San Diego State (1-2) vs. No. 10 Denver (1-1) Sunday, February 25 | 12 p.m. MT | Denver, Colo. | Peter Barton Lacrosse Stadium Live Stats | Live Stream

SAN DIEGO — The Aztec Lacrosse team will travel to Denver, Colo. this Sunday to face No. 10 Denver University at 12 p.m. MT/11 a.m. PT. There is a free live stream on Pioneer All-Access.

The Aztecs last game was a 11-19 loss at home against UC Davis.

Freshman Frankie Garcia (Newport Beach, Calif.) leads the team with nine points from seven goals

and two assists, and 12 shots on goal.

Goalkeeper Avery Dyer (Elkridge, Md.) made 19 saves against UC Davis, the most by a DI player so far this season and the second most in SDSU history. She leads the PAC-12 in saves with 29 and is

second in the country with 16.00 saves per game.

Jenna McDermott (Westminster, Md.), in her first year at SDSU after playing at UMBC for four seasons, also has seven goals on the season, leading the team in free-position goals with four.

Sara Toner (Reston, Va.) is tied at the top of the leaderboard with Garcia with 14 shots. She also

had the game winning goal against Xavier.

The Aztecs have seven assists on 33 goals, with Nikki Seven (Crofton, Md.) and Garcia leading the team with two each.

Mia Kohn (San Diego, Calif.) leads the Aztecs with four caused turnovers.

Kate Christos (Madison, N.J.) leads the team with nine draw controls.

Dyer leads the Aztecs with eight ground balls, followed by Reilly Hunter (Toronto, Ontario, Canada) and Tatum Neach (Danville, Calif.) with four ground balls each.

After facing No. 10 Denver, the Aztecs will travel to North Carolina for a weekend to play Campbell

(March 1) and High Point (March 3).

The Aztecs will then play four straight home games including the conference opener against ASU at Snapdragon Stadium.

Opponent Notebook (No. 10 Denver)

The Pioneers opened their season ranked No. 4 in the country and their first two games consisted of a 16-8 win against Louisville and a 4-8 loss to No. 10 Michigan... Denver will face Ohio State on Friday before facing the Aztecs... Graduate Students Julia Gilbert and Olivia Penoyer lead the team with five points each, Gilbert with five goals and Penoyer with two goals and three assists... Senior Anna Palmisano leads the Pioneers with six caused turnovers... Senior Abby Jenkins leads the team with six draw controls... Junior Goalkeeper Emelia Bohi has eight saves and 16 goals allowed on 41 shots faced... Denver is 9-0 against the Aztecs.

#### **Season Preview Tidbits**

The Aztecs will be competing in the PAC-12 conference in 2024. Also joining the PAC-12 this season are the Aggies of UC Davis.

SDSU will play a challenging schedule in 2024, facing three teams ranked in the IWLCA preseason poll: No. 4 Denver, No. 10 Florida and No. 17 USC.

Key returners for the Aztecs include Brooklyne Waddell, who had 12 goals and holds the school record for most assists in a game (eight, March 12, 2023), Emma Betts, 18 points on 14 goals and four assists and Mia Kohn, seven goals in 2023 on a .438 shot percentage.

The Aztecs will have to fill the shoes of goalkeeper Sam Horan, SDSU's all-time leader in career care percentage as well as in a correct Az well as Deaphra Balanga, who horange the all time leader.

save percentage as well as in a season. As well as Deanna Balsama, who became the all-time leader in goals (109) in just two years as an Aztec and was a part of the IWLCA All-Star team in 2023, and Cailin Young, who scored 16 points from 10 goals and six assists in 2023.

Kohn along with Avery Dyer and Courtney Anderson will be the team captains this season.

SDSU has 10 newcomers (seven freshmen and three transfers), and head coach Kylee White is excited about the experience and maturity transfer Jenna McDermott (UMBC) will bring to this younger team. In her four years playing for the Retrievers, McDermott scored 33 goals, three of which were game winners. Her senior year, she started in all 14 games and was named the team's unsung hero.

As the only head coach in program history, Kylee White is now in her 13th season with the Aztecs alongside Associate Head Coach Brandi Padilla who is back for her 12th season. They are joined by new assistant coach Rob Bray who spent the last four years as the assistant coach for the women's lacrosse team at Vanderbilt

University.

Coach White's Outlook on the 2024 season

"When facing opponents from all over the country, especially top programs like Dartmouth or Florida, we're able to measure where we're at and where we're going. We're excited to finally be in the PAC-12 conference. Although we've played these teams before, it has a different meaning when there's a potential championship at the end of the season. While our ultimate goal is the tournament, our sights are set on right now. Things will take care of themselves when we take care of the little things."
