THE MATCHUP

- No. 5 Loyola continues a three-game road swing at No. 19 Penn State on Saturday, with both teams looking to remain unbeaten on the year.

LAST TIME OUT

- Jr. M **Sam Fiedler** single-handedly outscored a top-five opponent last Saturday, contributing eight points (7 G, 1 A) in a dominant 17-6 win for Loyola at No. 4 Florida.
- The 11-goal margin was Loyola's largest ever over a top-five team, surpassing a 16-6 victory over No. 5 William & Mary on March 29, 1997.
- Jr. A **Livy Rosenzweig** added three goals and three assists, while Jr. M **Elli Kluegel** totaled three goals and an assist for Loyola, which topped Florida (2-1) for a second-consecutive season and earned the program's first win in Gainesville.
- The Gators were coming off a 15-14 win at defending national champions Maryland the previous weekend.
- Jr. GK **Kaitlyn Larsson** finished with 11 saves, reaching double figures for a third game in a row, and So. D **Katie Detwiler** recorded a career-high six draw controls.

QUICK NOTES



- The Greyhounds are projected to top the Patriot League standings for a seventh-consecutive season since joining the conference prior to the 2014 campaign.
- Loyola went 16-5 (9-0) last spring, winning its fourth Patriot League postseason championship in six seasons and advancing to the NCAA tournament for an eighth time in the last nine years.
- Livy Rosenzweig** became the first Greyhound to achieve first team IWLCFA All-America status since 2012 last season after breaking her own school record in points (116, 46 G, 70 A) and also setting a new program mark in assists.
- Loyola led Division I in both assists per game (9.4) and shot percentage (51.3) in 2019, ranked seventh nationally in scoring margin (+6.8) and ninth in goals per game (15.9).
- Loyola holds an overall mark of 156-66 (79-12 conference) in 11+ seasons under head coach **Jen Adams**, posting winning records every year during her tenure.
- Adams has been named Patriot League Coach of the Year in five of Loyola's six seasons in the conference, including each of the last four years.
- Loyola has scored 10+ goals in 18-straight games dating back to last March.

LOOKING AHEAD

- The Greyhounds are back on the road for a 1 p.m. matchup at Penn next Saturday.

SERIES HISTORY

- Penn State leads 17-16 in a series which dates back to 1986.
- The Greyhounds have won each of the previous two meetings, including a 13-8 home victory on March 2 last season.
- Loyola posted a 16-15 overtime win in the last meeting at Penn State on March 3, 2018, with the Greyhounds rallying from a 13-6 deficit in the early stages of the second half.
- Livy Rosenzweig has totaled 10 points in her career against the Nittany Lions, with three goals and two assists in both matchups.
- Penn State won four-straight in the series from 2014-17.

SCOUTING PENN STATE

- The Nittany Lions (4-0) have outscored opponents by a 64-33 margin while starting the season with four-straight victories.
- Penn State has scored 39 goals in its last two contests, topping Duquesne (20-6) on Feb. 19 and Cornell (19-9) last Sunday.
- So. GK Taylor Suplee made 20 saves, Penn State's most in a game since 2007, in Sunday's victory over Cornell. She ranks third in the nation in save percentage (.654) and fourth in saves per game (12.75).
- The Nittany Lions missed out on the NCAA tournament last season after finishing the year with an 8-9 record (3-3 Big Ten). They were ranked fourth out of seven teams in this year's Big Ten preseason poll.
- Sr. A Madison Carter, who has yet to play in a game this season due to injury, was selected to the 2020 Tewaaron Award Watch List. She is a two-time IWLCIA All-American.

TAKING CARE OF THE BALL

- After starting the season with two victories despite committing a combined 32 turnovers, Loyola had only seven giveaways in its 17-6 win at Florida last Saturday.
- The seven turnovers are tied for the program's second-fewest in a game dating back to the start of the 2016 season.
- Loyola's fewest turnovers in a contest during that span was six, a mark established in last year's Patriot League final during a 21-9 victory over Navy.

