### What's Happening?

With the Southeastern Conference portion of its campaign concluded, Florida finishes regular-season with a pair of non-conference opponents. First of those two is a road trip to University Park, Pa., to meet No 25 Penn State. This is Florida's first trip to Happy Valley since winning the 2018 NCAA University Park Regional. The Gators could make a post-season return trip, as Penn State is one of four teams playing host to 2020 NCAA Regional Championship action April 2-4 (other regional sites: Norman, Okla., Denver, Colo., Los Angeles, Calif.).

Florida claimed its second consecutive Southeastern Conference regular-season title last month. The Gators finished undefeated in SEC action (7-0) for the first time since 1992 (first season all league teams met in regular-season). SEC regular-season champions began being recognized in 2017.

Florida's 197.80 – 196.50 win in front of a sellout Stegeman Coliseum crowd last Friday at No. 10 Georgia closed the Gators' 2020 SEC regular-season schedule. The Gators swept the event titles, with sophomore **Trinity Thomas** claiming vault (9.95), uneven bars (9.975), floor exercise (9.95) and all-around (39.825). That all-around total equals Florida's school record (now shares with Alaina Johnson, Bridget Sloan and Alex McMurtry) and moves into a tie for the nation's No. 2 total for 2020. It was her sixth consecutive all-around win of the season and seventh overall for 2020. Another near-perfect mark of 9.975 gave junior **Alyssa Baumann** the balance beam win.

After her performance at Georgia, Thomas claims her sixth consecutive SEC Gymnast of the Week honor. It is her seventh such honor of 2020 and 10<sup>th</sup> of her Gator career.

Penn State is also done with league regular-season action, tying for fourth in Big Ten standings. The Nittany Lions are coming off winning the Penn State Quad last weekend with its season-high of 196.575. Junior Lauren Bridgens set the team's season high all-around of 39.475 to win the PSU Quad.

Florida Head Coach **Jenny Rowland** is in her fifth season with the Gators in 2020. In her first four seasons, the Gators won the 2016 Southeastern Conference Championships and the 2019 SEC regular-season titles. The team reached the NCAA team final in her first three seasons, finishing fourth (2016) and third (2017 & 2018). Eleven Gators collected 40 All-America honors in NCAA competition in the last four years, including winning seven NCAA event titles (**Bridget Sloan**: 2016 all-around, uneven bars, balance beam; **Alex McMurtry**: 2017 all-around, uneven bars; 2018 vault; **Alicia Boren**: 2019 floor exercise).

The Gators missed advancing to the 2019 NCAA Championships after taking third in the NCAA Corvallis Regional final. It was the second time in the NCAA Championships' 38-year history Florida didn't advance to the. Boren claimed a share of the NCAA floor title, becoming the third Gator to win the floor crown. NCAA Championships. Four Gators advanced as individual competitors to the 2019 NCAA Championships, with Boren and then freshmen **Savannah Schoenherr** and **Trinity Thomas** earning All-America honors.

UF returns six with 17 All-America honors - **Alyssa Baumann**, **Rachel Gowey**, **Amelia Hundley**, **Savannah Schoenherr**, **Megan Skaggs** and **Trinity Thomas**. Twenty Gator routines return from the 2019 NCAA Regional final.

For the third time in the program's 48-year history, just one freshman joins the Gator roster for the 2020 season (also one freshman in 1984 and 1990). **Payton Richards** of Mokena, Ill., shared the 2017 Junior Olympic Level 10 Senior A beam title and was runner-up in all-around and bars. She recorded three top-four individual finishes in 2018 JO Senior D competition - floor exercise (tied for third), all-around (4th) and uneven bars (T4th).

## MEET COACH ROWLAND



**Jenny Rowland**, one of the nation's rising coaching talents, is in her fifth season as University of Florida's head gymnastics coach. Rowland is the seventh head coach for the Gator program, which is in its 48<sup>th</sup> season in 2020.

She shared the 2016 Southeastern Conference Coach of the Year honor with Arkansas' Mark Cook. She joins volleyball's Mary Wise (1991) as a Gator coach who claimed SEC Coach of the Year honors in their first season at UF.

Rowland's experiences from the sport's highest level are the same as many current Gators. She is a former U.S. National Team member, a collegiate All-American and was named a 2015 National Collegiate Assistant of the Year.

