• The Aztecs (10-12, 4-7) host Nevada (15-7, 7-3) Wednesday at 11 a.m. for SDSU's annual Field Trip Day.

Fifth Year at Nevada

- The Wolf Pack knocked off the Aztecs 58-46 three weeks ago (Jan. 19), holding SDSU to their lowest point total of the year.
- Nevada is third in the conference with a 7-3 record but is sixth in the NET rankings (152) and just seven spots above SDSU.
- SDSU split their road trip last week, winning at Utah State 68-67 behind 27 points from Sophia Ramos and a last second bucket from Mercedes Staples, and then falling at Boise State 72-63.
- The Broncos shot 49.1 percent from the field, the highest field goal percentage SDSU has allowed this season. 40 of Boise State's points came in the paint.
- Against Boise State, Khylee-Jade Pepe had a career-high 10 rebounds at Boise State Saturday with seven coming on offense.
 She also had career-highs in steals (3), field goals (3) and minutes (21).
- Ramos (San Antonio, Texas) has scored 20 or more points in three consecutive games while averaging 24.7 points and 4.7
 assists per game in that span.
- After struggling from the line early in the year, Ramos is 19-for-20 (.950) over her last three games.
- Ramos surpassed 1,400 points last week, becoming the eighth Aztec to reach that mark. She is one of three active four-year players with career totals of at least 1,400 points, 500 rebounds, 350 assists and 150 steals (Ohio's Erica Johnson & Florida's Kiara Smith). She is currently in the top 10 in program history in seven statistical categories, including assists (6th), made threes (6th), made free throws (7th) and points (8th) and three-point percentage (10th).
- Ramos is second in the conference in steals per game (2.1) and minutes per game (36.91) and is in the top 100 nationally in seven statistical categories.
- Mallory Adams (Frisco, Texas) is averaging 13.7 points and 8.1 rebounds in conference games and is making 2.9 three-pointers
 per game in MW play, the most in the Mountain West.
- Adams reached the 800 point and 500 rebound plateau at Utah State last Wednesday.
- Asia Avinger (Cerritos, Calif.) is one of three freshmen in the nation to average at least 12.0 points, 4.5 rebounds and 3.5 assists per game. (Notre Dame's Olivia Miles & Pacific's Anava James). Avinger leads all Mountain West freshmen in scoring and assists.
- SDSU has three active players in the top 10 all-time in career three-point percentage. Mercedes Staples (Centerville, Utah) is fourth at 36.7 percent (55-150), Isabela Hernandez is eighth (35.6%, 58-163) and Sophia Ramos is 10th (35.3%, 141-399).
- The Aztecs are third in the MW in opponent field goal percentage (.385) and opponent three-point percentage (.302).

Sophia Ramos Enters Senior Year with Sights Set on SDSU Record Books

- Barring injury, senior guard Sophia Ramos (San Antonio, Texas) could finish her career in the top five all-time in points and assists and become the only Aztec ever with 1,500 points, 400 assists and 500 rebounds in a career. She is also one of the best free-throw and three-point shooters in program history.
- Sophia Ramos (San Antonio, Texas) is one of three active four-year players with career totals of at least 1,400 points, 500 rebounds, 350 assists and 150 steals (Ohio's Erica Johnson & Florida's Kiara Smith)
- Ramos is in the top 10 all-time in seven categories: 3-point field goal percentage, 3-point field goal attempts, 3-point field goals made, 3-point field goal attempts, assists, field goal attempts, made free throws and points.
- Career records aren't kept for free throw percentage, but she has two
 of the top ten single-season marks for free throw percentage. She was 85
 percent from the line in 2019-20 and 83.1 percent last year.
- Ramos is the 13th Aztec to reach 1,000 points in three seasons or less and the 10th to do it in 70 or fewer games.

