SAN DIEGO — The Aztec Lacrosse team will face No. 21 USC in their last conference matchup Saturday April 27th at 12 p.m. PT for senior day. The game will be streamed on the Aztec Lacrosse Youtube.

Aztec Tidbits

The Aztecs last game was a 17-13 loss against Cal in Berkeley.

- Sara Toner (Reston, Va.) leads the Aztecs with 38 points, including a team high 35 goals and three
- Toner leads the Aztecs in shots (80), shots on goal (55), and free position goals (8). She also had the game winning goal against Xavier.
 The Aztecs have 37 assists on 149 goals, with Kate Christos (Madison, N.J.) and Brooklyne Waddell
- (Wilsonville, Ore.) leading the charge with eight assists each.
 Victoria Rankin (Naples, Fla.) leads the team with 60 draw controls. She has the fourth most draw
- controls in a single season at SDSU.

Mia Kohn (San Diego, Calif.) leads the Aztecs with 13 caused turnovers.

- Goalkeeper Avery Dyer (Elkridge, Md.) made 19 saves in the first game against UC Davis and Caitlin Boughton (South Riding, Va.) tied Dyer with 19 saves in the game against Liberty. They are tied for the seventh most saves in a single game by a DI player so far this season and the second most in SDSU history.
- Dyer leads the Aztecs with 18 ground balls.
- Boughton is tied for eighth in ŠDSU history for most saves in a season.
- An Aztec victory coupled with an Oregon loss will lock in a SDSU Pac-12 Tournament appearance

Opponent Notebook (No. 21 USC)
The Trojans are 11-4 overall, 5-1 in conference... Their most recent game was a 15-6 win over No. 21 Colorado at home... Graduate Student Ella Heaney leads the Trojans with 63 points from a team-high 40 goals and 23 assists... Junior Isabelle Vitale leads the team and is 12th in the country with 41 assists... Vitale is also 11th in the country with 2.73 assists per game... Freshman Anna Regan leads the Trojans with 112 draw controls and is 13th in the country with 7.47 draw controls per game... Junior Alexis Niblock leads the team with 20 caused turnovers and 37 ground balls... Senior Goalkeeper Kate Devir has 54 saves and 91 goals allowed on 234 shots faced and is ninth in the country with a goals-against avergae of 8.54... The Trojans last faced the Aztecs in 2023 where they came out on top 16-7... They are 12-1 in the all-time series against the Aztecs.

Season Preview Tidbits

- The Aztecs will be competing in the PAC-12 conference in 2024. Also joining the PAC-12 this season are the Aggies of UC Davis.
- SDSU will play a challenging schedule in 2024, facing three teams ranked in the IWLCA preseason poll: No. 4 Denver, No. 10 Florida and No. 17 USC.

 Key returners for the Aztecs include Brooklyne No. 10 COCCO. Forms P. St. 10 Cocco.
- record for most assists in a game (eight, March 12, 2023), Emma Betts, 18 points on 14 goals and four assists and Mia Kohn, seven goals in 2023 on a .438 shot percentage.

 The Aztecs will have to fill the shoes of goalkeeper Sam Horan, SDSU's all-time leader in career
- save percentage as well as in a season. As well as Deanna Balsama, who became the all-time leader in goals (109) in just two years as an Aztec and was a part of the IWLCA All-Star team in 2023, and Cailin Young, who scored 16 points from 10 goals and six assists in 2023.
- Kohn along with Avery Dyer and Courtney Anderson will be the team captains this season.

In her four years playing for the Retrievers, McDermott scored 33 goals, three of which were game winners. Her senior year, she started in all 14 games and was named the team's unsung hero.

As the only head coach in program history, Kylee White is now in her 13th season with the Aztecs alongside Associate Head Coach Brandi Padilla who is back for her 12th season. They are joined by new assistant coach Rob Bray who spent the last four years as the assistant coach for the women's lacrosse team at Vanderbilt University
