PENN STATE TO FACE BIG TEN TOURNAMENT HOST INDIANA IN FIRST ROUND

The Penn State softball team heads to Bloomington, Indiana for the 2019 Big Ten Softball Tournament, May 9-11, on the campus of Indiana University. The No. 10 seeded Nittany Lions will face No. 7 seed and tournament hosts Indiana in the first round on Thursday, May 9 at 4:30 p.m.

PENN STATE IN THE BIG TEN TOURNAMENT

- Penn State returns to the Big Ten Softball Tournament after missing the field in the 2018 season.
- The Nittany Lions are 13-17 overall in the tournament and 3-4 in the **Amanda Lehotak** era.
- Penn State enters the tournament as the No. 10 seed, its highest seed since the 2016 season when it was No. 4.

SERIES HISTORY

- Indiana holds the all-time series advantage, 42-32.
- The Nittany Lions and the Hoosiers will match up for the fourth-straight game after concluding the 2019 regular season with a three-game series in Happy Valley.
- Penn State and Indiana are meeting for the first time in the conference tournament since it started in 1999.

SCOUTING THE INDIANA HOOSIERS

- Penn State is familiar with Indiana after concluding the regular season with a three-game conference series with the Hoosiers at Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field.
- Indiana finished the regular season at 35-20 overall and 10-13 in Big Ten play, and remain in the top-50 in RPI standings at 48.
- They boast wins over two top-10 teams this season in Georgia and LSU and were ranked as high as No. 16 in the NFCA poll.
- Maddie Westmoreland leads the Hoosiers at the plate, batting .320, while Taylor Lambert is batting .291 and leads the team with 51 hits.
- The Hoosiers hold a team ERA of 2.22 while Tara Trainer is the ace in the circle with a 1.79 ERA of her own with 225 strikeouts in 207.0 innings.

TRIO GARNERS BIG TEN SEASON ACCOLADES

- Three members of Penn State softball earned Big Ten postseason accolades as announced by the conference office on May 8.
- Senior **Toni Polk** was named Second Team All-Big Ten, freshman **Chelsea Bisi** earned a spot on the Big Ten All-Freshman Team, and senior **Madison Shaffer** picked up Penn State's Sportsmanship Award.

DINGER CITY TURNED PROGRAM RECORD

- Penn State has hit 48 home runs in the 2019 season so far, setting a new program record for total home runs in a single season. The previous record was 31 set in 2006.
- 13 games this season have been multi-home run performances by the Nittany Lions, including a single-game program record six against Saint Francis on April 3.
- Penn State has had five games this season where multiple home runs in the same inning, including three in the second inning against Saint Francis on April 3.
- Freshman **Melina Livingston's** two home runs against Saint Francis in game two of the doubleheader on April 3 marked the first multi-home run game for a Penn State hitter since the 2016 season when Macy Jones did so against Michigan State (4/2/16).

LEAD-OFF LEGEND

- **Toni Polk** is having a fantastic senior season batting in the lead-off position for the Nittany Lions, currently leading the team with a .324 average.
- The Niagara Falls, N.Y., native has hit a tied team-high 13 home runs after having only hit one each of the previous three seasons.
- Polk also has a .325 batting average and .610 slugging percentage in conference play, showing her strength of taking on even the best pitchers in the Big Ten.
- Polk earned her first career Big Ten season honors for her efforts as she was named Second Team All-Big Ten.

AIN'T NO PARTY LIKE A HOME RUN PARTY

- Senior **Toni Polk** and freshman **Chelsea Bisi** continue to pace the Nittany Lions with 13 home runs each.
- The duo has combined for eight of Penn State's 13 multi-home run games.

NO WALK ZONE

- Junior transfer pitcher **Hannah Shields** leads the nation in walks allowed per seven innings.
- The State College area native has given up just seven free bases in 69.0 innings pitched.

MAGIC NUMBER 3

- Penn State is 21-7 this season when scoring three or more runs.

10 RUNS IS A LOT

- Penn State has scored 10 or more runs in five games this season, the most double-digit scoring games since the 2016 season.
- The Nittany Lions' 10 runs in the third inning against Robert Morris on March 20 is the most in a single inning in the **Amanda Lehotak** era.

WE'RE PARSHALL TO BAILEY'S STRIKEOUT SUCCESS

- Freshman left-handed pitcher **Bailey Parshall** has made an immediate impact in the circle for Penn State.
- The Belle Vernon, Pa., native leads the team in total strikeouts (182) and has three games with 10+ strikeouts.
- Parshall's 182 strikeouts is enough for No. 9 in the program's single-season strikeout list, passing Ashley Esparza who struck out 166 in 2007.
- Parshall struck out 15 Detroit Mercy batters on March 2 to tie the program record for most strikeouts in a single game.
- Parshall is sixth in the conference and 38th in the nation in total strikeouts as of May 6.
- The freshman is averaging 7.7 strikeouts per seven innings.
- Parshall also has five saves on the season, the most in the conference and 12th in the nation.

