NAKE FOREST AT PENN STAT

DEACS VISIT PENN STATE IN BIG TEN/ACC CHALLENGE

- Wake Forest concludes a six-game road trip with a visit to Penn State in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge
- Penn State becomes the 11th different opponent for Wake in the Challenge
- The Deacs are looking for their fourth non-conference win away from home, a feat they haven't accomplished since 2016-17

UP TO THE CHALLENGE

- Wake Forest has an all-time record of 12-5 in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge, including a 5-3 road record
- The Demon Deacons' 12 wins are third most in challenge history (Duke 18, Virginia 13)
- The Deacs have won two of their last three Challenge road games, winning at Nebraska in 2011-12 and at Rutgers in 2015-16

LAST TIME OUT

- Wake Forest fell to No. 14 Arizona 73-66 in the final of the Wooden Legacy in Anaheim on Sunday
- Arizona led by as many as 15 in the second half before the Deacs closed within four in the final minute
- Olivier Sarr had a game-high 21 points and 13 rebounds to lead Wake

SARR SHINES AT WOODEN LEGACY

LAGE CAME'S STARTEDS

- Olivier Sarr had three strong performances at the Wooden Legacy to earn All-Tournament Team honors
- Sarr was also named ACC Player of the Week on Monday for his play in Anaheim
- He averaged 17.0 points and a tournament-leading 11.7 rebounds per game at the tournament
- Sarr had 14 points and a career-high 14 rebounds in the first round vs. Charleston
- He had 16 points and eight rebounds vs. Long Beach State in the semifinals
- Sarr tied a career high with 21 points and had 13 rebounds vs. No. 14 Arizona in the final
- He shot 16-27 (.593) from the floor and 19-24 (.792) from the line in the three games

INTERVIEW POLICIES

POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

HEAD COACHES: Both head coaches will appear in the media room following brief cool-down periods. In most cases, the visiting head coach will appear first, followed by Wake Forest coach Danny Manning. WAKE FOREST PLAYERS: Requested players will be available in the media room following both head coaches' press conferences. The Wake Forest locker room is closed to the media.

OPPONENT PLAYERS: Please see the visiting SID. If that team's locker room is closed to the media, interviews are usually held outside in the hallway near the entrance to the visitors' locker room.

PRE-PRACTICE INTERVIEWS

All interviews with head coach Danny Manning and/or Demon Deacon players should be arranged through Steve Kirkland in the Athletic Communications Office. Interview requests should be made at least 24 hours in advance.

Interviews will be arranged to accommodate players' academic and basketball schedules. Players will not do interviews on gameday, except for postgame interviews. At the conclusion of select practices, Coach Manning and players will be available for interviews after media is permitted to watch the end of practice. Contact Steve Kirkland for the schedule of practices with media availability.

ACC TELECONFERENCE

The 15 ACC basketball head coaches will be featured on a weekly teleconference each Monday. The teleconferences will begin on Jan. 6, 2020 and conclude on Mar. 2, 2020. Each coach will have 10 minutes to answer questions.

PRESS CREDENTIALS

Media credentials for Wake Forest home games should be requested by contacting Steve Kirkland in the Wake Forest Athletic Communications Office. Please make your requests at least 48 hours prior to tip-off.

Credential requests are contingent on available space. Priority is given to daily newspapers, radio/TV sports directors and other media who cover the Demon Deacons and their opponents on a regular basis, in addition to national print and electronic media.

Credentials will not be mailed if the credential request is received one week or less prior to the game. Credentials can be shipped overnight if a FedEx or UPS shipping number is provided.

PHOTOGRAPHERS

Photographers are restricted to either baseline area and are not permitted along the sidelines during game activity. Photographers will be assigned areas on the baseline.

The facility is lighted by 42 LED lamps with a vertical illumination of 102 footcandles and a horizontal illumination of 139 footcandles

MEDIA WILL CALL/MEDIA ENTRANCE

The media entrance to the Coliseum is located at the rear of the facility in close proximity to the media parking area. Media members can enter there and follow the hallway to the media workroom. This also serves as the primary exit for media staying to file stories.

