15-SEED PENN STATE SET TO HOST PROVIDENCE IN NCAA TOURNAMENT SECOND ROUND

The Penn State men's soccer team, under second-year head coach Jeff Cook, is set for its first NCAA Tournament appearance in five years when it hosts Providence College in the second round Sunday at Jeffrey Field. Kickoff is set for 5 p.m. and will stream live on BTN Plus.

PENN STATE IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

- » Penn State is 28-31-1 all-time in the NCAA Tournament as it makes its 33rd overall appearance and first since 2014 on Sunday.
- » The Nittany Lions earned the No. 15 seed, their first national seeding in the tournament since 2010 when they were also No. 15.
- » Penn State is 22-7-1 all-time in the tournament at home.

PENN STATE AGAINST PROVIDENCE

- » Sunday's game will mark the first meeting in program history between Penn State and Providence.

SCOUTING PROVIDENCE

- » Providence is 15-6-0 overall coming off a 2-0 win over NJIT in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.
- » Five Friars have recorded 14-plus points in 2019, with Joao Serrano (4G, 9A) and Paulo Lima (8G, 1A) leading the team with 17 each.
- » In net, Austin Aviza holds a 0.92 goals against average and a .716 save percentage.
- » The Friars shut out 11 opponents, including the Highlanders on Thursday.
- » With two wins over a ranked St. John's team, Providence is No. 14 in the NCAA's latest RPI rankings as well as No. 21 in the United Soccer Coaches poll.

BIG TEN IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

- » Four Big Ten programs earned spots in the NCAA Tournament, three all with national seeds and first-round byes, including the Nittany Lions.
- » Maryland won its first round game and will face No. 4 Wake Forest in the second round.
- » No. 13 Michigan will host Wright State and No. 5 Indiana will host Kentucky in the second round Sunday.

