## NOTES AND HEADLINES

### PENN STATE WELCOMES NO. 25 WISCONSIN TO BEARD FIELD

The 2019 Penn State softball team returns to conference play in Happy Valley, welcoming No. 25 Wisconsin to Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field for the first conference home series, March 29-31. The Nittany Lions and Badgers will play a three-game series with game one set for Friday, March 29 at 6 p.m., game two on Saturday, March 30 at 3 p.m., and the final game on Sunday, March 31 at noon. The first two games will be streamed via the subscription-based BTN Plus while Sunday's game will be the Nittany Lions' season debut on Big Ten Network.

### SERIES HISTORY

- Penn State has the all-time series advantage over Wisconsin, 29-19.
- The two teams have not faced each other since the 2015 season when Penn State won the series, 2-1.

### SCOUTING THE BADGERS

- Wisconsin is 24-5 overall and 1-2 in Big Ten conference play.
- The Badgers are currently one of three Big Ten teams ranked in the latest polls.
- Kayla Konwent leads the Badgers with a .442 batting average and a .860 slugging percentage. The junior has nine home runs and 32 RBI on the season.
- In the circle, the Badger pitching staff holds a 1.52 ERA. Haley Hestekin and Kaitlyn Menz have seen the majority of the innings pitched and hold records of 11-3 and 9-2, respectively.

### RUBBER MATCH TURNED CONFERENCE-OPENING SERIES WIN

- Penn State won its first conference-opening series since the 2016 season after taking the series from Michigan State, 2-1, in East Lansing, March 22-24.
- After a heartbreaking walk-off loss on Friday, the Nittany Lions rallied to score six runs in the seventh inning on Saturday to even the series.
- Penn State then shut out Michigan State, 3-0, in the Sunday rubber match to win its first conference series since the 2017 season (last - 4/28-29/17 at Maryland).

### DINGER CITY

- Penn State has hit 22 home runs through the first 31 games, including six multi-home run games.
- The 22 home runs surpasses the 2018 season total of 19.
- Against Robert Morris on March 20, the Nittany Lions hit three home runs in a single game for the first time since the 2017 season when they did against Rutgers at home on April 21, 2017.
- Those three home runs also all came in the same inning for the first time since the 2016 season when Penn State last did so against Maryland on April 15, 2016.
- Against Michigan State on March 23, both home runs in the game also came in the same inning.
- **Chelsea Bisi** and **Toni Polk** lead the team with five dingers each.

### NO WALK ZONE

- Junior transfer pitcher **Hannah Shields** leads the nation in walks allowed per seven innings.
- The State College area native has given up just two free bases in 35.1 innings pitched.

### MAGIC NUMBER 3

- Penn State is 15-1 this season when scoring three or more runs.

### 10 RUNS IS A LOT

- Penn State has scored 10 or more runs in three games this season, the most double-digit scoring games since the 2017 season.
- The Nittany Lions' 10 runs in the third inning against Robert Morris on March 20 is the most in a single inning in the **Amanda Lehotak** era.

## FRESHMEN DUO COMBINES FOR SHUTOUTS

- The Penn State pitching staff has shut out three opponents in 2019 via the work in the circle by freshmen **Kylee Lingenfelter** and **Bailey Parshall**.
- Lingenfelter and Parshall combined to shut out Duke, 6-0, in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge on Feb. 15, Florida A&M, 2-0, in the Madeira Beach Invitational on March 3, and Saint Joseph's, 6-0, in the USF Tournament Series on March 9.
- Parshall also picked up her first career complete-game shutout against Michigan State on March 23. It marked the first shutout against a conference opponent since the 2017 season when Penn State shutout Rutgers, 7-0 (4/22/17).
- Junior transfer **Hannah Shields** also owns a complete shutout this season against Robert Morris on March 20.
- The five shutouts this season is the most since the 2017 season, when the team also had five that year.

## WE'RE PARSHALL TO BAILEY'S STRIKEOUT SUCCESS

- Freshman left-handed pitcher **Bailey Parshall** has made an immediate impact in the circle for Penn State.
- The Belle Vernon, Pa., native leads the team in total strikeouts (124) and has three games with 10+ strikeouts.
- Parshall struck out 15 Detroit Mercy batters on March 2 to tie the program record for most strikeouts in a single game.
- Parshall is fourth in the conference and 28th in the nation in total strikeouts as of March 26.
- Parshall also has four saves on the season, the most in the conference and tied for third-most in the nation.

## SENIOR CLASS AWARD

- Senior **Tori Dubois** has been named one of 30 candidates for the 2019 Senior CLASS Award® in collegiate softball.
- To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition.

## SPRING BREAK TOUR

- Penn State went 10-2 during its 2019 spring break tour, playing 12 games in 10 days in the Clearwater, Fla., area.
- The Nittany Lions went 5-0 at the USF Tournament Series to close out the trip, including a walk-off win against South Dakota State.
- Both losses only came by a one-run differential.

## ROAD WARRIORS

- Penn State played 25-straight road games to start the season before finally getting to play a home game.
- Of the 55 scheduled regular season games, the Nittany Lions will play 38 of them away from Happy Valley.

## 300 CAREER WINS IN THE LEHOTAK FILE

- Head coach **Amanda Lehotak** enters her sixth year under the helm of Penn State softball.
- Lehotak recorded her 300th career win as the Nittany Lions took down Central Michigan on March 3 of the Madeira Beach Invitational and now has a 310-381 career record.
- Lehotak tallied her 100th win at Penn State in the 2018 season and now has a 122-175 record with the Nittany Lions.