Rowland is a Category 3 International Brevet level judge. She served on the judging panel for the 2008, 2012 and 2016 U.S. Olympic Trials.

In the fall of 2019, Rowland was appointed to the NCAA Women's Gymnastics Committee. Her term runs through the 2023 season.

### Rowland's Coaching Career:

#### At Florida:

Florida reached the NCAA Super Six team final in each of Rowland's first three seasons with the Gators, taking fourth in 2016 and third in 2017 & 2018. Rowland was named the 2016 Southeastern Conference Coach of the Year after the Gators won that season's team title. Florida won the 2019 SEC regular-season title with a 6-1 record

Gators won NCAA individual event titles in each of the last four seasons. Bridget Sloan won the 2016 NCAA all-around and shared that season's uneven bars and balance beam titles. Alex McMurtry won the 2017 NCAA all-around champion and shared that season's uneven bars crown. She finished her career by claiming a share of the 2018 vault title. In 2019, Alicia Boren claimed a share of the NCAA floor title. The Honda Award for gymnastics went to Sloan (2016) and McMurtry (2017), distinguishing them as the nation's top collegiate gymnast. McMurtry was part of a rare double in 2017 and 2018, claiming both the SEC Gymnast (2017)/SEC Event Specialist (2018) and the SEC Scholar-Athlete awards.

In Women's Collegiate Gymnastics Association (WCGA) All-America regular-season awards, 11 Gators earned 41 honors since 2016.

#### At Auburn:

Rowland came to Florida after spending five seasons at Auburn. She joined the Auburn coaching staff as an assistant coach in October of 2010 and was elevated to associate head coach in March of 2013. Rowland worked with all aspects of the Auburn gymnastics program, coordinating all of the program's community outreach efforts and interactions on campus as well as playing an integral role in recruiting and in-gym activities.

She was named co-National Assistant Coach of the Year in 2015 after helping Auburn reach the NCAA Super Six for the first time in 22 years.

#### Coaching Career Start in Sooner State:

Rowland coached Elite gymnasts at Bart Conner Gymnastics Academy in Norman, Okla., for five years and then joined the Oklahoma coaching staff in June of 2001. At OU, she helped coach the Sooners to the 2004 Big XIII title, three-time team NCAA qualifiers (2004-06) and three Big XIII Gymnasts of the Year.

#### As a Gymnast:

During her gymnastics career, Rowland was a USA National Team member from 1985-1990 and was part of the U.S.'s 1989 World Championships team. During her collegiate career, she earned All-America honors for the uneven bars in 1993 for Arizona State.

After retiring from competition, she returned to her home state, enrolling at the University of Oklahoma to finish her degree.

## 2019 NOTABLES

- Florida won Southeastern Conference regular season title (6-1) and second in Championship (197.75) competition.
- Third in NCAA Corvallis Regional; did not advance to NCAA Championship for first time since 2000.
- Three gymnasts collected four All-America honors in NCAA Championships competition.
- Four earned eight All-America honors in Women's Collegiate Gymnastics Association (WCGA) regular-season awards.
- Alicia Boren shared the NCAA floor exercise title. UF is the only program to have a gymnast claim at least one NCAA Individual title each of the last nine seasons, with a national-leading 16 wins in that span.
- SEC Freshman of Year went to Trinity Thomas. Ninth Gator to receive the honor and first since Kennedy Baker in 2015.
- Two SEC apparatus titles claimed by Gators – Alyssa Baumann, Rachel Gowey, Megan Skaggs (beam) and Trinity Thomas (vault).
- Gators turned in 2019 national leading total for uneven bars (49.725) versus Kentucky, which also set Florida record.
- Finished the season ranked sixth in the nation among gymnastics programs and No. 12 among all 2018-19 NCAA Division I Women's sports after setting school-record attendance average for second consecutive year (8,333).
- Eight Gators earned SEC Academic Honor Roll status and every freshman appeared on the SEC First-Year Academic Honor Roll
- Recorded a program record team cumulative GPA of 3.61 in fall 2018 and 3.57 in spring 2019 for a 3.6041 GPA for the academic year.

