#### KICKIN' IT

- No. 4 Penn State women's soccer hits the road to open its penultimate match week in Big Ten Conference play, as the Nittany Lions get set for a Thursday-night test against the Purdue Boilermakers. Kickoff is slated for 7 p.m. (ET) on Folk Field, with streaming available to a worldwide audience of authenticated subscribers via B1G+.
- The Blue & White return to work following a thrilling 2-1 victory over the Ohio State Buckeyes last Sunday on Jeffrey Field, with redshirt junior forward Kaitlyn MacBean booking her first collegiate brace to propel PSU. Penn State fell behind by a 1-0 margin early on, but a pair of scores from the Excelsior, Minnesota, native brought PSU its fifth B1G win.
- Penn State's defensive effort has been the most effective in the Big Ten Conference, with the Nittany Lions leading the league in goals-against average (0.462) and save percentage (0.870). The Blue & White rank 10th in Division I in goals against average and 14th nationally in save percentage.
- Graduate goalkeeper Katherine Asman garnered her second Big Ten Goalkeeper of the Week award of the 2023 campaign, the B1G office announced Tuesday afternoon. The veteran Nittany Lion shot-stopper turned back four Ohio State shots on goal and notched her 10th complete-match outing of the season. Additionally, Asman became just the fourth player in program history to join the illustrious 50-win club in a goalkeeping career.

#### PREPPING FOR PURDUE

- Led by nine-year head coach Drew Roff, Purdue enters Thursday evening's contest managing a 3-10-1 overall record coupled with an 0-5-1 start to Big Ten Conference play. The Boilermakers opened B1G competition with a narrow 1-0 home defeat against Northwestern, drew with Maryland and then dropped four straight against Rutgers, Iowa, Wisconsin and Indiana.
- On the pitch, sophomore forward Kayla Budish leads the team in scoring with eight points split between three goals and a pair of assists. Emily Mathews and Abigail Roy pace the squad with a quartet of assists apiece, while transfer keeper Charlotte Cyr paces the team with 46 saves.

#### STORY OF THE SERIES

- One of the most dominant all-time series in the Penn State record book, the Nittany Lions enter their 23rd meeting against the Boilermakers boasting a striking 19-1-2 overall record highlighted by a 17-match unbeaten streak and three-match win streak.
- The Nittany Lions make the trek to West Lafayette for the first time since the 2019 season, when the Blue & White registered a thrilling 2-1 win over the Boilermakers on Oct. 13.
- PSU and Purdue last met in the 2021 campaign, when the Nittany Lions edged the then-No. 19 Boilermakers by a narrow 2-1 margin on Jeffrey Field. Purdue's Sarah Griffith opened the scoring in the 58th, but PSU tallied two unanswered in the 62nd and 78th.

#### LAST TIME OUT: OHIO STATE

- Redshirt junior forward Kaitlyn MacBean equalized the match late in the first half and headed in the match-winning score with less than three minutes to play as No. 4 Penn State downed the Ohio State Buckeyes by a 2-1 margin Sunday afternoon on Jeffrey Field.
- Ohio State was victorious on the shot chart, outpacing Penn State by a 17-10 tally overall, but the Nittany Lions managed a slim 6-5 decision in shots on goal that proved to be fatal. The Buckeyes ran up an 8-2 edge in the corner kick battle and notched their only goal of the contest on a set-piece opportunity from a corner in the 36th minute. The Ohio State goal in the first period made Penn State the 336th and final team in NCAA Division I women's soccer to surrender a go-ahead goal in 2023.

#### READING THE RPI

- Penn State stands as the nation's No. 1 team in the most recent release of the NCAA RPI (rating percentage index), one of the most critical tools used in determining seeding and selection for the NCAA Women's Soccer Tournament.
- The RPI ranks teams based on wins, losses and strength of schedule. RPI is formulated by including a team's winning percentage, the winning percentage of the team's opponents, and the winning percentage of the team's opponent's opponents.
- The Nittany Lions maintain an RPI value of 0.721, leading second-ranked North Carolina. Penn State has held the top spot in the NCAA Division I RPI in each of the last three weeks.
- Penn State maintains the top spot in the nation's premier women's soccer conference. The Big Ten boasts the most top-40 RPI teams in Division I with eight, tying the SEC. Expanded to the top-60, the Big Ten and SEC each boast 10 teams, with the ACC and Pac-12 tying for third with seven each.

