REMINDER Parking Deck Information for Athletic Events at Rec Hall:

For parking at the Nittany Deck, Intercollegiate Athletics, in partnership with Transportation Services, sponsors a period of free parking for Men's and Women's Gymnastics attendees that begins 1.5 hours before the start of each match and ends approximately 1.5 hours after the meet has ended. Any fan parking prior to the grace period before the meet will be responsible for the standard \$1 per hour parking fee for the entirety of their stay in the garage.

Please note the procedures for visitor parking at Nittany Deck:

- Take ticket at entry lane and park in any non-reserved space (KEEP TICKET WITH YOU!). All lanes are available for entry.
- When ready to exit the deck after the meet, visit one of the pay-on-foot machines on the ground floor of the Parking Deck and submit your entry ticket.
 - o If no fee is due, the ticket will be returned to you as validated, and you may then proceed to your vehicle to exit.
 - o If a fee is due, you will be prompted to pay by credit card (Visa, MasterCard, Discover) or cash. Once payment has been received, your ticket will be returned to you as paid and you may proceed to your vehicle to exit.
- Submit your paid or validated ticket at the exit lane machine to raise the gate. Please use all three lanes upon exiting to keep traffic flowing.

Other Lots:

Intercollegiate Athletics will continue to provide parking free of charge in parking lot Red-A on the backside of Rec Hall beginning 1.5 hours prior through 2:00 a.m. No special permit is needed.

*PLEASE NOTE: if you have any University issued parking permit, you can park in Nittany Parking

Deck free of charge after 4:00 p.m. and all day on Saturday and Sunday. If there is Event Parking in place at Red-A, please let the attendant know you are there for Men's/Women's Gymnastics.

Similar/additional information will be distributed for Wrestling and Men's Volleyball.

For your information:

With construction of the new West Campus Parking Deck now underway, approximately 275 Red A parking spaces have permanently closed, which will significantly reduce the number of Red A spaces available for Rec Hall events this season.

For Intercollegiate Athletics fans who visit campus frequently during evening and weekend hours, a monthly permit providing access to most campus parking areas (including Nittany Deck) on weekdays after 4:00 p.m. and all day on weekends is available from the Parking Office *for just \$6 per month*.