# Gator Gymnastics Meet Notes

## FLORIDA QUICK HITS

► Florida opened at No. 3 on the 2020 Women's Collegiate Gymnastics Association (WCGA) preseason poll. Florida's been among the nation's preseason top five every season since 2007.

► Florida returns six gymnasts with 17 All-America honors – **Alyssa Baumann, Rachel Gowey, Amelia Hundley, Megan Skaggs, Savannah Schoenherr** and **Trinity Thomas**.

► Eight Gators have been a part of their national teams, including six for the U.S. Sophomores – **Trinity Thomas** (2016-17, 2017-18, 2018-19, 2019-20) and **Sydney Johnson-Scharpf** (2015-16) join juniors **Alyssa Baumann** (2016-17, 2015-16, 2014-15) and **Megan Skaggs** (2014-15), seniors **Rachel Gowey** (2016-17, 2014-15, 2013-14) and **Amelia Hundley** (2016-17, 2015-16, 2014-15) as past U.S. Senior National Team members. Another junior, **Jazmyn Foberg**, was a two-time U.S. Junior National Team member (2015-16, 2014-15). Senior **Maegan Chant** has been a part of Canada's national team.

## NATION'S BEST IN 2020 NCAA COMPETITION

The U.S. has taken team gold in the last two Olympic Games. The depth available to U.S. coaching staff has helped the U.S. take the team gold by comfortable margins. The last two U.S. Olympic Trials contained 24 different athletes and now nine of those gymnasts are competing in NCAA action.

Florida and Oklahoma are the two programs with a pair of representatives from the 2016 Olympic Trials. The Gator duo consists of **Rachel Gowey** (2016) and **Amelia Hundley** (2016). Junior **Alyssa Baumann** qualified for the 2016 Olympic Trials, but an elbow injury suffered leading up to the competition kept her out of the Trials.

## WELCOME BACK JAZZY!

Junior **Jazmyn Foberg** turned some heads with her 9.925 exhibition vault performance Jan. 31 at Kentucky. She made her 2020 debut in the Feb. 7 tri-meet, leading off the vault lineup with a 9.825. She's led off the last three vault lineups, earning a season best 9.85 versus Alabama.

As a freshman, Foberg appeared in all about one meet of the 2018 season, competing primarily on vault and bars. She was a part of the Gators final nine vault and final six bars lineups. Foberg turned in collegiate best of 9.95 (bars) and 9.90 (vault) in 2018.

Recovery from fall 2018 elbow surgery sidelined Foberg for 2019 season. Her performance on Feb. 7 was her first lineup appearance in 657 days (or 1 year, 9 months and 17 days).

## SEC STANDINGS

Beginning in 1981, the winner of the Southeastern Conference championship meet claimed the league trophy.

In 2017, the SEC began awarding two gymnastics trophies - a regular-season trophy based on dual meet results and the SEC Championship meet trophy.

In 2019, Florida won the SEC regular-season title and LSU claimed the championship meet. Florida won its second consecutive regular-season title in 2020 with a 7-0 record.

With its win at Georgia on Feb. 28, Florida completed its first undefeated SEC regular season (7-0). League teams began meeting all SEC teams in regular-season action in 1992 and the best previous regular-season record was 5-0-1 in 2007.

Florida has won 12 SEC titles – two regular-season (2019, 2020) and 10 SEC Championships (last in 2016).

Florida, with its one-member freshmen class, leads CollegeGymFans.com's "Just Outside the Top 10" list.

Here's what they said about the Gators' lone freshman:

*UF has just one frosh, but she's an exceptionally good one. Payton Richards is a three-time JO National team member from Aerials in Illinois. She tied for the AA title in 2016 and won BB. She also tied for the 2017 BB title, placed 2nd on UB and tied for 2nd AA. In 2018, she tied for 3rd on FX and placed 4th AA. Such a long history at the top of the JO ranks is a strong predictor of success in the NCAA, although with the Gators depth she'll have to fight to be an AAer.*

This is the first time in the last 11 seasons Florida is not among the top 10 recruiting classes. Since 2010, Florida's freshmen class ranked No. 1 seven times (including 2018 and 2019) and No. 2 twice.

## NATIONAL TEAM CONNECTIONS

Eight members of the Gator gymnastics team have been a part of their national teams.

