PENN STATE BEGINS CONFERENCE HOMESTAND WITH OHIO STATE TUESDAY

The Penn State softball team begins a five-game conference homestand this week, welcoming Ohio State to Happy Valley for a midweek doubleheader on Tuesday, April 9. Game one is set for a 5 p.m. first pitch with game two starting approximately 30 minutes after the conclusion of game one. Both games will be broadcast live on Big Ten Network with Mike Monaco (pxp) and Carol Bruggeman (analyst) on the call.

SERIES HISTORY

- Ohio State holds the all-time series advantage over Penn State, 56-32.
- The Buckeyes have won three of the last four over the Nittany Lions, however Penn State's last win over a ranked opponent came against then-No. 25 Ohio State in Happy Valley during the 2017 season (4/12/17).

SCOUTING THE BUCKEYES

- Ohio State is 23-11 overall and 7-2 in Big Ten conference play.
- Four of the Buckeyes' 11 losses came against ranked schools while they picked up a conference sweep over then-No. 22 Indiana in the first weekend of Big Ten play.
- Lilli Piper leads the Buckeyes with a .367 batting average, including a team-high 40 hits.
- Emily Clark leads the team with 12 doubles, seven home runs and 32 RBI.
- Morgan Ray and Lauren Rice have seen the most time in the circle for the Buckeyes, with 108.2 and 74.2 innings pitched, respectively. Ray holds a 1.87 ERA with 101 total strikeouts while holding batters to a .154 batting average.

DINGER CITY TURNED PROGRAM RECORD

- Penn State has hit 36 home runs in the 2019 season so far, setting a new program record for total home runs in a single season. The previous record was 31 set in 2006.
- Nine games this season have been multi-home run performances by the Nittany Lions, including a single-game program record six against Saint Francis on April 3.
- Penn State has had three games this season where multiple home runs in the same inning, including three in the second inning against Saint Francis on April 3.
- Freshman **Melina Livingston's** two home runs against Saint Francis in game two of the doubleheader on April 3 marked the first multi-home run game for a Penn State hitter since the 2016 season when Macy Jones did so against Michigan State (4/2/16).
- **Chelsea Bisi** and **Toni Polk** lead the Nittany Lions with nine home runs each.
- Penn State's 36 home runs is fourth-most in the conference behind Wisconsin (45), Minnesota (43) and Illinois (41).

NO WALK ZONE

- Junior transfer pitcher **Hannah Shields** leads the nation in walks allowed per seven innings.
- The State College area native has given up just five free bases in 53.0 innings pitched.

MAGIC NUMBER 3

- Penn State is 17-4 this season when scoring three or more runs.

10 RUNS IS A LOT

- Penn State has scored 10 or more runs in four games this season, the most double-digit scoring games since the 2016 season.
- The Nittany Lions' 10 runs in the third inning against Robert Morris on March 20 is the most in a single inning in the **Amanda Lehotak** era.

RUBBER MATCH TURNED CONFERENCE-OPENING SERIES WIN

- Penn State won its first conference-opening series since the 2016 season after taking the series from Michigan State, 2-1, in East Lansing, March 22-24.
- After a heartbreaking walk-off loss on Friday, the Nittany Lions rallied to score six runs in the seventh inning on Saturday to even the series.
- Penn State then shut out Michigan State, 3-0, in the Sunday rubber match to win its first conference series since the 2017 season (last - 4/28-29/17 at Maryland).

FRESHMEN DUO COMBINES FOR SHUTOUTS

- The Penn State pitching staff has shut out three opponents in 2019 via the work in the circle by freshmen **Kylee Lingenfelter** and **Bailey Parshall**.
- Lingenfelter and Parshall combined to shut out Duke, 6-0, in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge on Feb. 15, Florida A&M, 2-0, in the Madeira Beach Invitational on March 3, and Saint Joseph's, 6-0, in the USF Tournament Series on March 9.
- Parshall also picked up her first career complete-game shutout against Michigan State on March 23. It marked the first shutout against a conference opponent since the 2017 season when Penn State shutout Rutgers, 7-0 (4/22/17).
- Junior transfer **Hannah Shields** also owns a complete shutout this season against Robert Morris on March 20.
- The five shutouts this season is the most since the 2017 season, when the team also had five that year.

WE'RE PARSHALL TO BAILEY'S STRIKEOUT SUCCESS

- Freshman left-handed pitcher **Bailey Parshall** has made an immediate impact in the circle for Penn State.
- The Belle Vernon, Pa., native leads the team in total strikeouts (144) and has three games with 10+ strikeouts.
- Parshall struck out 15 Detroit Mercy batters on March 2 to tie the program record for most strikeouts in a single game.
- Parshall is fourth in the conference and 31st in the nation in total strikeouts as of April 8.
- The freshman is averaging 8.5 strikeouts per seven innings.
- Parshall also has four saves on the season, the most in the conference and seventh in the nation.

SENIOR CLASS AWARD CANDIDATE

- Senior **Tori Dubois** was named one of 30 candidates for the 2019 Senior CLASS Award® in collegiate softball.
- To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition.

SPRING BREAK TOUR

- Penn State went 10-2 during its 2019 spring break tour, playing 12 games in 10 days in the Clearwater, Fla., area.
- The Nittany Lions went 5-0 at the USF Tournament Series to close out the trip, including a walk-off win against South Dakota State.
- Both losses only came by a one-run differential.