#### UNBEATEN.

- The Blue & White are off to their best start to a season since 2005, as the Nittany Lions maintain an unblemished 11-0-2 record. The 2005 squad is the only team in program history to maintain a longer unbeaten start, ultimately finishing the year unbeaten with a 23-0-2 overall record and a Women's College Cup appearance.
- Following the team's win over Princeton on Sept. 7, PSU's 30th varsity squad became just the second team in school history to complete the non-conference slate undefeated.
- Penn State's 5-0-1 start to Big Ten play marks the strongest start to Big Ten Conference competition since the 2014 campaign when the Blue & White started the B1G portion of its schedule with a 7-0 record before its first conference defeat against Rutgers.
- PSU is one of just eight NCAA Division I teams yet to drop a match in the 2023 campaign, ranking third nationally in terms of overall winning percentage with a 0.923 mark.

#### BALLIN' WITH BALANCE

- Penn State women's soccer boasts one of the most balanced attacks in the nation, with 18 different student-athletes logging at least one point through the first 13 matches of the season. In total, 26 members of the Nittany Lions' 30-woman roster have appeared in at least one match, with 15 earning starts.
- On the offensive end, 13 different Nittany Lions have amassed a total of 32 goals on the season. PSU's balanced offensive front has allowed eight student-athletes to score at least twice, with senior+ forward Payton Linnehan and redshirt junior forward Kaitlyn MacBean leading the team with five apiece. Sophomore Olivia Borgen and senior+ midfielder Cori Dyke each rank tied for third this year with four goals scored.

#### DESIGNING A DIFFERENTIAL

- The Nittany Lions maintain a striking +26 goal differential overall this season, the best scoring difference in the Big Ten Conference and the ninth-best mark nationally.
- Penn State's remarkable goal differential in 2023 is led by the nation's 23rd-ranked scoring offense, with PSU averaging 2.46 goals per match more than midway through B1G action. PSU's offensive average stands as the third-best in the Big Ten behind Nebraska (2.86) and Michigan State (2.57).
- The Blue & White have made a name for themselves on the national stage defensively, with PSU's back line producing the nation's 10th-best goals-against average (0.462). Penn State leads the Big Ten Conference, beating second-ranked Iowa by 0.08 goals per match.

# UNITED, WE RANKED

- Penn State debuted at the No. 10 position in the inaugural United Soccer Coaches poll of the 2023 season and has maintained a top-10 ranking in every subsequent release. The Nittany Lions currently stand as the fourth-ranked team in the nation for the fourth week in a row, securing the program's highest ranking since the 2020-21 spring campaign. Prior to the organization's Sept. 19 release, PSU owned the No. 6 spot for three consecutive weeks, matching the program's highest ranking from last year.
- The Blue & White stand as the highest-ranked team in the B1G this week, leading a group of five programs that were either ranked or receiving votes. The surging Wisconsin Badgers rose from the No. 20 position last week to No. 12 in the Oct. 10 release, while the Michigan State Spartans rose from the receiving votes category to the No. 20 position. Indiana made its return to the top-25, rising to the No. 25 spot, while Michigan remained in the national conversation in the receiving votes category. Penn State non-conference opponents North Carolina (3) and TCU (21) round out the six Nittany Lion foes in and around the United Soccer Coaches top-25.