### U.S. National Team

Four current Gators were part of U.S. gold medal teams in Pan Am Games competition. Junior **Megan Skaggs** joined seniors **Rachel Gowey** and **Amelia Hundley** on the 2015 Pan Am team. Gowey also won Pan Am gold for the uneven bars. Gowey, part of the 2016-17, 2014-15, 2013-14 U.S. Senior National Teams, was also part of the 2014 Jesolo Trophy gold medal team. Hundley (2016-17, 2015-16, 2014-15 U.S. Senior National team member) was part of the 2014 Pan Am gold medal team and took silver on floor and bronze on bars at the 2015 event.

Sophomore **Trinity Thomas** is the only current member of the U.S. Senior National Team also on a 2020 NCAA roster. She became the fourth gymnast on a collegiate roster (and first since 2011) to earn an international medal when [U.S. took team gold](#) at 2018 Senior Pan American Championships in Lima, Peru. She was runner-up in [all-around and uneven bars](#) at the event. She competed at the 2016 and 2017 Jesolo Trophy event and was the U.S. representative in the 2018 Tokyo World Cup, taking second in the all-around.

Junior **Alyssa Baumann** was part of the U.S.'s gold medal team at the 2014 World Championships in Nanning, China. The three-time U.S. Senior Team member also competed on the U.S. gold-medal teams at the 2014 and 2015 City of Jesolo Trophy events. Gowey joined her on the 2014 roster for the Jesolo event. She took second on beam on both trips to Jesolo, Italy.

Junior **Jazmyn Foberg**, a 2015-16 and 2014-15 U.S. Junior National Team member, competed in the 2015 Jesolo Trophy junior division and also competed in that year's International Junior Japan meet. She was third in all-around at Jesolo Trophy and second in Japan.

Sophomore **Sydney Johnson-Scharpf**, a member of the 2015-16 U.S. Senior National Team, competed in two 2016 international assignments – Jesolo Trophy and Reykjavik International Games.

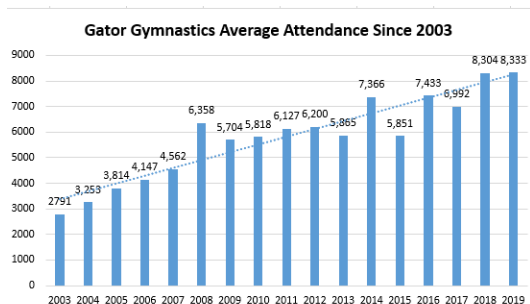

## FLORIDA SETS HOME ATTENDANCE RECORD IN 2019

The Gators' 2019 season set a school-record average of 8,333 per meet. Florida's attendance ranked No. 6 among the nation's collegiate gymnastics teams.

Several teams opened the 2020 campaign last weekend. Defending NCAA champion Oklahoma opened its season last weekend also with a 197.35. The Gators' 197.35 set the program's all-time best for a season opener, upping the previous high of 197.30 set in the 2019 opener.

Florida took the top two on each of the apparatus final standings. Sophomore **Trinity Thomas'** four titles includes setting the Gators' season opening all-around total best of 39.70. That stands second for 2020 opening all-around totals behind UCLA senior Kyla Ross's 39.725 set last week. Some big scores boosted Thomas' all-around, as she earned the ninth (balance beam) and 10<sup>th</sup> (floor exercise) 9.975 mark of her career. She also won bars at 9.925.

Sophomore **Nya Reed** equaled her collegiate vault best of 9.875 to take her first collegiate title on the event. She also matched her floor best of 9.925 to take second.

Florida's lone freshman **Payton Richards** anchored the vault lineup with her runner-up mark of 9.85. Senior **Amelia Hundley** was second on bars at 9.875. Three Gators scored a 9.9 or better on beam tonight, with senior **Rachel Gowey** matching her collegiate best of 9.95 and junior **Alyssa Baumann** taking third at 9.90.

#### GATOR PERFORMANCE NOTES:

- Florida's 197.35 is its all-time high in a season opener. The previous high of 197.30 came versus Missouri in the 2019 opener. Before 2019, the previous season opening best of 197.125 came in 2008.

Sophomore **Nya Reed** matched her collegiate-best of 9.875 again to claim her second consecutive vault win. Richards took second on the event at 9.775.

