- The Aztecs (14-14, 8-9) finish the regular season at Air Force (16-12, 10-7) Wednesday at 5:30 p.m. PT. With a win, SDSU will be the sixth or seventh seed in this weekend's Mountain West Tournament. With a loss, the Aztecs will be the seventh or eighth seed. Final seedings and the bracket will be revealed following all conference contests Wednesday evening.
- SDSU split their road trip last week, completing a season sweep of Colorado State Thursday with a 69-61 win in Fort Collins and then falling at Wyoming 70-46 Saturday.
- With a win Wednesday, SDSU will have its highest single season win total since the 2012-13 season.
- SDSU averages just 13.0 turnovers per game, their fewest per game in school history. The Aztecs also have their second-best assist-to-turnover ratio (0.93) in the Mountain West era.
- The Aztecs have four players averaging double-digit points: Sophia Ramos (14.9), Asia Avinger (11.9), Mallory Adams (10.7) & Mercedes Staples (10.4). This is just the second time in the Mountain West era (1999-present) that the Aztecs have had four players averaging 10 or more points.
- Sophia Ramos (San Antonio, Texas) surpassed 1,500 career points at Wyoming on Saturday, moving past former Aztec greats Courtney Clements and Jené Morris and into fifth place on the SDSU all-time scoring list.
- Ramos is the only Aztec to ever have 1,500 points, 500 rebounds and 400 assists in her career. She is currently in the top 10 in program history in seven statistical categories, including points (5th), assists (6th), made threes (6th), made free throws (7th) and three-point percentage (10th).
- Ramos is one of three active four-year players with career totals of at least 1,500 points, 500 rebounds, 400 assists and 150 steals (Ohio's Erica Johnson & Florida's Kiara Smith).
- Mallory Adams (Frisco, Texas) is shooting 39.2 percent from three in conference play while making 2.5 per game, both are the second most in the Mountain West.
- Adams has over 850 points & 500 rebounds in her career and her 14 career double-doubles are the second most in the Mountain West.
- Asia Avinger (Cerritos, Calif.) is one of four freshmen in the nation to average at least 11.5 points, 4.5 rebounds and 3.5 assists per game. (Notre Dame's Olivia Miles, USC Upstate's Rachael Rose & Pacific's Anaya James). Avinger leads all Mountain West freshmen in scoring and assists.
- Mercedes Staples (Centerville, Utah) is 14-for-21 (.667) from the field and 6-for-8 (.750) from three over her last three games.
- SDSU has three active players in the top 10 all-time in career three-point percentage. Mercedes Staples is second at 38.2 percent (65-170), Isabela Hernandez is fifth (35.9%, 62-170) and Sophia Ramos is 10th (35.3%, 151-428).
- The Aztecs are 10-3 when they shoot at least 40 percent from the floor and 9-2 when they out-assist their opponent.

Mountain West Seeding Possibilities

- The Aztecs enter Wednesday with an 8-9 record in the Mountain West and in seventh place.
- With a SDSU win at Air Force and a Colorado State (9-8) loss at Wyoming (10-6), the Aztecs will be the No. 6 seed and play No. 11 San Jose State Sunday at 7 p.m.
- If SDSU wins and Colorado State wins at Wyoming, CSU will be No. 6 seed and the Aztecs will be the No. 7 seed and play the No. 10 seed, either Boise State (4-13) or Utah State (4-13) Sunday at 4:30 p.m.
- If SDSU loses and Fresno State (7-9) loses at Utah State, the Aztecs will be the No. 7 seed.
- If the Aztecs lose and Fresno State wins at Utah State, SDSU will be the No. 8 seed and play the No. 9 seed either Boise State or Utah State Sunday at 2 p.m.
- Mountain West Tournament seedings and the bracket will be released Wednesday evening once all the conference games are completed. Seeds 3-10 are up in the air entering Wednesday.

Sophia Ramos Enters Senior Year with Sights Set on SDSU

Record Books

- Senior guard Sophia Ramos (San Antonio, Texas) is the only Aztec ever with 1,500 points, 400 assists and 500 rebounds in a career. She is also one of the best free-throw and three-point shooters in program history.
- Ramos is one of three active four-year players with career totals of at least 1,500 points, 500 rebounds, 400 assists and 150 steals (Ohio's Erica Johnson & Florida's Kiara Smith).
- Ramos is in the top 10 all-time in seven categories: 3-point field goal percentage, 3-point field goal attempts, 3-point field goals made, 3-point field goal attempts, assists, field goal attempts, made free throws and points.
- Career records aren't kept for free throw percentage, but she has two of the top ten single-season marks for free throw percentage. She was 85 percent from the line in 2019-20 and 83.1 percent last year.
- Ramos is the 13th Aztec to reach 1,000 points in three seasons or less and the 10th to do it in 70 or fewer games.

