#### **ABOUT THE MATCHUP**

- Thursday will be the 43rd meeting all-time between the Hoyas and Nittany Lions, with Penn State holding a 22-20 series advantage.
- The last matchup coming during the 2004-05 season and Georgetown has won the last five meetings, dating to 1973-74.
- Overall, the Hoyas are 65-92 all-time against members of the Big Ten Conference and 1-0 under Head Coach Patrick Ewing.
- This will be Georgetown's fourth contest in the Gavitt Tipoff Games, and the Hoyas hold a 1-2 record in the series with the one victory coming in an 88-80 win at Illinois last season.
- The Hoyas (2-0) are coming off an 89-78 victory over Central Arkansas on Saturday afternoon behind Omer Yurtseven's second-straight double-double.
- Jagan Mosely put in a flawless effort with 13 points from a 4-for-4 effort from the field including 2-for2 from downtown and a 3-for-3 performance from the charity stripe.
- Penn State enters Thursday's contest with a 2-o record after home wins over Maryland Eastern Shore (84-46) and Wagner (91-64) to start the season.

# YURTSEVEN SELECTED TO KAREEM ABDUL-JABBAR AWARD WATCH LIST

- Omer Yurtseven was among 20 men's basketball players selected to the watch list for the 2020 Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year Award.
- Named after Hall of Famer and three-time NCAA Champion Kareem Abdul-Jabbar, the annual honor is in its sixth year of recognizing the top centers in men's college basketball.
- Yurtseven is entering his first season in a Hoya uniform after sitting out last season due to NCAA transfer rules.
- In his sophomore season at NC State, Yurtseven averaged 13.5 ppg and 6.7 rpg while starting in 32 of 33 games.
- He is joined by Providence's Nate Watson as the representatives from the BIG EAST Conference on the watch list

#### **GAVITT TIPOFF GAMES**

- The fifth annual Gavitt Tipoff Games, an annual early-season series of eight games played between the BIG EAST and Big Ten Conferences and named in honor of BIG EAST founder and basketball visionary Dave Gavitt, runs from Monday, Nov. 11, through Thursday, Nov. 15.
- Dave Gavitt began his coaching career at Dartmouth, his alma mater, and then led Providence to eight straight postseason bids in 10 years and guided the Friars to the 1973 Final Four.
- Gavitt had a profound and lasting influence on the sport of basketball on the collegiate, professional and Olympic levels. He was inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in 2006.
- The Gavitt Tipoff Games are played in the first full week of the college basketball season. The series will span eight years (2015-22), with games played at home sites. In each of the first three seasons, the BIG EAST and Big Ten split the eight games, 4-4.

#### **BIG EAST WEEKLY HONORS**

- Georgetown University men's basketball center Omer Yurtseven was named to the BIG EAST Weekly Honor Roll on Monday following a 2-0 week for the Hoyas to open the season.
- Omer Yurtseven posted a pair of double-doubles in as many games to open the season.
- He averaged 18.5 points and 13.5 rebounds after a 20-point, 12-rebound effort against Mount St. Mary's and a 17-point, 15-board performance versus Central Arkansas.
- The senior shot 73.7 percent from the floor.
- It was Yurtseven's first nod to the honor roll of his career and the first of the season for the Blue & Grav.

#### **HOYAS CLAW PAST BEARS**

- The Georgetown University men's basketball team opened up a double-digit lead at halftime and three Hoyas scored in double figures in an 89-78 victory over Central Arkansas on Saturday afternoon
- Omer Yurtseven tallied his second double-double in as many games with 17 points and a team-leading 15 rebounds.
- Jagan Mosely put in a flawless effort with 13 points from a 4-for-4 effort from the field including a perfect pair from downtown and a 3-for-3 performance from the charity stripe. He contributed three rebounds, a pair of assists as well as one steal and one block in 26 minutes of action.
- Jamorko Pickett rounded out those in double figures with 10 points and he and Qudus Wahab each finished with seven rebounds.
- James Akinjo dished out a team-high seven assists.
- As a team, Georgetown shot 50 percent (33-66) from the field and outrebounded the Bears 55-31.
- Yurtseven was named to the BIG EAST Weekly Honor Roll for his consecutive double-doubles to open the season.

#### **BIG EAST PRESEASON HONORS**

- Sophomore James Akinjo was selected to the Preseason All-BIG EAST Second Team.
- Senior Omer Yurtseven earned Preseason All-BIG EAST Honorable Mention honors without having played a game in the BIG EAST.
- The Hoyas were selected sixth in the 2019-20 Preseason Coaches' Poll.

