PENN STATE RETURNS TO BIG PLAY ON THE ROAD AT WISCONSIN

The Penn State men's soccer team, under second-year head coach Jeff Cook, returns to Big Ten action on the road when it travels to Madison, Wisc. to face the Wisconsin Badgers on Saturday, Oct. 19 at 8 p.m. ET.

PENN STATE AGAINST WISCONSIN

- Penn State leads the overall series with Wisconsin, 18-12-3, as the teams meet for the 34th time in program history Saturday.
- Last season the Nittany Lions downed the Badgers, 1-0, at home at Jeffrey Field.
- The Badgers won on their home pitch in 2017, 1-0.

SCOUTING WISCONSIN

- The Wisconsin Badgers are 2-9-2 overall and 0-3-1 in Big Ten play heading into Saturday.
- Matthew Comiskey paces the Badgers with two goals while Inaki Iribarren adds a goal and an assist for three points.
- In net, Dean Cowdroy has played all but one game, totaling 1103:15 minutes. He holds a 1.47 goals against average and a .723 save percentage.

LAST TIME OUT

- Penn State scored three-plus goals for the fourth time this season when it took down in-state rival Pittsburgh, 3-1, Tuesday evening
- Pitt got the game going early with seven shots within the first 35 minutes of action, forcing freshman goalkeeper Kris Shakes to make four saves.
- In the 37th minute, junior Callum Pritchatt was tripped up in the box, drawing a penalty to give the Nittany Lions a chance on the penalty kick. Senior captain Aaron Molloy stepped up and put the PK right past Pitt's goalkeeper to give Penn State the 1-0 advantage headed into the break.
- The Nittany Lions took no time to increase their lead immediately out of halftime, scoring two goals within two and a half minutes.
- The first came courtesy of freshman Liam Butts as he went nearpost off the back-heel pass from Molloy.
- Penn State's third goal was from freshman defender Jalen Watson after both Adam Laundree and Pierre Reedy's headers got past the Pitt backline and Watson was unmarked to get it to the back of the net.

PK PERFECTION

- Penn State has drawn three penalties in the box this season.
- Senior captain Aaron Molloy has taken all three penalty kick attempts for the Nittany Lions and converted on all three.
- Molloy is one of 13 NCAA D1 men's soccer players to be at least 3-for-3 on PKs this season.

THREE'S (GOALS) NOT A CROWD

Penn State has scored three or more goals four times this season, the most since the 2012 season.

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Liam Butts was named the Big Ten Offensive Player of the Week after a multi-goal game against Northwestern, including the game-winner in overtime.
- Butts earns his first career conference weekly award and is the first Big Ten Offensive Player of the Week for the Nittany Lions since Ethan Beckford in 2017.

NO IFS, ANDS OR BUTTS ABOUT IT

- Freshman forward Liam Butts has a tied teamhigh 12 points on six goals through the first 11 games in his rookie season.
- Butts has two multi-goal games and four gamewinning goals, good for first in the conference and seventh nationally.
- His six total goals is tied for the category lead in the conference with Michigan's Nebojsa Popovic and Pablo Avila.

WELL-ROUNDED OFFENSE

- 15 different Nittany Lions have recorded points in the 2019 season, including 10 different goal scorers.
- Penn State has scored 21 goals through 11 games, the most since the 2016 season (22).

BEST START SINCE 2014

Penn State is 7-2-2, marking the best record through 11 games since 2014, also the last time the Nittany Lions made it to the NCAA Tournament.

GOING BACK-TO-BACK (WITH TWO DEFENSIVE PLAYERS OF THE WEEK)

- Redshirt juniors Brandon Hackenberg (Sept. 24) and Josh Levine (Oct. 1) were named Big Ten Defensive Player of the Week in back-to-back
- The honor was the first Big Ten weekly award of Hackenberg's career and the second for Levine.

SENIOR CLASS AWARD

- Senior Aaron Molloy has been named one of 30 candidates for the 2019 Senior CLASS Award in collegiate men's soccer.
- To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition.
- Mollov is the first Penn State men's soccer candidate for the award since Kyle MacDonald in 2015.

