NO. 16 PENN STATE CONCLUDES REGULAR SEASON AT RUTGERS

The Penn State men's soccer team, under second-year head coach Jeff Cook, will conclude regular-season play in Piscataway, N.J. at Rutgers on Sunday, Nov. 3. Kickoff is set for 3 p.m. from Yurcak Field.

PENN STATE AGAINST RUTGERS

- » Penn State leads Rutgers in the all-time series results, 13-8-0, including a five-game win streak.
- » Last season the Nittany Lions shut out the Scarlet Knights, 2-0, at Jeffrey Field.

SCOUTING RUTGERS

- » The Rutgers Scarlet Knights are 7-6-3 overall and 1-5-1 in Big Ten play heading into the final game of the regular season.
- » Sophomore Pablo Avila leads Rutgers with 14 points on six goals and two assists while freshman Jackson Temple adds five goals.
- » In net, freshman Oren Asher has played a majority of the minutes and holds a 1.38 goals against average and a .708 save percentage.
- » The Scarlet Knights have shut out four opponents in 2019.

LAST TIME OUT

- » Down two goals just 13 minutes in, Penn State men's soccer scored three unanswered goals, including the golden goal in overtime, to top defending national champions Maryland, 3-2, Tuesday evening at Jeffrey Field.
- » 17th-ranked Maryland got on the scoreboard first at 9:31 and then again less than three minutes later.
- » The No. 16 Nittany Lions seemed unfazed by the deficit, however, firing off six shots in the next 20 minutes before the seventh found the back of the net to cut the visitor's lead to one.
- » Senior Aaron Molloy crossed a perfect ball into the box that round redshirt junior Brandon Hackenberg's head for the defender's first goal of the season.
- » Both teams came out of haltime hot, but the Nittany Lions were the ones able to get back on the scoreboard to tie the game at two in the 56th minute when freshman Kyle May's left-footed rebound shot got in on the near post for his first-career goal.
- » Senior Christian Sload nearly had the game-winner in the 58th minute when his breakaway shot was denied by Maryland goalkeeper Niklas Neumann's face.
- » Freshman goalkeeper Kris Shakes made four great saves in the second frame to help force overtime for the second-straight

YOU CAN CALL IT A COMEBACK

- » Penn State's comeback victory over Maryland marks the first time the Nittany Lions have erased a 2-0 deficit to come back and win since a 3-2 win over then-No. 17 Ohio State on Oct. 11, 2008.

TOP-10 RPI

- » The third and most recent NCAA RPI ranking of the 2019 season has Penn State ranked No. 10, the highest-ranking team in the Big Ten.
- » Four other 2019 opponents rank in the top 25.

NATIONAL RECOGNITION

- » Penn State moved up to No. 16 in the United Soccer Coaches week nine poll from No. 19 last week.
- » Cracking the top 25 last week marked the first top-25 ranking for the Nittany Lions since Sept. 22, 2015 when they were ranked No. 21.
- » Previously this season Penn State had received votes in the USC weekly poll three times (weeks 4-5, 7).
- » The Nittany Lions are also ranked No. 15 in Top Drawer Soccer's poll this week.

IRISH MESSI

- » Senior midfielder Aaron Molloy leads the team with 21 points on a team-high eight goals and five assists.
- » Molloy is in the top 50 nationally (45) for total goals and is second in the conference.
- » The team co-captain is also second in the conference in total points and 37th nationally.
- » Molloy has the most goals by an individual player since Connor Maloney had eight in 2016 and the most total points since Chad Severs had 17 (7G, 3A) in 2003.
- » Molloy was named Big Ten Co-Offensive Player of the Week and Top Drawer Soccer's Player of the Week last week (10/22/19).

WELL-ROUNDED OFFENSE

- » 17 different Nittany Lions have recorded points in the 2019 season, including 13 different goal scorers.
- » Penn State has scored 31 goals so far, the most since the 2002 season.

THREE'S (GOALS) NOT A CROWD

- » Penn State has scored three or more goals six times this season, the most since the 2010 season.

SHAKE YOUR GROOVE THING

- » Freshman goalkeeper Kris Shakes has split time in net with veteran Josh Levine, playing a total of 639:28 minutes with a 0.70 goals against average and .857 save percentage.
- » He is a perfect 7-0-0 for the Nittany Lions.

OCTOBER OVERLOAD

- » Penn State played eight games in the month of October, including a stretch of six games in 18 days.
- » The Nittany Lions went 6-1-1 during the month.