NATIONAL HONOR FOR FIEDLER

- **Sam Fiedler** was selected as the US Lacrosse Player of the Week on Monday after setting career-highs in both goals (7) and points (8) during Loyola's 17-6 victory at No. 4 Florida.
- She had three points (2 G, 1 A) during Loyola's 4-1 run to start the contest, and she supplied four goals during a decisive 9-0 stretch that spanned over 25 minutes of game action.
- A 2020 Tewaaraton Watch List honoree, Fiedler was a second team IWLCA All-Region and first team All-Patriot League selection last spring after leading the nation with a .671 shot percentage.
- Fiedler is now up to 93 career goals after Saturday's performance, leaving her seven away from becoming the 31st player in program history to reach 100 in her collegiate career.

ANOTHER RANKED OPPONENT DOWN

- Loyola's win at Florida was its second victory over a nationally-ranked team in three games to begin 2020. The Greyhounds topped then-No. 24 Johns Hopkins by a 16-7 margin in their season opener on Feb. 15.
- Loyola has posted 47 victories over nationally-ranked opposition in 11-plus seasons under head coach **Jen Adams**. Saturday's win was the fifth victory against a top-five team during Adams' tenure.

ROSENZWEIG MOVING UP PROGRAM RECORD BOOK

- **Livy Rosenzweig** holds school records in single-season points (116) and assists (70) and single-game assists (8).
- She moved up to No. 3 all-time at Loyola in both assists (127) and draw controls (187) during last Saturday's 16-7 victory over Johns Hopkins.
- Rosenzweig is 22 assists away from surpassing Annie Thomas' school-record of 148. She also ranks sixth in Patriot League history, and is four away from moving past former teammate Hannah Powers into the top five.
- Rosenzweig has recorded points in 44 of 45 collegiate games, including each of the last 37 contests.

PATRIOT LEAGUE WEEKLY AWARD WINNERS

- Loyola accounted for three of the Patriot League's five weekly award recipients for a second-straight week on Monday.
- **Katie Detwiler** (Defender of the Week) and **Kaitlyn Larsson** (Goalkeeper) were repeat winners, while **Sam Fiedler** took home her first-career Midfielder of the Week award.
- Detwiler was matched up defensively against defending IWLCA and US Lacrosse POTW Shannon Kavanagh on Saturday. Kavanagh was limited to just two goals on two shots, as Loyola held Florida to its fewest goals in a game since March 19, 2016.
- Larsson had 21 stops on the week, with 10 saves in a 14-10 win over Towson and 11 more at Florida. Nine of her saves against the Gators came in the first half, allowing Loyola to open up a big early advantage.
- Larsson ranks fifth nationally in save percentage (.589), 10th in goals-against average (7.67) and 16th in saves per game (11.0) through the Greyhounds' first three contests.

WILSON PICKS UP WHERE SHE LEFT OFF

- So. M **Jillian Wilson** led all Loyola freshmen with 37 points (29 G, 8 A) in her debut season last spring, and she ranks third on the team with 11 points (10 G, 1 A) through three contests in 2020.
- Wilson is tied with Sam Fiedler for the team lead in goals, and she tops the Greyhounds with 15 draw controls.
- Wilson recorded four goals and six draws in back-to-back games against No. 24 Johns Hopkins and Towson to begin the year.

STRONG START FOR WILLS

- Fr. A **Emily Wills** has totaled 10 points (6 G, 4 A) while earning starts in each of her first three collegiate contests.
- Wills was chosen as the Patriot League's Rookie of the Week on Feb. 17 after supplying three goals and a pair of assists in her debut against No. 24 Johns Hopkins.
- Wills earned USLacrosse All-America status in each of her final two seasons at The Agnes Irwin School. She was part of two PAISAA championship-winning teams (2017, 2018).

HOME SWEET HOME

- With its 14-10 victory over Towson on Feb. 19, Loyola has now won 12 consecutive games at Ridley Athletic Complex.
- The Greyhounds have won all 12 contests by at least three goals, and six of the 12 victories have come against nationally-ranked opposition (Navy 2x, Florida, Penn State, Georgetown, Johns Hopkins).
- Loyola is 74-22 overall at home since its first contest at Ridley on March 16, 2010.