The main media parking lot is located off of Deacon Boulevard in the McCreary Tower Lot. The secondary media lot is located off Deacon Boulevard in the BB&T Field Gold Lot. Only media with valid parking passes or who are on the media parking list will be allowed to park in these areas.

There is a media will call desk for credentials located at the media entrance.

MEDIA BAG POLICY

Wake Forest has instituted a clear bag policy for fans at LJVM Coliseum. There are no bag restrictions for credentialed media who enter through the media entrance, but bags will be subject to search.

MEDIA SEATING

Media will be assigned seats at the press row tables along the baselines or in the five rows of seating in Section 113. Please check the media seating assignments posted in the media workroom.

MEDIA SERVICES

Pre-game statistics, game notes and roster cards are provided prior to tip-off. Final stats, play-by-play and postgame quotes will be available in the media workroom.

Statistical monitors will be provided for live TV and the home and visiting team radio crews.

Wireless internet access is available in the media workroom and on press row. For user name and password information, check the posted signs in the workroom or ask a member of the Wake Forest Athletic Communications staff.

DEACON NOTES

SERIES HISTORY

- Third all-time meeting with the series tied 1-1
- Penn State won the last meeting, 67-63, in 1989-90 in the consolation of the Fiesta Bowl Classic in Tucson, Ariz.
- Wake Forest won the first meeting, 84-78, in 1960-61 in Charlotte, N.C.

THE LONG ROAD

- Wake Forest is in the final game of a six-game span away from home (at Charlotte, at Davidson, at Wooden Legacy, at Penn State)
- It is the Deacs' longest streak of regular season road/neutral games since a six-game stretch in 1974-75
- The length of the trip totals 4,980 miles

ONE (SHOT) AND DONE

- Wake ranks 3rd nationally in defensive rebounding percentage, grabbing 80.9% of opponents' misses
- The Deacs have allowed just 41 total second chance points this season (6 at BC, 2 vs. Columbia, 8 vs. UNCA, 7 at Charlotte, 3 at Davidson, 6 vs. Charleston, 0 vs. Long Beach St., 9 vs. Arizona), giving up single-digit totals in every game
- The Long Beach State game marked the first time since 2012-13 (at UNCG) that the Deacs allowed no second-chance points in a game

FREE THROWS AGAINST THE BEACH

- Wake Forest went 24-of-25 from the free throw line against Long Beach State in the semi-finals of the Wooden Legacy
- The Deacs' 96% was the second-best singlegame average in school history (min. 20 attempts), trailing only the ACC record 32-of-32 Wake had against North Carolina in 2005

SHARP-SHOOTING VS. UNC ASHEVILLE

- In the 98-79 win over UNC Asheville on Nov. 13, the Deacs shot 70.2 percent from the floor (33-47), the second-highest field goal percentage in program history
- The performance only trailed a 73.5 percent (36-49) shooting night against Fairleigh Dickinson in 1979-80
- Against UNCA, the Deacs shot 70.4 percent in the first half and 70.0 percent in the second half, the first time in school history that Wake shot at least 70 percent in both halves of a game
- It marked the first time since the 2009 game at Duke that the Deacs shot at least 60 percent in both halves of a game
- The 70.2 percent from the floor is the highest FG% against a Division I team this season and just the ninth time a team has shot over 70% from the floor against a Division I opponent since 2015-16

FRENCH OFF THE BENCH

- Olivier Sarr has performed well over the last six games since coming off the bench
- Sarr has averaged 15.7 points, 11.3 rebounds and 1.8 blocks per game as a reserve after averaging 5.5 points, 4.0 rebounds and 0.0 blocks per game over the first two games as a starter
- Sarr posted a career-high 21 points vs. UNC Asheville and vs. Arizona, a career-high 14 rebounds vs. Charleston, a career-high five blocks at Charlotte and his first three career double-doubles at Davidson, vs. Charleston and vs. Arizona

