### NO. 12 PENN STATE FACES MICHIGAN IN BIG TEN TOURNAMENT SEMIFINALS IN COLLEGE PARK

The Penn State men's soccer team, under second-year head coach Jeff Cook, continues its 2019 postseason run in the Big Ten Tournament, facing No. 3-seed Michigan in the semifinals on Friday, Nov. 15 at Ludwig Field in College Park, Md. Kickoff is set for 4 p.m. and will broadcast live on the Big Ten Network with Dean Linke (play-by-play) and Jason Garey (analyst) on the call.

### PENN STATE IN THE BIG TEN TOURNAMENT

- » Penn State is 30-21-5 (.573) all-time in the Big Ten Tournament since it started in 1991.
- » The Nittany Lions are a No. 2 seed in the tournament for the first time since the 2009 season when they went on to the title game before eventually falling.
- » Penn State is 6-5-0 all-time as a two-seed and is making its first semifinal appearance since 2013.

### PENN STATE AGAINST MICHIGAN

- » Penn State narrowly leads Michigan in the all-time series history, 11-10-4. The series is tied 3-3-0 in the Big Ten Tournament.
- » The teams will meet for the second time in 2019 after recording a scoreless double-overtime draw during the regular season.

### SCOUTING MICHIGAN

- » Michigan finished the regular season with a 9-4-4 overall record and 4-1-3 record in conference play, including a convincing 4-2 win over then-No. 17 Maryland in the regular-season finale.
- » The Wolverines won their quarterfinal game, 2-1, over in-state rival Michigan State.
- » Big Ten Offensive Player of the Year Nebojsa Popovic leads the team with 10 goals and three assists for 23 total points.
- » Freshman Owen Finnerty took over in net for an injured Andrew Verdi and has played the last three and a half games. Finnerty has a 0.95 goals against average and a .625 save percentage.

### LAST TIME OUT

- » Penn State scored three second-half goals en route to a 3-0 shutout victory over Wisconsin in the quarterfinals of the Big Ten Tournament Sunday at Jeffrey Field.
- » Senior Christian Sload, freshman Liam Butts and redshirt freshman Josh Dabora were the goal scorers for the Nittany Lions.
- » Butts, freshman Andrew Privett and senior Aaron Molloy added

### STAY GOLDEN SLOAD

- » Senior Christian Sload has scored the game-winning goals in the last three games, including back-to-back golden goals in overtime against then-No. 17 Maryland and at Rutgers.

### BIG SUCCESS

- » The Nittany Lions won six Big Ten games in 2019, the most in conference play since the 2005 season.

### UNDEFEATED ON THE ROAD

- » Penn State went undefeated (6-0-1) on the road in 2019 after not winning a single road game just a year ago.
- » The Nittany Lions went undefeated in true road games for the first time since the 1995 season (one neutral site loss that season).

### SIX NITTANY LIONS RECOGNIZED WITH ALL-BIG TEN SEASON AWARDS

- » Six Penn State men's soccer student-athletes were honored by the Big Ten with season awards as announced by the conference office Friday.
- » The selections were highlighted by senior Aaron Molloy's Midfielder of the Year award, the first Big Ten Player of the Year award for a Penn State men's soccer student-athlete since 2014.
- » In addition to his Midfielder of the Year nod, Molloy was also named to the All-Big Ten First Team along with freshman Liam Butts and redshirt junior Brandon Hackenberg.
- » Butts and classmates Jalen Watson and Kris Shakes earned spots on the Big Ten All-Freshman Team while graduate transfer Will Campbell is Penn State's Sportsmanship Award honoree.
- » The three first-team honorees are the most for Penn State since having three in 2013 while the three All-Freshman team members are the most since 2008.

### SHAKE YOUR GROOVE THING

- » Freshman goalkeeper Kris Shakes has split time in net with veteran Josh Levine, playing a total of 821:43 minutes with a 0.66 goals against average and .857 save percentage.
- » In the national rankings, Shakes has the 14th-best goals against average and the third-best saver percentage.
- » He also holds the top spot in both statistical categories in the Big Ten.
- » He is a perfect 9-0-0 for the Nittany Lions with four shutouts.

### NO IFS, ANDS OR BUTTS ABOUT IT

- » Freshman forward Liam Butts has 19 points on nine goals and one assist in his rookie year.
- » Butts has two multi-goal games and five game-

winning goals, good for first in the conference and tied eighth nationally.

- » His nine goals is the most by an individual player since Connor Maloney had 10 in 2014.

### TOP-15 RPI

- » Penn State slipped a little in the most recent NCAA RPI ranking of the 2019 season to No. 12, but still remains the highest-ranking team in the Big Ten.
- » Four other 2019 opponents rank in the top 25.

### SAVED THE BEST FOR LAST

- » Senior Christian Sload is having a career-best season in his final year with the Blue and White.
- » Sload has five goals and five assists for 15 total points, including a five-game points streak in the month of September and back-to-back golden goals against then-No. 17 Maryland and Rutgers.
- » The forward was named Big Ten Offensive Player of the Week and Top Drawer Soccer's Player of the Week on Nov. 5.
- » His previous career season highs were a single goal in each of the last three seasons and four total points in 2017 and 2018.

### WELL-ROUNDED OFFENSE

- » 17 different Nittany Lions have recorded points in the 2019 season, including 13 different goal scorers.
- » Penn State has scored 36 goals so far, the most since the 2014 season when they scored 29.
- » Freshman Liam Butts leads the team with nine goals while seniors Aaron Molloy and Christian Sload have added eight and five, respectively.





## NOTES AND HEADLINES

### YOU CAN CALL IT A COMEBACK

- » Penn State's comeback victory over Maryland marks the first time the Nittany Lions have erased a 2-0 deficit to come back and win since a 3-2 win over then-No. 17 Ohio State on Oct. 11, 2008.

### NATIONAL RECOGNITION

- » Penn State has now been ranked for four consecutive weeks, moving up in the polls each week.
- » In the United Soccer Coaches week 11 poll, the Nittany Lions are No. 12, their highest ranking since Oct. 26, 2014 when they were also No. 12.
- » Cracking the top 25 on Oct. 22 marked the first top-25 ranking for the Nittany Lions since Sept. 22, 2015 when they were ranked No. 21.
- » The Nittany Lions are also ranked No. 10 in Top Drawer Soccer's poll this week.

### IRISH MESSI

- » Senior midfielder Aaron Molloy leads the team with 22 points on eight goals and six assists.
- » The team co-captain is second in the conference in total points and 49th nationally.
- » Molloy has the most total points since Connor Maloney had 21 (8G, 5A) in 2016.
- » Molloy was named Big Ten Co-Offensive Player of the Week and Top Drawer Soccer's Player of the Week on Oct. 22.

### THREE'S (GOALS) NOT A CROWD

- » Penn State has scored three or more goals seven times this season, the most since the 2010 season.

### OCTOBER OVERLOAD

- » Penn State played eight games in the month of October, including a stretch of six games in 18 days.
- » The Nittany Lions went 6-1-1 during the month.

### PK PRODUCTIVITY
