STARTING 5

Penn State associate head coach Keith Urgo (Fairfield '02), in his eighth season on the Nittany Lions' staff, will coach the Nittany Lions Sunday.

The Nittany Lions used their sixth different starting lineup of the 2018-18 season at Michigan Thursday night (14th game).

In the last six home games vs. Wisconsin since the 2011-12 season, the largest deciding margin has been eight points with a 4.83 average point differential in the six contests.

Following his double-double effort with a game-best 12 rebounds, redshirt junior Mike Watkins now has 591 and is 21st on Penn State's career chart. He led the Nittany Lions in scoring for the first time in 2018-19 with his 19 points.

Junior forward and Julius Erving Award candidate Lamar Stevens has scored in double figures in every game this season, has six double-doubles and six games with 20 or more points in 2018-19. He has started all 86 games in his career.

LAST TIME - #2 MICHIGAN HOLDS OFF LIONS

Mike Watkins and Lamar Stevens posted double-double nights, but No. 2 Michigan held off Penn State 68-55 in the Crisler Center. Watkins had with a game-high 12 rebounds and a season-best 19 points. Stevens had 17 points and 10 rebounds.

Michigan, which had three turnovers in its first five possessions of the game, reversed that trend with only two in the second half compared to eight for Penn State, which finished with 18 overall. Four Nittany Lion turnovers in the first seven possessions helped the Wolverines build a double-digit lead early in the second half.

Penn State pulled within eight points, 55-47, after keeping Michigan without a field goal for three minutes. A 3-pointer by Charles Matthews, followed by a layup by Matthews on the next trip down the floor pushed Michigan back up to a 13-point lead.

After a Josh Reaves steal to set up a Stevens layup to put the score at 60-51, Michigan countered with a three by Ignas Brazdeikis and closed out its scoring with five free throws.

Michigan went up by as many as 10 points in the first half, 20-10, but Penn State held the Wolverines scoreless for over 5:44, and went on an 8-0 run during that time. The Wolverines had a 25-20 halftime, the second-lowest total they posted in any half this year.

Guards Reaves and Jamari Wheeler played only eight minutes each in the first half and went to the bench with two fouls each.

As a team, the Nittany Lions had a 37-29 advantage on the boards and 44 points to the Wolverines' 32, but gave up a 10-point difference in points off turnovers at 10-20. Both teams attempted 14 3-point field goals, but only one found the bottom of the net for PSU.

Jordan Poole led a trio of Wolverines in double figures with 17 and Ignas Brazdeikis also recorded a double-double with 16 points and 11 rebounds. Charles Matthews finished with 14 points.

STEVENS NAMED TO ERVING WATCH LIST

Penn State junior Lamar Stevens was named to the watch list for the Julius Erving Small Forward of the Year Award as announced in October by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. Stevens, from North Wales, Pa., is one of the 20 student-athletes selected for the watch list for the 2019 award.

Named after Class of 1993 Hall of Famer and 16-year professional basketball player Julius Erving, the annual honor in its fifth year recognizes the top small forwards in Division I men's college basketball. A national committee comprised of top college basketball personnel determined the watch list of 20 candidates.

Stevens was voted the Most Outstanding Player of the 2018 National Invitation Tournament as he helped lead Penn State to its second NIT title this past March. He scored a game-high 28 points in the championship game and with that total, eclipsed the 1,000 career point mark, becoming only the second Penn State sophomore to achieve that milestone. An All-Big Ten Conference honorable mention, Stevens recorded double figures in 33 games in 2017-18 and with 10 games of 20 points or more, including two 30-point games.

TREY-MENDOUS

Since 2011-12, Penn State has had 66 games, including four so far in 2018-19 (Jacksonville State, DePaul, Colgate & UMBC), with nine or more 3-point field goals.

Three of the top four single-game totals in the Chambers' era occurred in 2017-18: Coppin State (14), Northwestern (BTT-13, Penn State BTT record) and at Iowa (12).

