#### **QUICK HITS**

- Penn State will face its first ranked team of the season with No. 19 Michigan coming to town.
- Junior pitcher Bailey Parshall recorded nine strikeouts during the Maryland series to move into sixth all-time at Penn State for career strikeouts with 390. She is 10 away from 400 career Ks.
- Both redshirt senior Kennedy Legg and junior Ally Kurland carry fourgame hit streaks into the Michigan series after registering at least one hit in each game at Maryland.
- Sophomore Michelle Leone is the toughest to strikeout in the conference and stands top-35 in that category too (34th).
- The Nittany Lions are led by firstyear head coach Clarisa Crowell and her new staff who were hired in August 2020. Crowell picked up her first win at the helm on March 28 at Nebraska.

### NOTES & HEADLINES

#### PENN STATE BACK HOME TO HOST NO. 19 MICHIGAN

The Penn State softball team, under first-year head coach Clarisa Crowell, is back home at Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field to host the 19thranked Michigan Wolverines in a four-game series, April 30 - May 2. All the games will be streamed live on Big Ten Network+.

#### **SERIES HISTORY**

- Playing a Big Ten-only schedule in 2021, Penn State will face familiar opponents all season long.
- The Nittany Lions are set to play a four-game series against the No. 19 Michigan Wolverines, starting with a single game Friday at 5 p.m. A doubleheader will then be played Saturday starting at 1 p.m., while the series will conclude with a single game Sunday at noon.
- Penn State trails Michigan in the all-time series, 7-70. The Nittany Lions are looking for their first win over the Wolverines since the 2007 season when they beat a ranked Michigan squad, 5-2, in a non-conference game in Fullerton, Calif.
- The last time Penn State beat Michigan in a Big Ten game was on April 23, 2006 by a score of 4-2 at home.

#### **SCOUTING MICHIGAN**

- Michigan, led by 37-year head coach Carol Hutchins, is at the top of the Big Ten standings with a 24-5 record heading in to the final three weeks of the regular season. The Wolverines are coming off a two-weekend homestand where they swept Maryland, 4-0, and took the series over Northwestern, 3-1, after dropping the first game.
- Junior Lexie Blair is pacing Michigan offensively, batting an impressive .433 with 42 hits and 16 RBI. Senior Lou Allan leads the Wolverines with 25 RBI thanks in part to a team-high seven home runs. Allan and five other players also have at least 20 hits on the season.
- In the circle, the Michigan pitching staff holds just a 1.01 team ERA, the lowest team ERA in the country. Junior Alex Storako has pitched the most innings for the Wolverines at 100.0. She has an impressive 0.49 ERA with 177 strikeouts and six shutouts. Storako has been named Big Ten Pitcher of the Week four times this season. Senior Meghan Beaubien has been just as dominant, with a 1.41 ERA in 94.1 innings, including 136 strikeouts and three shutouts of her own.

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

- Penn State hit the road last weekend for a four-game series at Maryland. The Terrapins took the series, 3-1.
- Game one of the series Friday was a pitchers' duel between junior Bailey Parshall and Maryland's Jennifer Brann. Both had six strikeouts and stranded five runners on base, but the Terrapins pulled through with the lone run of the game in the bottom of the sixth for the win. They then took game two by a five-inning score of 11-1.
- Game three Saturday was another defensive battle, but this time the Nittany Lions won, 1-0, for their first shutout of the season. Lefties Vanessa Oatley and Parshall combined for the shutout in the circle with Oatley earning the win and Parshall the save.
- Junior Chelsesa Bisi batted in the eventual game-winning run in the top of the fourth with two outs, her second game-winning hit of the season.
- Maryland won by walk-off in the final game Sunday to take the series.

#### WE'RE PARSHALL TO BAILEY'S STRIKEOUT SUCCESS

- Lefty ace Bailey Parshall has 77 strikeouts so far this season, including two double-digit strikeout peformances.
- She recorded 11 strikeouts against Wisconsin on Feb. 26 as well as against lowa on March 11 for her ninth and 10th career double-digit strikeout
- Parshall now totals 390 career strikeouts to move into sixth all-time in the Penn State record books, passing Marisa Hanson (388; 2001-04). She is 10 strikeouts away from 400 career Ks.
- The Belle Vernon, Pa., native ranks fourth in the conference and 50th nationally with a 5.13 strikeout-to-walk ratio.
- Parshall was credited with a save in game three against Maryland on April 24 for her first of the season and seventh in her career. She now moves into third alone all-time for career saves, passing Jackie Hill (6; 2007-11).

#### TWO HOT BATS

- Both redshirt senior Kennedy Legg and junior Ally Kurland currently carry four-game hit streaks into the Michigan series after registering at least one hit in each game at Maryland last weekend.
- Kurland is now tied for a team-high 12 hits, including three doubles, one triple, and two home runs.
- Legg has nine hits with the same amount of multi-base hits as Kurland.

