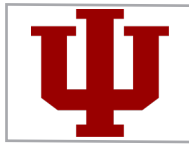

QUICK HITS

- » The Nittany Lions continue Big Ten play with five games in five days, starting with Indiana on Friday.
- » Penn State is coming off a 3-2 upset victory over No. 22 Michigan on Saturday. It was the Nittany Lions' first win over the Wolverines in 15 years and the program's first ranked road win since 2017.
- » Junior Cassie Lindmark played hero for Penn State in the win over Michigan, hitting the go-ahead home run in the seventh inning.
- » The Nittany Lions return to the comfy confines of Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field, where the Blue and White are 11-2 in 2022. Last time at home, Penn State swept Purdue in dominating fashion. It was the first series sweep for the Nittany Lions since 2016.
- » Head coach Clarisa Crowell continues her second year at the helm of the Nittany Lions as they return to a normal schedule with non-conference games after playing a Big Ten-only slate in 2021.

Penn State Softball Continues Big Ten Play with Five Games in Five Days

The Penn State softball team (23-15, 5-4 Big Ten) enters the final third of the season with five Big Ten contests in five days. The Nittany Lions host the Indiana Hoosiers (22-10, 5-4 Big Ten) over the weekend before traveling to Columbus for a doubleheader against Ohio State (24-10, 4-5 Big Ten) on Tuesday.

The Penn State softball team is coming off one of its biggest wins in 2022. The Nittany Lions downed No. 22 Michigan 3-2 on the road in Ann Arbor on Sunday. Cassie Lindmark's seventh inning home run was the difference as Penn State toppled Michigan for the first time in 15 years.

The Nittany Lions moved back above .500 in Big Ten play with a 5-4 record following the win against Michigan. Penn State returns home to the comfy confines of Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field, where the team has an 11-2 record, before heading back on the road for the team's second Big Ten road trip of the season.

SERIES HISTORIES

- » The Nittany Lions are 39-40 all-time against the Indiana Hoosiers, with the first meeting coming back in 1977. Last season, Penn State dropped the series to Indiana in Bloomington.
- » Penn State is 33-60 all-time against Ohio State. The Nittany Lions dropped the series against the Buckeyes in 2021.

SCOUTING THE HOOSIERS

- » The Hoosiers enter the weekend riding a four-game winning streak and boasting a 22-10 record, with a 5-4 mark in Big Ten play. Indiana has played stiff competition in 2022 against the likes of No. 3 Florida State, No. 1 Oklahoma, and No. 23 Ohio State. Their most notable victory was a 17-5 win over then-No. 23 Ohio State on March 25.
- » Last time out, Indiana swept Rutgers at home in a three-game series. The Hoosiers won the first two games in close contests, 6-4 and 5-4, before pulling away and winning game three 11-6. Indiana was set to face Purdue on Wednesday in a doubleheader, but those games were postponed.
- » Taylor Minnick and Cora Bassett are two offensive weapons for Indiana. Minnick, who is batting .463 on the year with three home runs and 15 RBI, was name Big Ten Freshman of the Week for the third straight week for her performance against the Scarlet Knights. She hit .667 with four hits, five runs, one home run, and a 1.500 slugging percentage. Bassett has seen more action than Minnick this season and has equally impressive numbers. The junior is batting .455 with a team leading 11 home runs and 25 RBI. She ranks first time the country in runs per game (1.41) and is second in doubles (14.)
- » The pitching staff is headed by sophomore Macy Montgomery and freshman Heather Johnson. Montgomery is 10-3 on the year while Johnson is 6-3. That duo has seen 158.2 combined innings for the Hoosiers this season. Brianna Copeland has also seen some action in the circle, having a 5-4 record over 41 innings pitched.

