PENN STATE SET FOR MIDWEEK MATCH WITH JAMES MADISON

The Penn State men's soccer team, under second-year head coach Jeff Cook, is set to play its fourth game in 11 days when it hosts the 18th-ranked James Madison Dukes on Tuesday, Oct. 22 at 7 p.m. at Jeffrey Field.

PENN STATE AGAINST JAMES MADISON

- » Penn State and James Madison are tied in the overall series, 4-4-2, and will look to break that on Tuesday when the teams meet for the 11th time.
- » The Nittany Lions and Dukes have met each of the last five seasons with Penn State holding the 3-1-1 advantage.
- » Last season, James Madison won, 1-0, on its home pitch.

SCOUTING JAMES MADISON

- » The James Madison Dukes are 9-5-1 overall and 4-1-1 in Colonial Athletic Association conference play coming into Tuesday.
- » The Dukes were ranked No. 18 in last week's United Soccer Coaches poll (this week's ranking will come out Tuesday afternoon before the match).
- » Senior midfielder Manuel Ferriol leads the Dukes with 27 points on 12 goals and three assists, tied for fifth nationally in total points. His 12 goals are tied for fourth most nationally.
- » In net, redshirt-junior goalkeeper TJ Bush has seen a majority of the minutes and holds a .756 save percentage with a 0.91 goals against average.
- » As a team, the Dukes have shut out seven opponents in 2019.

LAST TIME OUT

- » Penn State remains unbeaten on the road in 2019 after a 2-1 win at Wisconsin Saturday.
- » The Nittany Lions' first shot of the game found the back of the net when freshman Jalen Watson crossed the ball in from the left side of the box and junior Callum Pritchatt put the finishing touch on it to put Penn State up 1-0 in the 14th minute.
- » Wisconsin had two good looks at the net in the first half but freshman goalkeeper Kris Shakes made two diving saves to keep the home team off the board.
- » Senior captain Aaron Molloy put the Nittany Lions up by two in the 65th minute after a corner kick by sophomore Seth Kuhn was rebounded out of the box and Molloy took the running start into it for the goal.

OCTOBER OVERLOAD

- » Penn State will play eight games in the month of October, including six within the friendly confines of Jeffrey Field.
- » The Nittany Lions are currently in the middle of a stretch of six games in 18 days.
- » So far, the Nittany Lions are 4-1-0 this month.

PK PERFECTION

- » Penn State has drawn three penalties in the box this season.
- » Senior captain Aaron Molloy has taken all three penalty kick attempts for the Nittany Lions and converted on all three.
- » Molloy is one of eight NCAA D1 men's soccer players to be perfect on PKs this season.

NO IFS, ANDS OR BUTTS ABOUT IT

- » Freshman forward Liam Butts has 12 points on six goals through the first 12 games in his rookie season.
- » Butts has two multi-goal games and four game-winning goals, good for first in the conference

and seventh nationally.

WELL-ROUNDED OFFENSE

- » 15 different Nittany Lions have recorded points in the 2019 season, including 10 different goal scorers.
- » Penn State has scored 23 goals through 12 games, the most since the 2014 season (29).

THREE'S (GOALS) NOT A CROWD

- » Penn State has scored three or more goals four times this season, the most since the 2012 season.

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- » Liam Butts was named the Big Ten Offensive Player of the Week on Oct. 15 after a multi-goal game against Northwestern, including the game-winner in overtime.
- » Butts earns his first career conference weekly award and is the first Big Ten Offensive Player of the Week for the Nittany Lions since Ethan Beckford in 2017.

BEST START SINCE 2014

- » Penn State is 8-2-2, marking the best record through 12 games since 2014, also the last time the Nittany Lions made it to the NCAA Tournament.

GOING BACK-TO-BACK (WITH TWO DEFENSIVE PLAYERS OF THE WEEK)

- » Redshirt juniors Brandon Hackenberg (Sept. 24) and Josh Levine (Oct. 1) were named Big Ten Defensive Player of the Week in back-to-back weeks.
- » The honor was the first Big Ten weekly award of Hackenberg's career and the second for Levine.

SENIOR CLASS AWARD

- » Senior Aaron Molloy has been named one of 30 candidates for the 2019 Senior CLASS Award in collegiate men's soccer.
- » To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition.
- » Molloy is the first Penn State men's soccer candidate for the award since Kyle MacDonald in 2015.

NATIONAL RECOGNITION

- » Penn State received votes in the United Soccer Coaches weekly poll in back-to-back weeks (Week 4 & 5).
- » It marked the first time the Nittany Lions received votes in the poll since Sept. 6, 2016 when they got 10 votes.
- » The Nittany Lions also earned votes in the

week seven poll after an overtime win over Northwestern.

SAVED THE BEST FOR LAST

- » Senior teammates Christian Sload and Aaron Molloy are both having career-best seasons in their final year with the Blue and White.
- » Molloy has six goals and two assists for a team-high 14 points.
- » Sload has two goals and four assists for eight points, including a five-game points streak in the month of September.
- » Sload's previous career season highs were a single goal in each of the last three seasons and four total points in 2017 and 2018 while Molloy had three goals in 2017.

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

- » Five of Penn State's 16 regular-season opponents are ranked in the top 25 of the United Soccer Coaches' week seven poll.
- » Stanford is No. 5 followed by Indiana at No. 6. UCF and James Madison both dropped a couple spots at No. 11 and No. 18, respectively. Maryland remains at No. 25.
- » Penn State received votes in the week seven poll.
- » The Nittany Lions are 2-2-1 with ranked or receiving-votes teams in 2019.

BLUE AND WHITE DEBUT

- » 11 of the 13 Nittany Lion newcomers have seen time on the pitch in 2019.
- » Jalen Watson, Andrew Privett, Liam Butts, Seth Kuhn, Alex Stevenson, Will Campbell, Michael Gaines, Adam Laundree, Kyle May and Dax Hoffman all made their debuts against Stanford on Aug. 30.
- » Kris Shakes made his debut in between the pipes at Stony Brook on Sept. 2.
