Q: What wasn't clicking defensively?

A: We just weren't connected as a group, as a unit. And I take a lot of ownership in that, I made a lot of mistakes out there that I don't normally make. As a team, we just have to be better.

Q: The team struggled with turnovers again tonight, what's going on there?

A: We just have to be smarter with everything. We have to be more diligent about taking care of the basketball and value the ball more.

Q: What was happening offensively? [Getting the shots you wanted, but not falling]

A: That's it, the ball just wasn't going in. We had good shots, we got the shots we wanted. You put a lot of work into getting the shots up, but sometimes the ball doesn't fall in.

Q: Was there anything as to why the team wasn't able to get the counter-punch tonight?

A: Nebraska played harder than we did. Coach was trying to get the best five out there that he could, use a lot of rotations and substitutions. He was trying to get people that could give us a spark and we didn't have it.

Q: The game was played more at their pace, why do you think that happened?

A: We allowed them to play at their tempo. They set the tone early and we didn't adjust, to play at our speed and tempo. Playing at their tempo, they're really good. Playing at anybody else's tempo, it's hard to do when you're not used to it.
