## KICKIN' IT

- Fifth-ranked and second-seeded Penn State gets set for its first national quarterfinal appearance since 2018 on Saturday afternoon, as the Nittany Lions square off against the seventh-ranked and top-seeded Clemson Tigers in NCAA Division I Women's Soccer Championship action from Riggs Field. Kickoff is slated for 1 p.m. (ET), with streaming available to a worldwide audience of authenticated subscribers via ESPN+.
- PSU returns to action following an exhilarating 4-3 overtime victory over the sixth-seeded and 21st-ranked Saint Louis Billikens last weekend in Happy Valley. The Nittany Lions got out to a 2-0 lead but surrendered three unanswered goals before tying the match in the last three minutes on a Mieke Schiemann header. Payton Linnehan's strike in the 98th minute sent the Blue & White to the national quarterfinals for the first time in five years.
- Penn State will make its 14th appearance in the national quarterfinals all-time on Saturday, with the Nittany Lions advancing to the Women's College Cup on five prior occasions. The Blue & White maintain a 5-8 record in the quarterfinals all-time with their last win coming in 2015.
- Through three NCAA Tournament matches, Penn State owns the most goals, assists and total points in the tournament field of 64. Payton Linnehan leads all tournament participants in total goals (5) and points (11) while Kaitlyn MacBean ranks second in total assists with four.

## TAKING ON THE TIGERS

- Top-seeded and seventh-ranked Clemson prepares for its first national quarterfinal match since the 2020-21 spring campaign and just its second quarterfinal at home in program history, as the Tigers arrive in the Elite Eight boasting a 17-3-4 overall record. Clemson has suffered three losses this year, with two coming against Florida State and one against Notre Dame. The Tigers defeated Radford and Columbia before advancing past Georgia in PKs.
- On the pitch, Makenna Morris leads the team in scoring (24) and goals (9) while Jenna Tobia and Dani Davis pace the roster with eight assists apiece. Between the pipes, Halle Mackiewicz leads the team with 54 saves and a 0.783 save percentage.

## STORY OF THE SERIES

- Penn State will square off against Clemson for just the second time ever on Saturday afternoon, with the Nittany Lions picking up a win on Jeffrey Field in the only prior contest. PSU registered a hard-fought 1-0 win over the Tigers on Nov. 21, 1998 in the third round of the 1998 NCAA Division I Women's Soccer Championship. PSU's stay in the tournament concluded in the following round with a 3-1 quarterfinal defeat at Florida.
- The Nittany Lions will face a current member of the Atlantic Coast Conference in the NCAA Tournament for the 22nd time on Saturday afternoon, with the Blue & White looking to get back to .500, currently trailing ACC opponents by a 10-11 margin in the postseason.

## LAST TIME OUT: SAINT LOUIS

- In one of the most dramatic contests of the 2023 season, fifth-ranked and second-seeded Penn State overcame a late deficit against 21st-ranked and sixth-seeded Saint Louis to reach the quarterfinals of the NCAA Division I Women's Soccer Championship, logging a 4-3 overtime win over the Billikens to advance on Jeffrey Field Sunday afternoon.
- PSU published a dominant differential in multiple statistical categories, highlighted by an astonishing 24-13 margin on the shot chart overall, the fifth-most total shot attempts by a Nittany Lion squad this year. The Blue & White were also much more aggressive in placing shots on goal, doubling the Billikens up by an 8-4 tally. In the corner kick competition, the Nittany Lions booked three attempts against a lone try from Saint Louis.

## BONUS POINTS

- Since the start of the NCAA Tournament on Nov. 10, Penn State has been one of the most explosive offensive units in the nation. The Nittany Lions boast the highest scoring offense in the tournament, tied with Pittsburgh for the most goals per match with 4.33. The Nittany Lions also rank first in the tournament field in points per match (14.67), assists per match (6.00), total assists (18), total goals (13) and total points (44).
- Penn State's display of dominance in the tournament has the Nittany Lions ranked as the No. 2 team in the field in terms of goal differential, with PSU's +10 scoring margin trailing Florida State by a narrow one-goal difference.

