### San Diego State vs. Stanford Postgame Notes

## Final Score: San Diego State 74, Stanford 60

### Big Notes

- San Diego State has won 62 of its 67 home games (62-5) since the start of the 2019-20 season, and its five home losses are tied for the third fewest in the nation in that time frame.
- The 14-point victory by the Aztecs is their largest over a Pac-12 opponent since beating No. 20 UCLA by 15 points (73-58) on Nov. 5, 2020.
- SDSU wins its third game against a Pac-12 opponent this season, only trailing its four wins vs. the Big West.
- San Diego State commits just seven turnovers in the game. In its three games against Pac-12 opponents this season, SDSU has only 20 turnovers (6.7 per game) while its three Pac-12 opponents have 43 (14.3 per game).
- **G Lamont Butler** became the third Aztec under Brian Dutcher to record at least 18 points, 4 assists and 4 steals in a game, joining current Toronto Raptors Malachi Flynn (Jan. 21, 2020 vs. Wyoming) and Jalen McDaniels (Jan. 26, 2019 vs. UNLV).

### Team Notes

- SDSU improves to 2-4 against Stanford in the all-time series, including 1-2 in San Diego.
- San Diego State wins its 12th straight home game, and has won 43 of its last 45 home games (43-2), 61 of its last 66 (61-5) and 70 of its last 76 (70-6).
- SDSU improves to 89-10 under Brian Dutcher at home.
- The Aztecs have won 19 straight non-conference games at Steve Fisher Court at Viejas Arena (6-0 this season) and 30 of their last 31 (30-1) non-conference home games since the Jan. 1, 2019.

- SDSU improved to 164-27 (.859) in its last 191 non-conference games played at Steve Fisher Court at Viejas Arena and has won 44 of its 49 non-conference home games since the start of the 2015-16 campaign.
- The Aztecs had a 34-32 lead at the half and have won 15 straight when leading at the half. SDSU is 154-8 in its last 162 home games and 206 of their last 230 (206-24) when leading at intermission.
- San Diego State was up, 64-51, with five minutes left and moves to 397-14 (.966), including 144-10 under Brian Dutcher, and has won 15 straight games when leading with five minutes to play.
- SDSU improves to 68-150 against the current members of the Pac-12 but is 8-2 against the conference since the start of the 2019-20 season.
- SDSU moves to 232-48 in its last 280 games when outscoring the opponent's bench.
- Brian Dutcher improves to 28-9 in games played in the month of December.
- San Diego State is now 72-18 in its last 90 games in the 12th month.
- The Aztecs move to 20-3 on Thursdays under Brian Dutcher and have won their last three on the day.
- SDSU is now 103-16 in its last 119 games under Brian Dutcher wearing its white uniforms.
- San Diego State wins its 18th straight game when outrebounding its opponent.
- The Aztecs have one 69 of their last 72 game when outrebounding their opponent (69-3) and 86 of their last 90 (86-4).
- The Aztecs won the battle of the boards and moves to 117-12 under Brian Dutcher and 258-38 in its last 296 games when it outrebounds its opponent.
- San Diego State improves to 83-19 in its last 99 games when committing fewer turnovers than its opponent and improves to 111-28 when having less turnovers.
- The Aztecs improve to 130-9 under Brian Dutcher when shooting better than their opponent.
- SDSU outscored Stanford in the following situations:
  - 20-10 off the bench
  - 15-6 off turnovers
  - 10-4 in second-chance opportunities
  - 32-28 in the paint
- The Aztecs improve to 106-23 in the Brian Dutcher era when outscoring the bench of their opponents.

### **Series Notes**

- San Diego State improves to 2-4 against Stanford with coach Brian Dutcher owning both Aztecs wins.
- SDSU wins its second straight game against Stanford.

### **Game Flow**

- Stanford won the tip.
- San Diego State scored the first points of the game on an alley-oop dunk by Jaedon LeDee at 18:40 with an assist from Micah Parrish.
- Jaedon LeDee was assessed two personal fouls in the first 51 seconds of the game.
- Darrion Trammell scored with three or fewer seconds left in the first half for the fourth time this season.
- San Diego State took a two-point lead, 34-32, as time expired in the first half and never trailed the rest of the way.

- San Diego State used a 15-3 run to open the second half and had a 49-35 lead with 14:33 to play.
- San Diego State opened the second half 6-of-6 from the field.
- San Diego State shot 53.8 percent in the second half (14-for-26) after shooting just 38.2 percent (13-for-34) in the first half.

### **Player Notes**

#### **Lamont Butler – 18 points, 7-13 FG, 4 assists, 4 steals, 1 block, +15 plus/minus ratio**

Scored a season-high 18 points... Recorded his fourth double digit scoring game of the year and 30th time of his career (SDSU is 25-5)... His 18 points were four more than he had the three previous games combined (14)... Led the team in scoring for the first time this season and seventh time of his career (SDSU is 6-1)... Became the third Aztec under Brian Dutcher to record at least 18 points, 4 assists and 4 steals in a game, joining current Toronto Raptors Malachi Flynn (Jan. 21, 2020 vs. Wyoming) and Jalen McDaniels (Jan. 26, 2019 vs. UNLV)... Recorded his ninth career game with at least four steals... His +15 plus/minus ratio was the highest in the game.

#### **Jaedon LeDee – 16 points, 5-8 FG, 4 rebounds, 2 assists, 1 block, 1 steal**

Scored in double figures for the 11th time this season in 11 appearances... Now has 30 career double-figure scoring games... Scored in double figures despite playing only 1:34 in the first half because of foul trouble... Scored 14 of his 16 points in the second half, playing all 20 minutes.

#### **Micah Parrish – 10 points, 5 rebounds, 3 assists, 2 steals**

Reached double figures for the eighth time in 12 appearances this season and 50th time of his career.

#### **Miles Byrd – 8 points, 2 rebounds, 2 steals**

Scored a season high and matched a career high with eight points in just 8:57... Tied a career high with two steals.

### **Other Player Notes**

- **Jay Pal** had multiple three-pointers for the second time this season (each over the last three games). Pal is 4-for-5 over the last three games from beyond the arc after starting the season 0-for-3... **Miles Heide**

grabbed seven rebounds in 16:32 in the first half without playing in the second half. Heide has 16 rebounds over his last two games in just 28 minutes (22.9 rebounds per 40 minutes).
