THE MATCH-UP

Penn State and Ohio State will enter the week at No. 1 and No. 7, respectively in the USILA Coaches Poll. Penn State holds a 16-6 all-time winning record over the Buckeyes, with the Nittany Lions on a threegame winning streak after a 12-4 win in 2018, a 9-4 win in 2017, and a 6-5 overtime win in 2016.

Penn State is 7-4 against Ohio State at home, however this will be the Buckeyes' first trip to Panzer Stadium.

This series has a history of overtime as six of the 22 contests have gone into extra time. It is an even 3-3 in those overtime games.

In 2019, Ohio State is 7-1 and coming off a 14-6 loss in its Big Ten open to unranked Rutgers last Sunday. The lone mutual opponent between the Buckeyes and the Nittany Lions is the Cleveland State Vikings. Penn State beat the Vikings 15-11 just two weeks ago, while Ohio State beat CSU, 12-9, in the season opener.

WEEK 7 ROUND-UP

The No. 1 Penn State men's lacrosse team took down No. 3 Maryland, 13-10, on the evening of March 31 to move to 8-1, 1-0 in Big Ten play, earning the program's first varsity win over the Terrapins.

Penn State moved to 3-40 all-time against the Terps, but the two Nittany Lion wins came in 1916 and 1920 before Maryland became a varsity lacrosse program in 1924.

The Nittany Lions used a balanced offense and a solid defensive stand to take the 'W' back to University Park.

Penn State saw eight different players score goals and nine total players record points.

Sophomore middie Jack Kelly led the Nittany Lions with three goals for his sixth multi-goal performance and his fifth hat-trick of the year. Kelly also added an assist for four points.

Junior attackman Mac O'Keefe also recorded four points scoring two goals and dishing out two assists. O'Keefe is now at 124 career goals, just three goals shy of tying Will Driscoll's (1999-2002) Penn State Career Goals Record of 127. He also now has 38 goals on the year.

Senior Nick Spillane had a three-point performance with two goals and an assist.

Redshirt junior Grant Ament, redshirt freshmen Dan Reaume and freshman Jack Traynor each recorded two points as Ament dished out two assists, Traynor scored two goals, and Reaume tallied one of each.

Redshirt junior Dylan Foulds, sophomore Cole Willard and freshman TJ Malone all recorded a goal.

Ament is now has 48 assists this season and 112 for his career

At the 'x,' junior Gerard Arceri recorded 10 ground balls for a career-high in a Big Ten game. He also went 18 of 26 for the game for 69.2-percent.

Junior Colby Kneese stood tall in cage, recording seven saves and earning his eighth win of the season.

Senior defenseman Chris Sabia recorded two caused turnovers and three ground balls. He led a defense that allowed just one goal in the first 28 minutes as Penn State built an 8-1 lead and held Maryland to a season-low in goals.

ACTIVE STREAKS

Redshirt junior Grant Ament has the eighth longest point scoring streak in the nation, recording a point in all 39 of his career games played are 60-112-172. Senior Pat Spencer of Loyola currently leads the list at 60 as a senior at 129-203-332. Ament's streak is the longest active in the Big Ten with Michigan's Brent Noseworthy following at 34 games.

Junior Mac O'Keefe is on a 16 game goal scoring streak, dating back to March 17, 2018. He has scored 58 goals during that time. His streak is good for 10th in the nation.

NCAA STAT RANKINGS

As a team, the Nittany Lions currently rank No. 1 in the nation in seven categories. They are the top team in man-up offense (0.633), points per game (28.44), scoring margin (7.33), scoring offense (17.78), assists per game (10.67), and shot percentage (.429).

Redshirt junior Grant Ament currently leads the nation in assists per game at 6.00. He is second points per game at 7.25.

Junior Mac O'Keefe is second for goals per game at

Freshman TJ Malone is sixth in shot percentage (.528).