## GETTING DEFENSIVE

- Penn State boasts one of the most dominant back lines in all of Division I women's soccer, leading the Big Ten Conference while ranking 13th nationally in goals-against average (0.579). PSU's backline and goalkeepers have allowed a mere 13 scores through this point in the 2023 campaign, and have surrendered multiple goals in a match just twice. PSU allowed two scores in a shorthanded 2-2 draw on the road at Northwestern and surrendered three goals in last weekend's third-round match against Saint Louis.
- Nittany Lion goalkeepers have dominated all opponents in the 2023 campaign, highlighted by starting shot-stopper and team captain Katherine Asman. The Roswell, Georgia, native ranks 16th in the nation and first in the B1G with an individual GAA of 0.577, while simultaneously leading the league in save percentage and ranking 13th nationally with a 0.867 mark. Penn State's trio of keepers have combined for a 0.859 save percentage, leading the B1G and ranking 12th nationally as a group.

## ON THE RECORD

- The Blue & White published one of the strongest regular season finishes in program history in 2023, logging the fourth regular season campaign at PSU all-time that featured one loss or fewer. Penn State finished both the 2020-21 and 2004 regular seasons with just one loss, while the 2005 squad went unbeaten on the year at 23-0-2.
- Following the team's win over Princeton on Sept. 7, PSU's 30th varsity squad became just the second team in school history to complete the non-conference slate undefeated.
- Penn State's 6-1-3 finish in Big Ten Conference competition this season marked the 17th B1G season in program history with one loss or fewer. The Nittany Lions finished fourth in the league with 21 points, their best league finish since winning the conference title in 2020-21.
- PSU is one of just 16 NCAA Division I teams to record two overall losses or fewer through this point in the year, booking the ninth-best winning percentage in the nation with a 0.818 mark.

## B1G TIME POSTSEASON

- The Big Ten Conference made history during the 2023 NCAA Division I Women's Soccer Selection Show, landing Indiana, Iowa, Michigan, Michigan State, Nebraska, Ohio State, Penn State, Rutgers and Wisconsin in the 64-team national tournament field.
- The nine NCAA Tournament selections set the Big Ten Conference record for the most postseason selections in a given season for women's soccer in league history. Five of the nine Big Ten programs earned top-six seeds in their respective quadrants of the bracket and played host to first round matches, with all five B1G first-round host institutions advancing to the second round. Penn State and Nebraska each earned the right to host second and third round matches after results in their respective quadrants and advanced to the national quarterfinals. The B1G is currently 10-7-0 in the 2023 NCAA Tournament.

## KEYSTONE STATS

- Penn State women's soccer ranks prominently among NCAA Division I programs in multiple statistical categories, with the Nittany Lions ranking inside the top 20 nationally in total assists (ninth, 56), winning percentage (ninth, 0.818), assists per match (10th, 2.55), goal differential (10th, +39), total points (11th, 160), save percentage (12th, 0.859), goals-against average (13th, 0.579), points per match (13th, 7.27), total goals (13th, 52) and scoring offense (19th, 2.36).
- The Nittany Lions rank first among all 14 Big Ten Conference member institutions this season in fewest fouls committed per match (7.50), goal differential (+39), goals-against average (0.579), save percentage (0.859) and winning percentage (0.818).

## BALLIN' WITH BALANCE

- Penn State women's soccer boasts one of the most balanced attacks in the nation, with 18 different student-athletes logging at least one point through the first 22 matches of the season. In total, 26 members of the Nittany Lions' 30-woman roster have appeared in at least one match, with 17 earning starts.
- On the offensive end, 14 different Nittany Lions have amassed a total of 52 goals on the season. PSU's balanced offensive front has allowed 10 student-athletes to score at least twice, with senior+ forward Payton Linnehan leading the way with 10 goals scored this year. Redshirt junior forward Kaitlyn MacBean ranks second on the squad with nine, while sophomore midfielder Olivia Borgen stands in third with six.