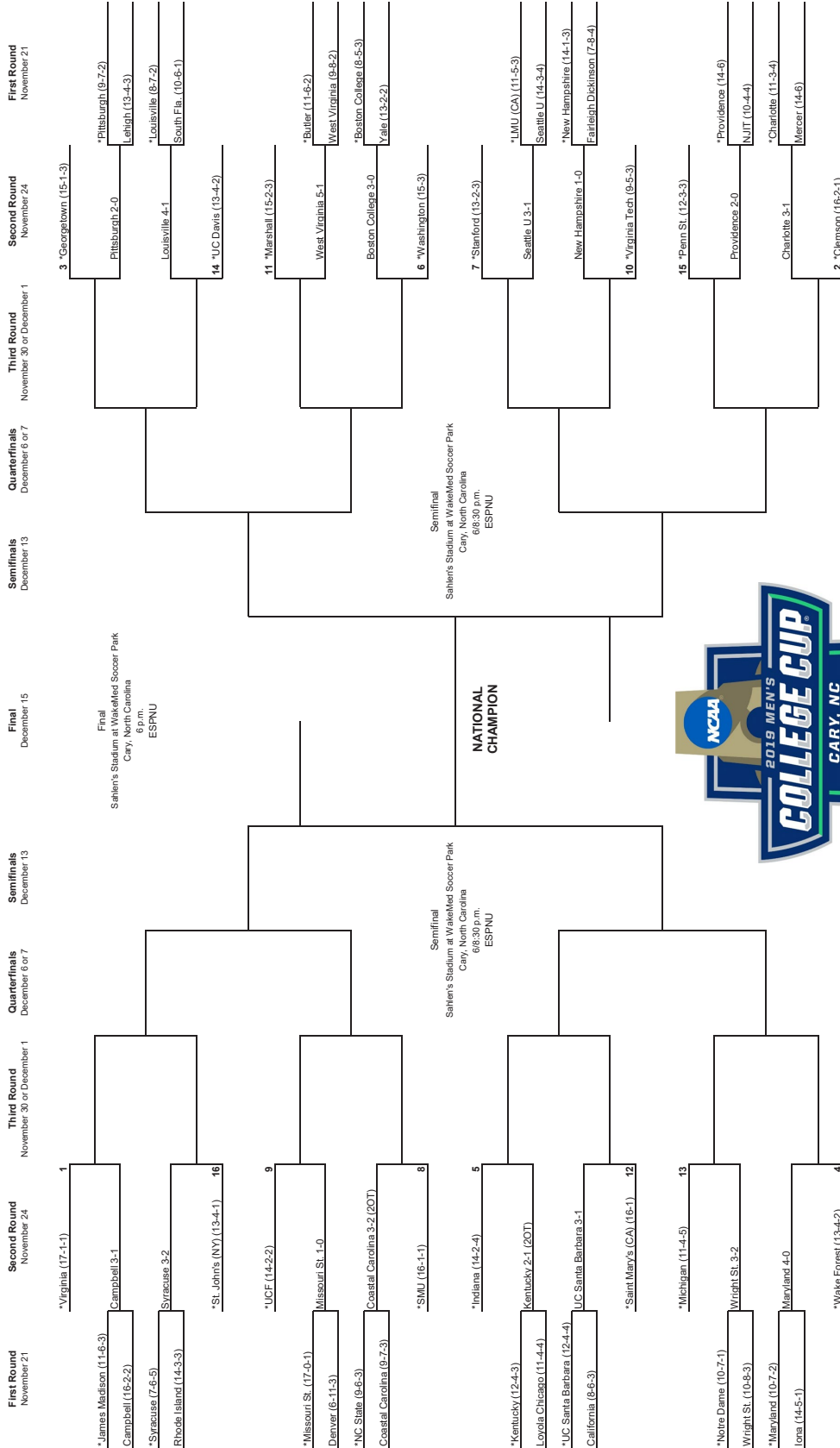

NOTES AND HEADLINES

LAST TIME OUT

- » Penn State saw its eight-game unbeaten streak come to an end in the Big Ten Tournament semifinals as Michigan won, 1-0.
- » Both teams played very tactical soccer in the first half as Penn State held a slight advantage in shots at the break, 4-2.
- » The Nittany Lions' best look at the net came in the 12th minute when Pierre Reedy was able to play a ball through to Christian Sload but his shot was blocked by Michigan's goalkeeper.
- » In the 62nd minutes, Penn State freshman goalkeeper played out of the box and an unfortunate foul set up a Michigan free kick in which Jack Hallahan scored for the eventual 1-0 winning scoreline.

STAY GOLDEN SLOAD

- » Senior Christian Sload scored the game-winning goals in three consecutive games, including back-to-back golden goals in overtime against then-No. 17 Maryland and at Rutgers.

BIG SUCCESS

- » The Nittany Lions won six Big Ten games in 2019, the most in conference play since the 2005 season.

UNDEFEATED ON THE ROAD

- » Penn State went undefeated (6-0-1) on the road during the regular season after not winning a single road game just a year ago.
- » The Nittany Lions went undefeated in true road games for the first time since the 1995 season (one neutral site loss that season).

SIX NITTANY LIONS RECOGNIZED WITH ALL-BIG TEN SEASON AWARDS

- » Six Penn State men's soccer student-athletes were honored by the Big Ten with season awards as announced by the conference office Friday.
- » The selections were highlighted by senior Aaron Molloy's Midfielder of the Year award, the first Big Ten Player of the Year award for a Penn State men's soccer student-athlete since 2014.
- » In addition to his Midfielder of the Year nod, Molloy was also named to the All-Big Ten First Team along with freshman Liam Butts and redshirt junior Brandon Hackenberg.
- » Butts and classmates Jalen Watson and Kris Shakes earned spots on the Big Ten All-Freshman Team while graduate transfer Will Campbell is Penn State's Sportsmanship Award honoree.
- » The three first-team honorees are the most for Penn State since having three in 2013 while the three All-Freshman team members are the most since 2008.

SHAKE YOUR GROOVE THING

- » Freshman goalkeeper Kris Shakes has split time in net with veteran Josh Levine, playing a total of

911:43 minutes with a 0.69 goals against average and .851 save percentage.

