HOME MEETS IN BOLD CAPS

NO. 25 PENN STATE WELCOMES NO. 22 MINNESOTA FOR DOUBLE DUAL

The No. 25 Penn State women's gymnastics team hosts No. 22 Minnesota on Saturday as part of a double dual with the men's gymnastics team.

Last Saturday, the Nittany Lions tallied 194.850 points, but fell against No. 17 Ohio State (196.075). Penn State won the bars (49.175) and floor (49.000) events, posting a season-best on bars.

Sophomore Lauren Bridgens won her first all-around title of the season, and the fourth of her career, with season highs in each event, including tying her career high on floor.

Senior Sabrina Garcia tied a career high on bars, winning the event with a 9.950, while Tess McCracken set a career high on bars with a 9.000.

No. 22 Minnesota enters the weekend with a 5-2 dual meet record, including a 195.475-194.350 win over No. 38 Iowa last Saturday. The Golden Gophers won all four events and sophomore Lexy Rambler won all-around.

HEAD COACH SARAH BROWN



Sarah Brown begins her second year as the head coach of the Penn State women's gymnastics team in 2018. Brown was named the eighth head coach of the Penn State women's gymnastics program on May 4, 2017. A two-time Big 12 Conference Gymnast of the Year, Brown came to Happy Valley after serving as the head coach at Eastern Michigan University.

In her first season at Penn State, Brown led the Nittany Lions to an 11-8 meet record, including three wins over ranked opponents. The Nittany Lions made an appearance in the NCAA Regionals and finished the season with a No. 32 national ranking.

Two Penn State gymnasts earned All-America honors with freshman Lauren Bridgens and senior Briannah Tsang claiming those accolades. Tsang was the Big Ten Gymnast of the Year, the eighth in program history, after winning the individual Floor Exercise title at the Big Ten Championships. Bridgens and Tsang were First Team All-Big Ten selections, while junior Sabrina Garcia was a Second Team honoree. Bridgens competed in the All-Around at the NCAA Championships.

On March 4, 2018, Bridgens set a Nittany Lion record with a perfect 10 on the Uneven Bars. Tsang earned two Top Five scores in program history on the Floor Exercise.

During her lone season as the head coach of the Eastern Michigan women's gymnastics team in 2017, Brown led the Eagles to the Mid-American Conference (MAC) regular season title, the MAC Championship, an appearance at the NCAA Regionals and a final national ranking of No. 27.

At the 2017 MAC Gymnastics Championships, Eastern Michigan tallied its second-best score in program history (196.500), recorded a school record on the uneven bars (49.300), and three gymnasts tied for the uneven bars title.

During the 2016-17 season, a total of 10 Eastern Michigan gymnasts were named Academic All-MAC and five were selected MAC Distinguished Scholars. Four of the Eagles' MAC Distinguished scholars owned a grade-point average of 3.85 or higher. During the 2016 fall semester, Brown's squad earned a combined 3.49 grade-point average and a 3.69 GPA in the spring of 2017.

Brown served for one season as a volunteer assistant coach at the University of Michigan during the 2015-16 school year, helping the Wolverines win the 2016 Big Ten Championship. She assisted on all four events and helped with development of daily practice plans. Her role with the Wolverines also included assisting with community service, recruiting and team travel.

Before joining the Michigan coaching staff, Brown was an assistant women's gymnastics coach at Southeast Missouri State University for three seasons, where she was selected the Midwest Independent Conference Assistant Coach of the Year in 2014.

Brown was the head beam coach and beam/floor choreographer and helped develop three MIC individual champions in 2014, two MIC Freshman of the Year selections and four NCAA regional all-around competitors.

She also was the director of operations for the University of Missouri women's gymnastics program for one year before starting her collegiate coaching career.

Brown began her collegiate gymnastics career at the University of Utah for one season before completing her collegiate career at the University of Missouri. A four-time All-American at Mizzou, she was the Tigers' Female Athlete of the Year in 2009 and 2010 and earned the Director of Athletics Leadership Award in 2010.

Brown brings numerous achievements from her time as a student-athlete to Penn State. Along with her All-America plaudits, Brown was selected the Big 12 Conference Gymnast of the Year in 2009 and 2010, was named to the All-Big 12 Championship Team nine times and was a nominee for the 2010 Honda Broderick Cup award.

A 2015 Missouri Athletics Hall of Fame inductee, Brown was named the 2008 Big 12 Newcomer of the Year and earned South Central Regional Gymnast of the Year honors twice (2009-10).