Florida raised its season-high floor exercise total to 49.475 Friday. The three Gators with marks of 9.90 or better swept the floor awards. **Trinity Thomas** won the event for the second consecutive week (9.95), while **Alyssa Baumann** (9.925) and **Rachel Gowey** (9.90) posted season-highs to claim second and third, respectively. Gowey's 9.90 equals her collegiate-best set last season.

Thomas claimed her second-straight balance beam title Friday with her mark of 9.925. Gowey shared second at 9.90 with MU's Hu.

# Gator Gymnastics Meet Notes

## Meet 3

### No. 2 Florida vs No. 8 LSU

Jan. 24, 2020

Stephen C. O'Connell Center at the Exactech Arena / Gainesville, Fla.

GAINESVILLE, Fla. - In Friday's only top-10 matchup, it was No. 2 Florida gymnastics using the nation's 2020 high for the win over No. 8 LSU in a key Southeastern Conference meet.

The Gators' 198.375 is the nation's leader in the first month of the 2020 season and the third-highest in school history. LSU also turned in its season-best of 197.775 Friday.

Friday's meet brought together the two teams claiming 2019 Southeastern Conference team titles. Florida won its first SEC regular-season title after posting a 6-1 record. The Tigers claimed the SEC Championship meet title in New Orleans.

#### TONIGHT'S MEET

A sellout crowd roared as the Gators posted 22 season or collegiate best scores Friday. A 10.0 by Gator sophomore **Trinity Thomas** on uneven bars gave her the first perfect score of her collegiate career. Tiger freshman Kiya Johnson also scored her first collegiate 10.0 Friday to win the balance beam title.

Florida trailed the Tigers by 0.025 after the opening rotation, despite turning in its season-best of 49.40 on vault. Gator freshman **Payton Richards** anchored the lineup with a collegiate-best 9.925 to take third. The vault title was shared at 9.95 by LSU's Ruby Harrold and the defending NCAA vault champion Kennedi Edney.

The Gators' uneven bars total of 49.65 tied for sixth highest in school history and put the team ahead for good. After Thomas' 10.0, fellow sophomore **Savannah Schoenherr** also set her collegiate-best to share second with Harrold at 9.975.

Five marks of 9.9 or better gave Florida a balance beam total of 49.675 – equaling the school record set in 2018 versus Oklahoma. Two Gators were nearly perfect on the event at 9.975 – junior **Alyssa Baumann** and senior **Rachel Gowey** – to share second overall.

Thomas was close to perfection again on floor exercise with her winning mark of 9.975. She shared the floor title with LSU's Johnson. Sophomore **Nya Reed** was third after upping her collegiate-best to 9.95.

In a meet featuring the last two to claim the SEC Gymnast of the Week honors, it was Thomas edging Johnson for the all-around title. Thomas' total of 39.775 sets her collegiate best and is the nation's third-highest total of 2020. Johnson's total of 39.725 is tied for the nation's sixth-highest of the season.

#### GATOR PERFORMANCE NOTES:

- Florida's total of 198.375 is the nation's high for 2020 (previous high: 198.25 by Oklahoma last Friday at Alabama). It is No. 3 for the Gators all-time.
- Three events scored 49.65 or better for Florida – beam (49.675 – No. T1 in school history), bars and beam (49.65 – No. T6 all-time for UF on bars; No. T10 all-time for UF on floor). This is the first time UF scored 49.65 or better on three events in a single meet and the third time in collegiate history (Oklahoma and UCLA have the three 49.65+ meets).

- This was the 24th consecutive meeting both teams brought top-10 rankings.
- Crowd of 9,332 is the third sellout for Gator gymnastics. It is the third-largest gymnastics crowd ever in the Exactech Arena at the Stephen C. O'Connell Center.
- Trinity Thomas' all-around total of 39.775 ties for No. 9 for Florida.
- Payton Richards' 39.50 is the third-highest ever for a Gator making her all-around debut (leader: 39.575 by Mackenzie Caquatto/2011 and Alicia Boren/2016)

This is the second time Florida posted a 197.875 this season. Along with Florida's 198.375 on Jan. 24 and its 197.80 on Jan. 31, the Gators own four of the nation's top 10 totals this season.

