Big Notes

- F Jaedon LeDee records a double-double in the first half and finishes with 15 points and 13 rebounds overall for his fourth double-double of the season in seven games.
- The Aztecs win their ninth straight game at home, and improve to the following at home:
 - 41-2 in their last 43
 - 59-5 in their last 64
 - 68-6 in their last 74

Team Notes

- SDSU improves to 16-5 against the current members of the PacWest Conference.
- The Aztecs had a 41-26 lead at the half, and have won 12 straight games and 197 of their last 221 (197-24) when leading at intermission.
- SDSU improves to 395-15 in its last 410 games when leading with five minutes to play.
- San Diego State wins its 15th straight game when outrebounding its opponent and is now 114-12 under Brian Dutcher. The Aztecs have won 66 of their last 69 and 83 of their last 87 when winning the rebound battle.
- SDSU wins its 27th consecutive game when attempting more free throws than its opponent (6-0 this season, 104-8 under Brian Dutcher).
- San Diego State improves to 128-9 under Brian Dutcher when shooting better than its opponent (46-3 in last 49, 100-5 in last 105 and 130-9 in last 139).

- The Aztecs held Point Loma to 29.3 percent shooting from the floor for their 15th straight win when holding their opponent to under 35 percent (50-2 in Brian Dutcher era).
- SDSU wins its 11th straight game and is 103-23 in its last 126 when outscoring the opponent's bench.
- Brian Dutcher improves to 36-9 in games played in the month of November.
- San Diego State is now 70-18 in the 11th month since the beginning of the 2010-11 season.
- The Aztecs move to 25-4 on Monday games since the start of the 2010-11 season.
- SDSU has won 18 straight games when wearing white uniforms, including its last three games on neutral court, and are now 70-7 in its last 77 games in its white kit.
- San Diego State moves to 50-25 under Brian Dutcher when its opponent scores first.
- SDSU outscored Point Loma Nazarene 14-4 in points off turnovers.
- San Diego State outscored Point Loma Nazarene in bench points 23-8.
- San Diego State outscored the Point Loma Nazarene 4-0 in fast break points.

Series Notes

- San Diego State improves to 10-5 against Point Loma Nazarene and has won five in a row and six of its last seven meetings.
- As a Division I program, SDSU moves to 3-0 against PNLU.

Game Flow

- San Diego State won the tip.
- Point Loma Nazarene scored the first points of the game on a 3-pointer at 18:36.
- Elijah Saunders scored the Aztecs first points on a jumper at 18:08.
- San Diego State used a 14-0 run over 3:38 in the first half to turn a 6-2 deficit into a 16-6 lead.
- San Diego State's six 3-pointers in the first half equals a season-best set vs. Long Beach State (11/14).

Player Notes

Jaedon LeDee – 15 points, 5-8 FG, 13 rebounds, 1 blocked shot, 1 steal

Achieved his 26th career double-digit scoring game, 18th as an Aztec and his seventh straight to open the season... Had his fourth double-double of the season and sixth of his career, all with the Aztecs... Reached his double-double

<u>in the first half with 13 points and 10 rebounds</u>... Led the team in scoring for the sixth time this season in seven games... Also led the team in rebounding for the seventh straight game... Through the first seven games of the season, is averaging 24.0 points and 10.4 rebounds on 57.1 percent shooting from the floor (56-for-98).

Reese Waters — 14 points, 3-6 3PFG, 3-3 FT, 4 rebounds, 2 assists, 1 steal

Has now scored in double figures in all seven games as an Aztec and nine straight for his career (had two over his final games at USC last season)... Has 23 career double-figures scoring games... Made multiple 3-pointers for the fifth time in seven games, including three for a third time.

Lamont Butler — 10 points, 3 rebounds, 3 assists, 1 steal

Scored in double figures for the second time this season and 28th time of his career (SDSU is 23-5)... Had multiple assists for the sixth time in seven games this season.

Darrion Trammell — 8 points, 3 rebounds, 5 assists, 3 steals, +24 plus/minus ratio

Led the team in assists for the third time this season and 70th time of his career... Had a game-high +24 plus/minus ratio.

Jay Pal — 6 points, 3-4 FG, 3 rebounds, 1 assist, +21 plus/minus ratio

Had the most points (6) of his Aztec career... SDSU outscored its opponents by 21 points when he was in the game (14 minutes).
