Last Time Out

- The Aztecs started the 2022 campaign on a winning note, with wins over Nebraska (2-1) and Idaho (7-2). It was the first time the Aztecs have started the season 2-0 since the 2020 campaign.
- In the season opener the Aztecs traveled to Nebraska to take on the Cornhuskers. The Aztecs would come out of the match with a win in dramatic fashion, as **Denise Castro** earned the Aztecs the win 2-1, in the 90th minute. Off a cross from Lauren Dicus, Castro headed the ball into the back of the net, earning her first game-winner of the season. She also scored the Aztecs first goal of the match in the 28th minute, and finished the night with a brace for the second time in her career.
- As for the match against Idaho, the Aztecs initially trailed 1-0, before marching to a 7-2 win on the Sports Deck. The Aztecs scored five goals in the span of 23 minutes during the first half. Emma Gaines-Ramos scored two goals, including the first penalty of the season. Six Aztecs got on the score sheet, including freshman **Logan Nidy** and sophomore **Olivia Sekimoto** who scored their first career goals.

Amongst The Nation's Elite

- San Diego State is amongst the nation's leaders in a multitude of both team and individual categories to start the 2022 season.
- The Aztecs are currently tied for **4th** in the country in total goals scored with nine so far this season.
- San Diego State's nine total goals over two matches puts them in a tie for **6th** in the country in goals per game, at 4.50.
- Amongst teams that have played at least two matches the Aztecs are one of 14 teams to have a points per game average of 12.50 or greater, and overall are tied for **13th** in the country in total points per game with 12.50.
- In total assists the Aztecs are tied for 16th in the nation with seven assists over their opening two matches. Additionally, SDSU is in a tie for 20th nationally in assists per game with 3.50.

At The Peak

- Denise Castro** (San Ysidro, Calif.) entered 2022 as the Aztecs top returning goal-scorer from the 2021 season when she bagged eight goals. The sophomore sensation has started the 2022 campaign on a tear, scoring three goals in

two matches, including the game-winner over Nebraska to open the season. That goal came in the 90th minute with 28 seconds remaining in the match, and gave the Aztecs a 2-1 win to start the season. She also scored the game-winner in the Aztecs 7-2 win over Idaho on Sunday.

- Entering this week's matches, Castro is tied for FIRST in the nation in game-winning goals with two, is tied for THIRD in the country in goals scored with three, and tied for THIRD in total points with seven.
 - Emma Gaines-Ramos (San Diego, Calif.) is also amongst the upper echelon in total goals. After the first week of matches Gaines-Ramos is tied for 15th in the country in goals scored with two.
- ### Sharing The Wealth
- San Diego State scored a total of nine goals last week, including putting seven past Idaho on Sunday.
 - Those seven goals scored against Idaho were the most the Aztecs had scored in a match since the 2008 season when the Aztecs beat the Air Force Academy 7-0.
 - The Aztecs have a total of seven assists through two matches this season, and all seven have come from a different player. San Diego State is the only team in the country to have had seven different players record an assist, and are the only squad with all of their assists being divided equally amongst all seven players.

Team Notes

- **Castro** earned Mountain West Offensive Player of the Week for her performance in the two matches. She totaled seven points over the two matches, scored three goals and dished out an assist. The award was the first Offensive Player of the Week award of Castro's career.
- Entering the second week of the season, the Aztecs are the only Mountain West team to win both of their matches, going 2-0. Utah State and Boise State also have not lost, but each have at least one tie on their record.
- Head Coach **Mike Friesen** enters his 16th campaign leading the Mountain West's most dominant women's soccer program. Friesen has guided his squad to ten Mountain West championships (five tournament and five regular season), and five NCAA Tournament appearances, both the most among any current league head coach. Now in his 16th season of conference play, Friesen has an 93-31-15 record. His 93 league victories are the most by any head coach in Mountain West history (the inaugural season of the MW was in 1999).
- Friesen's 165 victories (167-105-35) since the start of the 2007 season, the year he took control of the program, are the most by any current coach in the Mountain West and rank second in league history (Jennifer Rockwood, BYU, 190 victories). Colorado College's Geoff Bennett's 150 victories in the last 15 seasons ranks second among current MW head coaches.
- The Aztecs are opening the season on the road for the second time in nine seasons and for the first time since 2017 when they opened the season at UCLA. In season openers on the road the Aztecs are 6-7. Now in its 34th campaign, SDSU has a 19-14-1 record overall in season openers.
- San Diego State is picked to finish in second place in the MW coaches' preseason poll. This marks the 12th time in 13 seasons the Aztecs have been picked to finish in either first or second place. The only time SDSU was lower than second place in the preseason poll in the last 13 years was in 2019, a year in which the Aztecs were predicted to finish fourth. That team went 10-9-1, shared the Mountain West regular-season title at 8-2-0, and reached the championship game of the league tournament.
- Having won five of the last nine regular-season titles, not including the 2020 season in which the league was divided into two divisions and the Aztecs earned the West Division title, SDSU finds itself not the favorite in the eyes of the conference's head coaches for just the third time in the last nine years.
- The Aztecs have won nine of the last 19 MW trophies (regular season and tournament), all of which have come under the direction of head coach Mike Friesen. In total, the 16th-year head coach has guided San Diego State to 11 conference titles.
- San Diego State has earned 11 Mountain West titles since the conference's inception in 1999. SDSU was the regular season champions in 1999, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015 and 2019. The program was the tournament champion in 2009, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2017, and its five tournament titles are the most among any current member of the Mountain West and the second best in the league's history (BYU, 7).
- San Diego State has been predicted to finish either first or second in the preseason poll in 12 of the last 13 years and enters this season as the most decorated program in the Mountain West with six regular-season and five tournament titles, as well as six NCAA appearances.

Opponent Notebook

Long Beach State

The Aztecs head into Thursday match against Long Beach State with a 5-5-1 record against the Beach. Long Beach State is led by 17th year head coach Mauricio Ingrassia, and are 0-1-1 on the season. The drew their first match against the University of the Pacific 2-2, before falling to #15 USC 1-0. In the first match against Pacific, the went down 1-0 and 2-1 before finding the equalizing goals from Maddy Perez and Lena Silano. Silano was also named to The United Soccer Coaches Preseason forwards watch list. She scored 11 of the Beach's 19 goals last season. The two teams met last season, and Long Beach came out on top. 2-1.

No. 14 Pepperdine

The Aztecs will play Pepperdine for the 12th time overall on Sunday, and hold a 3-8-0 mark all-time against the Waves. Pepperdine spent all of 2021 ranked in the United Soccer Coaches Poll, and have been placed in the top 25 again this season, at No. 14 heading into this week's matches. They posted a 17-4-1 record last season and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the 12th time. The Waves opened the 2022 season with two shutout victories, first against CSUN 8-0 during the home opener and then a 1-0 road win at UC San Diego. They also return goal scorer Tori Waldeck who scored nine goals for the Waves last season.