TEN-DING TO DOUBLE DIGITS

Over the last 10 seasons only two Penn State freshmen scored in double digits in 10 of the first 13 games of the season: Rasir Bolton and former Nittany Lion guard Tony Carr (2016-17).

REAVES' PASSING ATTACK

Senior guard Josh Reaves has proved himself to be quite the passer. He recorded a career-best eight assists at DePaul and added five more vs. UMBC to lead the Nittany Lions so far this season with 48 total (3.4 app).

With 264 career assists, his total stands 18th behind Mike Lang's 267 (1980-83) at No. 17. Reaves had 107 assists in 2017-18, second to Tony Carr's 186.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

In preseason previews of the 2018-19 Big Ten Conference field and individual honors, senior guard Josh Reaves rises to the top as the pick for the league's top defensive player. Athlon Sports' superlatives tab Reaves and Lindy's also picked the league's two-time steals leader as its top defender.

REAVES, PRINCE OF THIEVES

Senior Josh Reaves is in sixth individually in the NCAA active career rankings for total steals (206) and ranks 11th for steals per game (2.02).

Reaves ranks fourth on Penn State's career list and needs just 13 more steals to pass Nittany Lion Titus Ivory for the No. 3 spot for PSU and No. 9 on the Big Ten Conference career list.

In addition to moving up on Penn State's career chart, Reaves snatched a spot on the single-season list with his 73 total (t-8th) in 2017-18.

BACK IN ACTION

Mike Watkins returned to competition against No. 13 Virginia Tech Nov. 27, collecting seven rebounds and adding three steals, two blocked shots and an assist to his stat line.

The Philadelphia native registered his first double-double of the 2018-19 season in his fourth game back on the floor with 18 points and 16 rebounds against Colgate.

POINTS RISING

Just one of the indicators of Penn State's increase in its offensive output was the setting of the program's record for points scored overall (2,833) and in the Big Ten (1,297) in 2017-18, with the Nittany Lions' breaking their own league scoring record from a year ago.

The 2017-18 points per game average of 74.7 was the highest since the 2000-01 season, highest under Chambers, and a 12.9-point difference from Chambers' first season in 2011-12.

The Big Ten Conference announced in October 2017 that the league's 14 men's basketball programs would move to a 20-game schedule beginning in 2018-19. The Big Ten is the first conference to play 20 conference games in the history of Division I basketball with each team playing seven opponents twice and six teams once (three home, three away) in a given season.

NEW FACES

Six newcomers joined the Nittany Lions for the 2018-19 season with four freshmen: guards Rasir Bolton, Myles Dread, Myreon Jones and Daniil Kasatkin and two transfers in guards Izaiah Brockington (St. Bonaventure) and Kyle McCloskey (Villanova-FB). McCloskey became eligible to play as of Dec. 15, 2018 and will have four years to play basketball and Brockington will have three years of eligibility.

NEW PLACES

Penn State guard and alumnus Tim Frazier (2009-14) recently signed a contract to join the NBA's New Orleans Pelicans. Shep Garner (2014-18) inked a deal with the Grand Rapids Drive of the G League during the fall while Donovan Jack (2012-16) signed with KD Hopsi Polzela in Slovenia. In June 2018, D.J. Newbill (2012-15) agreed to a new contract to play for NBL's Cairns Taipans.

Tony Carr, drafted by the New Orleans Pelicans in June 2018, is currently playing for Fiat Torino in the Italian Lega Basket Serie A. Brandon Taylor tipped off the 2018-19 season with his new team, Salon Vilpas, in Finland's Korisliiga.

6 FOR 8,719

During coach Patrick Chambers tenure at Penn State, six Nittany Lions have added their names to the 1,000-point career scoring list for a current total of 8,719 points. Three Nittany Lions finished their careers in the top 10: Tim Frazier (1,543), Shep Garner (1,629) and D.J. Newbill (1,812).