#### **KURLAND POWER AT THE PLATE**

- Junior Ally Kurland had a powerful weekend at the plate, both offensively and defensively, against Rutgers.
- Kurland totaled five hits and four RBI in the series, holding a .500 batting average and impressive 1.300 slugging percentage. Three of the five hits were multi-base hits, including two home runs in the same game.
- The catcher hit two home runs in game one of Saturday's doubleheader that scored three of the four total runs in the game. It marks the first multi-home run game for an individual player since Destiny Weber hit two at Alabama last season (2/22/20). It also ties a program record.
- The Burke, Va., native also made 19

putouts through the series, and made a critical play at the plate to keep Rutgers from scoring another run in game three.

#### **CLUTCH CROUTHAMEL**

- Junior Lilia Crouthamel is having the best season of her collegiate career so far, totaling career bests 11 hits and 10 RBI, including three multi-hit games and three multi-RBI games.
- The outfielder from Allentown, Pa. had a single game career-high three RBI against Rutgers in the final game of the series as she went 2-for-4 at the plate with the eventual game-winning two-out two-RBI double in the bottom of the sixth.

#### **LEAN ON LEONE**

- Sophomore Michelle Leone has been steady on both sides of the ball for Penn State.
- The Ponte Vedra Beach, Fla., native has 10 hits and six RBI, including a tied team-high three doubles.
- Leone also leads the team in walks drawn with 10, and has only struck out twice in 53 at-bats to make her the toughest player to strike out in the conference. She also ranks 34th in that category nationally.

#### COOMBS' CAREER DAY IN LINCOLN

- Freshman Mel Coombs had a career day in the series finale at Nebraska, going 4-for-5 at the plate to lead Penn State to its first victory of the season.
- The Mechanicsville, Md., native hit her first career home run in the top of the fourth.
- Coombs' four hits is the most hits in a single game by a Nittany Lion since the 2018 season when Delaney Elling had four against Ohio State (4/11/18).
- Coombs is batting a team-high .289 with 11 hits and four RBI. She also has a team-high .500 slugging percentage with her two home runs.

#### **OATLEY ENERGY**

- Sophomore left-handed pitcher Vanessa Oatley shows a lot of energy and heart in the circle, often shown by her end-of-frame celebrations.
- Oatley is having a good second year in the circle, with a 3.05 ERA and a 3-2 record in 43.2 innings.
- In 9.0 innings pitched during the Maryland series, she only gave up one run on five hits.
- The South Kingstown, R.I., native is also fifth in the league and 53rd in the nation in walks allowed per seven innings, only allowing 1.28.









## **NOTES & HEADLINES**

#### FRESHMEN IMPACT

- The Penn State freshmen have already played a key role in the team's lineup this season.
- Mel Coombs is leading the team with a .289 batting average and .500 slugging percentage.
- Lauren Marcotte has played in 14 games, and has four hits and been solid defensively playing shortstop and third base.
- Outfielder Liana Jones and infielder Emily Maddock have been in the starting lineups periodically. Both have registered a hit, and Maddock also has a RBI.
- Amanda Mack has also made her Penn State debut as pinch hitter. She made her first career start in game two against Ohio State.

#### UNPRECEDENTED SEASON

- Like all teams and sports across the country, Penn State will face an unprecedented season in 2021 among the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic.
- The Nittany Lions will play a leagueonly schedule, with all 44 scheduled games against Big Ten opponents.
- 32 of those games will consist of eight four-game series on campus sites, different than the traditional threegame conference series in years past.

#### PENN STATE ON BTN

- The Nittany Lions will be featured on national television on the Big Ten Network for their May 14 matchup at Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field against the Minnesota Golden
- All home games will be streamed live on the subscription-based Big Ten Network+ if not televised.

#### THE CLARISA CROWELL ERA BEGINS

- Head coach Clarisa Crowell was hired as the eighth head coach in program history on August 3, 2020.
- Crowell left Miami (Ohio) as the winningest coach in program history, posting a 209-182 record in eight seasons at the helm.
- Crowell was named the 2019 Mid-American Conference (MAC) Coach of the Year. She coached 12 studentathletes to first-team All-MAC honors. 10 to second-team honors, nine All-MAC Freshman Team recipients, and six National Fastpitch Coaches (NFCA) Association honorees. RedHawks student-athletes also excelled in the classroom with 40 NFCA Scholar-Athletes and 32 Academic All-MAC honorees during Crowell's tenure.
- Crowell brought in assistant coach Stephanie Sanders with her from Miami while also adding hitting

expert Jeff Tvlka to her staff who has head coaching experience at Loyola Chicago.

#### **HOME SWEET HOME**

- After 699 days, Penn State finally got to play its first home series at Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field against Ohio State, April 3-4.
- Penn State is scheduled for four total four-game home series this season.

#### 10 YEARS OF NITTANY LION SOFTBALL PARK AND BEARD FIELD

- Penn State is celebrating 10 years of its beautiful stadium and facility, Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field, in 2021.
- The state-of-the-art facility was dedicated and first utilized during the 2011 season after the generous support of many.
