SAN DIEGO — The Aztec Lacrosse team returns home for four home games in ten days. To start it off, they will face No. 11 Florida on Friday, March 8 at 3 p.m. PT. They will then face Liberty on Monday, March 11 at Noon PT. Both games will be streamed on the Aztec Women's Lacrosse Youtube channel.

Aztec Tidbits

The Aztecs last game was a 17-14 loss against High Point in North Carolina.

Jenna McDermott (Westminster, Md.), in her first year at SDSU after playing at UMBC for four seasons, is tied for the most goals on the team with 13 goals and is tied for the lead on the team in free-position goals with five. She is 12th in the nation in shot percentage (0.684).

Sara Toner (Reston, Va.) leads the team with 15 points from 13 goals and two assists, as well as in shots (27) and shots on goal (19). She also had the game winning goal against Xayier.

Freshman Frankie Garcia (Newport Beach, Calif.) is tied with McDermott with five free-position

The Aztecs have 17 assists on 67 goals, with Kate Christos (Madison, N.J.) and Brooklyne Waddell (Wilsonville, Ore.) leading the charge with four assists each.

Christos also leads the team in draw controls with 24.
Mia Kohn (San Diego, Calif.) leads the Aztecs with seven caused turnovers.

Goalkeeper Avery Dyer (Elkridge, Md.) made 19 saves in the game against UC Davis, the third most by a DI player so far this season and the second most in SDSU history.

Dyer leads the Aztecs with 11 ground balls, followed by Caitlin Boughton (South Riding, Va.) with

Next weekend the Aztecs will have their final non-conference match-up as they face Dartmouth on March 15, and then they will have their conference opener gaginst ASU at Snapdragon Stadium on March 17.

Opponent Notebook (No. 11 Florida)

The Gators lost their first two games against ranked teams before defeating No. 5 University of Maryland in overtime and have not lost a game since... Senior Maggi Hall leads the team with 30 points from 13 goals and 17 assists... Hall reached 200 career points in the game against UC Davis on March 6... Graduate Student Emily Heller leads the Gators with 14 goals and scored her 100th career goal against UC Davis... Senior Liz Harrison leads the team with 61 draw controls, including a career high and Florida high 19 draw controls against UC Davis... Harrison is 9th in the nation with 8.40 draw controls per game Freshman Gabbi Koury and Sophomore Theresa Bragg lead the Gators with three caused turnovers each... Senior Goalkeeper Georgia Hoey has 28 saves and 21 goals allowed on 65 shots faced... Florida has only faced the Aztecs in 2015 where they came out on top 17-7.

Opponent Notebook (Liberty)

The Flames are 2-4, with three of their four losses coming against ranked teams... Senior Mackenzie Lehman leads the team with 20 points from 15 goals and five assists, as well as in draw controls with 27... Senior Olivia Glaze leads the team with eight assists... Sophomore Katie Colavito leads the team with 18 ground balls and is second in draw controls with 26... Three players are tied with 15 caused turnovers and they are all ranked in the top 15 in caused turnovers per game... The team leads the nation in caused turnovers per game with 16.60... Junior Goalkeeper Mara Tellers has eight saves and 26 goals

allowed on 45 shots faced... Liberty and SDSU have faced twice in the past, and the Aztecs came out on top in both matches, taking down the Flames 18-12 in 2015 and 11-10 in 2018.

Season Preview Tidbits

- The Aztecs will be competing in the PAC-12 conference in 2024. Also joining the PAC-12 this season are the
- Aggies of UC Davis.
 SDSU will play a challenging schedule in 2024, facing three teams ranked in the IWLCA preseason poll: No. 4 Denver, No. 10 Florida and No. 17 USC.
- Key returners for the Aztecs include Brooklyne Waddell, who had 12 goals and holds the school record for most assists in a game (eight, March 12, 2023), Emma Betts, 18 points on 14 goals and four assists and Mia Kohn, seven goals in 2023 on a .438 shot percentage.

 The Aztecs will have to fill the shoes of goalkeeper Sam Horan, SDSU's all-time leader in career save percentage as well as in a season. As well as Deanna Balsama, who became the all-time leader in goals (109) in just
- two years as an Aztec and was a part of the IWLCA All-Star team in 2023, and Cailin Young, who scored 16 points from 10 goals and six assists in 2023.

 Kohn along with Avery Dyer and Courtney Anderson will be the team captains this season.

 SDSU has 10 newcomers (seven freshmen and three transfers), and head coach Kylee White is excited about
- the experience and maturity transfer Jenna McDermott (UMBC) will bring to this younger team. In her four years playing for the Retrievers, McDermott scored 33 goals, three of which were game winners. Her senior
- year, she started in all 14 games and was named the team's unsung hero.

 As the only head coach in program history, Kylee White is now in her 13th season with the Aztecs alongside

 Associate Head Coach Brandi Padilla who is back for her 12th season. They are joined by new assistant coach Rob Bray who spent the last four years as the assistant coach for the women's lacrosse team at Vanderbilt University.