Junior Gerard Arceri is 11th in the nation in faceoff winning percentage at .627 and seventh in groundballs at 9.00.

SYOSSET'S SHARP-SHOOTER

Junior Mac O'Keefe has been known as one of the nation's best shooters his entire career, and soon he will be the most prolific goal scorer in Penn State

The native of Syosset, New York is just four goals away from setting the Penn State record for career goals, just three-quarters of the way into his junior campaign. O'Keefe has 124 goals heading into Sunday night's contest. The record, held by Will Driscoll (1999-2002)

On February 16 against Stony Brook, O'Keefe scored seven goal to recorded his 100th career goal, becoming the first junior to surpass that mark. O'Keefe's seventh goal at the 2:47 mark in the second quarter in that game. He is just the eighth player in Penn State history to score 100th career goals.

O'Keefe also happens to hold the single season record for goals after scoring 51 in his rookie campaign. He is currently on pace to break that record as he is averaging 4.22 goals per game, good for second in the

In an article from Inside Lacrosse from his freshman year, O'Keefe credited a fence to his success.

"It served as his own private shot incubator. It still does, to a degree. Mistakes, and there were many, were tangible. The brown wooden fence in Mac O'Keefe's backyard took the brunt of each miss. The fence, which has since been restored, was at one time in shambles. Pocked by white, round blotches and splintered in other areas, O'Keefe's backstop took a beating through the years. The family dog would go in and out because the fence had so many gaping holes in it."

"That fence is where it started. Where the vision and precision began. The moves against imaginary defenders. The perfected lefty release."

COMING UP CLUTCH

Penn State has a clutch performer. It's probably not the first name you think of when it comes to the Nittany Lions offense, but Nick Spillane has established himself as a clutch performer.

When the situation requires it, Spillane is consistently there for his teammates on the offensive side of the

Spillane has recorded eight fourth quarter goals.

Let's set the scene for all of them to show the value of Penn State's No. 13

Against Yale, Penn State trailed 13-8 early in the fourth quarter. Nick Spillane was able to get back-to-back goals to close the game to 13-11, helping iginite a comeback. Though it fell short, it wasn't due to lack of

Against Penn, Spillane was on a different planet in the closing minutes. In a back-and-forth game, it was senior midfielder Nick Spillane who was able to stick the dagger in the back of the net to secure the win for the Blue & White.

Redshirt junior attackman Grant Ament found Spillane with 2:39 left to play in the game, and Spillane took the jump shot that found its way to the back of Penn's net, tying the game at 14-all.

Off the ensuing faceoff, Penn would find itself with the win and possession but redshirt junior Tommy Wright caused a Penn turnover and defensive middie Brian Townsend scooped up the groundball and charged into the Nittany Lions' offensive side of the field. The Nittany Lions called a timeout with 2:18 left of the clock.

Out of the timeout, Penn State was able to get the ball in Spillane's stick, and the senior middie sniped a rocket of a shot that found the back of the cage and gave Penn State the lead with 2:01 left to play, and it was ultimately the game-winner.

His versatility speaks to his team's attitude of playing together as a group, which head coach Jeff Tambroni emphasizes on a weekly basis with his offense.

Against Cornell, despite having a sizable lead, Cornell clawed back to 14-11 with Cornell scoring the first goal of the fourth. However, Spillane shut down their energy scoring less than a minute later. He added another game-sealing goal in the final minutes.

In the game against Cleveland State, the Viking closed the gap to 12-10 after three straight CSU goals to open the fourth quarter. Again Spillane said ENOUGH and sniped an unassisted goal that started a 3-0 run for the Nittany Lions go put the game at bay.

Against Maryland, Spillane answered a Maryland goal in the fourth, keeping the Terrapins from gaining any momentum and keeping the Nittany Lions in the lead.