## FRESH LINEUP

- All eight freshmen made their collegiate debuts at the FGCU Kickoff Classic in Fort Myers, Fla. on opening weekend.
- In the circle, lefty **Bailey Parshall** picked up her first career win against Ball State on Feb. 8, striking out eight Cardinals batters.
- In the batters' box, catcher **Ally Kurland** led her classmates with three hits for a .250 batting average on opening weekend.
- Kurland also led the team in fielding, totaling 31 putouts and four assists.
- Melina Livingston** and **Anna Deshaies** both had two hits and scored two runs for the Nittany Lions.

## HOME SWEET HOME

- Penn State will play 17 schedule games on 13 dates inside the friendly confines of Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field.
- After a 25-game road game swing, the Nittany Lions will face Robert Morris for a home-opener doubleheader on Wednesday, March 20.
- The Blue and White will host their first conference series of the season March 29-31 against Wisconsin.
- Penn State is 67-74-1 at Beard Field in its eight year existence for a .475 win percentage.

- Minnesota is No. 19, Michigan is No. 23, and Wisconsin is No. 25.
- Four other Big Ten schools in Northwestern, Illinois, Indiana and Ohio State are receiving votes.

- Penn State softball sees 10 newcomers for the 2019 season, including eight freshmen and two transfers.
- The freshmen include **Bailey Parshall** (Belle Vernon, Pa.), **Lilia Crouthamel** (Allentown, Pa.), **Kylee Lingenfelter** (Punxsutawney, Pa.), **Melina Livingston** (Detroit, Mich.), **Anna Deshaies** (Kennett Square, Pa.), **Claire Swedberg** (Lake Villa, Ill.), **Chelsea Bisi** (Latrobe, Pa.), and **Ally Kurland** (Burke, Va.).
- The Nittany Lions also added two transfers to the squad in pitcher **Hannah Shields** (State College, Pa.) from Delaware State and infielder **Jade Williams** (Fairfax Station, Va.) from Kent State.

## FAMILIAR FACES

- In addition to the new faces, Penn State returns 14 letterwinners from the 2018 season, including Second Team All-Big Ten honoree **Tori Dubois**.
- Dubois (Mt. Vernon, N.H.) is joined by fellow senior classmates **Madison Shaffer** (New Castle, Pa.), **Paige Johnson** (Clarksville, Tenn.), **Toni Polk** (Niagara Falls, N.Y.), and **Meghan Williams** (Bethlehem, Pa.).
- Additionally, seven starters return to the lineup, including **Haley Vallejos** (Chandler, Ariz.), **Dani Fey** (Bangor, Pa.), **Delaney Elling** (Washington, Pa.), and **Christa Wagner** (Plainville, Mass.).

## IN THE RECORD BOOKS

- Senior leader **Tori Dubois** has her name plastered in the program record books heading into her final season donning the Blue and White.
- Dubois is one of just two Nittany Lions to hit three doubles in a single game, which she did against Michigan State as a freshman in 2016.
- The outfielder and utility player also currently sits at No. 15 in the record books for career batting average at .314.
- She is tied for No. 11 for career home runs with 16, nine of which came during the 2018 season.

## SMART LIONS

- The Penn State softball team had eight student-athletes receive Academic All-Big Ten accolades last season.
- The returning honorees include **Tori Dubois**, **Delaney Elling**, **Amanda Grieco**, **Madison Shaffer** and **Destiny Weber**.
- Then-sophomore Delaney Elling also earned Big Ten Distinguished Scholar honors for carrying a GPA of 3.7 or higher during the previous academic year.

## LEHOTAK ADDS GOLER PERRIN TO STAFF

- Head coach Amanda Lehotak added **Alisa Goler Perrin**, a three-time All-American at the University of Georgia, to the Penn State softball staff as an assistant coach in June 2018.
- Goler Perrin joins the Nittany Lions from Syracuse where she spent three seasons with the Orange, most recently as the associate head coach. She served as the infield and hitting coach as well as the recruiting coordinator for the Orange.
- At Syracuse, Goler Perrin helped coach 2017 NFCA All-American Sydney O'Hara who boasted a .476 batting average, .626 on-base percentage and a .833 slugging percentage to set new single-season Orange records. In the 2018 season, Goler Perrin helped junior Bryce Holmgren lead the ACC in both batting average (.413) and on-base percentage (.549).
- As a student-athlete at Georgia, Goler Perrin was a three-time All-American, four-time first-team All-Southeast Region section, and three-time first-team All-SEC honoree. She set UGA single-season records for batting average (.455), slugging percentage (.994), on-base percentage (.551), home runs (24), extra-base hits (41), RBI (83), and total bases (164).

## SIGREST INDUCTED INTO HIGH SCHOOL HALL OF FAME

- Assistant coach (pitchers and catchers) **Sarah Sigrest** was inducted into Daphne High School's Hall of Fame in September 2018.
- Sigrest holds the Alabama High School Athletic Association shutout record with 33 before going on to play four-years under then-head coach Amanda Lehotak at Jacksonville.

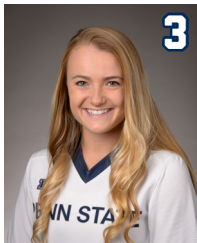

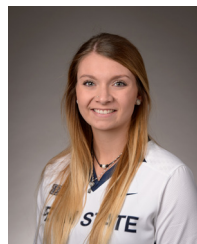
