PENN STATE HOSTS ROBERT MORRIS IN HOME OPENER DOUBLEHEADER

The 2019 Penn State softball team, under the direction of sixth-year head coach Amanda Lehotak, finally kicks off its home slate at Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field, playing host to Robert Morris on Wednesday, March 20. The Nittany Lions and the Colonials will play two games for a doubleheader starting at 5 p.m.

SERIES HISTORY

- Penn State has a three-game edge on Robert Morris, leading the all-time series, 8-5.
- Last season, the teams split the doubleheader in University Park, with the Nittany Lions winning game one, 9-7, before the Colonials took game two, 5-0.

-1 SCOUTING THE COLONIALS 0

- Robert Morris is 3-15 through the first five weeks of the 2019 season and comes to Happy Valley having not played since March 9.
- . Abrielle McCartney leads the Colonials at the plate with a .300 batting average with 15 hits and six RBI in 17 games played.
- Dana Vatakis has two of the Colonials' three wins in the circle and holds a 5.04 ERA with 11 strikeouts in 41.2 innings pitched.

- Penn State went 10-2 during its 2019 spring break tour, playing 12 games in 10 days in the Clearwater, Fla., area.
- The Nittany Lions went 5-0 at the USF Tournament Series to close out the trip, including a walk-off win against South Dakota State.
- . Both losses only came by a one-run differential.

FRESHMEN DUO COMBINES FOR SHUTOUT n.

- The Penn State pitching staff has shut out three opponents in 2019 via the work in the circle by freshmen Kylee Lingenfelter and Bailey Parshall.
- Lingenfelter and Parshall combined to shut out Duke, 6-0, in the ACC/Big Ten . Challenge on Feb. 15, Florida A&M, 2-0, in the Madeira Beach Invitational on March 3, and Saint Joseph's, 6-0, in the USF Tournament Series on March 9.
- It marks the first time since the 2017 season that Penn State has had three shutouts in the same season.

WE'RE PARSHALL TO BAILEY'S STRIKEOUT SUCCESS