TWO GREYHOUNDS NAMED TO 2020 TEWAARATON WATCH LIST

- **Livy Rosenzweig** and Jr. M **Sam Fiedler** were selected to the 2020 Tewaaraton Award Watch List on Feb. 13.
- A total of 50 players across the NCAA were chosen as early-season candidates for college lacrosse's top honor.
- Rosenzweig was one of 25 semifinalists for the award during her sophomore season last spring.
- Rosenzweig's sister Gabby, a senior attacker at Penn, was also included on this year's Watch List. The siblings will square off when Loyola travels to Penn on March 7

PRESEASON INDIVIDUAL ACCOLADES

- **Livy Rosenzweig** was named a second team Preseason All-American by Inside Lacrosse back in January, joining Navy's Kelly Larkin as the lone Patriot League honorees.
- One of two Loyola players - male or female - to reach 100 points in a season, Rosenzweig has accomplished the feat in each of her first two collegiate seasons. She recorded multiple points in every game last spring and tallied 8+ points on six occasions.
- Rosenzweig was joined by **Sam Fiedler**, Jr. M **Elli Kluegel** and So. D **Katie Detwiler** on the Preseason All-Patriot League team.
- Loyola's four selections were tied with Army for the most on the conference's 16-member Preseason All-League squad. Detwiler was the lone defender recognized.

PATRIOT LEAGUE DOMINANCE

- Loyola is 52-0 against Patriot League opponents in regular season play since joining the conference. That run is the longest active win streak in Division I.
- The NCAA record for consecutive conference wins is a 61-game streak by UMass in Atlantic 10 play which began in 2011 and ended on April 22, 2018.
- The Greyhounds claimed Patriot League championships in each of their first three years in the conference (2014-16), and added a fourth postseason title last spring.
- In its 11 games against conference foes last season (regular and postseason), Loyola outscored its opponent by a 207-78 margin. Seven of 11 victories were by double digits, with the closest margin a 13-6 win over Lehigh on March 23.

- Loyola loses eight letterwinners from last year’s Patriot League-championship team, including seven starters, five All-Patriot League performers and three IWLCA All-Americans.
- Hannah Powers, a 2019 third team IWLCA All-American, concluded her career as Loyola’s all-time leader with 317 points (187 G, 130 A). She ranks fourth all-time in the Patriot League in points and fifth in assists.
- Taylor VanThof, a 2019 second team IWLCA All-American and the PL Midfielder of the Year, graduated as the program’s career (392), single season (146) and single game (21) record holder for draw controls, as she became the first player in program history to win at least 100 draws in three different seasons.

- Katrina Geiger ’18, Hannah Powers ’19 and Taylor VanThof ’19 suited up for the Philadelphia Fire, Molly Hulseman ’15 and Molly Wolf ’16 played on the Upstate Pride, and Taryn VanThof ’15 and Bailey Mathis ’17 were on the New England Command.
- Loyola head coach **Jen Adams** serves as the league’s commissioner.

SMART HOUNDS

- Loyola has a cumulative team GPA of 3.48, including an impressive 3.64 average during the 2019 fall semester.
- **Elli Kluegel, Jr. M Bridget Ballard, Fr. M Catie Corolla** and **Fr. M Logan Olmstead** all recorded 4.0 GPA’s last semester.

HEAD COACH JEN ADAMS

Innovative. Difference-Maker. Creative. Stellar. Spectacular: All words used to describe Jen Adams throughout her illustrious playing career on the collegiate and international levels. Those same adjectives hold true for her coaching and leadership styles as she enters her 12th season at the helm of the Loyola women's lacrosse program in 2020.

AT LOYOLA

Since coming to Loyola, Jen Adams has directed a resurgence of the program back to national prominence. Inheriting a squad that posted a 6-10 record in 2008, Adams turned that into an 11-6 mark in 2009 and an 11-7 record in 2010. Her 2011 squad won its first of two-straight BIG EAST Championships, returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2004 and tied a school record for wins in a season, posting a 17-3 record. Since joining the Patriot League prior to the 2014 season, Adams' Greyhounds have added four more conference titles in the past six years.

