A WIN OVER PENN STATE WOULD:

- give Cornell a 3-0 record to start a season for the first time since 2016.
- make Cornell 4-8 all-time against Penn State.
- snap a three-game skid against the Nittany Lions.
- improve the Big Red to 23-12 against current members of the Big 10.
- end a two-game losing streak in road contests.
- be head coach Jenny Graap's 211th victory as head coach of the Big Red (210-142).
- be the 353rd in program history (352-307-4 in 48 seasons, .534).

STORYLINES

- After opening the season with a pair of solid home wins, the Cornell women's lacrosse team will hit the road for the first time in 2020 with its biggest challenge to date — a matchup at No. 25 Penn State.
- The two teams will meet on Sunday, Feb. 23 at 1 p.m. at Panzer Stadium in University Park, Pa.
- The contest will be broadcast live on BTN Plus.
- The Big Red opened its 2020 season with wins over Villanova (13-11) and Marist (18-13).
- Senior Caroline Allen is off to a big start, posting 10 goals and 11 total points in two games, with her seven scores against Marist matching the most by a Cornell player in more than a quarter-century.
- Freshmen have made a huge impact for the Big Red, with rookies Bridget Babcock (three goals, three assists) and Katie Castiello (five goals, one assist) ranks among the team's top scorers, while Hilary Hoover (11) and Annie Thomas (10) sit 1-2 in draw controls.
- Cornell meets an unbeaten Penn State squad (3-0) that owns wins over Towson, Lehigh and Duquesne while averaging 15.0 points per contest.
- Senior Maria Auth is off to a hot start, averaging 6.0 points per game while leading the team in goals (11), assists (seven) and total points (18).
- The Big Red will attempt to claim its first win over Penn State since 2016, the same year Cornell last started 3-0.

HEAD COACH OF WOMEN'S LACROSSE

- Now in her 23rd season directing the Cornell women's lacrosse program in 2020, Jenny Graap has amassed a 210-142 record as the head coach of the Big Red (231-186 in 27 seasons overall).
- Prior to returning to her alma mater in 1997, Graap spent four years as the head at George Mason.
- Her 200th win at Cornell came in the form of

a 15-7 victory over Binghamton on April 17, 2018.

- Under the tutelage of Graap, Cornell has made the Ivy League tournament eight of the 10 years it has been held.
- Graap guided the Big Red to back-to-back NCAA Tournaments in 2001 and 2002, and in 2016 and 2017, reaching the Final Four in the 2002 season.
- The program also made a postseason NCAA appearance in 2006.
- Graap has led the team to postseason play 11 times and has won at least 10 games nine times as well.
- The 2017 Ivy League Coach of the Year, Graap has also been named IWLCA National Coach of the Year in 2002, the IWLCA Northeast Coach of the Year in 2002, 2006 and 2016 and the Inside Lacrosse Northeast Coach of the Year 2006.

LAST TIME OUT:

- Cornell scored the game's final three goals to rally past Villanova 13-11 at Schoellkopf Field in the 2020 season opener for the Big Red women's lacrosse team.
- Genevieve DeWinter scored the tying and go-ahead goals 40 seconds apart and Katie McGahan's 11 saves made the effort hold up as Cornell improved to 19-5 in season openers under head coach Jenny Graap '86.
- Caroline Allen led a balanced Big Red offense with three goals and an assist, while DeWinter and Bridget Babcock were each credited with two goals and an assist and Grace Paletta and Shannon Brazier found the back of the net twice each.
- The Big Red held a 16-10 edge on the draw circle with Annie Thomas (five), Allen (four) and Hilary Hoover (three) combining for 12 of those wins.
- Taylor Lis forced a pair of turnovers on defense and won a pair of ground ball possessions in the win.
- Katie Comerford had four goals and Grainger Rosati posted a goal and three assists for a Villanova team that assisted on 10 of its 11 scores.
- The Wildcats held a 29-27 edge in shots and caused 10 turnovers.
- Alexa Moro had seven saves in goal, including six big ones in the second half to keep Villanova in the mix.

