## THIS WEEK

UNIVERSITY PARK, Pa. -- The Penn State Nittany Lion field hockey team (0-0, 0-0 B1G), under the direction of head coach Char Morett-Curtiss, will begin the 2022 season at home, hosting two national powers on the season's opening weekend. No. 11 Penn State hosts No. 12 Virginia (0-0) on Friday, Aug. 26, at 5 p.m. and No. 9 Louisville on Sunday, Aug. 28, at 12 p.m. Louisville will play Bucknell on the Nittany Lions' turf Friday night at 7:30 p.m. as well.

Penn State is coming off a 14-6 season that saw the team post a 6-2 mark in Big Ten games. The Lions earned a slot in the 2021 NCAA Tournament field but dropped an opening round game. This year's team returns all but a few players from that talented squad, including two first-team All-Americans, a number of All-Region players and nearly 10 athletes with starting experience.

Senior Mackenzie Allesie and junior Sophia Gladieux both return after being tabbed first team All-Americans, All-Region and All-Big Ten last year. Gladieux was the Regional Player of the Year as well. Gladieux led Penn State with 38 points off 18 goals and two assists last season while Allesie checked in with 30 off nine and 12.

Anna Simon returns for another year after earning All-Region honors in 2021 after a 33 points season (14 and 5). Senior keeper Brie Barraco, also an All-Region selection, returns after a 90 save season and senior Elena Vos, All-Region on defense, is back as well.

Virginia is coming off a 12-9 record, 3-3 in the ACC. The Cavaliers also advanced to the NCAA tournament a year ago, dropping a first round game as well. Penn State leads the all-time series 20-8, including a 3-2 overtime victory in the season opener last year.

Louisville, which plays Bucknell on Penn State's field Friday night, went 16-4 a year ago and posted a perfect 6-0 mark in the ACC to win the regular season title. The Cardinals, like Penn State and Virginia, was an NCAA tourney team a year ago and also dropped a tough first round contest. Louisville leads the all-time series 1-0.

**Fans are reminded to bring their own seating for games at the Complex this year as ongoing enhancement construction has made the bleacher seating unavailable.**

### ALLESSIE, REESE AND VOS VOTED TEAM CAPTAINS

Seniors Mackenzie Allesie, Meghan Reese and Elena Vos have been voted team captains by their teammates for the 2022 season. The trio have a combined 10 years of experience (with Reese returning for a fifth campaign). Allesie had 30 points last year, her first at Penn State. Reese has played in 70 games at Penn State, having started the last 54 straight. Vos has started all but one time during her storied Lion career (39 of 40 games).

### PARKING PAYMENT INFORMATION

- No charge with a valid Penn State parking permit
- Prepaid parking available through <https://psu.parkmobile.io/field-hockey-complex>
- \$5.50 through day before event, \$10 day of event
- \$40 season parking packages available through Thursday, Aug. 25
- Day-of-event payment also available using in-lot pay stations or the ParkMobile app (zone no. 95112)
- Fans who prepay for Stadium West or Jordan East parking through ParkMobile may also park at the Yellow H lots near the
- Shields and Wagner buildings except when they are posted as reserved for Bryce Jordan Center or Pegula Ice Arena event parking.
- On days when Field Hockey overlaps with a Men's Basketball, Women's Basketball or Men's Hockey game, ParkMobile prepayment and zone parking and pay station parking for Field Hockey will end two hours before those events, and cash only payment (\$10) will be collected at the lots by attendants for those without a valid permit or prepayment. When Field Hockey games overlap with a Bryce Jordan Center concert/show, day-of-event payment may be as high as \$30 for those without a permit or prepayment.
- \$1 per hour parking also available at the East Deck for most games

### PARKMOBILE PREPAYMENT INSTRUCTIONS

- Select game or season package at the bottom of the page
- Select parking area
- Enter the license plate information for the vehicle being driven to the event
- Note: If a different vehicle must be driven than the one registered at purchase, users must contact ParkMobile Member Support through the ParkMobile website or app (Settings & Chat Support) to request a vehicle change for that reservation.
- Purchase parking for the event
- Note: Guests must present their ParkMobile QR code to event parking staff on their mobile device, if requested. Printed permits from the ParkMobile website will also be accepted.

### IMPORTANT PARKING REMINDERS

- All vehicles must be parked with the license plate facing the drive aisle located closest to the parking space so that payment can be verified by parking enforcement staff.
- A valid permit or payment is required in event parking areas 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Vehicles parked without a valid permit or payment may be ticketed and/or towed at the owner's expense.