Opponent Notebook (Air Force)

- The Falcons are 16-12 overall and 10-7 in the Mountain West.
- They are in fifth place in the conference and have clinched a first round bye in the Mountain West Tournament.
- They are 10-4 at home.
- They lost at Fresno State 75-67 last Saturday, but prior to that they won three games in a row.
- They lead the Mountain West in six defensive categories, including scoring defense (58.4) and turnovers forced per game (20.5).
- They are second to last in the conference in scoring, averaging 61.8 points per game.
- Riley Snyder leads the Falcons with 15.3 points per game. She makes a living at the line, where she is 75-for-84 on the year (.893), 10th in the nation.
- Haley Jones averages 9.2 rebounds per game, the second most in the conference. Her 4.4 offensive rebounds per game are the eighth most in the nation.
- Cierra Winters averages 2.7 steals per game, tops in the Mountain West and 20th in the nation.
- Head coach Chris Gobrecht (7th season) has over 40 years of collegiate head coaching experience and over 600 wins. She has been a head coach at Cal State Fullerton (1979-85), Washington (1985-96), Florida State (1996-97), USC (1997-04) and Yale (2005-2015) before coming to the Academy.

Air Force Series Notes

- The Aztecs lead the all-time series 37-14 but are just 3-7 in the last 10 meetings.
- The Falcons have won four of the last five games and the last three meetings, their longest win streak in the all-time series
- SDSU is 16-6 all-time against the Falcons in Colorado Springs.
- The last six meetings have been in San Diego or in Las Vegas. The Aztecs last true road game against Air Force was Jan. 30, 2019, a 77-65 Air Force win.
- Neither team has topped 60 points in their last five meetings. The average score over that span is 55.6-51.4 Air Force.
- Their first meeting was Jan. 1, 1997, a 70-41 Aztec win. SDSU won 13 of the first 14 meetings.

Aztecs Partner with Jordan Brand

The San Diego State men's team has been partnered with the Jordan Brand since the beginning of the 2018-19 season.

"We are excited to be a part of this special brand," Head coach Stacie Terry-Hutson said. "We recognize that we are in elite company being one of the few women's programs to don the Jumpman logo. Jordan is one of the most popular shoes in the basketball community and this will help us market the San Diego State program."

- Avinger is the highest ranked recruit under head coach Stacie Terry-Hutson. She was one of the nation's best prep combo guards in 2020 earning a ranking of No. 56 in the nation according to espnW.
- Following her senior year, she was named the Orange County Register's Female Athlete of the Year and to the MaxPreps All-California First Team. She was also named the Trinity League MVP and the OC Player of the Year.
- As a senior she averaged 13.8 points, 6.3 rebounds and 4.0 assists and helped lead Rosary High School to the 2020 CIF Southern California DI Regional championship before the tournament was suspended due to COVID-19. Rosary HS won the 2019 State Championship and Avinger took home tournament MVP honors after scoring 24 points in the championship game.
- Avinger's twin brother Noah is on the Aztec football team and became the first freshman cornerback to start a game since 2009. Her older brother Lucky is also on the team.

Aztecs Add Jason Glover and Kellie Lewis to Coaching Staff

Head coach Stacie Terry-Hutson added two new assistant coaches in the offseason in Jason Glover and Kellie Lewis.

Glover was most recently the Associate Head Coach at USC (2017-21) and brings over 30 years of coaching experience to SDSU including 15+ years at the DI level. Glover, who has spent time in the NBA, WNBA, NBA G-League and junior college, is known for being an X's and O's tactician and has an impressive track record in player development.

Glover, who attended SDSU for two years, has spent the past eight seasons as an associate head coach at the DI level. He was at USC for the last four years coaching under Mark Trakh, who he also coached with at New Mexico State for the 2016-17 season. That year the Aggies went 24-7 and 14-0 in the WAC and reached the NCAA Tournament.

Lewis was most recently at Colorado State (2018-21) and comes to SDSU with 17 years of DI experience, including five as the head coach at Florida Atlantic.

Lewis also spent a combined nine years at Nebraska (2007-12) and Washington (2003-17) as an assistant while also coordinating each program's recruiting efforts. In her career, Lewis has coached in the Big Ten, Big 12, Pac-12 (then Pac-10), Conference USA and Sun Belt.

During Lewis' last two years at Colorado St., the Rams were second in the nation for fewest turnovers per game. Last season, CSU went 15-6 overall and 11-5 in the Mountain West and ranked in top ten nationally in four categories (turnovers/game, assist-to-turnover ratio, three-point % and defensive rebounds/game).

Lewis coached a high-scoring offense throughout her tenure as head coach of Florida Atlantic, including the program's No. 2 all-time single-season scoring offense both by total points (2,331) and average (77.7) in 2013-14. Her teams made 195 three-pointers or more in four of her five seasons and broke the school record for threes in a season twice. The Owls sunk 264 triples in 2013-14, then 294 in 2015-16, a Conference USA record.

In addition to those single-season three-point field goal records, FAU also set the program record for highest team three-point field goal percentage (.350) in 2015-16.

Terry-Hutson also announced the hiring of Mel Boscarino as the Director of Player Development She joins the women's basketball team after working for SDSU's event management department since 2019.

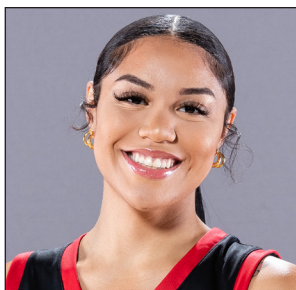

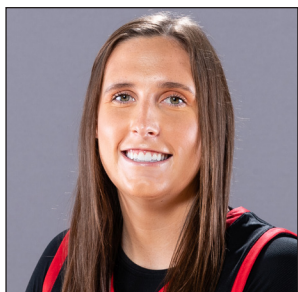