## AWARD-WINNING WORK

- Graduate goalkeeper Katherine Asman hauled in her second Big Ten Goalkeeper of the Week distinction in 2023 this week, garnering recognition following her four-save win over Ohio State that marked her 50th collegiate victory since donning the Blue & White.
- Senior defender Eva Alonso, redshirt junior forward Kaitlyn MacBean and junior defender Mieke Schiemann have each landed individual placements on the TopDrawerSoccer National Team of the Week, with Alonso earning a spot on Sept. 19, Schiemann garnering a placement on Sept. 12 and MacBean appearing on Aug. 29.
- Senior defender Ellie Wheeler and senior+ midfielder Cori Dyke have both hauled in TopDrawerSoccer Honorable Mention National Team of the Week accolades this season, earning those honors on Aug. 22 and Sept. 26, respectively.
- In addition to Asman's accolade on Oct. 10, Penn State has hauled in three additional B1G weekly accolades through this point in the 2023 campaign. In the B1G's first release on Aug. 22, Dyke, as well as Asman brought home Defensive Player of the Week and Co-Goalkeeper of the Week, respectively. Senior+ defender Kate Wiesner landed B1G Co-Defensive Player of the Week honors on Tuesday, Sept. 19.

## PAYTON'S PLACES

- Senior+ forward Patyon Linnehan continues her dominant stretch of offensive performances in the 2023 campaign, leading the Nittany Lion roster in both goals scored and total scoring. The Douglas, Massachusetts, native is tied for the team lead on the squad with five goals and 13 total points through 13 matches started.
- Linnehan's scoring total of 13 points ranks 14th among Big Ten Conference women's soccer players, while her five goals place her as the No. 10 goal scorer in the B1G. In terms of shot on goal percentage (shot accuracy), Linnehan owns 15 shots on goal against 29 total shot attempts for a 0.517 rating in the category. Linnehan's shot accuracy ranks fifth in the Big Ten Conference overall.

## ASTOUNDING ASMAN

- Graduate captain and goalkeeper Katherine Asman is off to a dominant start in the 2023 campaign, boasting 13 starts with the Big Ten's best goals-against average (0.422) and the eighth-best GAA in all of Division I women's soccer. The team captain stands as the only Big Ten keeper to allow five or fewer goals in at least 13 appearances this season. Her exemplary start to the year landed her as a B1G Co-Goalkeeper of the Week in the conference's Aug. 22 release in addition to another recognition on Oct. 10.
- Asman made history in PSU's win over Ohio State on Oct. 8, as she became the fourth goalkeeper in program history to crack the 50-win club all-time. Asman joins Nittany Lion legends Emily Oleksiuk, Britt Eckerstrom and Alyssa Naeher on the list.
- Asman ranks prominently in the Penn State record book in multiple career goalkeeping statistical categories. The Roswell, Georgia, native has recorded the fourth-most saves in program history (279), ranks fifth in career shutouts (23), fourth in career minutes played (6,675) and owns the fourth-most GK wins in program history with 50.

## BEANY BALL

- Redshirt junior forward Kaitlyn MacBean has carved out a reputation for herself as one of the premier clutch players in the Big Ten Conference. The Excelsior, Minnesota, native has notched a quartet of match-winning goals for the Blue & White this season, booking the decisive score against West Virginia, TCU, Michigan State and Ohio State.
- MacBean's propensity for logging match-winning goals places her as the second-best clutch performer in the Big Ten Conference while tying for ninth nationally. She trails Nebraska star Eleanor Dale for the league lead in match-winners, with the Cornhusker tied for the Division I lead in the category with six this season.
- The ascendent Nittany Lion has already surpassed her single-season career high in goals scored with five this year. MacBean ranks second overall on the roster with 10 points in 2023.

## EVA'S EMERGENCE

- Senior defender Eva Alonso's return to Penn State's starting XI in the 2023 season has coincided with the team's resurgence to the top of the national conversation. The Madrid, Spain, native has started in all 13 Nittany Lion contests this year and has already surpassed her total minutes played from the 2022 campaign.
- Alonso notched the 15th instance of a Nittany Lion passing for three assists all-time in Penn State's rout of Maryland and became the first to accomplish that feat since Kate Wiesner did so in the second round of last year's NCAA Tournament.
- The senior owns seven total assists, the fourth-most in the conference and 21st-most nationally, while notching 0.54 assists per match, the fifth-best mark in the B1G and 26th-highest tally across Division I.