In 2017-18, Tony Carr (1,161) and Lamar Stevens became the first- and second-ever Penn State men's basketball sophomores to reach the milestone.

THE WINS

Penn State has achieved 15 or more wins in five straight years – a first for the Nittany Lion program. Prior to the 2013-17* seasons under Chambers, the Nittany Lions had not previously reached at least 15 wins in four consecutive seasons since joining the Big Ten.

The Lions had at least eight regular-season, non-conference wins in each of Chambers' seven seasons with 10 in 2017-18.

BIG WINS

With the February 3, 2018 Big Ten victory over Iowa, the 2017-18 Nittany Lions made another impact on Penn State's Big Ten basketball history. Following the 2017-18 season, Patrick Chambers claimed the highest per year wins average among Penn State men's basketball coaches at 16.14 wins per season. Elmer Gross (1949-54) averaged 16 wins during his five-year tenure.

ON THE ROAD, AGAIN

Penn State won six "true" away games (at an opponent's arena) in 2017-18, a total achieved only four times since joining the Big Ten Conference for the 1992-93 season. The 11 "away from home" wins logged was the most since the 2000-01 campaign (11).

FIRST 20-WIN SEASON SINCE 2008-09

Coach Chambers and the Nittany Lions posted the first 20-win season since 2008-09 and Penn State's 10th season with 20 or more wins, fifth in its Big Ten era. The 26-win total is the second-highest all-time.

EARLIEST TO 21 WINS

When Penn State recorded its 21st win of the 2017-18 season, a thrilling 69-68 win over No. 13 Ohio State in the quarterfinals of the Big Ten Tournament on March 2, it marked the earliest, by date, that Penn State achieved 21 wins.

AH-MAZING MARCH

March was amazing for the Nittany Lions as they won seven games during the month, tied for the most by a Penn State team. The 2017-18 squad also posted the highest-ever win percentage in conference and postseason games in March 2018, at 87.5 percent (7-1 record).

TOP HALF

Penn State finished in a tie for sixth in the 2017-18 Big Ten standings, earning the No. 7 seed in the 2018 Big Ten Tournament. The sixth-place finish was only the third time in history the Nittany Lions have finished in the top half of the standings and sixth time finishing above .500 at 9-9.

The No. 7 seed is highest achieved in Chambers' tenure and is tied for second-highest since the Big Ten Tournament started in 1998 (#6 – 2009, 2011, #7 - 1998, 2008).

BIG BYE

Penn State earned a bye in the first round for only the second time in the 20-year tournament history, its first in 2016.

LUCKY 7

Penn State became the first No. 7 seed to advance to the Big Ten Tournament semifinals since 2011 (Michigan State). It was the Nittany Lions' fourth trip to the semifinals since the inception of the tournament in 1998 and second under Chambers.

29 GAMES WITH 70+ POINTS

Penn State scored 70 or more points 29 times in 2017-18, the most games in a single season in program history and breaking the old record by five games (24, 1999-2000)

POWER RANKINGS

At the end of the 2017-18 season, Penn State had climbed to its highest rankings of the season in kenpom.com (19), the ESPN Basketball Power Index (20) and Sagarin (27).

NATIONAL NOTICE

Penn State earned 19 votes in the final USA Today Coaches Top 25 poll, fifth among the other teams receiving votes. It was the first time since the 2008-09 season the Nittany Lions had been recognized. In the February 19 Associated Press poll, Penn State received six votes, the first time the program had received votes since December 29, 2014, and the most votes received since a total of 14 on January 31, 2011.

Continuing to build on the foundation for Penn State basketball's success, Keith Uργο begins his fifth season as associate head coach and eighth season overall. Uργο and Patrick Chambers, who have worked side-by-side for more than a decade, combine to create the energetic force that drives the Nittany Lion program forward.

