PENN STATE OPENS BIG TEN PLAY AT OHIO STATE

The Penn State men's soccer team, under second-year head coach Jeff Cook, opens 2019 Big Ten conference play at Ohio State on Saturday, Sept. 21 at 7 p.m. at Jesse Owens Memorial Field in Columbus.

PENN STATE AGAINST OHIO STATE

- Penn State leads the overall series with Ohio State, 19-14-4, and will face the Buckeyes Saturday for the 38th time in program history.
- Penn State is 3-2-1 against Ohio State in the last five seasons, which includes a matchup in the Big Ten Tournament in 2015.
- Last season, the Nittany Lions defeated the Buckeyes, 3-1, at Jeffrey Field, also in the Big Ten opener.

SCOUTING OHIO STATE

- The Ohio State Buckeyes are 5-1-0, including a five-game win streak, ahead of starting conference play this weekend.
- Redshirt sophomore Devyn Etling has a team-high five goals this season and was named the Big Ten Offensive Player of the Week on Tuesday.
- Etling also has a team-high 11 points while junior Jack Holland has nine on three goals and three assists.
- Buckeye goalkeeper Parker Siegfried has three shutouts in 2019 and has not surrendered a goal in the last 177 minutes of game action.
- Ohio State picked up votes in the latest United Soccer Coaches weekly poll.

LAST TIME OUT

- Penn State ended Villanova's bid for a perfect season, shutting out the Wildcats, 1-0, last Friday at Jeffrey Field.
- Head coach Jeff Cook called the victory the team's "best overall performance of the season."
- In the 11th minute, Christian Sload set up Seth Kuhn for a welltaken goal, the first goal Villanova's Carson Williams had given up all season.
- Goalkeeper Kris Shakes had three saves in the match for his second consecutive shutout. The freshman in 3-0-0 in between the pipes in his debut campaign.

BEST START SINCE 2015

Penn State is 3-1-1 to start 2019, marking the best start since the 2015 season.

PENN STATE IN BIG TEN OPENERS

- Penn State men's soccer is 15-11-2 in Big Ten openers since joining the conference in 1991.
- Head coach Jeff Cook is 1-0-0 in conference openers after his Nittany Lions defeated Ohio State, 3-1, in 2018.

SAVED THE BEST FOR LAST

- Senior forward Christian Sload is already having a career-best season in his final year with the Blue and White.
- The Reading, Pa., native has two goals and two assists for six points through five games, including recording points in the last four games.
- Sload's previous career season highs were a single goal in each of the last three seasons and four total points in 2017 and 2018.

CAREER FIRSTS

- The start of 2019 has brought many career firsts for Nittany Lion men's soccer student-athletes.
- Against Stony Brook, senior captain Aaron Molloy had his first multi-goal game while freshman Alex Stevenson scored his first career goal and Andrew Stevenson recorded his first career
- Against Stetson, freshman goalkeeper Kris Shakes recorded his first career shutout and senior Kyle Perno scored his first career goal.
- Sophomore transfer Seth Kuhn scored his first collegiate goal against Villanova.

BLUE AND WHITE DEBUT

- 11 of the 13 Nittany Lion newcomers have seen time on the pitch in 2019.
- Jalen Watson, Andrew Privett, Liam Butts, Seth Kuhn. Alex Stevenson, Will Campbell, Michael Gaines, Adam Laundree, Kyle May and Dax Hoffman all made their debuts against Stanford on Aug. 30.
- Kris Shakes made his debut in between the pipes at Stony Brook on Sept. 2.
- Redshirt freshman Josh Dabora made his Penn State debut against Stanford on Aug. 30 after sitting out 2018.

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

- Five of Penn State's 16 regular-season opponents are ranked in the top 25 of the United Soccer Coaches' week three poll while two more are receiving votes.
- Nonconference opponents Stanford (No. 2) and UCF (No. 13) and Big Ten foe Indiana (No. 4) sit

- in the top-15 while Rutgers (No. 24) and Maryland (No. 25) round out the top 25 opponents for the Nittany Lions.
- Ohio State picked up votes in the poll for the first time this season as the Buckeyes are on a five-game win streak while Villanova continues to receive votes even after losses at Penn State and Maryland.
- The Nittany Lions are 1-1-1 with ranked or receiving-votes teams in 2019.

FAMILIAR NAMES, FAMILIAR FACES

- Penn State returns 12 players from the 2018 roster, including Big Ten preseason honorees Brandon Hackenberg, Aaron Molloy and Pierre Reedv.
- Redshirt junior goalkeeper Josh Levine returns in between the pipes for the Nittany Lions after posting a career-high four shutouts in 2018 and earning Co-Defensive Player of the Week honors once.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK

- Penn State adds 13 newcomers to the 2019 roster, which includes nine freshmen, two transfers and two walk-ons.
- Seth Kuhn (Duke) and Will Campbell (UNC) re-join Coach Cook in Happy Valley from their respective universities after playing for him at the Philadelphia Union Academy.

TOP-10 RECRUITING CLASS

Head coach Jeff Cook's first six 2019 recruits in Liam Butts, Michael Gaines, Kyle May, Andrew Privett, Kris Shakes and Alex Stevenson earned top-10 recruiting class kudos from Top Drawer Soccer during the early signing period in fall 2018.

BIG TEN PRESEASON HONORS

- Senior Aaron Molloy and redshirt juniors Brandon Hackenberg and Pierre Reedy each earned a spot on the 2019 Big Ten preseason honors list as announced by the conference office.
- Molloy earned preseason honors for the third consecutive season. In 2018, Molloy was named to the All-Big Ten second team and the United Soccer Coaches All-North Region third team. The midfielder had two goals and two assists in 15 matches last season.
- Hackenberg earned preseason honors for the first time in his career.