JOHNSON RISES TO THE OCCASION

- Torry Johnson has made the most of his chance to enter the starting lineup for the last four games
- Filling in for an injured Chaundee Brown at Davidson, Johnson scored a Wake career-high 15 points
- He added 13 points in his second start against Charleston
- As a starter, he is averaging 11.8 points per game on 14-28 shooting, after averaging 0.8 points per game on 1-5 shooting over the first four games

CHILDRESS FROM DEEP

- Brandon Childress enters the game with 152 career 3-pointers, ranking 10th in school history
- Last season he made 74 threes, the most by a Deac in 13 seasons and more than he made in his freshman and sophomore years combined (66)

BRANDON HITS 1K

- Brandon Childress became the 53rd player in Wake Forest history to reach the 1,000 career point milestone in the win over UNC Asheville
- His 1,000th point came on a layup late in the second half of the victory

LIKE FATHER, LIKE SON

- Randolph and Brandon Childress are the highest scoring father-son duo in ACC history with a combined 3,291 career points
- Randolph (1991-95) scored 2,208 career points (2nd most in Wake Forest history), while Brandon has scored 1,083 career points
- They are the sixth father/son duo in Division I history to combine for 3,000 career points at one school
- Childress is one of two players on the Deacons' current roster whose father also played in the ACC (Sharone Wright, Jr.'s father Sharone played at Clemson)

DEACON NOTES

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?

- Chaundee Brown is third on the team in scoring and second in rebounding
- He posted consecutive 20-point games against Columbia (20) and UNC Asheville (career-high 23)
- Against UNCA, Brown went 11-11 from the FT line, the best perfect game from the line by a Deac since Bryant Crawford went 15-15 vs. Duke in 2016-17
- He ranks third in the league in free throw percentage at 89.2 (33-37) for the season

OGUAMA SHINES IN DEBUT

- Ody Oguama scored 10 points and had seven rebounds off the bench in his collegiate debut at Boston College
- It marks the third straight year at least one Deacon freshman has scored in double figures in his first collegiate game (Hoard/Wright/Mucius in 2018-19, Brown in 2017-18)

WHITE FINDING HIS SHOT

- Andrien White made his Wake Forest debut at Boston College after sitting out last season after transferring from Charlotte where he scored 1,058 points in three years with the 49ers
- After scoring just eight points on 3-11 shooting (27.3%) in his first two games as a Demon Deacon, White is averaging 9.2 points per game on 19-41 shooting (46%), including 11-23 (48%) from three over the last six games

NOVEMBER WINS

• Wake Forest had five wins in the month of November, tying the most its has had in the Danny Manning era (2015-16, 2016-17)

 Wake Forest returns a majority of its scoring, rebounds, assists and minutes from last year's squad

- Wake Forest returns six of its seven top scorers from last season

8K ON THE BENCH

- All four coaches on the Wake Forest staff scored at least 1,000 points in their collegiate career, combining for 8,005 career points (all at the major conference level)
- Wake Forest is the only school in the nation to have all four coaches score at least 1,000 career points at the Division I level
- Head coach Danny Manning scored 2,951 career points at Kansas, associate head coach Randolph Childress scored 2,208 career points at Wake Forest, associate head coach Rex Walters scored 1,606 career points at Northwestern and Kansas and assistant coach Steve Woodberry scored 1,240 career points at Kansas

DEACS IN THE NBA

- Wake Forest has six players in the NBA this season in addition to one player on a two-way contract
- Nine-time All-Star Chris Paul is in his 15th NBA season and his first with the Oklahoma City Thunder
- 2015 All-Star Jeff Teague is in his 11th NBA season and third with the Minnesota Timber-wolves
- James Johnson is in his 11th NBA season and his fourth with the Miami Heat
- Al-Farouq Aminu is in his first season with the Orlando Magic and his 10th overall in the NBA
- Ish Smith is in his first season with the Washington Wizards, one of 10 organizations of his 10-year NBA career