While she was at Utah, Brown was a member of the team that finished second at the NCAA Women's Gymnastics Championships in 2007.

Prior to her collegiate gymnastics career, she was a four-time member of the USA National Team (2002-05).

A two-time graduate of the University of Missouri, Brown earned a bachelor's degree in interdisciplinary studies with an emphasis in communication and business in 2010 and a master's of education in counseling psychology with an emphasis in sport psychology in 2012.

A native of Columbia, Missouri, the former Sarah Shire is married to Antonio Brown. Sarah and Antonio welcomed a son, Isaiah, to the family on August 9, 2017.

SCOUTING THE GOPHERS

No. 22 Minnesota enters the meet with a 5-2 record after topping No. 38 Iowa, 195.475-194.350 in its Big Ten opener. The Gophers also own wins over No. 24 Illinois-Chicago, Gustavus Adolphus, Hamline and Winona State this year.

Minnesota is averaging 195.075 points per meet. They currently rank ninth in the nation on bars (49.108), 23rd on vault (48.792), 36th on floor (48.692) and 40th on beam (48.483).

Sophomore Lexy Ramler ranks ninth in the nation in all-around, averaging a 39.483. Ramler is also third in the country on beam (9.925) and tied with teammate Ivy Lu for 17th on bars (9.883).

Last Saturday, Ramler won all-around with a 39.450 as well as vault (9.825), beam (9.950) and floor (9.825). Lu won the bars title with a 9.875.

OHIO STATE RECAP

Last weekend, the Nittany Lions won the floor and bars events, but fell 196.075-194.850 against No. 17 Ohio State.

Sophomore Lauren Bridgens won all-around with a 39.300, posting a season-high on all four events. She tied a career-best with a 9.850 on floor. She also tallied a 9.900 on bars, 9.825 on beam and 9.725 on vault.

Senior Sabrina Garcia led the Nittany Lions to a win on bars with an individual bars title for the second straight week. She tied a career-high with a 9.950. Junior Tess McCracken also had a strong performance with a 9.900 on bars, establishing a career-high. PSU totaled a season-best 49.175 on bars.

On floor, the Nittany Lions won 49.000-48.950, led by 9.850 performances by Bridgens and freshman Melissa Astarita.

Garcia had a season-high in all-around with a 39.225.

SEASON HIGHS

Penn State established numerous season and career highs against Ohio State.

Sophomore Lauren Bridgens earned season-high scores on all four events and all-around, while tying a career-high on floor.

Senior Sabrina Garcia set season-bests on all-around, vault and beam, while matching a career-high on bars.

Junior Tess McCracken established a career-high on bars. Sophomore Kourtney Chinnery set a season-high on vault (9.800), while sophomore Alissa Bonsall had a season-high 9.725 on floor.

BALANCED EFFORT

Penn State has achieved a 49.000 or higher in three events so far this season.

Last weekend, the Nittany Lions had a 49.175 on bars and 49.000 on floor.

Against Temple and Towson, PSU earned a 49.125 on bars and a 49.025 on floor. At Utah, Penn State had a 49.000 on beam, its highest in a season-opener since 2004.

The Nittany Lions also have a different high-scoring athlete for each event.

Sophomore Kourtney Chinnery has the team's top vault (9.800), while senior Sabrina Garcia owns the team's top bars performance (9.950).

Senior Mason Hosek has the team's top beam effort (9.850) and freshman Melissa Astarita has the team's top floor score (9.900).

Sophomore Lauren Bridgens has the top all-around score with a 39.300.

EVENT TITLES

As a team, Penn State has won six event titles this season. In each of the last two meets, PSU has won the bars and floor titles. The Nittany Lions also won beam against Utah and Temple/Towson.

The Nittany Lions have won four individual event titles. Senior Sabrina Garcia earned individual bars titles against Temple/Towson (9.900) and Ohio State (9.950). Sophomore Lauren Bridgens won the all-around title against Ohio State (39.300), while freshman Melissa Astarita won the floor title against Temple/Towson (9.900).

NATIONALLY RANKED NITS

As a team, Penn State currently ranks 11th in the nation on bars, with a 49.083 average, and 27th on beam, with a 48.650 average.

Senior Sabrina Garcia is tied for 17th in the nation and ranks second in the Big Ten on bars (9.883), while ranking 66th in all-around (38.725) and 69th in the country and sixth in the league on floor exercise (9.833).

Sophomore Lauren Bridgens sits tied for No. 21 in the country and fifth in the conference on bars (9.875) and No. 22 in the nation and No. 5 in the Big Ten on all-around (39.212).