NOTES FROM THE MARIST GAME:

- Senior Caroline Allen's seven goals were on off the school record and tied with seven other players who have tallied seven times in a game — the last being Lindsay Toppe vs. Colgate in 2011.
- Allen also moved her into the top 20 in career points all-time at Cornell with 125 (19th), while boosting her goal total to 90.
- With eight draw control wins, freshman Hilary Hoover is tied for fifth in a single game, joining seven others with that total.
- The Big Red had 13 goals, the most in a half since posting 13 in the first half of a 22-3 win over Binghamton on March 11, 2015.

CAREER MILESTONES:

- Senior Caroline Allen is climbing up the school's career points list and currently is 19th with 125. She needs three more to reach the 18th, four to get to 17th and five to reach 15th.
- Allen is five assists shy of becoming the 12th player in school history to reach 40 in her career.
- The senior is also six free position goals from matching Cari Hills '98 with a school record of 37.
- Senior Katie McGahan already ranks in the top 10 in career saves (seventh, 264) and needs 12 to move to sixth.
- With 16 victories, McGahan needs three win to reach fourth on the list of Cornell goalkeeper wins Beth Paciello '88 and Tiffy Zachos '92 with 19).

ALL-IVY RETURNERS:

- Six members of the Big Red garnered all-Ivy recognition in 2019 and each returns for the 2020 season.
- Caroline Allen and Mary Kate Bonanni were named to the first team, while Ellie Walsh was tabbed to the second team.
- Taylor Lis, Katie McGahan and Grace Paletta each earned honorable mention.

IVY TOURNAMENT HISTORY:

- In 2019, Cornell qualified for the Ivy League Tournament for the eighth time in its 10 year history.
- Cornell has won one tournament title (2016), downing Princeton 10-9 in overtime in the semifinal round and host Penn by an 11-10 margin in the title game.
- The program also reached the finals in 2017, falling to the Princeton, 12-9.

SCHEDULE NOTES:

- Six 2019 NCAA Tournament teams dot the 2020 Cornell women's lacrosse 15-game schedule.
- The Big Red plays seven opponents that had at least 10 wins last spring and two that advanced to the NCAA quarterfinals - Syracuse and Princeton.
- In fact, its final three contests (two at home) and six of its final nine (four at home) will come against teams eyeing a return trip to the NCAA Tournament.

PRESEASON POLL:

- The Big Red was projected to finish fourth in the Ivy League preseason poll released on Feb. 6.
- The three teams that were selected to finish above Cornell — Princeton, Penn and Dartmouth — were all ranked in the IWLCA Division I Preseason Coaches Poll.

- Junior Finley Frechette and her sophomore sister Gillis are also member of the Big Red's top-ranked women's hockey team, while senior Colby Gallagher is a member of the nationally-ranked squash team. All three will join the team once their seasons are complete.
- Junior Grace Paletta's father, Stephen, was an All-American lacrosse player and captained the Big Red's 1987 national runner-up team and her mother, Christine, was an All-Ivy League gymnast.
- Freshman Annie Thomas has a cousin, Caroline Ramsey, playing field hockey for the Big Red.
- Freshman Olivia Wall was one of two New Yorkers named to the U.S. Soccer Coaches Scholar All-America team and was honored at the sport's national convention in January in Baltimore, Md.
- On Monday, Jan. 6, alumnae from Cornell women's athletics teams hosted a career day and networking event in New York City. In all, 39 student-athletes and 83 alumnae and speakers representing 12 varsity sports engaged for a powerful and inspirational Cornell Women's Athletics Career Day.
- For the eighth consecutive season and the 12th time in the last 13 years, the Cornell women's lacrosse team was honored as an Intercollegiate Women's Lacrosse Association (IWLCA) Zag Sports Academic Honor Squad.
- The Big Red held its 15th annual dodgeball tournament to benefit the Multiple Sclerosis Society on Sunday, Dec. 8, raising over \$500 for the organization.
- Cornell hosted more than 50 local elementary and middle school players for a free youth clinic in November on Schoellkopf Field. The Big Red student-athletes taught drills to improve player skills, as well as leading fun games to support the growth of the sport. Seniors Lucy Pedlow and Taylor Lis and junior Hailey Andress spearheaded the project.
- Katie Lavin '03 joined the National Lacrosse League as Vice President of Marketing in February of 2020. A member of the 2002 NCAA Final Four squad, she was chosen to play in the IWLCA North-South Senior All-Star game after a career that included helping the team to two NCAA Tournament appearances and a pair of ECAC titles as a four-year letter winner.