SCOUTING THE BUCKEYES

- » The Buckeyes come into the weekend 24-10 with a 4-5 record in conference play. Ohio State will play Iowa in Iowa City this weekend before facing off against the Nittany Lions in Columbus on Tuesday.
- » Last time out, the Buckeyes defeated in-state opponents Toledo 5-4 in Columbus on Tuesday. Last weekend, Ohio State plated a rough series against No. 10 Northwestern. The Buckeyes were run-ruled in game one 12-3 in six innings before dropping game two 9-8 and game three 7-1.
- » At the plate, the Buckeyes are led by committee. Sam Hackenbracht,

McKenzie Bump, Melina Wilkison, and Niki Carver are all solid contributors for the Ohio State offense. Hackenbracht paces the group with a .365 batting average and team leading 11 home runs and 32 RBI.

- » Lexie Handley is the ace of the Ohio State pitching staff and one of the better pitchers in the Big Ten. Handley is 13-6 with a 2.46 ERA with 168 strikeouts through 131 innings pitched. She is fourth in the Big Ten in innings pitched and strikeouts.

LAST TIME OUT

- » Last time out, Penn State concluded a weekend series at Michigan with a massive 3-2 over the No. 22 Wolverines. Ally Kurland and Cassie Lindmark both hit home runs in the win. Lindmark's seventh inning blast was the difference in the game.
- » It was the first win for Penn State over Michigan since 2007, when the Nittany Lions defeated No. 9 Michigan 5-2 at the Judi Garman Classic in Fullerton, Calif. It was the first Big Ten victory over the Wolverines since 2006 and the first at Alumni Field since 2005.
- » Lindmark hit .500 with two home runs, a 1.500 slugging percentage, and a .727 on base percentage over

the course of last weekend. She also reached base in her final seven at bats in the series.

QUEEN B

- » Senior Bailey Parshall continues to be the standout leader on the Penn State pitching staff in 2022. Parshall leads the Nittany Lions with a 13-6 record and a 1.57 ERA in 134 innings pitched.
- » Parshall's seven shutouts is the best mark in the Big Ten and the fifth best in Division I. Here 1.57 ERA is also the fourth best mark in the Big Ten.
- » Parshall was named Big Ten Co-Pitcher of the Week on March 21 after going 4-0 with two complete game shutouts. It was the second Big Ten weekly award of her career with her other honor coming in March 2020.
- » The gem of Parshall's season is her perfect game against FIU Feb. 18. The perfect game was the fifth in program history and second to be a seven-inning perfect game. Parshall's perfect effort is the first for Penn

KURLAND KILLIN' IT

- » Senior Ally Kurland has been one of the best sluggers in the Big Ten and country in 2022. She leads Penn State in home runs (14), RBI (35), and

slugging percentage (.786). Her 14 home runs this season is the third most all-time by a Nittany Lion in a single season. Her 14 doubles are also the sixth best mark all-time by a Nittany Lion in a single season.

- » After Penn State's sweep over Purdue, Kurland was named the Big Ten Player of the Week. Against Purdue and Bucknell, she batted .583 with seven hits, three home runs, and eight RBI while posting a 1.417 slugging percentage and .667 on base percentage. She was the first Nittany Lion to win the award since Alyssa VanDerveer in 2015.
- » In the first game against Purdue, Kurland hit two home runs and had five RBI. She tied the school record for the most home runs in a game and became the seventh Nittany Lion ever to record five RBI in a game.
- » On March 4, Kurland rocked a grand slam in the seventh inning as part of a 12-0 victory over North Carolina. Before Lilia Crouthamel's grand slam against Bucknell she was the first Nittany Lion to hit a grand slam since Toni Polk against Purdue on April 5, 2019.
- » Kurland also had a career-high six RBI off of her two-run double and

grand slam against the Tar Heels. Her six RBI are tied for the third-most in program history and the most by a Penn State player since Alyssa VanDerveer had a school-record seven RBI against Fordham on February 27, 2016.