ROAD WARRIORS

- Penn State played 25-straight road games to start the season before finally getting to play a home game.
- Of the 55 scheduled regular season games, the Nittany Lions will play 38 of them away from Happy Valley.

300 CAREER WINS IN THE LEHOTAK FILE

- Head coach **Amanda Lehotak** enters her sixth year under the helm of Penn State softball.
- Lehotak recorded her 300th career win as the Nittany Lions took down Central Michigan on March 3 of the Madeira Beach Invitational and now has a 312-387 career record.
- Lehotak tallied her 100th win at Penn State in the 2018 season and now has a 124-181 record with the Nittany Lions.

FRESH LINEUP

- All eight freshmen made their collegiate debuts at the FGCU Kickoff Classic in Fort Myers, Fla. on opening weekend.
- In the circle, lefty **Bailey Parshall** picked up her first career win against Ball State on Feb. 8, striking out eight Cardinals batters.
- In the batters' box, catcher **Ally Kurland** led her classmates with three hits for a .250 batting average on opening weekend.
- Kurland also led the team in fielding, totaling 31 putouts and four assists.
- Melina Livingston** and **Anna Deshaies** both had two hits and scored two runs for the Nittany Lions.

HOME SWEET HOME

- Penn State will play 17 schedule games on 13 dates inside the friendly confines of Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field.
- After a 25-game road game swing, the Nittany Lions will face Robert Morris for a homeopener doubleheader on Wednesday, March 20.
- Penn State is 67-74-1 at Beard Field in its eight year existence for a .475 win percentage.

COMPETITIVE SCHEDULE

- Penn State will face four 2018 NCAA Tournament participants during the 2019 season in Michigan, Ohio State, Wisconsin and Saint Francis.
- In week eight of the USA Today/NFCA Division I Top 25 Coaches Poll, three Big Ten schools are ranked, including two opponents the Nittany Lions will face in 2019.
- Minnesota is No. 19, Michigan is No. 23, and Wisconsin is No. 25.
- Four other Big Ten schools in Northwestern, Illinois, Indiana and Ohio State are receiving votes.

FAMILIAR FACES

- In addition to the new faces, Penn State returns 14 letterwinners from the 2018 season, including Second Team All-Big Ten honoree **Tori Dubois**.
- Dubois (Mt. Vernon, N.H.) is joined by fellow senior classmates **Madison Shaffer** (New Castle, Pa.), **Paige Johnson** (Clarksville, Tenn.), **Toni Polk** (Niagara Falls, N.Y.), and **Meghan Williams** (Bethlehem, Pa.).
- Additionally, seven starters return to the lineup, including **Haley Vallejos** (Chandler, Ariz.), **Dani Fey** (Bangor, Pa.), **Delaney Elling** (Washington, Pa.), and **Christa Wagner** (Plainville, Mass.).

IN THE RECORD BOOKS

- Senior leader **Tori Dubois** has her name plastered in the program record books heading into her final season donning the Blue and White.
- Dubois is one of just two Nittany Lions to hit three doubles in a single game, which she did against Michigan State as a freshman in 2016.
- The outfielder and utility player also currently sits at No. 15 in the record books for career batting average at .314.
- She is tied for No. 11 for career home runs with 16, nine of which came during the 2018 season.

SMART LIONS

- The Penn State softball team had eight student-athletes receive Academic All-Big Ten accolades last season.
- The returning honorees include **Tori Dubois**, **Delaney Elling**, **Amanda Grieco**, **Madison Shaffer** and **Destiny Weber**.
- Then-sophomore Delaney Elling also earned Big Ten Distinguished Scholar honors for carrying a GPA of 3.7 or higher during the previous academic year.

LEHOTAK ADDS GOLER PERRIN TO STAFF

- Head coach Amanda Lehotak added **Alisa Goler Perrin**, a three-time All-American at the University of Georgia, to the Penn State softball staff as an assistant coach in June 2018.
- Goler Perrin joins the Nittany Lions from Syracuse where she spent three seasons with the Orange, most recently as the associate head coach. She served as the infield and hitting coach as well as the recruiting coordinator for the Orange.
- At Syracuse, Goler Perrin helped coach 2017 NFCA All-American Sydney O'Hara who boasted a .476 batting average, .626 on-base percentage and a .833 slugging percentage to set new single-season Orange records. In the 2018 season, Goler Perrin helped junior Bryce Holmgren lead the ACC in both batting average (.413) and on-base percentage (.549).
- As a student-athlete at Georgia, Goler Perrin was a three-time All-American, four-time first-team All-Southeast Region section, and three-time first-team All-SEC honoree. She set UGA single-season records for batting average (.455), slugging percentage (.994), on-base percentage (.551), home runs (24), extra-base hits (41), RBI (83), and total bases (164).

SIGREST INDUCTED INTO HIGH SCHOOL HALL OF FAME

- Assistant coach (pitchers and catchers) **Sarah Sigrest** was inducted in to Daphne High School's Hall of Fame in September 2018.
- Sigrest holds the Alabama High School Athletic Association shutout record with 33 before going on to play four-years under then-head coach Amanda Lehotak at Jacksonville.

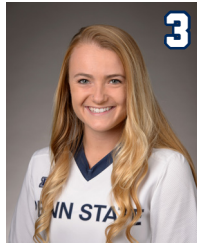

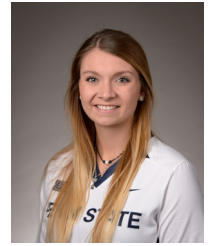
