MONDAY NIGHT FÚTBOL: PENN STATE HOSTS NO. 15 PITT ON FS1

The Penn State men's soccer team, under fourth-year head coach Jeff Cook, starts a three-game homestand as it hosts in-state foe Pitt on Monday, Sept. 13 at Jeffrey Field. The match will broadcast live on FS1 with Dave Popkin (pxp) and Monica Moore (analyst) on the call starting at 7 p.m.

LAST TIME OUT - TWO SECOND-HALF GOALS LIFT NITTANY LIONS OVER PENN

- » Penn State scored twice in the second half to top in-state foe Penn Friday evening in Philadelphia.
- » The Quakers struck first, netting a goal in the ninth minute of action as a shot slide just under the outstretched arms of junior goalkeeper **Kris Shakes**. This would be the only shot on goal Penn would get off in the match.
- » The Nittany Lions pressured the backline to find the equalizer in the first 45 but were unable to do so.
- » Penn State held the majority of the possession in the first half and transitioned that into the early stages of the second half.
- » In the 52nd minute, the Nittany Lions took advantage of a Penn mistake as the Quaker keeper came off his line in an attempt to clear a long pass and sophomore **Peter Mangione** secured the ball and found junior **Andrew Privett** in the box and Privett slotted it into the back of the net to tie the match.
- » With the clock just crossing the 80-minute mark, junior **Alex Stevenson** headed the ball into the box to the feet of classmate **Liam Butts** and Butts blasted a low shot to the far post for the eventual game-winning goal.

OFFENSIVE WEAPONS

- » Penn State's offense has weapons at every position on the pitch, making it difficult for opposing defenses to keep the ball out of the back of the net.
- » Eight different players have already recorded points this season with junior midfielder **Andrew Privett** leading the Nittany Lions with seven points on three goals and an assist.
- » Captain of the midfield, **Seth Kuhn**, paces the team with four assists.
- » Penn State averages 13.8 shots per game and 6.75 shots on goal per game. Its 50.0 percent shot accuracy is first in the Big Ten and top-35 (35th) nationally.
- » For full national statistical rankings, see page six.

NATIONAL TV DEBUT

- » Penn State makes its debut on national television when it hosts No. 15 Pitt on Monday live on FS1.
- » The Nittany Lions also have four conference games on the Big Ten Network in the month of October.

KUHN IN THE MIDDLE

- » Senior vice captain **Seth Kuhn** has proven to be an integral piece in Penn State's play, especially on the offensive end creating scoring chances as a central midfielder.

NOTES AND HEADLINES

- » Kuhn paces the team with four assists to average 1.00 assists per game, a mark that is first in the league and second in the nation. The four total assists also leads the Big Ten and is tied for first nationally.
- » The Wyomissing, Pa., native has already matched his assist total from a season ago and is one shy of matching his career high (5, 2019).
- » He recorded multi-assist games against Syracuse (8/29) and American (9/6) for two on the year.

GAME-WINNERS ONLY FROM MANGIONE

- » Forward/midfielder **Peter Mangione** is clutch when needed most.
- » The Hunt Valley, Md., native has two goals so far this season, both eventual game-winners.
- » His two game-winning goals paces the Big Ten and is fourth nationally.
- » Mangione has eight career goals, six of which are game-winners.

PRIVETT IN FORM

- » Junior midfielder **Andrew Privett** is really playing well to start the 2021 season, currently pacing the Nittany Lions with seven points on three goals and one assist.
- » The Fallston, Md., native is fast on the wing in run of play and can also be dangerous in the box to find the back of the net.
- » His three goals is a career high, surpassing his previous best of two as a freshman in 2019.

FIRSTS FOR FEMI

- » Sophomore defender **Femi Awodesu** has had an outstanding start to year two in Happy Valley, recording his first career goal at West Virginia (9/3) and his first career assist against American (9/6).
- » The Philadelphia, Pa., native is also defending well on the backline, making crucial tackles and causing turnovers to help out goalkeeper Kris Shakes and get the Nittany Lions back on offense.