On bars, sophomore Alissa Bonsall is tied 57th with a 9.825 average and junior Tess McCracken is tied 71st with a 9.817 average.

Sophomore Kourtney Chinnery sits No. 8 in the Big Ten on vault with a 9.792 average.

CHALLENGING SCHEDULE

Heading into the weekend, the Nittany Lions are set to face 14 opponents among the Top 40 of the RoadToNationals standings during the 2019 season. The Nittany Lions already competed against No. 5 Utah, No. 32 Temple and No. 17 Ohio State.

PSU is set to compete against No. 3 Florida, No. 8 Michigan, No. 14 Ohio State, No. 18 Nebraska, No. 19 Arizona State, No. 22 Minnesota, No. 26 West Virginia, No. 31 NC State, No. 32 Maryland, No. 33 Illinois and No. 40 Iowa.

BROWN BEGINS SECOND SEASON

Penn State Head Coach Sarah Brown led the Nittany Lions to an 11-8 record in her first season in Happy Valley, finishing seventh at the Big Ten Championships.

The Nittany Lions earned five wins over ranked opponents and finished the season with a No. 32 national ranking.

Brown enters her third year overall as a head coach with a 22-12 career record.

ALL-AMERICAN RETURNING

Sophomore Lauren Bridgens became the 29th All-American in program history in 2018, collecting the program's 96th All-American honor.

She was a second-team selection on Uneven Bars by the NACGC/W. A first-team All-Big Ten honoree, Bridgens won three all-around titles, three vault titles, six uneven bars titles, one beam title and one floor exercise title. She placed third in the all-around at the NCAA Regional to advance to the NCAA Championships, where she finished 29th.

Bridgens earned a perfect 10.0 on bars during the BYU Quad Meet.

BIG TEN GYMNASTS TO WATCH

Bridgens was joined by senior Sabrina Garcia being named Big Ten Gymnasts To Watch for the 2019 season.

Garcia was a second-team All-Big Ten selection in 2018 after finishing third or better in the all-around five times. She placed ninth in the all-around at the NCAA Regional. Garcia earned four uneven bars titles, one balance beam title and two floor exercise titles. She has 18 career event titles.

#RESTORETHEROAR

Bridgens and Garcia are two of 11 returners from the 2018 squad.

The group includes seniors Amber Autry, Mason Hosek, Jessica Jones and Gianna LaGuardia. Hosek owns two career event titles, including one on beam last year, while Jones has three career titles and LaGuardia won three vault titles in 2018.

Juniors Tess McCracken and Kristen Politz return to Happy Valley. Politz has one career title on floor exercise.

Alissa Bonsall, Kourtney Chinnery and Ava Verdeflor join Bridgens in the sophomore class. Bonsall earned an event title on vault last season.

WELCOME TO HAPPY VALLEY

The Nittany Lions welcomed five newcomers to the program, including two transfers.

Freshmen Melissa Astarita, Dymiana Cox and Donna Howell all joined the program. Astarita competed for Action Gymnastics in New Jersey, while Cox participated in the Junior Olympic Nationals in 2017 and 2018 as part of Parkette Gymnastics in New York. Howell competed for United Sports Academy in Pennsylvania.

Junior Erynne Allen and redshirt freshman Jessie Bastardi joined the program as transfers. Allen transferred from Kentucky where she competed in one meet as a sophomore after redshirting as a freshman. Allen earned a score of 9.525 on vault as an exhibition participant in a meet against Ball State, George Washington and Southeast Missouri State. Allen was the first Level 10 gymnast to come out of the Paulding Gymnastics club in Georgia.

Bastardi, a State College native, transferred from West Virginia. She was a Pennsylvania State Champion and National Qualifier while competing for Centre Elite Gymnastics.

PSU ON BTN

Two Penn State meets have been selected for Big Ten Network broadcasts.

The Nittany Lions hosted Ohio State on Saturday, January 19 to open the broadcast slate.

Penn State travels to Rutgers on Saturday, February 9 for a 7 p.m. meet. It will be broadcast live on BTN2Go with the broadcast being shown on Big Ten Network on February 10 at 10 a.m.

BIG TEN CHAMPIONSHIPS

For the first time since 2014, the Nittany Lions will host the Big Ten Championships at Rec Hall.

On March 23, Penn State will welcome the rest of the Big Ten for two sessions, with the first at noon and the second at 5 p.m.

FUTURE NITTANY LIONS

On December 4, Penn State signed three future Nittany Lions to National Letters of Intent.