NATIONAL RECOGNITION

- Penn State received votes in the United Soccer Coaches weekly poll in back-to-back weeks (Week 4 & 5).
- It marked the first time the Nittany Lions received votes in the poll since Sept. 6, 2016 when they got 10 votes.
- The Nittany Lions also earned votes in the week seven poll after an overtime win over Northwestern.

OCTOBER OVERLOAD

The Nittany Lions will play eight games in the month of October, including six within the













- friendly confines of Jeffrey Field.
- Last October, Penn State went 4-2-1 in the month, including four-straight shutouts.
- So far, the Nittany Lions are 3-1 this month.

SAVED THE BEST FOR LAST

- Senior teammates Christian Sload and Aaron Molloy are both having career-best seasons in their final year with the Blue and White.
- Sload has two goals and four assists for eight points, including a five-game points streak in the month of September.
- Molloy has five goals and two assists for a tied team-high 12 points.
- Sload's previous career season highs were a single goal in each of the last three seasons and four total points in 2017 and 2018 while Molloy had three goals in 2017.

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

- Five of Penn State's 16 regular-season opponents are ranked in the top 25 of the United Soccer Coaches' week seven poll.
- Stanford is No. 5 followed by Indiana at No. 6. UCF and James Madison both dropped a couple spots at No. 11 and No. 18, respectively. Maryland remains at No. 25.
- Penn State received votes in the week seven poll.
- The Nittany Lions are 2-2-1 with ranked or receiving-votes teams in 2019.

BLUE AND WHITE DEBUT

- 11 of the 13 Nittany Lion newcomers have seen time on the pitch in 2019.
- Jalen Watson, Andrew Privett, Liam Butts, Seth Kuhn, Alex Stevenson, Will Campbell, Michael Gaines, Adam Laundree, Kyle May and Dax Hoffman all made their debuts against Stanford on Aug. 30.

- Kris Shakes made his debut in between the pipes at Stony Brook on Sept. 2.
- Redshirt freshman Josh Dabora made his Penn State debut against Stanford on Aug. 30 after sitting out 2018.

FAMILIAR NAMES, FAMILIAR FACES

- Penn State returns 12 players from the 2018 roster, including Big Ten preseason honorees Brandon Hackenberg, Aaron Molloy and Pierre Reedy.
- Redshirt junior goalkeeper Josh Levine returns in between the pipes for the Nittany Lions after posting a career-high four shutouts in 2018 and earning Co-Defensive Player of the Week honors once.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK

- Penn State adds 13 newcomers to the 2019 roster. which includes nine freshmen, two transfers and two walk-ons.
- Seth Kuhn (Duke) and Will Campbell (UNC) re-join Coach Cook in Happy Valley from their respective universities after playing for him at the Philadelphia Union Academy.

TOP-10 RECRUITING CLASS

Head coach Jeff Cook's first six 2019 recruits in Liam Butts, Michael Gaines, Kyle May, Andrew Privett, Kris Shakes and Alex Stevenson earned top-10 recruiting class kudos from Top Drawer Soccer during the early signing period in fall 2018.

BIG TEN PRESEASON HONORS

- Senior Aaron Molloy and redshirt juniors Brandon Hackenberg and Pierre Reedy each earned a spot on the 2019 Big Ten preseason honors list as announced by the conference office.
- Molloy earned preseason honors for the third consecutive season. In 2018, Molloy was named to the All-Big Ten second team and the United Soccer Coaches All-North Region third team. The midfielder had two goals and two assists in 15 matches last season.
- Hackenberg earned preseason honors for the first time in his career. The defender appeared in all 17 matches for the Nittany Lions in 2018 as a key member of the backline that record six clean sheets, including three against Big Ten opponents. Hackenberg is a two-time Academic All-Big Ten honoree and a 2018-19 Big Ten Distinguished Scholar.
- Reedy earned preseason honors for the second time in his career. The midfielder returns to the pitch in 2019 after missing the previous two seasons due to injury. As a true freshman in 2016, Reedy was named to the Big Ten All-Freshman Team. Reedy is a two-time Academic All-Big Ten
