PENN STATE TRAVELS TO NEBRASKA FOR FOUR-GAME SERIES

The Penn State softball team, under first-year head coach **Clarisa Crowell**, travels to Lincoln, Neb. to face the Nebraska Cornhuskers in a four-game series, March 26-28, at Bowlin Stadium. All the games will be streamed live on Big Ten Network+.

SERIES HISTORY

- » Playing a Big Ten-only schedule in 2021, Penn State will face familiar opponents all season long.
- » The Nittany Lions are set to play a four-game series against the Cornhuskers. The teams will play a single game Friday night at 6:30 p.m. ET, a doubleheader starting at 1 p.m. ET Saturday, before concluding with a single game Sunday at noon ET.
- » Penn State trails Nebraska in the all-time series, 5-10. The two teams have not faced off since the 2017 season. The Cornhuskers swept the regularseason series in Lincoln, but the Nittany Lions won in the first round of the Big Ten Tournament in May in Ann Arbor, Mich.

SCOUTING NEBRASKA

- » Nebraska is 6-6 after the two bubble weekends in Florida to open the 2021 season. The Cornhuskers have one ranked win on the season, taking down then-No. 23 Michigan, 5-4, in extra innings during the second weekend of play at Sleepy Hollow Sports Complex.
- » Senior Tristen Edwards is pacing the Cornhuskers offensively, batting .375 with 12 hits and eight RBI. Edwards also has a team-high three home runs and a .511 on-base percentage.
- » In the circle, the Nebraska pitching staff holds a 2.47 team ERA. Senior Olivia Ferrell and junior Courtney Wallace have pitched the most innings at 36.0 and 35.0, respectively. Ferrell holds a 2.33 ERA with 35 strikeouts while Wallace is at a 2.80 ERA and 3-2 record.

LAST TIME OUT

- » Penn State struggled offensively during the second weekend down in the Big Ten "bubble", dropping both three-game series to Iowa and Illinois.
- » The Nittany Lions battled the Iowa Hawkeyes to back-to-back extrainning games, including a 12-inning battle in which junior Bailey Parshall pitched 11.1 innings with 11 strikeouts, her second double-digit strikeout peformance of the season.
- » Senior Dani Fey led Penn State with four hits that weekend and now has a team-high seven hits, batting .280 on the season. Fey had two hits and two RBI in the 12-inning game against Iowa, her first multi-hit and multi-RBI games of the season.

THE CLARISA CROWELL ERA BEGINS

- » Head coach **Clarisa Crowell** was hired as the eighth head coach in program history on August 3, 2020.
- » Crowell left Miami (Ohio) as the winningest coach in program history, posting a 209-182 record in eight seasons at the helm.
- » Crowell was named the 2019 Mid-American Conference (MAC) Coach of the Year. She coached 12 student-athletes to first-team All-MAC honors, 10 to second-team honors, nine All-MAC Freshman Team recipients, and six National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) All-Region honorees. RedHawks student-athletes also excelled in the classroom with 40 NFCA Scholar-Athletes and 32 Academic All-MAC honorees during Crowell's tenure.
- » Crowell brought in assistant coach Stephanie Sanders with her from Miami while also adding hitting expert Jeff Tylka to her staff who has head coaching experience at Loyola Chicago.

NEBRASKA GIRLS GOING HOME

- » Sisters Lexie and Logan Black are Nebraska natives, growing up in Omaha, Neb., approximately an hour away from Lincoln.
- » Both stated in a media availability earlier in the week their excitement to show their teammates their home state, as well as being able to see their family and have them watch their games, something they are not always able to do.
- » Lexie has started 10 games at first base for the Nittany Lions while Logan has made four appearances in the circle in her senior season.

2020 IN REVIEW

- The 2020 season obviously did not end how any coach or student-athlete wanted due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic.
- The Nittany Lions ended with an 11-15 record but were just starting to pick things up as the season got cut short.
- Then-sophomore Bailey Parshall led Penn State in the circle with a 7-6 record in 20 total appearances. She held a 2.51 ERA and struck out 129 batters in just 89.1 innings. Parshall pitched eight complete games, and had three shutouts and one save.
- In the batters' box, Penn State had productive at-bats from then-freshman Maggie Finnegan who hit .306 with

15 hits and 4 RBI. Redshirt junior Kennedy Legg returned to play in 2020 after missing the previous season due to injury. Legg hit .299 making appearances in all 26 games with 20 hits and 8 RBI. Then-sophomore Melina Livingston also started to heat up in the box before the season ended, posting a .274 batting average with 20 hits and a team-high 14 RBI.