FRESHMEN DUO COMBINES FOR SHUTOUTS

- The Penn State pitching staff has shut out three opponents in 2019 via the work in the circle by freshmen **Kylee Lingenfelter** and **Bailey Parshall**.
- Lingenfelter and Parshall combined to shut out Duke, 6-0, in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge on Feb. 15, Florida A&M, 2-0, in the Madeira Beach Invitational on March 3, and Saint Joseph's, 6-0, in the USF Tournament Series on March 9.
- Parshall also owns two complete-game shutouts in conference play against Michigan State (March 23) and Indiana (May 5).
- Junior transfer **Hannah Shields** also owns a complete shutout this season against Robert Morris on March 20.
- The six shutouts this season is the most since the 2011 season.

RUBBER MATCH TURNED CONFERENCE-OPENING SERIES WIN

- Penn State won its first conference-opening series since the 2016 season after taking the series from Michigan State, 2-1, in East Lansing, March 22-24.
- After a heartbreaking walk-off loss on Friday, the Nittany Lions rallied to score six runs in the seventh inning on Saturday to even the series.
- Penn State then shut out Michigan State, 3-0, in the Sunday rubber match to win its first conference series since the 2017 season (last - 4/28-29/17 at Maryland).

SENIOR CLASS AWARD CANDIDATE

- Senior **Tori Dubois** was named one of 30 candidates for the 2019 Senior CLASS Award® in collegiate softball.
- To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition.

SPRING BREAK TOUR

- Penn State went 10-2 during its 2019 spring break tour, playing 12 games in 10 days in the Clearwater, Fla., area.
- The Nittany Lions went 5-0 at the USF Tournament Series to close out the trip, including a walk-off win against South Dakota State.
- Both losses only came by a one-run differential.

ROAD WARRIORS

- Penn State played 25-straight road games to start the season before finally getting to play a home game.
- Of the 55 scheduled regular season games, the Nittany Lions will play 38 of them away from Happy Valley.

300 CAREER WINS IN THE LEHOTAK FILE

- Head coach **Amanda Lehotak** enters her sixth year under the helm of Penn State softball.
- Lehotak recorded her 300th career win as the Nittany Lions took down Central Michigan on March 3 of the Madeira Beach Invitational and now has a 317-398 career record.
- Lehotak tallied her 100th win at Penn State in the 2018 season and now has a 129-192 record with the Nittany Lions.

FRESH LINEUP

- All eight freshmen made their collegiate debuts at the FGCU Kickoff Classic in Fort Myers, Fla. on opening weekend.
- In the circle, lefty **Bailey Parshall** picked up her first career win against Ball State on Feb. 8, striking out eight Cardinals batters.
- In the batters' box, catcher **Ally Kurland** led her classmates with three hits for a .250 batting average on opening weekend.
- Kurland also led the team in fielding, totaling 31 putouts and four assists.

HOME SWEET HOME

- Penn State will play 17 schedule games on 13 dates inside the friendly confines of Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field.
- After a 25-game road game swing, the Nittany Lions will face Robert Morris for a homeopener doubleheader on Wednesday, March 20.
- Penn State is 67-74-1 at Beard Field in its eight year existence for a .475 win percentage.

COMPETITIVE SCHEDULE

- Penn State will face four 2018 NCAA Tournament participants during the 2019 season in Michigan, Ohio State, Wisconsin and Saint Francis.

- The Nittany Lions also added two transfers to the squad in pitcher **Hannah Shields** (State College, Pa.) from Delaware State and infielder **Jade Williams** (Fairfax Station, Va.) from Kent State.

- In addition to the new faces, Penn State returns 14 letterwinners from the 2018 season, including Second Team All-Big Ten honoree **Tori Dubois**.
- Dubois (Mt. Vernon, N.H.) is joined by fellow senior classmates **Madison Shaffer** (New Castle, Pa.), **Paige Johnson** (Clarksville, Tenn.), **Toni Polk** (Niagara Falls, N.Y.), and **Meghan Williams** (Bethlehem, Pa.).
- Additionally, seven starters return to the lineup, including **Haley Vallejos** (Chandler, Ariz.), **Dani Fey** (Bangor, Pa.), **Delaney Elling** (Washington, Pa.), and **Christa Wagner** (Plainville, Mass.).

IN THE RECORD BOOKS

- Senior leader **Tori Dubois** has her name plastered in the program record books heading into her final season donning the Blue and White.
- Dubois is one of just two Nittany Lions to hit three doubles in a single game, which she did against Michigan State as a freshman in 2016.
- The outfielder and utility player also currently sits at No. 15 in the record books for career batting average at .314.
- She is tied for No. 11 for career home runs with 16, nine of which came during the 2018 season.

In the 2018 season, Goler Perrin helped junior Bryce Holmgren lead the ACC in both batting average (.413) and on-base percentage (.549).
- As a student-athlete at Georgia, Goler Perrin was a three-time All-American, four-time first-team All-Southeast Region section, and three-time first-team All-SEC honoree. She set UGA single-season records for batting average (.455), slugging percentage (.994), on-base percentage (.551), home runs (24), extra-base hits (41), RBI (83), and total bases (164).