Entering the 2020 season, Adams has a career record of 153-66 in 11 years. The three-time IWLCMA Mid-Atlantic Region Coach of the Year has led Loyola to eight NCAA tournaments in the last nine years, advancing to the Quarterfinals in 2011, 2012 and 2015.

In conference play, Adams' squads have dominated. In the last seven seasons, her teams have posted an overall record of 58-2 in regular-season conference contests, including an unblemished 52-0 mark in Patriot League play - the longest active win streak in the NCAA. Her Greyhounds have also claimed six league tournament titles - back-to-back BIG EAST Championships (2011, 2012) and four Patriot League titles (2014, 2015, 2016, 2019).

Nationally, nine of Adams' squads have began the season ranked in the top-15 of the IWLCMA Preseason Coaches Poll. She's also brought 23 All-America honors to the Greyhounds, including churning out 13 All-Americans and producing three of the program's eight three-time All-Americans: Marlee Paton '14, Taryn VanThof '15 and Maddy Leshner '16.

As a member of the BIG EAST Conference, Adams picked up co-BIG EAST Coach of the Year honors in 2011 and led the Greyhounds to back-to-back BIG EAST Tournament titles, a 27-12 record in conference games and a 4-2 mark in tournament action.

Adams didn't miss a beat in transitioning to the Patriot League in 2014. Tabbed as the

League's preseason favorite each of her first seven years, Adams has been named the League's Coach of the Year five times (2014, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019) and brought 14 major awards to the Greyhounds.

BEFORE LOYOLA

Prior to coming to Loyola, Adams served as the associate head coach under Cathy Reese at the University of Maryland during the 2007 and 2008 seasons. She was also an assistant to Reese at the University of Denver from 2004-06.

At Maryland, Adams rejuvenated the Terrapins offense to play in her up-tempo attacking style. In her first season as associate head coach, Maryland scored 287 goals, the most it had recorded in a season since 2001, Adams' senior year.

COACHING INTERNATIONALLY

Adams took a break from the college game during the summer of 2012 and 2015 and assisted her sister, Trish, at the Under-19 World Championships. The Adams duo led the U-19 Australian National Team to a silver medal in 2012 and to the semifinals in 2015. She served as the Australian's U-19 Co-Head Coach with former Greyhound Stacey (Morlang) Sullivan at the 2019 World Championships.

AS A PLAYER

Adams is regarded as the finest female lacrosse player of all time. Putting together arguably the greatest collegiate women's lacrosse career in the sport's history, Adams led Maryland to four-straight national titles from 1998-2001, including a 21-0 record in 1999 and a 23-0 mark in 2001. She racked up honors like she scored goals and recorded assists, and was named to the NCAA Division I Women's Lacrosse 25th Anniversary Team in April 2007.

The Brighton, South Australia native, was a three-time national player of the year and was the first recipient of the Tewaaraton Trophy in 2001. She set every scoring record for the Terrapins - season and career - finishing her

storied career with 267 goals, 178 assists and 445 total points. Her marks for total points stands today as an NCAA record and her goals total is still a record at Maryland.

In addition to her career marks, Adams had single-season performances that also rank amongst the best in Maryland and NCAA history. During her Tewaaraton-winning senior season, Adams led the nation with 88 goals, 60 assists and 148 total points, setting school single-season marks in the process. Those season totals only added her name one rung higher, as she had set school records with 81 goals, 55 assists and 136 total points the previous season.

Adams' efforts were not limited just to the lacrosse field. In addition to her three All-America honors as a player, Adams earned the 2000 and 2001 Honda/Broderick Award for women's lacrosse excellence in the classroom and on the field. She also garnered CoSIDA Academic All-America First Team honors as a senior, was named the National Attacker of the Year in 1999, 2000 and 2001 and the Atlantic Coast Conference Female Athlete of the Year in 2000 and 2001.