SHAKE YOUR GROOVE THING

- » Junior goalkeeper **Kris Shakes** posted a shutout against Syracuse (8/29) with six saves in his first game of the season in between the pipes.
- » Shakes has averaged 5.67 saves per game to stand first in the conference and 11th nationally in that category.
- » The Parkland, Fla., native has eight career shutouts and 20-3-2 career record.

NATIONAL RECOGNITION

- » After a tough result at West Virginia (9/3), Penn State dropped out of the United Soccer Coaches rankings, but is still receiving votes.
- » The Nittany Lions are still in the top 25 in two other polls: Top Drawer Soccer (No. 21) and College Soccer News (No. 20).
- » Penn State currently has five opponents ranked in the top 25: West Virginia (No. 5; L, 9/3), Maryland (No. 7; 10/26), Indiana (No. 9; 10/17), Pittsburgh (No. 15; 9/13), Akron (No. 16; 10/13).

MAC HERMANN TROPHY WATCH LIST

- » **Danny Bloyou** and **Pierre Reedy** were both named to the MAC Hermann Trophy preseason watch list on August 26.
- » Both are first-time members to the list after standout seasons in 2020-21 as United Soccer Coaches Third Team

All-Americans and first team All-Big Ten members.

PRESEASON HONORS

- » Senior forward **Danny Bloyou** is considered a second team preseason All-American by College Soccer News.
- » Bloyou was also named a Big Ten Player to Watch along with sophomore forward **Peter Mangione** and redshirt senior midfielder **Pierre Reedy**.
- » Bloyou and redshirt senior defender **Brandon Hackenberg** have also been ranked as No. 34 and No. 39, respectively, by Top Drawer Soccer in the preseason top-100 individual player rankings.

KEEP IT 100

- » Penn State returns 100 percent of its scoring offense in 2021, including top point scorers in **Danny Bloyou**, **Peter Mangione** and **Pierre Reedy**.
- » The Nittany Lions averaged 2.15 goals per game in 2020-21 to pace the league and rank 13th nationally.
- » They also had three games with four goals for the most four-goal games in a season since 2010.

FAMILIAR NAMES, FAMILIAR FACES

- » Penn State returns 21 players from the 2020-21 roster, including Big Ten Preseason Players to Watch **Danny Bloyou**, **Peter Mangione** and **Pierre Reedy**.
- » Redshirt senior **Brandon Hackenberg** also returns for extra season of eligibility granted by the NCAA due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- » Junior goalkeeper **Kris Shakes** returns in between the pipes for the Nittany Lions after another solid season where he held a 1.05 goals-against average and 0.782 save percentage in 11 starts.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK

- » Penn State added five newcomers to the 2021 roster in four freshmen and one graduate transfer.
- » The freshmen include midfielders **Sean Bettenhausen** (Media, Pa.), **Van Danielson** (Columbia, Md.), and **Ben Liscum** (Lewisburg, Pa.), and defender **Mani Diop** (Kaolack, Senegal).
- » Goalkeeper **Christopher Palacios** (Washington, D.C.) joins the Nittany Lions as a graduate transfer from Dartmouth.

OH CAPTAIN, OUR CAPTAINS

- » Redshirt seniors **Brandon Hackenberg** and **Pierre Reedy** will lead the Nittany Lions for the second-straight season as team co-captains.
- » Senior **Seth Kuhn** and sophomore **Peter Mangione** have been added as vice captains for a broader leadership group.

NEXT TIME OUT

Penn State continues its homestand as it opens conference play on Friday, Sept. 17, hosting Northwestern at Jeffrey Field at 7 p.m. The game will also be the team's Ninth Annual Mack Brady Match.

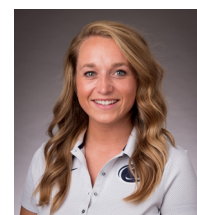
