- Penn State hits the halfway point of its five-weekend long road stand to start the season with weekend three in Atlanta, Ga. for the I-75 Challenge.
- Senior pitcher Bailey Parshall threw a perfect game at FIU on Feb. 18 for the first perfect game by a Nittany Lion since 2005, and only the fifth all-time.
- The Nittany Lions are on a tear offensively to start the season, outscoring opponents, 34-13, with four batters hitting above .333 through the first two weekends.
- The Nittany Lions have a veteran roster in 2022, returning 18 players from last season, including 13 upperclassmen.
- Head coach Clarisa Crowell begins her second year at the helm of the Nittany Lions as they return to a normal schedule with nonconference games after playing a Big Ten-only slate in 2021.

PENN STATE HEADS TO ATLANTA FOR I-75 CHALLENGE

The Penn State softball team, under second-year head coach Clarisa Crowell, heads to the Atlanta, Ga. area for the I-75 Challenge, Feb. 25-27. The Nittany Lions will play doubleheaders at Georgia Tech (Friday) and Kennesaw State (Saturday) before finishing the trip with a single game at Georgia State on Sunday.

SERIES HISTORY

- » Having only faced Big Ten opponents in 2021, the Nittany Lions continue non-conference tournament play at the start of the new campaign.
- » The Nittany Lions are returning to the I-75 Challenge having last participated during the 2020 season prior to the COVID-19 shutdown. Penn State went 3-2 that weekend with a sweep (2-0) over Georgia State, a split decision (1-1) with Georgia Tech, including a 10-inning win in game two, and a loss against Kennesaw State in the finale.
- Penn State has a winning record all-time against all three teams: Georgia Tech, 5-3; Kennesaw State, 2-1; Georgia State, 4-0.

SCOUTING THE FIELD

- Georgia Tech is 10-2 through the first two and a half weeks of 2022 and has won five of its last six games. Graduate student Tricia Awald leads the Yellow Jackets with a .559 batting average with 19 hits and 10 RBI, plus a .941 slugging percentage. In the circle, junior Blake Neleman holds a 1.01 ERA in seven starts for a 6-1 record with a shutout and 61 strikeouts.
- » Kennesaw State has struggled through the first two weekends, with a 2-6 record including a four-game losing streak. Junior Cheyanne Sales paces the Owls with a .348 batting average with eight hits and four RBI. The pitching staff has a 5.33 ERA as junior Melanie Bennett has seen the most time with 23.1 innings pitched.
- Georgia State is also off to a slow start with a 2-6 record. Junior Bailee Richardson leads the Panthers offensively with a .385 batting average with 10 hits and nine RBI. In the circle, three Panther pitchers have seen nearly split time, with redshirt junior Emily Buck having the most starts (4) and innings (17.2) with a 4.36 ERA.

LAST TIME OUT

- Penn State carried its winning ways into the second weekend of play in Florida, going 3-1 in the Panther Invitational at FIU in Miami. The Nittany Lions shut out FIU twice and beat Cleveland State in the opener while narrowly falling to Buffalo on Saturday.
- On the offensie end, the bats were hot for the Nittany Lions with five players batting above .350 on the weekend and three of the four games totaling double-digit hits. Senior Ally Kurland led all players with a .563 batting average with nine hits, including five multi-base hits, and six RBI with a 1.125 slugging percentage. Junior Michelle Leone (.538) and sophomore Lauren Marcotte (.500) also batted well consistently while juniors Cassie Lindmark (.429) and Lexie Black (.364) added their first career home runs.
- » In the circle, senior pitcher **Bailey Parshall** made history with a perfect game against FIU on Friday, the first for a Nittany Lion since 2005 and only the fifth all-time. Parshall retired all 21 batters faced with no hits, no base runners, and 11 strikeouts. She also had another complete-game shutout against the hosts on Sunday.

PERFECTION

- » Senior pitcher **Bailey Parshall** made Penn State history Friday night at FIU with the first perfect game since 2005.
- » It marked only the fifth perfect game all-time, and only the second seveninning perfect game in program history. It was also the first no-hitter by a Nittany Lion since 2008.

LEAN ON LEONE

- » Junior Michelle Leone has been consistent at the plate for the Nittany Lions through the first two weekends, pacing the offense with a .458 batting average.
- $\,$ » The Ponte Vedra Beach, Fla., native is tied for the team lead with 11 hits and has added five RBI.
- » She is on a four-game hitting streak and has three multi-hit and two multi-RBI games this season.

