### PENN STATE SET FOR KNIGHTS CLASSIC

The 2019 Penn State softball team, under the direction of sixth-year head coach **Amanda Lehotak**, goes back to the Sunshine State for the Knights Classic, Feb. 23-24 in Orlando, Fla. The Nittany Lions will face Coastal Carolina, host UCF, Pitt and Louisiana Tech.

### SERIES HISTORY

- Penn State has met up on the field with all four weekend opponents.
- The Nittany Lions are 1-3 all-time against Coastal Carolina, with the last matchup coming in the 2017 season.
- Penn State is 2-1 against host UCF and will face the Knights for the second-straight year. Last season UCF won, 7-2, in the Houston Hilton Plaza Classic in Houston, Texas.
- Penn State holds the 13-6 advantage over in-state foe Pitt. Pitt won, 7-1, in the 2017 season and last season's game was cancelled due to weather.
- The Nittany Lions are seeking their first victory over Louisiana Tech as they are 0-3 against the Bulldogs but have not seen them since the 2012 season.

### SCOUTING THE OPPONENTS

- Coastal Carolina enters the weekend 9-1 and are riding a nine-game win streak. Taylor Sweigart leads the Chanticleers in hitting (.370) while Courtney Dean is right behind batting .357 with a team-leading four home runs, 11 RBI, and .857 slugging percentage.
- Host UCF is 4-4 after two weekends of play. Tamesha Glover leads the Knights with a .476 batting average while Breann Vasquez leads the team in the circle with two complete game shutouts.
- Pitt is 1-8 through the first part of the 2019 season, including five losses to Big Ten teams. Brie Horrell leads the team in hitting (.455) and is tied for the lead in home runs (2) and RBI (5).
- Louisiana Tech is receiving votes in week two of the USA Today/NFCA Top 25 Coaches Poll with its 10-1 start to the season. The Bulldogs boast a team batting average of .349 with eight of their top-nine regulars batting .300 or better.

### LAST TIME OUT

- Penn State went 2-2 in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge in Durham, N.C., Feb. 15-17.
- The Nittany Lions swept day one with a 3-2 win over Syracuse and a 6-0 shutout of Duke.
- Freshman left-handed pitcher **Bailey Parshall** struck out a career high 13 of 25 Syracuse batters faced in game one, tying for fourth-most in a single game in program history.
- Classmates **Melina Livingston** and **Ally Kurland** hit their first collegiate home runs on the weekend while senior **Toni Polk** added another.
- As a team, Penn State led all teams in the tournament with 26 hits in four games.

## FIRST SHUTOUT SINCE 2017

- Penn State shut out Duke, 6-0, in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge on Feb. 15.
- It marks the first time since the 2017 season that Penn State has shut out its opponent when they last did so against Nebraska in the first round of the Big Ten Tournament.

## WE'RE PARSHALL TO BAILEY'S STRIKEOUT SUCCESS

- Freshman left-handed pitcher **Bailey Parshall** has made an immediate impact in the circle for Penn State.
- The Belle Vernon, Pa., native leads the team in total strikeouts (39) and has only walked seven batters in 29.2 innings pitched.
- Parshall struck out 13 Syracuse batters on Feb. 15, the most in a single game by a Nittany Lion pitcher since 2010 and the fourth-most in a single game in program history.
- Parshall is fourth in the conference and 21st in the nation in total strikeouts.

## FRESH LINEUP

- All eight freshmen made their collegiate debuts at the FGCU Kickoff Classic in Fort Myers, Fla. on opening weekend.
- In the circle, lefty **Bailey Parshall** picked up her first career win against Ball State on Feb. 8, striking out eight Cardinals batters.
- In the batters' box, catcher **Ally Kurland** led her classmates with three hits for a .250 batting average on opening weekend.
- Kurland also led the team in fielding, totaling 31 putouts and four assists.
- **Melina Livingston** and **Anna Deshaies** both had two hits and scored two runs for the Nittany Lions.

## ROAD WARRIORS

- Penn State will open the 2019 season with 25 straight road games before they play a home contest at Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field.
- The Blue and White participate in five road tournaments to start the season, four of which are in the Sunshine State.
- The first weekend in the Sunshine State features the Nittany Lions in the FGCU Kickoff Classic, Feb. 8-10 in Fort Myers, Fla. The team will face Ball State and Kent State twice and host, Florida Gulf Coast, once.
- From there, the team will make their third-straight appearance in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge, Feb. 15-17 in Durham, N.C. facing Syracuse and Duke twice each.
- Penn State then travels back to Florida for the Knights Classic, Feb. 23-24 in Orlando to face Coastal Carolina, host UCF, Pitt and Louisiana Tech.
- The final trip to Florida includes a 10-day stint during spring break. The team will first play in the Madeira Beach Tournament, March 1-3 against Boston College, Florida International, Detroit Mercy, Florida A&M and Central Michigan. Penn State will then play a mid-week doubleheader against Penn and Villanova on March 6 in Clearwater, Fla. before appearing in the USF Tournament March 8-10 against Holy Cross, South Dakota State, Central Michigan, Saint Joseph's and Toledo.