LINDMARK LEADS THE WAY

- » Along with Ally Kurland, Cassie Lindmark's offensive output has helped create one of the most formidable one-two punches in the Big Ten.
- » After transferring to Happy Valley from Kentucky, the catcher from Lyons, Illinois leads the Nittany Lions in batting average (.416) and hits (47). She is sixth in batting average and third in on-base percentage (.521) in the Big Ten.
- » In the win over No. 22 Michigan, Lindmark's seventh inning home run was the difference that led Penn State to the upset victory. In Ann Arbor last weekend, she batted .500 with two home runs, a 1.500 slugging percentage, and a .727 on base percentage. She also reached base in her final seven at bats in the series.
- » Lindmark put up monster numbers on the way to being among the Louisville Slugger/Wilson D1 Top Performers of the Week on March 21. The junior hit .500 with eight hits and six RBI. She also had an on base percentage of .636 and a .688 slugging percentage.

ERROR FREE SOFTBALL

- » Penn State's defensive game in 2022 has been one of the best in the country.
- » The Nittany Lions' .975 fielding percentage is the second-best mark in the Big Ten and ranks 18th in the country.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

- » The Nittany Lions have hit a combined 52 doubles so far in 2022. That is the fifth-best mark in the Big Ten.
- » Aly Kurland's 14 doubles is the second-best mark in the Big Ten and seventh best in Division I.

HOME SWEET HOME

- » Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field has been kind to the Nittany Lions in the 2022 season.
- » Penn State is 11-2 at home in 2022, including a 7-0 record against non-conference opposition in Happy Valley.
- » Last time at home, the Nittany Lions swept Purdue in dominating fashion. Penn State outscored the Boilermakers 26-5 in the three game, including a 11-3 run-rule victory in game three. It was the first Big Ten series sweep for Penn State since 2016.

BACK IN BLACK

- » Junior infielder Lexie Black has contributed to the the Nittany Lions in the field and at the plate in 2022.
- » Black is third on the team in batting average (.280), hits (30), and RBI (24). Her eight home runs is the second best mark on the team.
- » In the team's doubleheader against Kennesaw State on February 26, Black hit two run home runs in both games, helping Penn State to two victories on the day.

LILIA "I LOVE DEFENSE" CROUTHAMEL

- » Senior center fielder Lilia Crouthamel has been a human highlight film in the outfield for Penn State in 2022. Her highlights include a spectacular diving catch against Saint Francis and gunning a runner out at home from dead center field against Purdue.
- » Crouthamel also had a grand slam in Penn State's 5-1 win over Bucknell last week. It was the first grand slam of her career and second home run as well. She was the second Nittany

Lion to hit one in 2022 and it was Penn State's third grand slam since 2019.

HYPE QUEEN IN THE CIRCLE

- » After returning from injury in Penn State's March 19 victory against UMass Lowell, junior Vanessa Oatley has been a big boost to the Penn State pitching staff.
- » Oatley is 3-1 with wins over UMass Lowell, Bucknell, and Purdue.

PENN STATE DEBUTS

- » Junior transfer Cassie Lindmark and freshman outfielder Lydia Coleman both made their Penn State debuts as starters vs. Mizzou in the opener.
- » Sophomore Amanda Mack made her first career start as the designated player also against Missouri.
- » Freshman Maddie Gordon collegiate debuted as a pinch runner against Eastern Kentucky. She made her pitching debut against No. 12 Oregon.
- » Freshman pitcher Lydia Spalding made her collegiate debut in the circle against Buffalo, throwing 1.1 innings with her first career strikeout.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK

- » Penn State softball welcomes four newcomers for the 2022 season, including three freshmen and one transfer.
- » The freshmen include Lydia Coleman (OF; Hoover, Ala.), Maddie Gordon (INF; Shenandoah, Va.), and Lydia Spalding (P; Youngstown, Ohio).
- » The Nittany Lions also added junior catcher Cassie Lindmark (Lyons, Ill.), a talented transfer from the University of Kentucky.

AGE AND EXPERIENCE

- » Penn State returns 18 players from 2021, including 13 upperclassmen, led by the senior class of Bailey Parshall, Lilia Crouthamel, Shelli Rivard, Kylee Lingenfelter, Claire Swedberg and Ally Kurland.

ON DECK

- » The Nittany Lions continue Big Ten play with a series in the Garden State against the Rutgers Scarlet Knights. Game one of that series is set for Friday, April 22 at 3 p.m. All games will be streamed on B1G+ (\$).
