THIS WEEK'S MATCHUP

 This marks the 39th meeting in the series, with the Nittany Lions Trailing 25-13. The Nittany Lions fell 13-12 against the Tigers last season. Penn State held an 8-5 advantage going into halftime, but Princ-eton responded with a 5-0 run to start the second half. The teams traded goals until Elizabeth George gave Princeton a 13-11 lead with 5:45 remaining. Maria Auth and Katie O'Donnell each scored three goals for PSU.

CARTER MOVES UP POINTS LIST

 Senior Madison Carter tallied a seasonhigh seven points on Saturday, including a career high-tying six goals. It was her 20th career game with five or more points.

• Carter now has 210 career points, mov-ing into ninth all-time at PSU. She passed Michelle DeJuliis (203; 1994-97) and Col-leen O'Hara (208; 2000-03). Carter is just one point behind current volunteer coach Steph Lazo (2014-17) for eighth place. • Carter currently ranks 10th in the nation

among career active leaders in points and fourth in goals (190).

• On Carter's second goal of the Towson game with 12:46 left to go, the senior earned her 200th career point, becoming the 15th Nittany Lion to reach the 200-point mark for her career.

SHOOT TO SCORE

 One of the keys to PSU's offensive attack this year is a high volume of shots.

· PSU leads the Big Ten, and ranks seventh in the country, averaging 28.7 shots on goal per game.

 The Nittany Lions also sit 11th in the nation, and third in the conference, averaging 36.3 shots per game.

• PSU is 28th in the nation with 14.0 goals per game and 13th with 22.3 points per

game. PSU is eighth in the country, first in the Big Ten, in assists per game (8.3).
Carter is eighth in the Big Ten with 10 goals and fifth with 3.3 goals per game. She leads the Big Ten, and ranks eighth in the nation, with 8.67 shots per contest. She averages 6.0 shots on goal per game.

STRONG DEFENSE

· Penn State currently ranks 18th in the nation, and second in the Big Ten,

allowing just eight goals per game. • Freshman goalie Taylor Suplee is also 18th nationally and second in the conference with an 8.00 goals against average.

 The Nittany Lions have caused 13.3 turnovers per game, ranking 13th in the country, led by Reilly Masterson's 2.7 caused turnovers per game, which leads the Big Ten.

SECOND HALF SURGE

• The Nittany Lions started Saturday's second half with four unanswered goals to take a 12-6 lead early in the half.

 PSU is currently averaging 8.3 goals in the second half.

 Against Lehigh, PSU scored the first seven goals of the second half, including two goals each from Lauren Craft and

Delaney Muldoon. PSU outscored Lehigh, 9-2 in the half.

• In the season opener, PSU scored 10 goals in the second half against Towson, starting the period on a 6-1 run.

 The Nittany Lions moved up to No. 8 in this week's IWLCA Poll, rising two spots. • The blue and white is No. 11 in the Inside

Lacrosse Poll and No. 14 in the Nike/US Lacrosse Poll.

· PSU was selected third the Preseason Big Ten Poll behind Maryland and Northwestern.

FIRST WIN IN PANZER

• The Nittany Lions earned a 15-5 win over Lehigh in the first ever regular season game at Panzer Stadium.

• The state of the art venue was dedicated on September 23, 2018 and features a new videoboard, permanent concessions, ac-cessile bathrooms and a ticket office.

• The first goal in Panzer Stadium history was scored by Kristin Roberto with 26:50 left in the first half.

NATIONAL AUDIENCE

 Penn State will be featured on three Big Ten Network broadcasts and two ESPNU broadcasts this Spring.

• The Nittany Lions' Big Ten home opener against No. 2 Maryland on March 21 will be shown on ESPNU. The blue and white will also face No. 17 Johns Hopkins in an ESPNU matchup on April 19.

 The blue and white's matchup at No. 4 Northwestern, a 7 p.m. start, will be broad-cast on Big Ten Network on March 28. PSU will also be on BTN on April 4 vs. Ohio State, a 7 p.m. matchup, and April 27 vs. Rutgers, an 11 a.m. game.



• Princeton, coached by Chris Sailer, fell 14-9 at No. 12 Virginia last Saturday.

• The Tigers led 6-5 at halftime against the Cavaliers. After a 4-0 run by UVA, Princeton answered with a 3-0 run to tie the game, but UVA scored the final five goals.

• Attacker Tess D'Orsi led the Tigers with four points, including two goals. Elizabeth George had a goal and two assists, while Kyra Sears and Kathryn Hallett each had two goals.

Goalie Sam Fish made seven saves.

• Princeton won its season opener, 16-7, against Temple.

Head coach Missy Doherty is set for her ninth season at Penn State in 2019. Doherty's guidance has seen Penn State reach seven straight NCAA Tournaments and four NCAA Quarterfinals in that timespan including Penn State's first Final Four in 17 years during the 2016 season. Doherty guided the Nittany Lions back to the Final Four in 2017.

In 2018, Doherty led her team to an NCAA Tournament appearance for the seventh straight year. The Nittany Lions went 10-10 and reached the Big Ten Championship game. Penn State went 3-3 in Big Ten play. The Nittany Lions knocked off four ranked opponents, including No. 17 Cornell, No. 22 Johns Hopkins, No. 6 Virginia and No. 7 Northwestern.

