ANTHONY BOWIE OF WESTERN MICHIGAN, KATE DEL FAVA OF ILLINOIS STATE LEAD ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICA® DIVISION I MEN'S & WOMEN'S SOCCER TEAMS

AUSTIN, Texas – Western Michigan University senior midfielder Anthony Bowie and Illinois State University senior forward Kate Del Fava headline the 2019 Academic All-America® Division I men's and women's soccer teams selected by the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA) and announced Thursday.

Bowie has been named the 2019 Academic All-America® Team Member of the Year for Division I men's soccer, while Del Fava earned the distinction of 2019 Academic All-America® Team Member of the Year for Division I women's soccer.

A sales & business marketing major from Grand Rapids, Michigan, Bowie becomes a two-time Academic All-America selection after also earning first team honors in 2018. Carrying a 4.0 GPA, Bowie scored a career-high six goals on the season, to go along with three assists. This season he was named to the Mid-American Conference Second Team and was twice named the MAC Player of the Week.

Del Fava, a pre-veterinary medicine and animal science major from Kenosha, Wisconsin, earns Academic All-America® Team Member of the Year honors after being named to the Academic All-America® Second Team in 2018. She boasts a perfect 4.0 GPA while being named the 2019 Missouri Valley Player of the Year. She led the conference in goals (17), points (39), and game-winning goals (6). Del Fava was named the MVC Scholar-Athlete of the Year and Elite 17 Award winner. She is also a Senior CLASS Award finalist.

Of the 34 members on the Academic All-America® Division I men's soccer teams, 11 boast a perfect 4.0 GPA. The 11 members of the first team have an average GPA of 3.96, with the entire men's team holding a collective average GPA of 3.92

Ten others join Bowie as repeat selections on Academic All-America® Division I Men's Soccer teams from 2018 - Austin Day (Grand Canyon University), David Grana (Saint Joseph's University), Dylan Waugaman (Valparaiso University), Gideon Betz (Campbell University), Jack Casey (University of Notre Dame), Kyle Hiebert (Missouri State University), Marius Kullmann (Loyola University), Michael Creek (Missouri State University), Rikard Lindqvist (Northern Kentucky), and Tyrone Mondi (Coastal Carolina University). Additionally, Casey and Hiebert were named to the 2017 Academic All-America® teams.

Twenty five of the 33 members of the Academic All-America® Division I women's soccer teams sport a perfect 4.0 GPA. The 11 members of the first team average a near perfect GPA of 3.99, with the complete 33-member women's team averaging a 3.96 GPA.

Along with Del Fava, the Academic All-America® Division I Women's Soccer teams have six other repeat performers from last year's teams — Hannah Drkulec (University of Iowa), Heather Martin (Texas State University), Kaleigh Haus (University of Iowa), Kerry Abello (Pennsylvania State University), Stasia Mallin (University of Memphis), and Tziarra King (North Carolina State University).