MARCOTTE'S EMERGENCE

- Sophomore Lauren Marcotte has grown significantly from year one to year two, starting every game at shortstop through the first nine games of 2022.
- Marcotte is batting .346 with nine hits, five RBI and three runs scored, already personal bests from her rookie year.
- The Torrance, Calif., native is currently on a team-high six-game hitting streak after batting .500 on the weekend at the Panther Invitational.
- She is the eighth-toughest player to strikeout in the Big Ten.

ARE YOU NEW HERE?

- Junior transfer Cassie Lindmark has been solid through her first two weekends as a Nittany Lion after transferring from Kentucky in the summer.
- Lindmark has a .423 batting average with a tied team-high 11 hits and six RBI. She also has one of the best onbase percentage at .531 with six free hases
- She hit her first career home run in the Panther Invitational against Buffalo (2/19)
- The Lyons, III., native has had three multi-hit games and one multi-RBI

game.

Lindmark has also been effective » defensively, splitting time between catcher and designated player. She was behind the plate for Parshall's perfect game.

KURLAND POWER AT THE PLATE

- Senior Ally Kurland had a huge weekend at the plate in the Panther Invitational, leading the team in nearly every offensive category.
- Kurland batted .563 with nine hits and six RBI. Five of her nine hits went for multiple bases for a 1.125 slugging percentage, including two home runs, one of which was a game-winning three-run shot against FIU (2/20).
- The Burke, Va., native also scored a » team-high six runs throughout the weekend.

WE'RE PARSHALL то **BAILEY'S** STRIKEOUT SUCCESS

- Lefty ace Bailey Parshall reached and surpassed the 400 career strikeouts mark during opening weekend, and has 46 total strikeouts to start the season.
- Parshall sits second in the league and 51st ntaionally with a 0.82 ERA. She's fourth in the Big Ten and 63rd in the

nation with a 7.57 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

- » She is averaging 9.4 strikeouts per seven innings with her 46 total strikeouts third in the Big Ten and top-15 (12th) nationally.
- The senior sits sixth all-time in the Penn State record books for career strikeouts with 442, with a decent jump needed to tie for fifth with Jaci Kalp (1997-2000) at 535.
- The Belle Vernon, Pa., native owns 13 double-digit strikeout efforts after three so far in 2022.
- Parshall also has seven career saves to stand third all-time in that category.

LINGENFELTER CAME OUT SLINGING

- Righty pitcher Kylee Lingenfelter put together one of the best weekends of her career in the circle, going 2-1 in 14.2 innings with a complete-game shutout against Eastern Kentucky, the first solo shutout of her career.
- After a tough loss as the relief pitcher against No. 11 Missouri, Lingenfelter showed resiliency in the next matchup, pitching all seven innings against the Colonels of EKU, allowing no runs on five hits while adding five strikeouts.
- The Punxsutawney, Pa., native then pitched another full game in the

circle Sunday morning against Akron and stayed strong after giving up two early runs to help the Nittany Lions to the comeback victory. She tied a career best with seven strikeouts.

» Lingenfelter's 0.95 ERA is eighth best in the Big Ten and 112th nationally.

SPEED ON THE BASE PATHS

- » Penn State has been extremely successful on the base paths in going 12-for-14 in stolen bases.
- » Senior **Claire Swedberg** was perfect on the base paths opening weekend, going 4-for-4 in stolen bases in the leadoff position, including two against Pitt (2/13).

PENN STATE DEBUTS

- » Junior transfer **Cassie Lindmark** and freshman outfielder **Lydia Coleman** both made their Penn State debuts as starters against Mizzou in the season opener.
- » Sophomore **Amanda Mack** made her first career start as the designated player also against Missouri.
- » Freshman **Maddie Gordon** debuted as a pinch runner against EKU and again against UConn.
- » Freshman pitcher **Lydia Spalding** made her collegiate debut in the circle against Buffalo, throwing 1.1 innings with her first career strikeout.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK

- » Penn State softball welcomes four newcomers for the 2022 season, including three freshmen and one transfer.
- » The freshmen include Lydia Coleman (OF; Hoover, Ala.), Maddie Gordon (INF; Shenandoah, Va.), and Lydia Spalding (P; Youngstown, Ohio).
- » The Nittany Lions also added junior catcher **Cassie** Lindmark (Lyons, III.), a talented transfer from the University of Kentucky.

AGE AND EXPERIENCE

- » Penn State returns 18 players from 2021, including 13 upperclassmen, led by the senior class of Bailey Parshall, Lilia Crouthamel, Shelli Rivard, Kylee Lingenfelter, Claire Swedberg and Ally Kurland.