Asia Avinger Named Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year

- Redshirt freshman point guard Asia Avinger (Cerritos, Calif.) was named the Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year by select media and the league's coaches.
- Avinger won the award prior to last year as well but then suffered a season-ending injury.
- She is the first player to ever win the Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year twice.
- Avinger is the highest ranked recruit under head coach Stacie Terry-Hutson. She was one of the nation's best prep combo guards in 2020 earning a ranking of No. 56 in the nation according to espnW.
- Following her senior year, she was named the Orange County Register's
 Female Athlete of the Year and to the MaxPreps All-California First Team.
 She was also named the Trinity League MVP and the OC Player of the Year.
- As a senior she averaged 13.8 points, 6.3 rebounds and 4.0 assists and helped lead Rosary High School to the 2020 CIF Southern California DI Regional championship before the tournament was suspended due to COVID-19. Rosary HS won the 2019 State Championship and Avinger took home tournament MVP honors after scoring 24 points in the championship game.
- Avinger's twin brother Noah is on the Aztec football team and became the first freshman cornerback to start a game since 2009. Her older brother Lucky is also on the team.

- The Wolf Pack are 15-7 and 7-3 in conference.
- They are just 5-4 on the road and 10-3 at home.
- They had home wins against San Jose State (88-63) and Fresno State (66-67) last week.
- They have a NET ranking of 152, sixth in the Mountain West. The Aztecs are seventh at
- They are 10th in the nation in free throw percentage (.786) but attempt just 12.0 a game (265th).
- They commit just 12.6 turnovers per game and have the second best turnover margin in the conference (+5.09).
- Kylie Jimenez, the preseason Mountain West Newcomer of the Year, has the best assist-toturnover ratio in the nation (3.81).
- Audrey Roden is shooting 40.0 percent from three and has a team-high 40 made threes.
- Da'Ja Hamilton leads the team with 13.5 points per game.
- Head coach Amanda Levens (5th season) helped lead Nevada to a first round bye in last year's Mountain West Tournament after being picked to finish 10th in the preseason poll.

Series Notes

- Nevada leads the all-time series 13-12 and 10-9 since Nevada joined the Mountain West.
- The Aztecs are 8-2 all-time against the Wolf Pack in San Diego.
- SDSU has won their last four games against Nevada at home and six of their last seven.
- The teams split their two meetings last year, which were both played in Reno. The Aztecs won the first one 59-43 before falling 66-59. Tea Adams averaged 18.0 points in those
- Neither team has ever won more than three in a row in the all-time series. Nevada has won the last three.

Trakh, who he also coached with at New Mexico State for the 2016-17 season. That year the Aggies went 24-7 and 14-0 in the WAC and reached the NCAA Tournament.

Lewis was most recently at Colorado State (2018-21) and comes to SDSU with 17 years of DI experience, including five as the head coach at Florida Atlantic.

Lewis also spent a combined nine years at Nebraska (2007-12) and Washington (2003-17) as an assistant while also coordinating each program's recruiting efforts. In her career, Lewis has coached in the Big Ten, Big 12, Pac-12 (then Pac-10), Conference USA and Sun Belt.

During Lewis' last two years at Colorado St., the Rams were second in the nation for fewest turnovers per game. Last season, CSU went 15-6 overall and 11-5 in the Mountain West and ranked in top ten nationally in four categories (turnovers/game, assist-to-turnover ratio, three-point % and defensive rebounds/game).

Lewis coached a high-scoring offense throughout her tenure as head coach of Florida Atlantic, including the program's No. 2 all-time single-season scoring offense both by total points (2,331) and average (77.7) in 2013-14. Her teams made 195 three-pointers or more in four of her five seasons and broke the school record for threes in a season twice. The Owls sunk 264 triples in 2013-14, then 294 in 2015-16, a Conference USA record.

In addition to those single-season three-point field goal records, FAU also set the program record for highest team three-point field goal percentage (.350) in 2015-16.

Terry-Hutson also announced the hiring of Mel Boscarino as the Director of Player Development She joins the women's basketball team after working for SDSU's event management department since 2019.