#### SOPHOMORE SURGE

The sophomore trio of James Akinjo, Josh LeBlanc and Mac McClung took the BIG EAST by storm last season as freshmen. Akinjo was named the BIG EAST Freshman of the Year and the three were all named to the BIG EAST All-Freshman Team, only the second time a school had three representatives in league history.

#### James Akinjo

- Akinjo started 32 of 33 games and ranked second on the team with 13.4 ppg.
- He led the BIG EAST with 5.2 apg and was sixth with a 1.7 assist-turnover ratio.
- Akinjo scored a career-high 25 points twice and reached double figures in scoring 24 times, including four games with at least 20 points.
- He dished out a career-high 11 assists against Creighton on Jan. 21.

#### Josh LeBlanc

- LeBlanc averaged 9.1 points and 7.3 rebounds per game while shooting 63.0 percent from the floor.
- He posted six double-doubles, tying the most for a freshman at Georgetown since 2000.
- He ranked second overall in the BIG EAST in field goal percentage, sixth in rebounding and seventh in blocked shots.

#### Mac McClung

- McClung was third on the team and second among BIG EAST freshmen with 13.1 ppg.
- He was also 10th in the conference with a 79.8 free throw percentage.
- He scored in double figures 18 times, including six games with at least 20 points, and had a career-high 38 points against Little Rock.

- The BIG EAST and Madison Square Garden have been partners since the Tournament was first played at the iconic venue in 1983.
- The BIG EAST Tournament is the longest-running postseason championship at the same location in college basketball.

Phase II of Capital One Arena's updates were completed during summer 2019. Upgrades include:

# **PATRICK EWING**

HEAD COACH | THIRD SEASON GEORGETOWN C'85

On April 3, 2017 Georgetown University named Patrick Ewing (C'85) its new head men's basketball coach. Ewing came back to Georgetown after serving for 15 years as an assistant coach in the NBA. He served as an assistant coach for the Washington Wizards (2002-03), Houston Rockets (2003-06) and Orlando Magic (2007-12) and as the associate head coach for the Charlotte Hornets (2013-17).

In just two seasons on the Hilltop, the Hoyas have already hit some early milestones. The 2018-19 season saw Georgetown win a major BIG EAST award in the league's Freshman of the Year honor as well as a trio of athletes named to the All-Freshman Team, just the second time in conference history three honorees have come from the same institution. The 2018-19 campaign saw a return to the postseason for the first time since the 2014-15 season as the Hoyas earned a berth to the 2019 National Invitation Tournament.

Ewing is recognized as the greatest men's basketball player to ever don the Blue & Gray. He was selected as one of the top 50 players in the history of the National Basketball Association (NBA) and was elected to the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in 2008.

Ewing was a three-time consensus First Team All-American (1983, 1984, 1985) on the Hilltop, leading the Hoyas to three NCAA Championship Game appearances and the 1984 National Championship title. He was named Most Outstanding Player of the 1984 NCAA Championships. His play propelled Georgetown into one of the most respected basketball programs in the country.

During his illustrious career, Ewing had the opportunity to play for, and coach, alongside some of the great coaches in basketball, including Pat Riley (New York Knicks), Jeff Van Gundy (Knicks, Houston Rockets), Stan Van Gundy (Orlando Magic), Tom Thibodeau (Chicago Bulls, Minnesota Timberwolves) and Steve Clifford (Charlotte).

He was the first pick in the 1985 NBA Draft and went on to earn NBA Rookie of the Year honors in 1986 with the New York Knicks after averaging 20.0 points and 9.0 rebounds per game. Ewing scored 24,815 points during his 17-year NBA career to go along with 11,607 rebounds. Ewing spent 15 years with the Knicks and made 10-consecutive NBA All-Star appearances. Ewing averaged 21.0 points, 9.8 rebounds and 2.45 blocks in 1,183 career games and was a member of the NBA's 50th Anniversary Team. He remains the New York Knicks' all-time leader in points, rebounds, blocked shots, steals and field goals made.

He still stands second all-time in scoring at Georgetown, averaging 15.3 points in 143 games. He is one of only four players in program history to score at least 2,000 points (2,184). Ewing is the all-time leader in total rebounds (1,316), blocked shots (493) and games played (143).