## CORI'S CORNER

- Senior+ midfielder and captain Cori Dyke is in the midst of her fifth and final season in Happy Valley coming off her most successful campaign with the Nittany Lions a year ago. The Littleton, Colorado, native rose into sole possession of the No. 9 position at Penn State all-time in matches started, securing her 98th career start against Ohio State.
- Dyke ranks tied for third on Penn State's roster in goals scored this season with four, matching sophomore midfielder Olivia Borgen's tally through 13 matches in 2023. Dyke has scored goals in every on-target shot she has attempted this year, highlighted by a pair of penalty kick goals and run-of-play scores against West Chester and Nebraska.
- In recognition of her efforts against UNC and WCU, Dyke was honored as the B1G Defensive Player of the Week on Aug. 22, followed by TopDrawerSoccer National Team of the Week Honorable mention accolades three weeks ago after notching the match-winner on a spectacular free kick against Nebraska.

## WHAT 2 WATCH 4

- In addition to Penn State's trio of Big Ten Players to Watch, the Nittany Lions also saw multiple student-athletes land recognition on a variety of preseason watch lists. Senior forward Rebecca Cooke led the way, garnering an appearance on the MAC Hermann Trophy Watch List in addition to garnering recognition as a United Soccer Coaches Forward to Watch. Cooke was also named the No. 19 preseason player in Division I by TopDrawerSoccer, who released their list of top-100 preseason players on Aug. 16.
- Senior+ defender Kate Wiesner also hauled in recognition from TopDrawerSoccer in the preseason, landing the national No. 86 ranking on the preseason top-100 players list.

## POWER OF THE PORTAL

- Penn State welcomed a trio of transfer athletes out of the portal prior to the start of the 2023 campaign, with all three individuals immediately eligible to play for the Blue & White this season. PSU signed the nation's returning scoring leader in forward Rebecca Cooke from Quinnipiac, All-B1G Second Team midfielder Rowan Lapi out of Northwestern and defender Michela Agresti, a two-time team captain from Boston College.
- PSU's trio of transfers amassed a combined 160 starts in their collegiate careers prior to arriving at PSU, adding a variety of depth and experience to the Nittany Lion field position groups. The newest crop of Nittany Lions played a combined 13,862 minutes before arriving in Happy Valley.

## RECRUITING ROUNDUP

- The 2023 Nittany Lion recruiting class ranked as the No. 9 squad in the nation according to TopDrawerSoccer, the organization announced on Monday, August 14. PSU welcomed a quintet of incoming freshmen student-athletes and bolstered its class with three Division I transfer performers.
- Penn State features a trio of incoming freshmen who were ranked inside the national top-150 by TopDrawerSoccer, highlighted by the No. 10 recruit in the country in Worcester, Massachusetts, native forward Nicollette Kiorpes. PSU also welcomed the nation's No. 20 prospect in Bolingbrook, Illinois, native defender Keegan Schmeiser as well as No. 148-ranked defender Kaelyn Wolfe out of West Chester, Pennsylvania. The Nittany Lion recruiting class also featured Chesterfield, Ohio, native forward Frankee Fleisher in addition to Downingtown, Pennsylvania, native defender Ava Rightmire.

## THE BIG LEAGUES

- For the 21st year in a row, the Penn State women's soccer program was selected as the preseason favorite to win the Big Ten Conference regular season championship following a preseason poll of the league's coaches, the B1G announced on Tuesday, August 15.
- Northwestern took the No. 2 spot behind the Nittany Lions, with Rutgers and Michigan State rounding out the top four slots. Wisconsin, Nebraska, Ohio State and Michigan were selected as preseason favorites to complete the eight-team Big Ten Tournament field. Additionally, each school saw three players selected as Big Ten Players to Watch in 2023, with Cori Dyke, Payton Linnehan and Kate Wiesner earning the nods from PSU.
- Penn State has been selected as the preseason favorite by the Big Ten Conference's women's soccer coaches in every season since 2003. Since that inaugural selection in the early 2000s, the Nittany Lions have hauled in 15 Big Ten Regular Season Championships in addition to six Big Ten Tournament titles.