#### TONIGHT'S MEET

Another 10.0 on balance beam highlighted an evening of spectacular performances by Florida sophomore **Trinity Thomas**. Along with her beam win, Thomas posted marks of 9.95 to win uneven bars and floor exercise plus equaled her collegiate best of 39.775 to claim her fifth 2020 all-around win.

Freshman **Payton Richards** set her collegiate vault best of 9.95 to complete Florida's event titles sweep. It was her second vault win of the last three meets. Richards also took second in all-around after matching her career high of 39.50.

Several strong scores helped boost the Gators' team total Friday. Sophomore **Savannah Schoenherr** anchored the bars lineup with a 9.90. Both senior **Amelia Hundley** and sophomore **Sydney Johnson-Scharpf** turned in a 9.90 on floor. Florida finished the meet on beam, with senior **Rachel Gowey** earning a 9.95 and junior **Alyssa Baumann** a 9.925.

Two Gators equaled their collegiate bests of 9.875 Friday - senior **Sierra Alexander** (vault) and sophomore **Leah Clapper** (beam).

#### ANOTHER 10.0 FOR TRINITY THOMAS:

With her 10.0 on beam tonight, **Trinity Thomas** now has three perfect marks in 2020.

Her 10.0 beam routine last week made Thomas the nation's first with perfect marks on multiple events. Two others joined her with 10.0s earned tonight – Oklahoma's Maggie Nichols (vault, bars) and LSU's Kiya Johnson (vault, beam).

Of the four Gator gymnasts to earn a 10.0 on beam, Thomas joins Gator Great **Bridget Sloan** as the only two to earn multiple beam perfect marks. Thomas is the first to earn a beam 10.0 in consecutive meets.

# Gator Gymnastics Meet Notes

## Meet 7

### No. 2 Florida vs No. 8 Alabama

Feb. 21, 2020

Stephen C. O'Connell Center at the Exactech Arena / Gainesville, Fla.

GAINESVILLE, Fla – No. 2 Florida claims its second consecutive Southeastern Conference gymnastics title with Friday's win over No. 8 Alabama.

The top two gymnastics teams in league standings met Friday in front of a sellout Exactech Arena crowd. The Gators led the meet from the first rotation and added to the margin to claim the win, 198.05 – 197.45, over the Tide. Florida's 198.05 is the nation's No. 5 total of the 2020 season. Half of the nation's top 10 totals of 2020 belong to the Gators.

#### SEC TITLE:

- Florida claims its 12<sup>th</sup> SEC title and second consecutive (1982, '83, '84, '85, '89, '07, '10, '12, '13, '16, '19, '20). This is the fourth year for the awarding of a regular-season SEC gymnastics title. From 1981-2016, the winner at the SEC Championship meet was considered the league champion.
- Florida athletics leads all league programs with 246 SEC team titles.

Florida's win tonight clinches the SEC title with one league meet remaining on its schedule (Feb. 28 at No. 11 Georgia). The Gators are 6-0 in league action and all other teams have at least two SEC losses.

#### TONIGHT'S MEET

Florida's opening rotation was highlighted by a perfect vault score for senior **Sierra Alexander**. Her soaring Yurchenko full earned a 9.95 – the vault's maximum value. She took second in the event to Alabama's Lexi Graber's 9.975. Two other Gators scored a 9.90 – **Trinity Thomas** and Gator sophomore **Savannah Schoenherr**.

Little hops on landing kept the Gators from reaching their full potential on the uneven bars. Alabama's Makarri Doggette won the bars title at 9.95. Florida's **Amelia Hundley** and Thomas shared second at 9.90.

Florida powered past an early miss in the beam lineup to equal its school-record total of 49.675. Every counting score was a 9.9 or better. The back half of the lineup was stellar, with 9.95s by **Rachel Gowey** and Thomas. Sophomore **Leah Clapper** anchored with her collegiate-best 9.975 to claim her first event title.

Floor produced consistent marks of 9.9 from four consecutive Gators. Junior **Alyssa Baumann** broke that trend with a bang, winning the evening's event title by matching her collegiate best of 9.975.

Thomas won her fifth consecutive all-around (39.65) and freshman **Payton Richards** was third (39.425). Alabama's Graber was just a fraction away from her season best, as she was runner-up at 39.625.

