was Dec. 20, 2005, a 54-51 Aztec win. SDSU won the first five meetings.

The apparel will feature San Diego State's official color scheme of red and black elements and will sync with Jordan Brand's iconic colors.

The San Diego State men's team has been partnered with the Jordan Brand since the beginning of the 2018-19 season.

"We are excited to be a part of this special brand," Head coach Stacie Terry-Hutson said.

"We recognize that we are in elite company being one of the few women's programs to don the Jumpman logo. Jordan is one of the most popular shoes in the basketball community and this will help us market the San Diego State program.

Glover, who attended SDSU for two years, has spent the past eight seasons as an associate head coach at the DI level. He was at USC for the last four years coaching under Mark Trakh, who he also coached with at New Mexico State for the 2016-17 season. That year the Aggies went 24-7 and 14-0 in the WAC and reached the NCAA Tournament.

Lewis was most recently at Colorado State (2018-21) and comes to SDSU with 17 years of DI experience, including five as the head coach at Florida Atlantic.

Lewis also spent a combined nine years at Nebraska (2007-12) and Washington (2003-17) as an assistant while also coordinating each program's recruiting efforts. In her career, Lewis has coached in the Big Ten, Big 12, Pac-12 (then Pac-10), Conference USA and Sun Belt.

During Lewis' last two years at Colorado St., the Rams were second in the nation for fewest turnovers per game. Last season, CSU went 15-6 overall and 11-5 in the Mountain West and ranked in top ten nationally in four categories (turnovers/game, assist-to-turnover ratio, three-point % and defensive rebounds/game).

Lewis coached a high-scoring offense throughout her tenure as head coach of Florida Atlantic, including the program's No. 2 all-time single-season scoring offense both by total points (2,331) and average (77.7) in 2013-14. Her teams made 195 three-pointers or more in four of her five seasons and broke the school record for threes in a season twice. The Owls sunk 264 triples in 2013-14, then 294 in 2015-16, a Conference USA record.

In addition to those single-season three-point field goal records, FAU also set the program record for highest team three-point field goal percentage (.350) in 2015-16.

Terry-Hutson also announced the hiring of Mel Boscarino as the Director of Player Development. She joins the women's basketball team after working for SDSU's event management department since 2019.

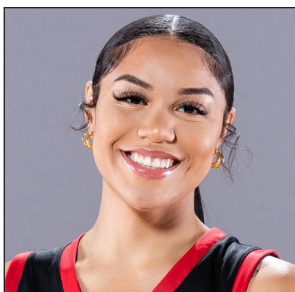

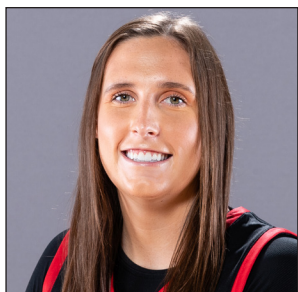