## 30 FOR 30

- The Penn State women's soccer program celebrates its 30th varsity season in the 2023 campaign. PSU began as a club team in the 1970s and blossomed, ultimately reaching varsity status for the first time in 1994, publishing a winning record in the squad's inaugural campaign. The following season in 1995, Penn State began its 28-year NCAA Tournament streak that survives to the present day while simultaneously managing a 29-year streak of overall winning seasons.
- Penn State has won 20 Big Ten Regular Season Championships, nine Big Ten Tournament Titles, participated in five NCAA Women's College Cups and took home the 2015 National Championship. The Blue & White have combined for 500 all-time victories, and look to build on that rich tradition in 2023.

## UP NEXT

- No. 4 Penn State women's soccer gears up for its final road contest of the 2023 Big Ten regular season campaign, as the Nittany Lions get set to square off against the Northwestern Wildcats on Sunday, Oct. 15. Kickoff from Lanny and Sharon Martin Stadium in Evanston, Illinois, is slated for 5 p.m. (ET), with a national television broadcast provided via the Big Ten Network and FOX Sports App.

The Penn State women's soccer program saw five program alumnae participate in the 2023 FIFA Women's World Cup in Australia and New Zealand. Those five individuals represented five different national teams, signifying the diverse array of talent that the Penn State program attracts. Canada's Olivia Smith, Costa Rica's Raquel Rodriguez, Germany's Laura Freigang, Ireland's Marissa Sheva and American Alyssa Naeher rounded out the five Nittany Lions to appear on senior women's national teams at the event.

Five selections to the 2023 FIFA Women's World Cup stands as a tie for the fourth most among all collegiate programs, and the most in the Big Ten Conference. The Nittany Lions have a long track record of preparing student-athletes for success on the international level, with Head Coach Erica Dambach having previously served as an assistant coach for the four-time World Cup Champion and reigning Olympic Bronze Medalist United States Women's National Team. Multiple program alumnae have made history at the event, including Alyssa Naeher's groundbreaking score in a Round of 16 PK shootout in 2023 that marked the first instance of a goalkeeper converting on a penalty kick attempt in ANY FIFA World Cup, men's or women's.

# JEFFREY FIELD

## THE HOME OF THE NITTANY LIONS



Jeffrey Field, the home of Nittany Lion soccer, was dedicated on Sept. 29, 1972. Located in the heart of the Penn State athletic facilities complex with a picturesque view of Mount Nittany, the stadium was named in honor of the late Bill Jeffrey, legendary head coach of the soccer program from 1926-52. Jeffrey Field has been the host site for numerous NCAA and conference contests in men's and women's soccer. Games are frequently televised from Jeffrey Field, allowing a nationwide audience to view Penn State in action. Widely regarded as one of the finest grass surfaces in the country, Jeffrey Field was honored as the 2006 Collegiate Soccer Field of the Year by the SportsTurf Managers Association.

Dambach enters her 17th season at the helm in University Park heading into the 2023 campaign, Penn State's 30th varsity season.

The numbers that document PSU's success are staggering. The Nittany Lions have accumulated 20 Big Ten championships, with 11 coming under Dambach's watch, in addition to five Big Ten Tournament crowns in the Dambach era.

A two-time National Coach of the Year and five-time Big Ten Coach of the Year, Dambach has led her teams to 16 NCAA Tournaments, 11 Big Ten titles, five Big Ten Tournament titles and the 2015 NCAA National Championship.

In 21 years as a head coach and 17 seasons leading the Nittany Lions, Dambach has accumulated 309 career wins with a .711 winning percentage, one of the most dominant marks in all of college athletics.

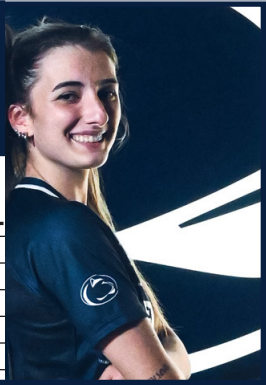

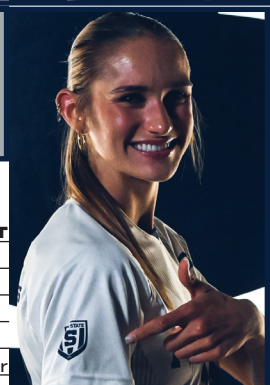