"Our offense is set up to take advantage of all six guys," Tambroni said. "The timeliness of his plays has to do with a combination of his ability, maturity and courage. In the Cornell game, he scored a couple of really big goals down the stretch, so I think he recognizes the moment as a veteran player.

"I also think he's courageous enough to make mistakes, and you need to have that senior leadership. If you do, you can be in every game as guys like that have a sense about them, and it is great to see him take a lead role in some of these crucial moments in these games."

JACKS OF ALL TRADES

On Sunday afternoon against Maryland, Jack Kelly and Jack Travnor were the two names that stuck out to most - despite most not knowing who they were.

Sophomore Jack Kelly has been on a quite offensive tear in 2019 after playing just six games in his freshman season due to injury. In 2019, Kelly has 19 goals and two assists. Against Maryland, Kelly scored a team-best three goals and added an assist. It was his sixth multi-goal performance and his fifth hat-trick of the year.

Freshman Jack Traynor has also been sneaky good for the Nittany Lions out of the midfield. The rookie score two goals in the opening quarter against Maryland on Sunday for just his third two-goal game of his career. He currently has a five-game point streak recording at least an assist or a goal dating back to the Penn game. He is shooting 41.2-percent on the year, but more impressively his shot on goal percentage is 76.5-percent. He also recorded his first game-winner against Cornell. His versatility goes beyond the offense though. Against Jacksonville, the middie scooped up an impressive five ground balls.

RECORDS BROKEN

On Sunday, March 10 against Jacksonville, Penn State saw two juniors break records.

Faceoff man Gerard Arceri surpass the school's career faceoff wins record. On his 14th faceoff win of the game against Jacksonville, Arceri become the Penn State record holder for career faceoff wins with 511, he now sits at 527 for his career. Starting the day at third on the all-time list, Arceri passed both second-place Greg Gurenlian (508; 2003-06) and first-place Danny Henneghan (510; 2010-13), to take sole possession of the top.

The Nittany Lions also saw Grant Ament take hold of the PSU single season assists record. On his seventh assist of the afternoon on Sunday, Ament broke the Penn State single season assist record of 44 set by both Gary Martin (1982) and Jeff Connor (1988). Ament is now at 110 career assists, good for second all-time, trailing only Martin who recorded 156 from 1981-84.

SABIA NAMED SENIOR CLASS AWARD FINALIST

Penn State men's lacrosse senior Chris Sabia has demonstrated excellence on and off the field, and that has recently been recognized by those at the Senior CLASS Award organization as he was named one of 10 finalists for the award. He is the only Big Ten student-athlete up for the award for men's lacrosse.

To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition.

Sabia has excelled in all four areas.

Sabia, a labor and employment relations major, is also earning a business minor and will graduate with both to his name in his four years at Penn State. He has earned Academic All-Big Ten honors during both of his eligible seasons.

The defenseman has been a staple in leading the Penn State men's lacrosse team in the community. He led and put together a group of 10 teammates to participate in a day of volunteer work at the Habitat for Humanity of Greater Centre County & ReStore this past fall, and he has also participated in many other community service events. He was a part of the 2018 State College Sustainability and Diversity Expo, where he shared research and information on different initiatives in the local area. Each of the last four years Sabia has helped freshmen move into their dorms on campus on Move-In Day and has participated in the "Day of Giving" on Penn State's campus the last four years as well. He has built a relationship with the Wounded Warriors Project by participating in the Wounded Warrior Walk, Run and Roll even, as well as a wheelchair basketball event.

Sabia was named a 2018-19 team captain for his work ethic and his competitive nature that helps lead the Penn State men's lacrosse team.

Sabia is also a two-year veteran of Penn State's Athletics Directors Leadership Institute.

The 10 names will be placed on the official ballot. Ballots will be distributed through a nationwide voting system to media, coaches and fans, who will select one candidate who best exemplifies excellence in the four Cs of community, classroom, character and competition.