- » In the national rankings, Shakes has the 14th-best goals against average and the fifth-best saver percentage.
- » He also holds the top spot in save percentage and is second in GAA in the conference.
- » He is 9-1-0 on the season with four shutouts.

NO IFS, ANDS OR BUTTS ABOUT IT

- » Freshman forward Liam Butts has 19 points on nine goals and one assist in his rookie year.
- » Butts has two multi-goal games and five game-winning goals, good for first in the conference and tied eighth nationally.
- » His nine goals is the most by an individual player since Connor Maloney had 10 in 2014.

TOP-25 RPI

- » Penn State slipped a little in the most recent NCAA RPI ranking of the 2019 season to No. 20.
- » Five other 2019 opponents rank in the top 25, including Providence at No. 14.

SAVED THE BEST FOR LAST

- » Senior Christian Sload is having a career-best season in his final year with the Blue and White.
- » Sload has five goals and five assists for 15 total points, including a five-game points streak in the month of September and back-to-back golden goals against then-No. 17 Maryland and Rutgers.
- » The forward was named Big Ten Offensive Player of the Week and Top Drawer Soccer's Player of the Week on Nov. 5.
- » His previous career season highs were a single goal in each of the last three seasons and four

total points in 2017 and 2018.

WELL-ROUNDED OFFENSE

- » 17 different Nittany Lions have recorded points in the 2019 season, including 13 different goal scorers.
- » Penn State has scored 36 goals so far, the most since the 2014 season when they scored 29.
- » Freshman Liam Butts leads the team with nine goals while seniors Aaron Molloy and Christian Sload have added eight and five, respectively.

YOU CAN CALL IT A COMEBACK

- » Penn State's comeback victory over Maryland marks the first time the Nittany Lions have erased a 2-0 deficit to come back and win since a 3-2 win over then-No. 17 Ohio State on Oct. 11, 2008.

NATIONAL RECOGNITION

- » Penn State has now been ranked for five consecutive weeks.
- » In the United Soccer Coaches week 12 poll, the Nittany Lions are No. 13, dropping one spot after the loss to Michigan in the semifinals.
- » Cracking the top 25 on Oct. 22 marked the first top-25 ranking for the Nittany Lions since Sept. 22, 2015 when they were ranked No. 21.
- » The Nittany Lions are also ranked No. 20 in Top Drawer Soccer's poll this week.

IRISH MESSI

- » Senior midfielder Aaron Molloy leads the team with 22 points on eight goals and six assists.
- » The team co-captain is second in the conference in total points and 49th nationally.
- » Molloy has the most total points since Connor Maloney had 21 (8G, 5A) in 2016.
- » Molloy was named Big Ten Co-Offensive Player of the Week and Top Drawer Soccer's Player of the Week on Oct. 22.

THREE'S (GOALS) NOT A CROWD

- » Penn State has scored three or more goals seven times this season, the most since the 2010 season.

OCTOBER OVERLOAD

- » Penn State played eight games in the month of October, including a stretch of six games in 18 days.
- » The Nittany Lions went 6-1-1 during the month.

PK PRODUCTIVITY

- » Penn State has drawn four penalties in the box this season.
- » Senior captain Aaron Molloy has taken all four penalty kick attempts for the Nittany Lions and converted on three of them.
- » The three penalties converted is the most since four were converted in the 2009 season.

DOUBLE-DIGIT RECORD

- » Penn State finished the regular season with a 11-2-3 record, marking the first double-digit record since 2014 (13-6-1), also the last time the Nittany Lions made it to the NCAA Tournament.

GOING BACK-TO-BACK (WITH TWO OFFENSIVE AND TWO DEFENSIVE PLAYERS OF THE WEEK)

- » Redshirt juniors Brandon Hackenberg (Sept. 24) and Josh Levine (Oct. 1) were named Big Ten Defensive Player of the Week in back-to-back weeks.
- » The honor was the first Big Ten weekly award of Hackenberg's career and the second for Levine.
