Q: Twenty-four turnovers for the team today. How big of a role did that play in the loss?

If we just hone in and make it easier for ourselves, there's a lot going on in college basketball, but we try to make it simple. We just need to put more emphasis on what our game plan is in those five areas.

Q: What went into your offensive play and energy on the court today and how good did it feel to play like that?

A: Felt really good. I'm going to give it all to my coaches and my teammates. Obviously, the game plan and just reading the way Maryland covers our offensive game plan, it's super fun to play with Makenna Marisa. Coach had mentioned she had five assists and she was finding me open on the three-point line, which was great. I'm also proud of our freshman, Kayla Thomas. She stepped in, played more minutes today which was nice to see. Build up her confidence. I enjoyed playing tonight and that's why I came back to Penn State for my sixth year because I love this game and I know that Coach Kieger is going to do great things with this program, we're already on the way but it was a lot of fun.