DRAFTED

Penn State saw Chris Sabia and Nick Spillane picked in the top-10 of the 2019 Major League Lacrosse Draft on March 8 in at the NASCAR Hall of Fame in Charlotte, N.C.

Sabia, a defenseman from Harleysville, Pennsylvania, was selected in the first round at the No. 8 pick and the first selection by the Dallas Rattlers. "I am extremely honored to have been drafted by the Dallas Rattlers," Sabia said of his selection. "I'd especially like to thank Coach [Jeff] Tambroni and Coach [Peter] Toner. They have done a tremendous job allowing me to grow as a player and a young man."

Spillane, a midfielder from Franklin Square, New York, was the first pick of the second round, No. 10 overall, by the Ohio Machine. "Getting drafted is an unbelievable feeling," Spillane said of his selection. "There have been so many people who have had an unmeasurable impact on my growth as a person and a player. I am so thankful for the opportunity to join the [Ohio] Machine organization. I wouldn't be here without the help of all of my coaches, especially Coach [Jeff] Tambroni. From the day I stepped on campus, he challenged me to grow and develop into a better player and teammate. I am so grateful for all the time and effort he has put into me, which has definitely allowed me to grow and mature through my four years."

MORE THAN A NUMBER

Penn State has special meaning behind the jersey numbers 11 and 16.

Matt Donnelly has proven his perseverance throughout his career and was given the No. 11 jersey as a freshman as the No. 11 is presented to a young man who has persevered in the face of adversity. Donnelly lost his father during his junior year of high school. The jersey number 11, worn by Michael Jacober, 2002-05, has become symbolic of the strength and compassion of the 2005 Penn State lacrosse team who rallied around Michael after his family was tragically killed in a plane crash during his senior season year.

The No. 16 uniform will be worn by Chris Sabia in 2019 as he was selected by former Nittany Lion Ryan Keenan to next wear the number, which has been presented annually, since 2016, to a senior who best represents the "Heart of a Competitor" in honor of our "Teammate for Life" Connor Darcey. Connor passed away tragically on June 12, 2015 in a car accident, prior to his redshirt junior season. The No. 16 is passed down by the student-athlete who had the honor of wearing the No. 16 during the previous season.

ARCERI, AMENT & O'KEEFE ON TEWAARATON WATCH LIST

Penn State men's lacrosse juniors Grant Ament, Gerard Arceri and Mac O'Keefe were named to the 2019 Tewaaraton Watch List by the Tewaaraton Foundation committee.

Ament and Arceri were named to the initial list on February 28, while O'Keefe was added in the first round of additions on March 21.

Ament, a redshirt junior from Doylestown, Pa., and O'Keefe, out of Syosset, N.Y., has made their first appearances on a Tewaaraton Watch List.

This marks Arceri's third-straight appearance on the watch list as he was named added in the first round of addition in the 2017 season and was on the first edition in 2018. He made it to the final 25 and was considered a Tewaaraton Nominee in 2018.

CAPTAINS

The Penn State head coach Jeff Tambroni named Mike Aronow, Matt Donnelly and Chris Sabia as captains for 2019.

Aronow, a native of Holbrook, N.Y., returns as team captain after being the only underclassman in the role in 2018, an honor he received after missing all of the 2017 season due to injury. In his comeback season as a redshirt junior, Aronow started all 14 games at defender, causing 11 turnovers, which was good for second on the team. He added 24 ground balls and an assist in 2018.

Donnelly, a native of Sewell, N.J., played in all 14 games in 2018, including earning four starts. He scored eight goals and added five assists for 13 points. He also added seven ground balls and two caused turnovers on the season. Donnelly has also proven his perseverance throughout his career, and was given the No. 11 jersey as a freshman.

Entering his senior campain, Sabia started all 45 games in his collegiate career, and accumulated 51 career turnovers, 75 ground balls, six goals and an assist. The defenseman has earned both conference and national recognition as he was named both a 2017 and 2018 All-Big Ten second team honoree and was a USILA honorable mention All-American in 2017 and 2018 as well.