## UNITED, WE RANKED

- Penn State debuted at the No. 10 position in the inaugural United Soccer Coaches poll of 2023 and maintained a top-10 ranking in every subsequent release. The Nittany Lions earned the No. 5 ranking in the final regular season release after holding the No. 4 spot for five weeks earlier this season. The No. 4 mark was the program's highest ranking since the 2020-21 spring campaign. Prior to the organization's Sept. 19 release, PSU owned the No. 6 spot for three consecutive weeks, matching the program's highest ranking from last year.
- The Blue & White stood as the highest-ranked team in the B1G at the start of the NCAA Tournament, leading a group of five programs that were either ranked or receiving votes. The Wisconsin Badgers improved four spots following their B1G quarterfinal advancement over Rutgers, while the Nebraska Cornhuskers also saw a four-spot improvement by rising to No. 15. The B1G co-champion Michigan State Spartans fell eight spots following their upset loss against Iowa two weeks ago, while Indiana fell into the receiving votes category after their loss to PSU. Penn State non-conference opponent North Carolina (13) rounds out the five Nittany Lion challengers in and around the final United Soccer Coaches top-25 until the postseason.

## AWARD-WINNING WORK

- Penn State has hauled in a litany of weekly awards and honors over the course of the 2023 season, with redshirt junior forward Kaitlyn MacBean and senior+ forward Payton Linnehan each landing recognition from TopDrawerSoccer in this week's release from the organization. MacBean was named the National Player of the Week after her dominant performances against Santa Clara and Saint Louis, while Linnehan landed Honorable Mention accolades following her match-winner against the Billikens.
- MacBean, Linnehan junior defender Mieke Schiemann and senior defender Eva Alonso have each landed individual placements on the TopDrawerSoccer National Team of the Week this season.
- Linnehan, Senior defender Ellie Wheeler, senior+ midfielder Cori Dyke and sophomore midfielder Olivia Borgen have each hauled in TopDrawerSoccer Honorable Mention National Team of the Week accolades this season, with Dyke booking honorable mention recognition on two separate occasions this year (Sept. 26, Nov. 14).
- Graduate goalkeeper Katherine Asman led the way for Penn State during the regular season, appearing in the B1G weekly release on three occasions highlighted by back-to-back recognitions on Oct. 10 and Oct. 17. In addition to Asman's consecutive accolades, Penn State hauled in three more B1G weekly honors through the conclusion of the 2023 regular season campaign. In the B1G's first release on Aug. 22, Dyke, as well as Asman brought home Defensive Player of the Week and Co-Goalkeeper of the Week, respectively. Senior+ defender Kate Wiesner landed B1G Co-Defensive Player of the Week honors on Tuesday, Sept. 19.

**PAYTON'S PLACES**

- Senior+ forward Payton Linnehan continues her 2023 campaign, leading the Nittany Lions in points (24) and goals scored (10). Linnehan currently stands as the most prolific scorer in the 2023 NCAA Division I Women's Soccer Championship, logging five goals through the opening two rounds of play while contributing an assist in the second round against Santa Clara. Linnehan buried the match-winning goal in the 98th minute against Saint Louis to propel Penn State to its first quarterfinal since 2018.
- In Penn State's first round NCAA Tournament match against CCSU, Linnehan booked the 24th all-time hat trick in Nittany Lion history and first since Sam Coffey in 2021. The trio of scores marked her second career hat trick, making her just the fourth Nittany Lion in program history to score multiple hat tricks in a career. She joins Christie Welsh, Tiffany Weimer and Katie Schoepfer on the esteemed list.
- Overall, she ranks sixth among Big Ten Conference athletes and 53rd nationally in total goals scored, ranking sixth in the B1G and 71st nationally in total points. The Douglas, Massachusetts, native owns three match-winners this year, with two in the last three contests.