NO IFS, ANDS OR BUTTS ABOUT IT

- » Freshman forward Liam Butts has 14 points on seven goals through the first 14 games in his rookie season.
- » Butts has two multi-goal games and five game-winning goals, good for first in the conference and second nationally.

PK PRODUCTIVITY

- » Penn State has drawn four penalties in the box this season.
- » Senior captain Aaron Molloy has taken all four penalty kick attempts for the Nittany Lions and converted on three of them.
- » The three penalties converted is the most since four were converted in the 2009 season.

DOUBLE-DIGIT RECORD

- » Penn State is 10-2-3, marking the first double-digit record since 2014 (13-6-1), also the last time the Nittany Lions made it to the NCAA

- » Redshirt juniors Brandon Hackenberg (Sept. 24) and Josh Levine (Oct. 1) were named Big Ten Defensive Player of the Week in back-to-back weeks.
- » The honor was the first Big Ten weekly award of Hackenberg's career and the second for Levine.
- » Freshman Liam Butts (Oct. 15) and senior captain Aaron Molloy (Oct. 22) also earned back-to-back Big Ten Offensive Player of the Week honors.
- » Both those were career firsts for the Nittany Lions' leading goal scorers.

SAVED THE BEST FOR LAST

- » Senior teammates Christian Sload and Aaron Molloy are both having career-best seasons in their final year with the Blue and White.
- » Molloy has eight goals and five assists for a team-high 21 points.
- » Sload has three goals and five assists for 11 points, including a five-game points streak in the month of September and the golden goal against Maryland.
- » Sload's previous career season highs were a single goal in each of the last three seasons and four total points in 2017 and 2018 while Molloy had three goals in 2017.

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

- » Five of Penn State's 16 regular-season opponents are ranked in the top 25 of the United Soccer Coaches' week nine poll, including three in the top 10.

- » Stanford is No. 5 followed by UCF at No. 6 and Indiana at No. 10. Maryland comes in at No. 17 while James Madison rounds out the group at No. 21.
- » Pitt also received votes.
- » The Nittany Lions also moved up in the rankings to No. 16 after cracking the top 25 at No. 19 last week for the first time since the 2015 season.
- » The Nittany Lions are 3-2-2 with ranked or receiving-votes teams in 2019.
- » The win over No. 17 Maryland marked Penn State's first win over a ranked team since 2016.

SENIOR CLASS AWARD

- » Senior Aaron Molloy has been named one of 30 candidates for the 2019 Senior CLASS Award in collegiate men's soccer.
- » To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition.
- » Molloy is the first Penn State men's soccer candidate for the award since Kyle MacDonald in 2015.

BLUE AND WHITE DEBUT

- » 11 of the 13 Nittany Lion newcomers have seen time on the pitch in 2019.
- » Jalen Watson, Andrew Privett, Liam Butts, Seth Kuhn, Alex Stevenson, Will Campbell, Michael Gaines, Adam Laudree, Kyle May and Dax Hoffman all made their debuts against Stanford on Aug. 30.
- » Kris Shakes made his debut in between the pipes at Stony Brook on Sept. 2.
- » Redshirt freshman Josh Dabora made his Penn State debut against Stanford on Aug. 30 after sitting out 2018.

FAMILIAR NAMES, FAMILIAR FACES

- » Penn State returns 12 players from the 2018 roster, including Big Ten preseason honorees Brandon Hackenberg, Aaron Molloy and Pierre Reedy.
- » Redshirt junior goalkeeper Josh Levine returns in between the pipes for the Nittany Lions after posting a career-high four shutouts in 2018 and earning Co-Defensive Player of the Week honors once.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK

- » Penn State adds 13 newcomers to the 2019 roster, which includes nine freshmen, two transfers and two walk-ons.
- » Seth Kuhn (Duke) and Will Campbell (UNC) re-join Coach Cook in Happy Valley from their respective universities after playing for him at the Philadelphia Union Academy.

TOP-10 RECRUITING CLASS

- » Head coach Jeff Cook's first six 2019 recruits in Liam Butts, Michael Gaines, Kyle May, Andrew Privett, Kris Shakes and Alex Stevenson earned top-10 recruiting class kudos from Top Drawer Soccer during the early signing period in fall 2018.

BIG TEN PRESEASON HONORS

- » Senior Aaron Molloy and redshirt juniors Brandon Hackenberg and Pierre Reedy each earned a spot on the 2019 Big Ten preseason honors list as announced by the conference office.
