SERIES HISTORY

- Penn State has the all-time series advantage over Michigan State, 37-28.
- Last season, the Spartans won the series, taking two of the three games over the Nittany Lions in Happy Valley.
- The series is tied 5-5 over the last 10 meetings.

SCOUTING THE SPARTANS

- Michigan State is 10-16 heading into conference play.
- Charla Echols leads the Spartans at the plate with a .377 batting average while Ebonee Echols leads the team with a .609 slugging percentage and 19 RBI.
- In the circle, Alli Walker and McKenna Gregory have each made 19 appearances. Walker holds a 3.25 ERA in 64.2 innings pitched.

NO WALK ZONE

- Junior transfer pitcher Hannah Shields leads the nation in walks allowed per seven innings.
- The State College area native has given up just two free bases in 33.0 innings pitched.

DINGER CITY

- Penn State has hit 17 home runs through the first 27 games, including four multihome run games.


