San Diego State (1-10, 0-2) vs. No. 22 Colorado (6-3, 1-1) Saturday, March 30 | 12 p.m. MT | Boulder, Colo. | Kittredge Field Live Stats | Live Stream - PAC-12 Mountain

Boulder, Colo. — The Aztec Lacrosse team heads to Boulder to face No. 22 Colorado in a conference matchup Saturday at Noon MT, 11 a.m. PT. The game will be streamed on the PAC-12 Mountain Network.

Aztec Tidbits

The Aztecs last game was a 15-12 loss against UC Davis at home.

Sara Toner (Reston, Va.) is tied with Frankie Garcia (Newport Beach, Calif.) with 26 points, including a team high 24 goals and two assists

Toner leads the Aztecs in shots (52) and shots on goal (38). She also had the game winning goal

against Xavier and is tied at the top in free position goals with six.

Jenna McDermott (Westminster, Md.), in her first year at SDSU after playing at UMBC for four seasons, is tied with Toner in free-position goals with six.

The Aztecs have 29 assists on 110 goals, with Kate Christos (Madison, N.J.) leading the charge with eight assists.

Victoria Rankin (Naples, Fla.) leads the team with 40 draw controls. Mia Kohn (San Diego, Calif.) leads the Aztecs with 11 caused turnovers. Goalkeeper Avery Dyer (Elkridge, Md.) made 19 saves in the first game against UC Davis and Caitlin Boughton (South Riding, Va.) tied Dyer with 19 saves in the game against Liberty. They are tied for the sixth most saves in a single game by a DI player so far this season and the second most in SDSU history.

Dyer and Boughton lead the Aztecs with 14 ground balls.

Boughton is 19th in the nation and second in PAC-12 in saves with 89, 26th in Save Percentage (0.468) and 27th in Saves per Game (8.90).

The Aztecs return home next weekend to face Stanford.

Opponent Notebook (No. 22 Colorado)
The Buffaloes are 6-3 overall, 1-1 in conference where their most recent victory was a 15-7 win over Cal... Senior Madeline Pisani leads the team with 37 points from a team high of 32 goals alongside 5 assist, including 12 free-position goals... Pisani is ranked fourth in the nation in free-position percentage (0.833), 10th in free-position goals per game (1.25), and 11th in shots on goal per game (6.00), leading the conference in each category... Senior Ashley Stokes leads the Buffaloes nine assists... Sophomore Jess Peluso leads the team with 19 ground balls and 19 caused turnovers... Freshman Aidan Carr leads the Buffaloes with 28 draw controls... Senior Goalkeeper Danielle Heintz has 59 saves and 100 goals allowed on 210 shots faced... The Buffaloes last faced the Aztecs 17-4... The Buffaloes are undefeated in all nine matchups with the Aztecs.

Season Preview Tidbits

The Aztecs will be competing in the PAC-12 conference in 2024. Also joining the PAC-12 this season are the Aggies of UC Davis.

SDSU will play a challenging schedule in 2024, facing three teams ranked in the IWLCA preseason poll: No. 4 Denver, No. 10 Florida and No. 17 USC.

Key returners for the Aztecs include Brooklyne Waddell, who had 12 goals and holds the school record for most assists in a game (eight, March 12, 2023), Emma Betts, 18 points on 14 goals and four assists and Mia Kohn, seven goals in 2023 on a .438 shot percentage.

The Aztecs will have to fill the shoes of goalkeeper Sam Horan, SDSU's all-time leader in career save percentage as well as in a season. As well as Deanna Balsama, who became the all-time leader in goals (109) in just two years as an Aztec and was a part of the IWLCA All-Star team in 2023, and

Cailin Young, who scored 16 points from 10 goals and six assists in 2023.
Kohn along with Avery Dyer and Courtney Anderson will be the team captains this season.
SDSU has 10 newcomers (seven freshmen and three transfers), and head coach Kylee White is excited about the experience and maturity transfer Jenna McDermott (UMBC) will bring to this younger team. In her four years playing for the Retrievers, McDermott scored 33 goals, three of which were game winners. Her senior year, she started in all 14 games and was named the team's unsung hero.
As the only head coach in program history, Kylee White is now in her 13th season with the Aztecs alongside Associate Head Coach Brandi Padilla who is back for her 12th season. They are joined by new assistant coach Rob Bray who spent the last four years as the assistant coach for the women's lacrosse team at Vanderbilt University.