The Nittany Lions tied the team record with 303 goals on the season. Three Nittany Lions earned IWLCA All-America honors, including senior Katie O'Donnell (First Team), junior Madison Carter (Second Team) and Kayla Brisolari (Third Team). O'Donnell was a Second Team All-America selection by Inside Lacrosse and was named Big Ten Midfielder of the Year, the first in program history, before being drafted 4th overall by the New England Command in the WPLL Draft. O'Donnell finished her career ranking fourth all-time at Penn State in goals (203) and sixth in points (227). Carter and Brisolari joined O'Donnell as All-Big Ten and All-Region selections. Sophomore Maria Auth led the team with 71 points, including 54 goals.

In eight seasons in Happy Valley, Doherty has coached 34 IWLCA All-Americans, 34 IWLCA All-Region athletes, 37 all-conference members, one CoSIDA Academic All-American, 28 IWLCA Honor Roll selections, one Big Ten Attack Player of the Year, one Big Ten Midfielder of the Year, one Big Ten Goalkeeper of the Year and one Big Ten Freshman of the Year.

In 2017, Doherty's team went 17-4 finishing second in the Big Ten and securing the second most single-season victories in program history and the most since 1989 when Penn State went 19-1. Doherty coached three IWLCA All-Americans during the 2017 season including the program's 43rd First-Team All-American, Steph Lazo, and the first in 13 seasons. Katie O'Donnell and Madison Carter earned second-team recognition.

The Nittany Lions set program records for goals with 303 and points with 427 while their 124 assists were the second most in a single-season in program history. Penn State earned an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament and hosted the first three rounds advancing to its 11th Final Four in program history at Gillette Stadium.

In 2016, Doherty's team went 14-7 finishing second in the Big Ten, but were upset in the first round of the Big Ten Championship Tournament by Northwestern, 9-6. Her squad earned an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament and immediately caught fire outscoring their opponents 38-23 en route to the national semifinals where they came up just one goal shy, bowing out to eventual National Champion North Carolina, 12-11. Doherty coached Madison Carter to the 2016 Big Ten Freshman of the Year honor while two players earned IWLCA All-America status and five earned IWLCA All-Region accolades. Penn State finished fourth in the final IWLCA national poll.

Doherty has led her Nittany Lion teams to double-digit wins each year since stepping foot on the University Park campus, including a 16-5 mark in 2015 while capturing the Big Ten Tournament Championship with a 13-11 victory over Ohio State.

During that 2015 season, Doherty earned Big Ten Coach of the Year, ECAC Coach of the Year and IWLCA Regional Coach of the Year accolades Penn State went 13-1 late in the season to reach the NCAA Quarterfinals and narrowly missed the program's first semifinals appearance in 16 years. Doherty coached three IWLCA All-Americans, six IWLCA All-Region players and five All-Big Ten honorees including Big

Ten Goalkeeper of the Year Emi Smith.

Following a pair of NCAA quarterfinals appearances in 2012 and 2013, Doherty guided her Nittany Lions to a 10-8 overall mark and a third NCAA Tournament showing in 2014.

LACRO

During Doherty's third year at the program's helm in 2013, Penn State continued its national ascension. The Nittany Lions reached the NCAA quarterfinals for the second straight season, making back-to-back appearances for the first time since a three-year span from 1995-97, and captured the program's most wins since 1999. Penn State, which went 14-7, also claimed a share of its first ALC regular-season championship with a 4-1 conference mark.

Under her guidance, Penn State defeated its highest ranked opponent since 2007 with a 16-11 upset victory against then-No. 2 Florida. The Nittany Lions, who were ranked as high as No. 6 for the first time since 2007, also finished a perfect 9-0 at home to complete their first undefeated home campaign since 1991.

In 2012, Doherty led Penn State to a 12-7 record, earning the program's most wins since 2005 and its third consecutive double-digit win season. Five of those wins came against ranked opponents, including three versus top-10 teams. Penn State excelled on the road in 2012, registering eight victories, the most by the Nittany Lions since the 1989 national championship team. Penn State received an at-large bid to the 2012 NCAA championship, advancing to the quarterfinals for the first time since 1999.

In her first season at the helm of the collegiate women's lacrosse's second winningest program, Doherty led the Penn State to a 10-8 record and a second-place finish in the American Lacrosse Conference. The Nittany Lions knocked off four ranked opponents during the regular season and advanced to the semifinals of the ALC Championship.

In seven years at Towson, Doherty built the Tigers into one of the top teams in the Colonial Athletic Association and into a nationally recognized and competitive program. At Towson, she posted an impressive 79-46 (.632) record, including five seasons with 13 or more victories, and led it to three CAA Tournament championships (2005, 2008-09) and a share of one CAA regular season title (2008). Doherty coached six All-Americans during her tenure, including Towson's first three-time honoree in program history.

In 2010, Doherty guided Towson to a season of unprecedented success, as the Tigers earned an at-large berth to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in program history and received their first-ever top 10 national ranking in the IWLCA Division I poll.

A 1997 graduate of the University of Maryland, Doherty (nee Holmes) was a fouryear letterwinning defender, helping the Terrapins claim three NCAA championships. Maryland was a dominant force in collegiate women's lacrosse during her career, amassing a remarkable 68-2 record, including an NCAA record 50-game winning streak.
