PENN STATE TO PLAY FINAL NONCONFERENCE GAME AGAINST **APPALACHIAN STATE**

The Penn State men's soccer team, under second-year head coach Jeff Cook, will play its final nonconference game of the regular season when it hosts Appalachian State at Jeffrey Field on Friday, Oct. 25 at 7 p.m.

PENN STATE AGAINST APPALACHIAN STATE

Penn State and Appalachian State are set to meet on the pitch for the first time in program history Friday.

SCOUTING APPALACHIAN STATE

- The Appalachian State Mountaineers are 9-3-1 overall and 2-1-0 in the Sun Belt Conference.
- Sophomore classmates Camden Holbrook and Kelan Swales lead the team with 10 points each on a team-high four goals and two assists.
- In net, redshirt freshman Jacob Madden has played all 13 games and holds a 0.93 goals against average and .782 save percentage.
- As a team, the Mountaineers have shut out six opponents in 2019.
- App State holds a NCAA RPI of 51 as of Wednesday.

LAST TIME OUT

- Foggy conditions rolling through Happy Valley Tuesday evening forced an early end to No. 19 Penn State's game with No. RV James Madison. With 72 minutes being played, the game officially ended in a 1-1 draw.
- The Dukes struck first on their first shot on net in the 17th minute but Penn State was a force on attack with five shots on net in the first 20 minutes of play.
- Senior captain Aaron Molloy was finally able to get one past the Dukes' goalkeeper in the 42nd minute after Dax Hoffman crossed it in and Molloy finished with his left foot.
- The Nittany Lions then had multiple offensive opportunities to take the lead in the second half, starting with freshman Andrew Privett's shot in the 56th minute that hit off the post.
- The game was officially called by the referees in the 72nd minute due to player safety concerns with the dense fog.

OCTOBER OVERLOAD

- Penn State will play eight games in the month of October, including six within the friendly confines of Jeffrey Field.
- The Nittany Lions are currently in the middle of a stretch of six games in 18 days.
- So far, the Nittany Lions are 4-1-1 this month.

PK PERFECTION

- Penn State has drawn three penalties in the box this season.
- Senior captain Aaron Molloy has taken all three penalty kick attempts for the Nittany Lions and converted on all three.
- Molloy is one of eight NCAA D1 men's soccer players to be perfect on PKs this season.

IRISH MESSI

Senior midfielder Aaron Molloy leads the team with 16 points on a team-high seven goals and

- two assists.
- Molloy is in the top 50 nationally for total goals and is second in the conference.
- The team co-captain is also second in the conference in total points and 70th nationally.
- Molloy was named Big Ten Co-Offensive Player of the Week and Top Drawer Soccer's Player of the Week on Tuesday.

NO IFS, ANDS OR BUTTS ABOUT IT

- Freshman forward Liam Butts has 12 points on six goals through the first 12 games in his rookie season.
- Butts has two multi-goal games and four gamewinning goals, good for first in the conference and seventh nationally.

WELL-ROUNDED OFFENSE

- 15 different Nittany Lions have recorded points in the 2019 season, including 10 different goal scorers.
- Penn State has scored 24 goals through 13 games, the most since the 2014 season (29).

THREE'S (GOALS) NOT A CROWD

Penn State has scored three or more goals four times this season, the most since the 2012 season.

BEST START SINCE 2014

Penn State is 8-2-3, marking the best record through 12 games since 2014, also the last time the Nittany Lions made it to the NCAA Tournament.

GOING BACK-TO-BACK (WITH TWO OFFENSIVE AND TWO DEFENSIVE PLAYERS OF THE WEEK)

- Redshirt juniors Brandon Hackenberg (Sept. 24) and Josh Levine (Oct. 1) were named Big Ten Defensive Player of the Week in back-to-back weeks.
- The honor was the first Big Ten weekly award of Hackenberg's career and the second for Levine.
- Freshman Liam Butts (Oct. 15) and senior captain Aaron Molloy (Oct. 22) also earned back-to-back Big Ten Offensive Player of the Week honors.
- Both those were career firsts for the Nittany Lions' leading goal scorers.

SENIOR CLASS AWARD

- Senior Aaron Molloy has been named one of 30 candidates for the 2019 Senior CLASS Award in collegiate men's soccer.
- To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition.
- Molloy is the first Penn State men's soccer candidate for the award since Kyle MacDonald in

- Seth Kuhn (Duke) and Will Campbell (UNC) re-join Coach Cook in Happy Valley from their respective universities after playing for him at the Philadelphia Union Academy.

Head coach Jeff Cook's first six 2019 recruits in Liam Butts, Michael Gaines, Kyle May, Andrew Privett, Kris Shakes and Alex Stevenson earned top-10 recruiting class kudos from Top Drawer Soccer during the early signing period in fall 2018.

- Molloy earned preseason honors for the third consecutive season. In 2018, Molloy was named to the All-Big Ten second team and the United Soccer Coaches All-North Region third team. The midfielder had two goals and two assists in 15 matches last season.
- Hackenberg earned preseason honors for the first time in his career. The defender appeared in all 17 matches for the Nittany Lions in 2018 as a key member of the backline that record six clean sheets, including three against Big Ten opponents. Hackenberg is a two-time Academic All-Big Ten honoree and a 2018-19 Big Ten Distinguished Scholar.
- Reedy earned preseason honors for the second time in his career. The midfielder returns to the pitch in 2019 after missing the previous two seasons due to injury. As a true freshman in 2016, Reedy was named to the Big Ten All-Freshman Team. Reedy is a two-time Academic All-Big Ten honoree and a 2018-19 Big Ten Distinguished Scholar.