**BEANY BALL**

- Redshirt junior forward Kaitlyn MacBean has carved out a reputation for herself as one of the premier clutch players in the Big Ten Conference. The Excelsior, Minnesota, native has notched a quintet of match-winning goals for the Blue & White this season, booking the decisive score against West Virginia, TCU, Michigan State and Ohio State before booking the match-winning goal to propel PSU to its seventh-straight Sweet 16 against Santa Clara.
- MacBean's propensity for logging match-winning goals places her as the second-best clutch performer in the Big Ten Conference while ranking 13th nationally. She trails Nebraska star Eleanor Dale for the league lead in match-winners, with the Cornhusker ranking second in Division I in the category with eight this season.
- In the 2023 NCAA Division I Women's Soccer Championships, MacBean ranks second in the tournament behind Linnehan with three total goals and 10 total points, while also ranking second in the tournament field in total assists with four this postseason.
- MacBean's breakout redshirt junior season was rewarded by the conference office at the conclusion of the regular season, landing her as an All-B1G Third Team selection.

**LIVIN' LIKE 'LIV**

- Sophomore midfielder Olivia Borgen is in the midst of a breakout campaign for the Blue & White, ranking second on the Nittany Lion roster in total goals scored this season with six. Her performance in the regular season against Northwestern on the road featured her first collegiate brace, as well as a career-high tying two shots on goal. Borgen added her first collegiate assist in PSU's B1G quarterfinal win over Indiana and has booked a pair of assists in the NCAA Tournament.
- The Hanson, Massachusetts, native secured the first national accolade of her collegiate career on Oct. 17, as TopDrawerSoccer named her to the Honorable Mention National Team of the Week. The award made her the sixth different Nittany Lion to land weekly national honors this year.

**ASTOUNDING ASMAN**

- Graduate captain and goalkeeper Katherine Asman maintains the best statistical season by a goalkeeper in the B1G this year, boasting 22 starts with the conference's best goals-against average (0.577) and the 16th-best GAA in all of Division I women's soccer. She also leads the B1G and ranks 13th nationally in save percentage with a 0.867 mark. Asman hauled in a trio of B1G Goalkeeper of the Week accolades this season in addition to being crowned as the All-B1G Second Team goalkeeper following the conference office's release on Friday, Oct. 27.
- Asman made history in PSU's win over Ohio State on Oct. 8, as she became the fourth goalkeeper in program history to crack the 50-win club all-time. Asman joins Nittany Lion legends Emily Oleksiuk, Britt Eckerstrom and Alyssa Naehner on the list.
- Asman ranks prominently in the Penn State record book in multiple career goalkeeping statistical categories. The Roswell, Georgia, native has recorded the third-most shut-outs in program history (27), ranks third in career saves (318), third in career minutes played (7,479) and owns the fourth-most GK wins in program history with 55.

## EVA'S EMERGENCE

- Senior defender Eva Alonso's return to Penn State's starting XI in the 2023 season has coincided with the team's resurgence to the top of the national conversation. The Madrid, Spain, native has started in 21 of 22 Nittany Lion contests this year and has already significantly surpassed her total minutes played from the 2022 campaign.
- Alonso notched the 15th instance of a Nittany Lion passing for three assists all-time in Penn State's rout of Maryland and became the first to accomplish that feat since Kate Wiesner did so in the second round of last year's NCAA Tournament.

## CORI'S CORNER

- Senior+ midfielder Cori Dyke took home Big Ten Defender of the Year accolades, in addition to All-Big Ten First Team recognition following a release from the conference office on Friday, Oct. 27. She became the ninth recipient and seventh woman in program history to book the league's highest defensive honor.
- Against Santa Clara in the second round of the NCAA Tournament, Dyke moved into first place all-time at PSU for minutes played by a field position player with 8,854 minutes.
- Dyke is in the midst of her fifth and final season in Happy Valley coming off her most successful campaign with the Nittany Lions a year ago. The Littleton, Colorado, native owns the Penn State program record for matches started and matches played, booking her 107th in both categories during Penn State's NCAA third-round matchup against the Saint Louis Billikens.
- Dyke ranks tied for fourth on Penn State's roster in goals scored this season with five, setting a single-season career high in the category. Dyke has scored goals in five-of-six on-target shots she has attempted this year, highlighted by a trio of penalty kick goals against Monmouth, Michigan State and CCSU as well as run-of-play or set piece scores against West Chester and Nebraska. Dyke has added five assists in the 2023 season, moving her into third place on the team roster with 15 points scored this season.