## HOME SWEET HOME

- Penn State will play 17 schedule games on 13 dates inside the friendly confines of Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field.
- After a 25-game road game swing, the Nittany Lions will face Robert Morris for a home-opener doubleheader on Wednesday, March 20.
- The Blue and White will host their first conference series of the season March 29-31 against Wisconsin.
- Penn State is 67-74-1 at Beard Field in its eight year existence for a .475 win percentage.

## COMPETITIVE SCHEDULE

- Penn State will face four 2018 NCAA Tournament participants during the 2019 season in Michigan, Ohio State, Wisconsin and Saint Francis.
- In week two of the USA Today/NFCA Division I Top 25 Coaches Poll, Indiana is now ranked No. 19 after going undefeated in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge.
- Michigan, Louisiana Tech and Ohio State are also receiving votes.

## NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK

- Penn State softball sees 10 newcomers for the 2019 season, including eight freshmen and two transfers.
- The freshmen include **Bailey Parshall** (Belle Vernon, Pa.), **Lilia Crouthamel** (Allentown, Pa.), **Kylee Lingenfelter** (Punxsutawney, Pa.), **Melina Livingston** (Detroit, Mich.), **Anna Deshaies** (Kennett Square, Pa.), **Claire Swedberg** (Lake Villa, Ill.), **Chelsea Bisi** (Latrobe, Pa.), and **Ally Kurland** (Burke, Va.).
- The Nittany Lions also added two transfers to the squad in pitcher **Hannah Shields** (State College, Pa.) from Delaware State and infielder **Jade Williams** (Fairfax Station, Va.) from Kent State.

- In addition to the new faces, Penn State returns 14 letterwinners from the 2018 season, including Second Team All-Big Ten honoree **Tori Dubois**.
- Dubois (Mt. Vernon, N.H.) is joined by fellow senior classmates **Madison Shaffer** (New Castle, Pa.), **Paige Johnson** (Clarksville, Tenn.), **Toni Polk** (Niagara Falls, N.Y.), and **Meghan Williams** (Bethlehem, Pa.).
- Additionally, seven starters return to the lineup, including **Haley Vallejos** (Chandler, Ariz.), **Dani Fey** (Bangor, Pa.), **Delaney Elling** (Washington, Pa.), and **Christa Wagner** (Plainville, Mass.).

## IN THE RECORD BOOKS

- Senior leader **Tori Dubois** has her name plastered in the program record books heading into her final season donning the Blue and White.
- Dubois is one of just two Nittany Lions to hit three doubles in a single game, which she did against Michigan State as a freshman in 2016.
- The outfielder and utility player also currently sits at No. 15 in the record books for career batting average at .314.
- She is tied for No. 11 for career home runs with 16, nine of which came during the 2018 season.

## THE LEHOTAK FILE

- Head coach Amanda Lehotak enters her sixth year under the helm of Penn State softball.
- Lehotak tallied her 100th win at Penn State in the team's series-opening win over Maryland on March 24 for a 105-161 record with the Nittany Lions.
- Lehotak sits just seven wins away from 300 career wins (293-367).

## SMART LIONS

- The Penn State softball team had eight student-athletes receive Academic All-Big Ten accolades last season.
- The returning honorees include Tori Dubois, Delaney Elling, Amanda Grieco, Madison Shaffer and Destiny Weber.
- Then-sophomore Delaney Elling also earned Big Ten Distinguished Scholar honors for carrying a GPA of 3.7 or higher during the previous academic year.

## LEHOTAK ADDS GOLER PERRIN TO STAFF

- Head coach Amanda Lehotak added Alisa Goler Perrin, a three-time All-American at the University of Georgia, to the Penn State softball staff as an assistant coach in June 2018.
- Goler Perrin joins the Nittany Lions from Syracuse where she spent three seasons with the Orange, most recently as the associate head coach. She served as the infield and hitting coach as well as the recruiting coordinator for the Orange.
- At Syracuse, Goler Perrin helped coach 2017 NFCA All-American Sydney O'Hara who boasted a .476 batting average, .626 on-base percentage and a .833 slugging percentage to set new single-season Orange records. In the 2018 season, Goler Perrin helped junior Bryce Holmgren lead the ACC in both batting average (.413) and on-base percentage (.549).
- As a student-athlete at Georgia, Goler Perrin was a three-time All-American, four-time first-team All-Southeast Region section, and three-time first-team All-SEC honoree. She set UGA single-season records for batting average (.455), slugging percentage (.994), on-base percentage (.551), home runs (24), extra-base hits (41), RBI (83), and total bases (164).

## SIGREST INDUCTED INTO HIGH SCHOOL HALL OF FAME

- Assistant coach (pitchers and catchers) **Sarah Sigrest** was inducted in to Daphne High School's Hall of Fame in September 2018.
- Sigrest holds the Alabama High School Athletic Association shutout record with 33 before going on to play four-years under then-head coach Amanda Lehotak at Jacksonville.

## ON DECK

Penn State travels once more to Florida for a 10-day spring break trip. The Nittany Lions will play 12 total games in the Clearwater area, including stints in the Madeira Beach Tournament and USF Tournament.