#### GATOR PERFORMANCE NOTES:

- Tonight's sellout Exactech Arena crowd of 9,301 is the top Gators Link to Pink crowd in the event's 14-year history. It is the No. 4 crowd since the reopening for the 2017 season.
- This is the 58th consecutive time both Florida and Alabama brought a top-10 ranking into a meeting (dating back to 2002 NCAA Championships). Tonight's meeting between No. 2 Florida and No. 8 Alabama was the nation's only top-10 meeting of the day.
- Alexander's perfect 9.95 for her Yurchenko full set her collegiate best for the second consecutive meet. Last week at Auburn, Alexander equaled her then best of 9.875 for the fifth time.
- Clapper returned to the Gator lineup last week at Auburn, equaling her then best of 9.875. She is the third among the 2020 Gators with a collegiate beam best of 9.975, joining Baumann and Gowey. Thomas twice has posted a beam 10.0.
- Tonight's performance was the second 9.975 on floor for Baumann. She set her collegiate best in the Feb. 7 tri-meet.
- Florida is the 2020 leader on balance beam. With its 49.675 event total tonight, **Florida is the first program in NCAA history to post a team total of 49.50 or better in five consecutive meets.** UCLA twice recorded four-meet strings of 49.50-plus in their history.
- This is the first time in the 37 all-time regular-season meetings between these two programs that Florida won three consecutive (2018 home, 2019 away, 2020 home).

## Meet 8

### No. 2 Florida at No. 17 Auburn

Feb. 14, 2020

Auburn Arena / Auburn, Ala.

ATHENS, Ga. – As if the No. 2 Florida gymnastics team needed any more motivation for the rivalry meet at No. 10 Georgia, a video message from a fan gave the team some fuel Friday.

That fan? Florida Head Football Coach Dan Mullen. His message is one that echoes through Gator Nation, which is "Beat the Bulldogs" in whatever sport the two teams meet.

Florida heard that message, defeating Georgia 197.80 – 196.50 in front of a sellout Stegeman Coliseum crowd of 9,695.

#### 7-0 SEC SEASON:

Tonight's win gives Florida its first undefeated SEC regular-season at 7-0. Beginning in 1992, all league teams met during regular season action. Florida's was unbeaten in the 2007 season with a 5-0-1 record. That tie? It came when No. 1 Florida and No. 2 Georgia tied at 197.25 on Jan. 28, 2007 in Stegeman Coliseum.

#### TONIGHT'S MEET

In the nation's only top-10 dual of the evening, Florida led from the opening rotation.

Florida opened on bars, with sophomore **Trinity Thomas** anchoring with a near-perfect 9.975 to claim the event title. Junior **Megan Skaggs** took second at 9.875 and sophomore **Savannah Schoenherr** shared third at 9.85 with UGA's Megan Roberts.

When Thomas and Schoenherr moved to vault, they both equaled their collegiate-best marks. Thomas won the evening's vault competition at 9.95 and Schoenherr took third at 9.90. At the midway point, Florida owned a 0.60 lead over Georgia.

Florida's final two competitors – Thomas and **Alyssa Baumann** – led the Gators on floor. Thomas won floor with a 9.95 and Baumann shared second at 9.90 with Georgia's Sabrina Vega.

On its closing event, Florida was just a fraction away from its school balance beam record (49.675) with its 49.65 total tonight. The final four Gators all turned in marks of 9.9 or better. Baumann won the beam competition after equaling her collegiate best of 9.975. Thomas and sophomore **Leah Clapper** shared second at 9.95 and senior **Rachel Gowey** added a 9.9.

Thomas claimed her sixth consecutive all-around at 39.825 – equaling Florida's record and the nation's No. 2 total in 2020.

#### GATOR PERFORMANCE NOTES:

- Florida's 197.80 equals the nation's No. 13 total of 2020. Six of the top 15 totals belong to the Gators.
- Florida's 49.65 is No. 4 on its all-time best beam totals chart. The Gators have scored a 49.5 or better on the event in its last six meets, which is the longest stretch for 49.5-plus beam totals in NCAA history.
- The 1.30 point victory is the largest for the Gators in Athens since SEC competition began in the 1981 season.
- Thomas' winning all-around total of 39.825 equals the program record and shares second among the nation's 2020 gymnasts.