## WEEZY BREEZY

- Senior+ defender Kate Wiesner continues her fifth year in Happy Valley and her fourth season of on-field competition in 2023. The Monrovia, California, native was dominant in her first full season as a routine starter a year ago, finishing with two goals, 11 assists and 15 total points in 2022. Wiesner ranked at the top of the Big Ten Conference in both total assists (11) and assists per match (0.48) last year.
- The Nittany Lions' starting left back stands alone in fourth place with five dishes through 20 individual matches played this year. Wiesner set a season high against West Chester with a pair of dishes in the contest, in addition to assists against Princeton, Nebraska and Saint Louis.
- The veteran Nittany Lion outside back has also tallied a pair of goals through this point in her fifth year, notching match-winning goals in the run of play against Maryland and Indiana during the regular season.

## POWER OF THE PORTAL

- Penn State welcomed a trio of transfer athletes out of the portal prior to the start of the 2023 campaign, with all three individuals immediately eligible to play for the Blue & White this season. PSU signed the nation's returning scoring leader in forward Rebecca Cooke from Quinnipiac, All-B1G Second Team midfielder Rowan Lapi out of Northwestern and defender Michela Agresti, a two-time team captain from Boston College.
- PSU's trio of transfers amassed a combined 160 starts in their collegiate careers prior to arriving at PSU, adding a variety of depth and experience to the Nittany Lion field position groups. The newest crop of Nittany Lions played a combined 13,862 minutes before arriving in Happy Valley.

## RECRUITING ROUNDUP

- The 2023 Nittany Lion recruiting class ranked as the No. 9 squad in the nation according to TopDrawerSoccer, the organization announced on Monday, August 14. PSU welcomed a quintet of incoming freshmen student-athletes and bolstered its class with three Division I transfer performers.
- Penn State features a trio of incoming freshmen who were ranked inside the national top-150 by TopDrawerSoccer, highlighted by the No. 10 recruit in the country in Worcester, Massachusetts, native forward Nicollette Kiorpes. PSU also welcomed the nation's No. 20 prospect in Bolingbrook, Illinois, native defender Keegan Schmeiser as well as No. 148-ranked defender Kaelyn Wolfe out of West Chester, Pennsylvania. The Nittany Lion recruiting class also featured Chesterfield, Ohio, native forward Frankee Flesher in addition to Downingtown, Pennsylvania, native defender Ava Rightmire.

## THE BIG LEAGUES

- For the 21st year in a row, the Penn State women's soccer program was selected as the preseason favorite to win the Big Ten Conference regular season championship following a preseason poll of the league's coaches, the B1G announced on Tuesday, August 15.
- Northwestern took the No. 2 spot behind the Nittany Lions, with Rutgers and Michigan State rounding out the top four slots. Wisconsin, Nebraska, Ohio State and Michigan were selected as preseason favorites to complete the eight-team Big Ten Tournament field. Additionally, each school saw three players selected as Big Ten Players to Watch in 2023, with Cori Dyke, Payton Linnehan and Kate Wiesner earning the nods from PSU.
- Penn State has been selected as the preseason favorite by the Big Ten Conference's women's soccer coaches in every season since 2003. Since that inaugural selection in the early 2000s, the Nittany Lions have hauled in 15 Big Ten Regular Season Championships in addition to six Big Ten Tournament titles.

## 30 FOR 30

- The Penn State women's soccer program celebrates its 30th varsity season in the 2023 campaign. PSU began as a club team in the 1970s and blossomed, ultimately reaching varsity status for the first time in 1994, publishing a winning record in the squad's inaugural campaign. The following season in 1995, Penn State began its 29-year NCAA Tournament streak that survives to the present day while simultaneously managing a 30-year streak of overall winning seasons.
- Penn State has won 20 Big Ten Regular Season Championships, nine Big Ten Tournament Titles, participated in five NCAA Women's College Cups and took home the 2015 National Championship. The Blue & White have combined for 516 all-time victories, and look to continue building on that rich tradition in 2023.

