PENN STATE RETURNS TO FLORIDA FOR THREE-GAME SERIES AGAINST **IOWA AND ILLINOIS**

The Penn State softball team, under first-year head coach Clarisa Crowell, returns to Leesburg, Fla. and the Big Ten "bubble" for six more games, March 11-14. The Nittany Lions will face Iowa and Illinois in three-game series each at Sleepy Hollow Sports Complex. All the games will be streamed live on Big Ten Network+.

SERIES HISTORY

- Playing a Big Ten-only schedule in 2021, Penn State will face familiar opponents all season long.
- The Nittany Lions' first three games come against the Iowa Hawkeyes. The teams will play a doubleheader on Thursday, March 11 starting at 10 a.m. and then will conclude the series on Friday, March 12 at 11 a.m.
- Penn State trails Iowa in the all-time series, 20-39. The two teams have not faced off since the 2016 season when the Nittany Lions took two-ofthree games in Iowa City.
- The final three games of the weekend will be against the Illinois Fighting Illini. The first two games will be played as a doubleheader on Saturday, March 13 starting at 10:20 a.m. and then the series will conclude on Sunday, March 14 at 9:20 a.m.
- Penn State trails Illinois in the all-time series, 15-24. The Fighting Illini took two-of-three from the Nittany Lions at Beard Field back in 2018.

SCOUTING THE FIELD

- Iowa went 2-4 the first weekend down in Florida to open the 2021 season. Sophomore Nia Carter leads the Hawkeyes with a .500 batting average with 10 hits and three RBI. Junior Riley Sheehy is also batting well at .385 with five hits and two RBI. The lowa pitching staff has seen five total Hawkeyes in the circle. Seniors Allison Doocy and Sarah Lehman have seen the most innings, holding ERAs of 1.93 and 2.77, respectively.
- Illinois is 5-1 to start 2021, including two big wins over then-No. 17 Michigan to end the first weekend in Florida. Junior Avrey Steiner is batting .500 with 11 hits and six RBI. Junior Kailee Powell and redshirt freshman Jaelyn Vickery are also hitting above .400 at .421 and .412, respectively. In the circle, five Fighting Illini pitchers have seen innings. Juniors Sydney Sickels and Addy Jarvis have pitched the most, with ERAs of 0.42 and 1.66, respectively. Illinois is receiving votes in two of the major polls.

LAST TIME OUT

- Penn State's opening weekend did not produce the results the team wanted, but the Nittany Lions showed lots of grit and a "never give up"
- Junior Lilia Crouthamel led the Nittany Lions at the plate through the six games, batting .313 with five hits and three RBI. Senior Dani Fey added three hits and led the team with a .417 on-base percentage, also drawing two walks.
- In the circle, junior Bailey Parshall pitched the most innings throughout the weekend. She recorded 11 strikeouts in game one against Wisconsin for her ninth career double-digit strikeout performance.

THE CLARISA CROWELL ERA BEGINS

- Head coach Clarisa Crowell was hired as the eighth head coach in program history on August 3, 2020.
- Crowell left Miami (Ohio) as the winningest coach in program history, posting a 209-182 record in eight seasons at the helm.
- Crowell was named the 2019 Mid-American Conference (MAC) Coach of the Year. She coached 12 student-athletes to first-team All-MAC honors, 10 to second-team honors, nine All-MAC Freshman Team recipients, and six National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) All-Region honorees. RedHawks student-athletes also excelled in the classroom with 40 NFCA Scholar-Athletes and 32 Academic All-MAC honorees during Crowell's
- Crowell brought in assistant coach Stephanie Sanders with her from Miami while also adding hitting expert Jeff Tylka to her staff who has head coaching experience at Loyola Chicago.

WE'RE PARSHALL TO **BAILEY'S** STRIKEOUT SUCCESS

- Lefty ace Bailey Parshall registered 20 strikeouts opening weekend, including an 11-strikeout performance against Wisconsin in game one on Feb. 26.
- Her 11 strikeouts against the Badgers marks her ninth career double-digit strikeout performance.
- Parshall now totals 333 career strikeouts to move into seventh alltime in the Penn State record books, passing Marlaina Laubach (323, 2014-17).
- The Belle Vernon, Pa., native ranks seventh in the conference with an average 8.1 strikeouts per seven innings.

CROUTHAMEL LEADING AT THE PLATE

- Junior outfielder Lilia Crouthamel is leading the Nittany Lions at the plate after the first weekend of games.
- The Allentown, Pa., native is batting .313 with five hits and three RBI, which paces the team in both categories.
- Crouthamel's five hits is already a season-career high while the three RBI matches her season best from a year ago as she starts to find her stride in her junior campaign.

LEGG UP

- Redshirt senior Kennedy Legg tallied her first career triple in game one against Wisconsin on Feb. 26.
- Legg is averaging 0.20 triples per game, a stat that leads the conference and is 20th in the nation.

FRESHMEN IMPACT

- The Penn State freshmen have already played a key role in the team's lineup after the first weekend.
- Lauren Marcotte has started every game at shortstop for the Nittany Lions and recorded her first collegiate hit against Wisconsin in game two on Feb. 26. She has also scored two runs, tied for a team high.
- Outfielders Mel Coombs and Liana Jones have also been in the starting lineups, starting three games and two games, respectively. Both have recorded hits and Coombs has also driven in a run.
- Freshmen Amanda Mack and Emily Maddock have also made their Penn State debuts as pinch hitters.

B1G STREAM

In partnership with FloSoftball, Big Ten Network+ is streaming all 84 total games played down in the Big Ten

UNPRECEDENTED SEASON

- Like all teams and sports across the country, Penn State will face an unprecedented season in 2021 among the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic.
- The Nittany Lions will play a leagueonly schedule, with all 44 scheduled games against Big Ten opponents.
- 32 of those games will consist of eight four-game series on campus sites, different than the traditional threegame conference series in years past.

HOME SWEET HOME

- Penn State is scheduled for 16 games inside the friendly confines of Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field in 2021.
- Those 16 games include four, fourgame series against Big Ten opponents.
- The Nittany Lions will host Ohio State April 2-4 for their first home series.

10 YEARS OF NITTANY LION SOFTBALL PARK AND BEARD FIELD

- Penn State is celebrating 10 years of its beautiful stadium and facility, Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field, in 2021.
- The state-of-the-art facility was dedicated and first utilized during the 2011 season after the generous support of many.
- It is widely considered one of the best softball-only facilities in the Big Ten Conference and across the country.

2020 IN REVIEW

- The 2020 season obviously did not end how any coach or student-athlete wanted due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic.
- The Nittany Lions ended with an 11-15 record but were just starting to pick things up as the season got cut short.
- Then-sophomore Bailey Parshall led Penn State in the circle with a 7-6 record in 20 total appearances. She held a 2.51 ERA and struck out 129 batters in just 89.1 innings. Parshall pitched eight complete games, and had three shutouts and one save.

In the batters' box. Penn State had productive at-bats from then-freshman Maggie Finnegan who hit .306 with 15 hits and 4 RBI. Redshirt junior Kennedy Legg returned to play in 2020 after missing the previous season due to injury. Legg hit .299 making appearances in all 26 games with 20 hits and 8 RBI. Then-sophomore Melina Livingston also started to heat up in the box before the season ended, posting a .274 batting average with 20 hits and a team-high 14 RBI.

ON DECK

Penn State will have a week off before starting traditional Big Ten-series play on campus sites. The Nittany Lions travel to Lincoln, Neb. to face the Nebraska Cornhuskers in four games, March 26-28.


