SAN DIEGO – The Aztec Lacrosse team will face Cal in a conference matchup Saturday April 20th at 11 a.m. PT for their second to last regular season game. The game will be streamed on the Pac-12 Mountain Network.

Aztec Tidbits

- The Aztecs last game was a 13-12 win against Oregon at home.
- Sara Toner (Reston, Va.) leads the Aztecs with 34 points, including a team high 31 goals and three assists.
- Toner leads the Aztecs in shots (67), shots on goal (48), and free position goals (7). She also had the game winning goal against Xavier.
- The Aztecs have 35 assists on 136 goals, with Kate Christos (Madison, N.J.) leading the charge with eight assists.
- Victoria Rankin (Naples, Fla.) leads the team with 52 draw controls. She is tied at ninth for most draw controls in a season at SDSU.
- Mia Kohn (San Diego, Calif.) leads the Aztecs with 13 caused turnovers.
- Goalkeeper Avery Dyer (Elkridge, Md.) made 19 saves in the first game against UC Davis and Caitlin Boughton (South Riding, Va.) tied Dyer with 19 saves in the game against Liberty. They are tied for the sixth most saves in a single game by a DI player so far this season and the second most in SDSU history.
- Dyer, alongside Christos, leads the Aztecs with 17 ground balls.
- Boughton is 21st in the nation in Saves per Game with 9.15, 25th in the nation in save percentage (0.465), and 26th in the nation in saves (119). She is eighth in SDSU history for most saves in a season.
- The Aztecs have an eight game winning streak against Cal, winning nine of the last 10 face-offs.
- The Aztecs return home for Senior Day against USC on April 27.

Opponent Notebook (California)

The Golden Bears are 4-9 overall, 1-4 in conference... Their most recent game was a 12-11 loss to UC Davis at home... Junior Mya Wang leads the Bears with 23 goals, tied with two others for the most points at 26... Sophomore Josie Lillquist leads the team with 12 assists... Senior Kennedy Goss leads the Bears with 68 draw controls... Sophomores Clara Page and Amanda Pio lead the team with 13 caused turnovers and Page also leads in ground balls with 22... Senior Goalkeeper Callan Fritsch has 88 saves and 109 goals allowed on 280 shots faced... The Bears last faced the Aztecs in 2023 where the Aztecs came out on top 11-9... They are 3-10 in the all-time series against the Aztecs.

Season Preview Tidbits

- The Aztecs will be competing in the PAC-12 conference in 2024. Also joining the PAC-12 this season are the Aggies of UC Davis.
- SDSU will play a challenging schedule in 2024, facing three teams ranked in the IWLC A preseason poll: No. 4 Denver, No. 10 Florida and No. 17 USC.
- Key returners for the Aztecs include Brooklyne Waddell, who had 12 goals and holds the school record for most assists in a game (eight, March 12, 2023), Emma Betts, 18 points on 14 goals and four assists and Mia Kohn, seven goals in 2023 on a .438 shot percentage.
- The Aztecs will have to fill the shoes of goalkeeper Sam Horan, SDSU's all-time leader in career save percentage as well as in a season. As well as Deanna Balsama, who became the all-time leader in goals (109) in just two years as an Aztec and was a part of the IWLC A All-Star team in 2023, and

- Cailin Young, who scored 16 points from 10 goals and six assists in 2023.
- Kohn along with Avery Dyer and Courtney Anderson will be the team captains this season.
- SDSU has 10 newcomers (seven freshmen and three transfers), and head coach Kylee White is excited about the experience and maturity transfer Jenna McDermott (UMBC) will bring to this younger team. In her four years playing for the Retrievers, McDermott scored 33 goals, three of which were game winners. Her senior year, she started in all 14 games and was named the team's unsung hero.
- As the only head coach in program history, Kylee White is now in her 13th season with the Aztecs alongside Associate Head Coach Brandi Padilla who is back for her 12th season. They are joined by new assistant coach Rob Bray who spent the last four years as the assistant coach for the women's lacrosse team at Vanderbilt University.