## UP NEXT

- The winner of Saturday's NCAA Tournament quarterfinal matchup between Penn State and Clemson will continue action at the 2023 NCAA Division I Women's College Cup, with the second-seeded Nittany Lions or top-seeded Tigers set to face either top-seeded Florida State or seventh-seeded Pittsburgh in the national semifinals. Both national semifinal matches will take place on Friday, December 1, with match time to be announced when available. All three matches at the Women's College Cup will air live to a national television audience on the ESPN family of networks, with live streaming available via the ESPN app.

The Penn State women's soccer program saw five program alumnae participate in the 2023 FIFA Women's World Cup in Australia and New Zealand. Those five individuals represented five different national teams, signifying the diverse array of talent that the Penn State program attracts. Canada's Olivia Smith, Costa Rica's Raquel Rodriguez, Germany's Laura Freigang, Ireland's Marissa Sheva and American Alyssa Naeher rounded out the five Nittany Lions to appear on senior women's national teams at the event.

Five selections to the 2023 FIFA Women's World Cup stands as a tie for the fourth most among all collegiate programs, and the most in the Big Ten Conference. The Nittany Lions have a long track record of preparing student-athletes for success on the international level, with Head Coach Erica Dambach having previously served as an assistant coach for the four-time World Cup Champion and reigning Olympic Bronze Medalist United States Women's National Team. Multiple program alumnae have made history at the event, including Alyssa Naeher's groundbreaking score in a Round of 16 PK shootout in 2023 that marked the first instance of a goalkeeper converting on a penalty kick attempt in ANY FIFA World Cup, men's or women's.

THE HOME OF THE NITTANY LIONS



Jeffrey Field, the home of Nittany Lion soccer, was dedicated on Sept. 29, 1972. Located in the heart of the Penn State athletic facilities complex with a picturesque view of Mount Nittany, the stadium was named in honor of the late Bill Jeffrey, legendary head coach of the soccer program from 1926-52. Jeffrey Field has been the host site for numerous NCAA and conference contests in men's and women's soccer. Games are frequently televised from Jeffrey Field, allowing a nationwide audience to view Penn State in action. Widely regarded as one of the finest grass surfaces in the country, Jeffrey Field was honored as the 2006 Collegiate Soccer Field of the Year by the SportsTurf Managers Association.

Dambach enters her 17th season at the helm in University Park heading into the 2023 campaign, Penn State's 30th varsity season.

The numbers that document PSU's success are staggering. The Nittany Lions have accumulated 20 Big Ten championships, with 11 coming under Dambach's watch, in addition to five Big Ten Tournament crowns in the Dambach era.

A two-time National Coach of the Year and five-time Big Ten Coach of the Year, Dambach has led her teams to 17 NCAA Tournaments, 11 Big Ten titles, five Big Ten Tournament titles and the 2015 NCAA National Championship.

In 21 years as a head coach and 17 seasons leading the Nittany Lions, Dambach has accumulated 314 career wins with a .710 winning percentage, one of the most dominant marks in all of college athletics.

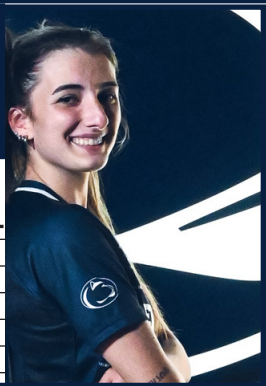

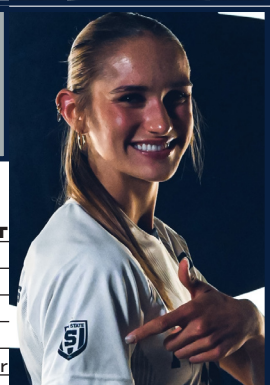