Jeff Tambroni, who is in his ninth season at Penn State in 2019, has a 177-90 career record, and a 68-50 record at the helm of the Nittany Lion squad.

Tambroni led the Nittany Lions to the NCAA Tournament in 2013 and 2017.

Tambroni, one of the sport's most decorated coaches, enters the 2019 season eighth among all active Division I coaches in career win percentage. In 2018, the Nittany Lions went 8-6 overall, 2-3 in Big Ten play. Throughout the season, Penn State grabbed ranked wins over No. 13 Penn, 10-7, and the program's first win over No. 5 Johns Hopkins, 14-12. Gerard Arceri made a name for himself on a national level with a 68.1-winning percentage at the 'x,' earning 216 wins on the season. He scooped up an impressive 145 groundballs, for 10.36 per game average, adding a career-best six goals, while dishing out one assist. His percentage at the face and his ground balls per game were both good for fourth in the NCAA and led the Big Ten. He was named the Big Ten Specialist of the Year, First Team All-Big Ten, and USILA third team All-Americans. Mac O'Keefe was also named first-team All-Big Ten, and was a USLIA honorable-mention All-American along with Chris Sabia. Ryan Keenan was selected to the USILA North-South Team, and was drafted 54th in the MLL Draft to the Ohio Machine.

In 2018, Tambroni led the Nittany Lions to a 12-4 record, just the seventh double-digit win season, and only the second in the last 20 seasons (2013, 2017). Penn State set a program record, opening the season with a 10-0 record for the best start in school history. The 10th win highlighted the streak as Penn State took down No. 5 Ohio State, 9-4, to earn just the eighth victory in program history over a top-five team. Penn State also earned their first winning record in Big Ten play, going 3-2. Tambroni saw three student-athletes earn USILA All-America honorable mention honors, while Nick Aponte earned a USILA Scholar All-America accolades.

Penn State's 2013 campaign saw Tambroni lead Penn State to one of the greatest seasons in program history while celebrating its 100th season. The Nittany Lions set a record for wins (12) and earned the program's first outright regular-season conference title by sweeping the CAA with a 6-0 record. PSU rattled off 10-straight wins from March through May to earn the school's third NCAA bid and first chance to host an NCAA Tournament game.

The program's 12 wins in 2017 tied the record. There have been four USILA Scholar All-America honorees under Tambroni and 14 USILA All-Americans during his time at Penn State.

Tambroni was named USILA Division I Coach of the Year following the 2009 season while at Cornell and was tabbed the 2007 and 2009 Field Turf/NCAA Division I Coach of the Year. Tambroni was also the 2004 and 2009 Ithaca Journal Male Coach of the Year and a three-time National Coach of the Week.

While at Cornell, Tambroni became the 10th-fastest coach to reach the 100win mark when he accomplished the feat in his 134th career game in March 2010.

During his tenure, his players earned 37 first-team All-lvy honors, including five lvy League awards, and three conference Rookie of the Year selections. Thirty-nine players, also garnered All-America recognition.

A 1992 graduate, Tambroni earned his bachelor's degree in American studies. He claimed first-team All-America honors as a senior and was twice named a second-team All-American (1990-91). The MVP of the 1990 NCAA title game, Tambroni helped lead the team to back-to-back NCAA championships (1990-91) and left Hobart tied for seventh on the school's all-time scoring list with 202 points, and currently sits in eighth.

Before embarking upon his collegiate coaching career, Tambroni coached the Heaton Mersey Lacrosse Club of the English Lacrosse Union for one year and served as a visiting coach for the Czech-American Lacrosse Foundation in Prague in the summer of 1996.

Tambroni and his wife, Michelle, have three daughters, Carissa, Madison, and Ella. Michelle played field hockey at Penn State from 1988-90 and earned All-America honors as a senior.