The 2017-18 season witnessed Penn State's highly regarded recruiting classes transfer their success to the win column with 26 victories, the second-highest total in program history, an appearance in the Big Ten semifinals at Madison Square Garden, and Penn State's second National Invitation Tournament championship.

Penn State's progress and upward trajectory are products of a purposeful plan with unwavering belief and an intrinsic work ethic, with the goal of getting better each and every day. The improvements have been steady, with three more wins over ranked opponents added to those the Nittany Lions have compiled in the last seven years.

The success on the court, paired with the university's nationally ranked academic programs, an engaged alumni network that is second to none, and the opportunity to establish the Nittany Lion basketball program on the national scene offer opportunities, but Uργο and the members of the basketball staff are assets in their own right. While the Washington, D.C., native may not tout his own strengths as a coach and person, his abilities in building relationships and developing young men into the leaders of tomorrow do not go unnoticed.

Shep Garner and Tony Carr, the most recent additions to Penn State's list of professional players join Tim Frazier, now with the Milwaukee Bucks, and D.J. Newbill, with the National Basketball League's Cairns Taipans, as those who benefitted from Uργο's instruction and guidance.

Carr, Garner, Frazier and Newbill helped pave the way for the Nittany Lions' success and all etched their names in the Penn State record book. They are just a few of the student-athletes mentored by Uργο, as the list is lengthy, and includes Scottie Reynolds, the Most Outstanding Player at the 2009 NCAA East Regional, Corey Fisher, Maalik Wayns and Reggie Redding from Villanova, to name just a few.

Uργο is at the forefront of Penn State's recruiting efforts which have produced two classes that earned national rankings with more to come. The class of 2015 was the first-ever top-30 signing class in program history.

A year later, Penn State's first top-25 recruiting class took the mantle as the program's best. The 2017 class made major contributions to the Nittany Lions' milestone 2017-18 campaign with the class of 2018 prepared to do the same for the upcoming season.

Mentored by the head coaches of his two teams at Gonzaga College High School, his decision to embark on a career in coaching was influenced primarily by the assistant basketball coach at his high school.

A 2002 graduate of Fairfield University, Uργο was a two-sport athlete who played varsity basketball and lacrosse for the Stags. Following graduation, he helped develop a non-profit organization with his best friend and teammate from Gonzaga High School and his two brothers, "Playing for Peace, Inc.," designed to aide in conflict resolution. The organization is based in four locales: Durbin, South Africa, Northern Ireland, the West Bank in the Middle East, and Cypress, Greece.

Uργο's role with the organization took him first to South Africa and then to Northern Ireland, where for the next 18 months he would teach basketball to local youth and help them develop leadership skills. The organization, now operating as "PeacePlayers International," has been recognized with numerous prestigious awards including the 2007 Arthur Ashe ESPY Award for Courage.

Returning stateside in 2004, Uργο accepted a position as an assistant coach at Gonzaga and directed the junior varsity squad to a 32-7 record while assisting with the national powerhouse varsity team. A student of the game, Uργο planned trips to university campuses during the Eagles' offseason to observe programs and learn more from coaches in the collegiate ranks.

A hallway conversation, based on relationships Uργο had developed throughout his life, opened the door for an opportunity to join the Villanova basketball staff in 2007 as video coordinator. He moved up to the position of director of basketball operations and spent two seasons in that role, including 2008-09, when Villanova reached the NCAA Final Four. He was named an assistant coach for the Wildcats' 2010-2011 season.

In his five years at Villanova, the Wildcats made the NCAA Tournament every season while Uργο was on the staff, including a Sweet 16 appearance in 2008, in addition to the trip to the 2009 Final Four.

Uργο, and his wife, Kristy, have three children: Ty, Cody and Samantha.

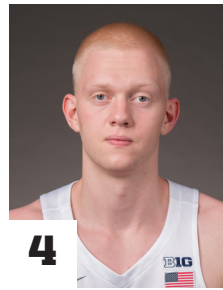
